Landstedt took over as head coach in 2007. Aljaž Praznik and Carl-Johan Öster are former student-athletes for the Lobos who are serving as assistant coaches for Nordic and alpine, respectively.

What to Look For

The University of New Mexico ski team has 35 consecutive top-nine finishes in the NCAA Championships. The team has one national title (2004), two runner-up finishes (1992, 2006), six third-place finishes (1984, 1993, 1994, 2009, 2010 and 2014) and three fourth-place finishes (2003, 2005, 2011).

The U.S. Cross Country Championships served not only as the opening competition for the 2018 season, but the first since the announcement that the team was being brought back. That announcement came on May 12 in front of the ski team and a packed board room for the May UNM Board of Regents meeting. It came one day shy of a month from the original announcement (April 13) that the team was slated to be cut due to budget measures.

Academic Successes

Despite the turmoil of April, 2017, the Lobo student-athletes of the ski program kept up their high academic standards. For the second straight season, the Lobo women's ski team earned the Athletic Director's Cup as the department's top academic program.

Additionally, Eva Sever Rus was named the winner of the Lou McKinnon Wellborn/Lobo Women's Society Fifth Year Scholarship.

Nineteen Lobos were also named to the 2017 RMISA All-Academic Team. The 19 student-athletes were the most of any RMISA program, and it represented 86.3% of the team. Alexander Barounos, Kyle Beling, Patrick Brachner, Vegard Busengdal, Julia Devaux, Brenna Egan, Julie Ensrud, Taylor Grauer, Katharine Irwin, Youri Mougel, Karoline Myklebust, Krista Niiranen, Kati Roivas, Niklas Rombock, Eva Sever Rus, Sydney Staples, Tyler Theis, Petteri Vaherkoski, Nicolas Veth were all honored by the league.



Irwin Nets Pair of GS Victories

Katharine Irwin now has three top five finishes in the giant slalom in 2018, including her first two career collegiate victories.

At Montana State, she won the MSU Invitational GS by .19 seconds over Colorado's Tonje Healey Trulsvrud, and it was her first career win. That win came on the heels of a fourth place finish the day before in the giant slalom RMISA qualifier. In her only other GS this season, she didn't finish her opening run in Utah.

Irwin made it a seasonal double by picking up a win in Denver in the Denver Invitational GS, giving her GS wins in half of this season's races.

Women's Alpine Win MSU GS

With Irwin leading the way in the Montana State Invitational GS, and backed by two other top 10 finishes, the women's team took the title in the MSU Invitational giant slalom, scoring 94 points. The team finished 14 points clear of Denver, who was second with 80 points.

Along with Irwin's 40 points, Rebecca Fiegl was fifth (scoring 29 points) and Haley Cutler was seventh (scoring 25 points).

Men's Alpine With Two Titles

Along with the women's team capturing the MSU Invitational GS, the men's team has won both the MSU Invitational GS and the Utah Invitational slalom. Combined UNM's alpine squads have won three of the eight races this season.

The men's team took the MSU Invitational giant slalom as Vegard Busengdal finished third (34 points) and Tyler Theis tied for fifth (28 points), tying his best-ever finish in a collegiate race. Rob Greig rounded it out for UNM with a 14th place finish (17 points). The Lobos nipped Utah 79-75.

A week later, the men's team won the slalom in Utah, paced by Busengdal's second career win (40 points). Isak Klein then had a career-best sixth place finish (26 points, finishing in a tie) and Yuri Mougel had a career-best 15th place finish (18 points). UNM picked up 84 points to finish nine clear of Colorado.

Busengdal Earns RMISA Honors

Busengdal was named the RMISA Alpine Skier of the Week after finishing first and fourth at the Utah Invitational. His win in the slalom was his second career victory and helped UNM win the race on that side, and then he finished fourth, giving him 71 points in the meet. He was the only men's alpine skier to finish in the top five in both disciplines.

Sindre's Excellent Adventure

You can forgive Sindre Tungesvik if he was confused about where he was when he woke up in Montana. Two days prior he was in Norway. In a span of about 60 hours, he went from Norway, to New York, to Albuquerque, to Salt Lake, to Bozeman, to West Yellowstone. He went to Montana for the second half of the Utah Invitational, which was moved due to a lack of snow.

He made that trip. His luggage didn't (lost in the shuffle from Norway). His skis didn't (ditto). He barely got sleep, but somehow, using an old set of team skis, borrowed poles and goggles from new teammate Carolyn Lucca, and thankfully making a trip to WalMart for socks and other sundries, Tungesvik amazingly led the Lobo Nordic contingent with an 11th place finish in the 10K Classic.

Tungesvik recorded the highest men's finish by a Lobo this season, missing UNM's second Nordic top 10 finish by just 4.4 seconds (Brenna Egan turned in a 10th place finish in Alaska). Tungesvik scored 22 points, and Niklas Rombock finished 23rd, scoring 12 points. Tungesvik didn't arrive at the team hotel until 2 a.m. that morning.

Faces In the Crowd

When you win a collegiate race ... let's face it, it doesn't make a big dent in the overall sports world. When you win your first collegiate race in the first official meet since the program was disbanded and then brought back, and the person that won the race was the unequivocal leader in terms of rallying support, including members of the U.S. Ski Team, namely Mikaela Shiffrin, that will in fact make a dent.

That's exactly what Katharine Irwin did, and due to those facts, she will be featured in an upcoming issue of Sports Illustrated for Faces in the Crowd. It is believed that she will be the first active UNM skier to make the popular list.

MVP Races

Probably not hard to believe this, but Vegard Busengdal is in the running for alpine men's MVP, as he currently sits second with one race to go. Busengdal has 227 MVP points, and sadly he won't be able to catch Ola Buer Johansen. While Busengdal is second, Rob Greig has moved into the top 10 in eighth place. The MