LOBO BASEBALL QUICK HITS

- **We really are New Mexico ...** The 2016 New Mexico baseball team has 12 players from the state of New Mexico. It is no secret coach Ray Birmingham wants to take local kids all the way to Omaha. Ever since he got to UNM, he has been a big advocate of recruiting the best local talent New Mexico has to offer. In fact his rosters have had more players from New Mexico than any other state in each of his nine years at UNM.
- **Ken Jacome is Finally Smiling Again ...** After a weekend series in which UNM allowed 50 runs in three games, the Lobo pitching staff was back to its old self, limiting Nevada to 12 runs over three games. UNM's ERA is 6.10 for the season, but minus the lost weekend vs. Dallas Baptist, it's a solid 3.84
- **Bullpen Dominance ...** The UNM bullpen has been outstanding at protecting leads during the last several seasons. If UNM is leading after eight innings? Forget it. The Lobos haven't lost when leading after eight in 88 straight games, a streak that dates back to March 24, 2013.
- **Follow my lead ...** The Lobos have had their leadoff man reach in 57 of 125 innings, good for an inning-starting OBP of .456.

Career Notes

- Four straight NCAA regionals appearances (2010-13), first postseason berths for UNM since 1962
- Birmingham coached the Lobos to their first two MW Tournament Championships in 2011 and 2012. The Lobos also shared the regular-season crown in both 2012 and 2014, and won the league by a record seven games in 2013.
- Attained highest RPI in UNM history (No. 19) in 2010 and its highest ranking ever (No. 13 by *Baseball America*) in 2013.
- Earned his 1,000th collegiate victory with a 19-5 victory at Air Force on April 6, 2013.
- Coached his 1,500th collegiate game on Thursday, May 23, 2013, in the Mountain West Tournament against Nevada.
- The NMJC Thunderbirds won the 2005 NJCAA National Championship and were the national runners-up in 2007.
- Birmingham set the foundations for the programs at College of the Southwest (1988-89) and NMJC (1990-2007).
- Birmingham began his coaching career at Las Cruces Mayfield High School where the Trojans won the 4A championship in 1981 and had three No. 1 rankings through 1983.

HOME, SWEET HOME

On March 24, 2013, the UNM baseball team moved into its new old home. After spending most of the previous nine seasons at Isotopes Park, the Lobos returned to a newly renovated Santa Ana Star Field with astounding success. After losing two of their first five games in their new home park, the Lobos finished the season with 11 straight wins at home to post a 14-2 record at Santa Ana Star Field.

SCOUTING GRAND CANYON ... The Grand Canyon Antelopes are members of the Western Athletic Conference and they are in their last year of their transition period into Division I, as they were a former Division I powerhouse.

The have been led by Austin Bull and Thomas Lerouge, who are hitting .409 and 3.393 respectively. Lerouge's 24 hits lead the team, as does his three stolen bases. Overall, GCU's offense has hit .297 with six homers and slugged .414. On the mound, Jake Repavich is 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA in four starts, and UNM might see him briefly on Wednesday. Tuesday's starter is Tyler Wyatt, who is 0-1 with a 7.71 ERA in three start. He also has started eight games in the infield. Mick Vorhog is a superior closer, with a 2-0 record and three saves in six appearances. He has allowed just four hits and no runs in 6.2 innings.

BACK ON TRACK ... The Lobos got back on track against the Nevada Wolf Pack, going 2-1 in the opening weekend series of conference play for UNM after having the bye last weekend. The 2-1 record has the Lobos in a tie for second place (and most likely first but Nevada's 12-5 lead over Air Force isn't officially in the books yet as they will continue that suspended game later in the year).

UNM opened the weekend with wins of 8-3 and 3-2 before bowing 7-6 in the get-away game. Carson Schneider had his first career complete game in the win on Friday, allowing just six hits and three runs. Tyler Stevens then turned in 7.2 innings on Saturday, allowing just two runs before UNM's bullpen closed the door.

UNM nearly pulled off a nice comeback on Sunday, but stranded the tying run at second in the ninth inning.

FOLLOW MY LEAD ... The Lobos have had their leadoff man reach in 57 of 125 innings, good for an inning-starting OBP of .456.

ATTENDANCE UPDATE ... Through six home games the Lobos are averaging 1,018 fans, which is 60th in the country.

WE BE ILLIN' ... If New Mexico's lineup looked a little odd on Saturday, it was as five players were left at the hotel after coming down with some sort of quick bug. That led to Andre Vigil starting in right field, and eventually picking up his first game winning RBI of the season. It also forced Carl Stajduhar into his first game of the season at first base. He was tested too, making a diving stop down the line to keep a runner on second from scoring, which would have given Nevada a 1-0 lead in the fifth inning.

THE GINGER HAMMER (LOBO VERSION) ... While Roger Goodell is mockingly called the Ginger hammer by some media types... the real Ginger Hammer is Chris DeVito. Girthquake (as he is known on Twitter) picked up four hits over the weekend and extended his hitting streak to 12 straight games. The Mountain West Player of the Week back on March 7, DeVito's average this season is a robust .453, and his OPS is a staggering 1.309 for the season.

He hit his fourth home run of the season on Sunday, tying him for the team lead.

BULLPEN DOMINANCE ... The UNM bullpen has been outstanding at protecting leads during the last several seasons. If UNM is leading after eight innings? Forget it. The Lobos haven't lost when leading after eight in 88 straight games, a streak that dates back to March 24, 2013.

THE MANGHATTAN PROJECT ... It didn't take long for Lobo freshman Jared Mang to receive a nickname. Half a game, maybe? During UNM's opener on Feb. 19 at Hawai'i, TV broadcaster Sam Spangler, himself an Albuquerque native, coined the nickname "Manghattan Project" for the Los Alamos, N.M. native. Los Alamos of course was home of the laboratory for the Manhattan Project, and Mang, a two-time Gatorade State Player of the Year, has prodigious power. Mang lived up to the nickname in his first collegiate series by smashing two home runs against the Rainbow Warriors.

THOMSON RETURNS ... Senior Colton Thomson missed the final two and a half months of the 2015 season with an injury, and he made his return in dominating fashion on Feb. 21 at Hawai'i. He pitched six

shutout innings and allowed just two hits and one walk, all of which came in the fourth inning. He retired the first 10 batters he faced and the last eight in helping the Lobos romp to an 18-0 win.

HIT ME BABY ONE MORE TIME

... Despite standing just 5-foot-8 and being the shortest player in each of his four years on the Lobos, Jared Holley has become a baseball magnet. He was hit twice during UNM's season-opening series at Hawai'i, which moved his career total to 31. That is the second most in UNM history, just seven behind the leader, Joe Salas.

LOBOS TABBED CO-FAVORITES BY MW COACHES ...

The University of New Mexico baseball team was picked as co-favorites in the Mountain West by the conference's coaches. The Lobos received three first-place votes and 32 points overall to tie atop the standings with San Diego State. Junior outfielder Danny Collier, sophomore third baseman Carl Stajduhar and junior first baseman Jack Zoellner were named to the preseason All-Mountain West Team.

This is the fourth straight season the Lobos have been picked as at least co-favorites in the conference.

"It shows you the quality of our program and where we're going," UNM head coach Ray Birmingham said. "In the end, though, it's meaningless. You still have to play the games."

Air Force and Fresno State finished tied for third with 24 points, and the Bulldogs received the final first-place vote. UNLV (15) was picked fifth, just ahead of last year's regular season champion, Nevada (14). San José State finished seventh with six points.

Collier is one of just three players to repeat on the Preseason All-Conference Team, joined by junior outfielder Tyler Jones of Air Force

and junior utility player Trenton Brooks of Nevada. Collier, who was the MW 2014 Freshman of the Year and a First Team All-MW performer last season, is a career .349 hitter.

Stajduhar is one of just two sophomores on the preseason team. A 2015 Second Team All-MW player, he set a new UNM freshman record for RBIs with 53 on his way to a pair of Freshman All-America honors. He led the Lobos in hits (75), doubles (21), home runs (nine) and total bases (127). This year he has already been named a Preseason All-American by both College Sports Madness and Collegiate Baseball Newspaper.

Zoellner is UNM's leading returning hitter after posting a .352 average last season en route to Second Team All-MW honors. A career .330/.434/.492 hitter, he was also named to the Mountain West All-Tournament Team last year after hitting .450 (9-for-20) with nine runs, eight RBIs, four doubles and two home runs in the conference tournament in May.

PRESEASON HONORS ... Coming off a Freshman All-America season, sophomore infielder Carl Stajduhar has been named a Preseason All-American by both Louisville Slugger and College Sports Madness.

Junior left-hander Carson Schneider, meanwhile, was named the 260th best college prospect for the 2016 MLB Draft by D1Baseball.com.

BIRMINGHAM ELECTED TO NM SPORTS HALL OF FAME ... UNM head coach Ray Birmingham was elected to his third Hall of Fame this offseason when the New Mexico Sports Hall of Fame opened its doors for him. The official induction ceremony is April 3. He was previously elected to the NJCAA Hall of Fame in 2011 and the Lea County (N.M.) Hall of Fame in 2012.

NEXT FRESHMAN UP ... Five years running now the Lobos have produced a Freshman All-American, including a record three in 2015. It started with DJ Peterson and his NCAA-freshman record 32 doubles in 2011. Then Ryan Padilla hit .353 and helped UNM to Mountain West regular-season and tournament titles in 2012. In 2013 Sam Haggerty was honored after being named Co-MW Freshman of the Year and leading UNM with 49 walks. Last season Danny Collier followed in Haggerty's footsteps in earning MW Freshman of the Year honors and hitting .353 despite being limited by hamstring and heel problems. Last season Carl Stajduhar, Cory Voss and Tyler Stevens all earned the honor, with Stevens becoming the first pitcher in program history to be named a Freshman All-American.

So who's next up for the Lobos? UNM has several intriguing

possibilities including two-time New Mexico Gatorade High School Player of the Year Jared Mang. Austin Bell, Andrew Pratt and Austin Treadwell, each of whom hails from Albuquerque, should all receive ample playing time to make their case.

The opportunities will be there for all 12 of the Lobos' freshmen, and one thing is for sure: whoever is playing well will get his chance to be a Freshman All-American.

SANTA ANA STAR FIELD ... The Lobos have a new name for their old home in 2016. On Dec. 11, 2015, it was announced that the home of Lobo Baseball (formerly Lobo Field) would now be known as Santa Ana Star Field after a 10-year, \$1 million naming gift from Tamaya Enterprises.

PLAYING THE CREAM OF THE CROP ... Head Coach Ray Birmingham and the University of New Mexico baseball team face another daunting schedule in 2016. It features 17 games against teams that made the NCAA Tournament in either of the last two seasons, and is highlighted by a season-opening four-game trip to Hawai'i, and a three-game series at Lobo Field against Dallas Baptist, which was a No. 1 seed in last year's tournament.

In total UNM will play 32 games away from home in 2016 compared to just 24 at Lobo Field.

"Our schedule is tough again, just like always," said Birmingham, who is entering his ninth season at the helm of the Lobos. "There are no easy games on the schedule. We open in Hawai'i, and we hope our fans will come watch us for four days."

The Lobos begin the season against the Rainbow Warriors on Friday, Feb. 19 and conclude the series on Monday, Feb. 22. After the long flight back UNM will host

its home opener on Friday, Feb. 26 against traditional power Wichita State, which swept UNM in Kansas last season, as part of a three-game series.

Things won't get any easier for the Lobos the following weekend when Dallas Baptist comes to town.

"Wichita State is a storied program, and DBU was terrific last year," Birmingham said. "It's another exciting schedule with a lot of RPI points in it."

Tuesday, March 8 will mark the first of four midweek games the Lobos have scheduled against Rio Grande Rival New Mexico State. The two teams will play games in both Albuquerque and Las Cruces, but also Roswell, N.M., and El Paso, Texas, which will be the host of the first contest.

UNM opens Mountain West play the following weekend at Nevada, the 2015 regular season conference champion. A two-game, mid-week series at Grand Canyon concludes the six-game road trip.

However, after three games at Santa Ana Star Field against San José State March 18-20, UNM is back on the road for six more games. It begins with a Tuesday showdown in Lubbock, Texas, against Texas Tech on March 22, continues with a MW showdown with 2015 Tournament champion San Diego State, and concludes with two games in northern California against Sacramento State.

Following that, though, comes UNM's longest homestand of the season, albeit with an asterisk. Sandwiched between two MW series at Santa Ana Star Field versus UNLV April 1-3 and Fresno State April 8-10 is the Lobos' game in Roswell against NMSU on Tuesday, April 5, for which UNM is the designated home team.

The Lobos close the season with 10 of its final 13 games on the road, beginning with a three-game series at Arizona State April 29

through May 1. That's followed by a trek down I-25 to face off with the Aggies in Las Cruces for the fourth and final game of the year in the Rio Grande Rivalry on May 3.

Then it is three straight MW series to close the regular season. It begins with a trip to face UNLV, continues back in Albuquerque against Nevada, and concludes with a trip to Air Force, which will be UNM's only matchup with the Falcons in 2016.

However, the difficult end to the season comes with a bonus: the Mountain West Tournament will be held at Santa Ana Star Field from May 25-28. So unlike previous seasons, including 2015, UNM will not be on the road for two straight weeks while trying to clinch a spot in the NCAA Tournament.

SEASON PREVIEW ... Every season starts with the same goal for the University of New Mexico baseball team.

Omaha.

The coaches know it. The players know it. The team is reminded of it every day because there is a sign in the clubhouse pointing the way to Omaha, Nebraska, the home of the College World Series. It is 886 miles from Santa Ana Star Field to TD Ameritrade Park, but the journey is much more difficult than simply hopping on a flight.

"We've got a great team," head coach Ray Birmingham said. "If we can stay healthy then we will have an excellent chance to (reach the NCAAs)."

Catchers

After years of stability at the position ranging from Rafael Neda to Mitch Garver to Alex Real, the Lobos are in a little bit of flux at backstop this year. UNM lost its 2015 Freshman All-American, Cory Voss, this offseason when he decided to transfer, but that doesn't mean the Lobos don't have an answer. It's just unproven.

Junior Chris DeVito (.314, 6 HR, 39 RBIs) spent the majority of last season as designated hitter, but he currently is the front runner for the job. Sophomore Scottie Graham made 10 starts and appeared in 33 total games behind the plate last season and looks much improved from the .211 hitter he was as a freshman. Andrew Pratt, meanwhile, was picked as the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year by College Sports Madness and has loads of potential.

"Can DeVito hold up?" Birmingham asked. "We're going to find out. If not there are two guys right behind him and our philosophy is 'next guy up.'"

Both Pratt and Graham need to be ready for their opportunities as both will play. On Saturday in the Alumni Game DeVito started at DH, which allowed both Graham and Pratt to get some time behind the plate.

Infield

UNM is experienced at every position on the infield. Junior Jack Zoellner (.352, 4, 33) is the Lobos' leading returning hitter and was a Second Team All-Mountain West performer last year. Michael Eaton is a graduate transfer from the University of San Francisco where he played three seasons for the Dons, including two games at Santa Ana Star Field last year.

Sophomore Carl Stajduhar (.322, 9, 53) was a Freshman All-American after setting a UNM freshman record for RBIs in 2015. College Sports Madness picked him as its preseason Mountain West Player of the Year.

"I think Carl can play for Team USA," Birmingham said. "Offensively he's as good as anybody in the country. He's got all the accolades. He's going to hit for a high average, and he's going to hit a lot of doubles. And Jack is going to be really special. He's also

going to hit for a high average and hit some taters. And Eaton? Now that he is here and is buying in to his swing, he might just be the best hitter on the team."

The starter at shortstop is still undecided, but either way it will be a senior. Jared Holley has been a three-year starter for UNM at multiple positions, while Dalton Bowers started the majority of the games there last year before an ankle injury ended his season.

Sophomore Hayden Schilling will also factor into the infield, as will freshmen Aaron Corral and Jared Mang. Mang is a two-time Gatorade New Mexico High School Player of the Year from Los Alamos HS.

Outfield

The Lobos are absolutely loaded at talent in the outfield. First Team All-Mountain West junior Danny Collier (.346/.418/.433) is the likely starter in left once he is fully healthy. Sophomore Luis Gonzalez (.299, 4, 23) is a two-way athlete who excelled both in the field and on the mound last season and is poised to make a big leap this season. He will likely start in center field on days he is not on the mound. Redshirt sophomore Reece Weber hit .375 in 80 at bats last season and has a tremendous arm. He reached base in each of UNM's final 14 games in 2015. Junior Andre Vigil is also battling for playing time. He hit just .268 last year but drove in 30 runs and hit .311 as a freshman in 2014.

Freshmen Austin Bell, Jacob Westerman, Erick Migueles and Austin Treadwell are all talented, but they will need to produce in order to crack the everyday lineup. Mang will also see time in the outfield in order to get his bat in the lineup. He played a little in left in the Alumni Game last Saturday and hit a home run.

"We have some freshmen that are going to be really, really good," said Birmingham. "I'm really

excited to see their development. Athletically they're as good a class as we've had."

Starters

UNM lost its ace, lefty Toller Boardman, to the MLB Draft, but it still has plenty of options to turn to in a deep rotation. Back is senior southpaw Colton Thomson, who earned a medical redshirt after missing the last three months of the season last year. He went 6-6 with a 3.68 ERA in 2014. Also returning is sophomore Tyler Stevens, who was UNM's first pitcher to ever earn Freshman All-America honors. He set a Lobo freshman record with a 3.44 ERA, and on April 12 last season he threw the first nine-inning, one-hit complete game for the Lobos since 1965.

Joining the rotation full-time this year will be junior left-hander Carson Schneider. The Albuquerque native set a UNM freshman record for appearances in 2014 with 24 out of the bullpen, but he started six games last year and went 5-1 with a 3.68 ERA. He tossed 7.1 innings of one-run ball in the Mountain West Tournament to help the Lobos advance to the championship game.

"Carson Schneider, Tyler Stevens and Colton Thomson have turned into guys we can put out there against anybody," Birmingham said. "Our pitching staff has a chance to be as good as it has ever been."

The coaching staff also expects big things out of sophomore right-hander James Harrington (1-1 in five starts) and Gonzalez (4-2 in 16 appearances). And if senior Drew Bridges can regain his form from his freshman season when he went 3-1 with a 4.46 ERA in nine starts, and Birmingham thinks he can, that would add yet another element to UNM's rotation.

"Drew Bridges is back to being the Drew Bridges of old," he said.

Bullpen

Much like the rotation, the

UNM bullpen lost its statistical leader in Jake Cole (4 saves in 25 appearances), but they were not reliant on just one reliever last season. Schilling (3.38 and two saves in 17 appearances) was excellent at the back end of games, and the Lobos still have Victor Sanchez. The senior had 10 saves as a sophomore in 2014, but he struggled to find his form last year and recorded just two in 19 relief appearances. Still, he has a devastating breaking ball that can leave hitters diving out of the batter's box.

"Victor Sanchez is back to where he belongs at the back of the bullpen," said Birmingham. "We feel good about our situation there."

Fellow senior Alex Estrella, a left-hander, tied Cole for the team lead in appearances last year and went 2-2 in 30.2 innings. Junior college transfer Fernando Fernandez will also work out of the pen in the early goings. Three freshmen – Austin Isenhardt, Jaylyn Whitehead and redshirt freshman Jake Nelson – represent other left-handed options for UNM in the bullpen.

The most experienced reliever UNM has is senior right-hander Taylor Duree. He is only 12 appearances shy of setting a new Lobo record with 76 in his career. Other veteran right-handers include junior Preston Ryan (3-2 in 20 appearances) and junior Matt Villalobos, who is back after redshirting last season and transferring full-time to the bullpen after coming to UNM as a position player. Freshmen Christian Tripp and Gage O'Brien provide depth, as do Migueles and Treadwell who can both also work on the mound in addition to their outfield duties.

WE ARE NEW MEXICO ... The 2016 New Mexico baseball team has 12 players from the state of New Mexico. It is no secret coach

Ray Birmingham wants to take local kids all the way to Omaha. Ever since he got to UNM, he has been a big advocate of recruiting the best local talent New Mexico has to offer. In fact his rosters have had more players from New Mexico than any other state in each of his eight years at UNM.

LOBOS DRAFTED ... The New Mexico baseball program has had 91 student-athletes in its history drafted by Major League Baseball including a school-record seven in the 2013 draft. DJ Peterson led the way by becoming the highest draft pick in school history when the Seattle Mariners selected him with the 12th overall pick. Sam Wolff (sixth round - Texas Rangers) and Mitch Garver (ninth round - Minnesota Twins) gave UNM a trio of picks in the first 10 rounds. Alex Allbritton (21st round - Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim), Will Mathis (25th round - Seattle Mariners), Jake McCasland (26th round - San Francisco Giants) and Josh Melendez (37th round - Houston Astros) completed the record-setting draft for UNM. Last season left-handed pitcher Toller Boardman and second baseman Sam Haggerty were selected in the MLB Draft.

During Birmingham's tenure at UNM, New Mexico has had 23 players drafted and 26 have played professional baseball.

30-WIN SEASONS ... The Lobos are averaging 34 wins per year in the eight years under Ray Birmingham. UNM only reached that number eight times before the Birmingham era. The Lobos' run from 2012-14 (three straight 37-win seasons) was the most wins UNM has recorded in a three-year period. In 2010, New Mexico had the third most wins in program history. The Lobos are currently in the midst of the most successful eight-year stretch in
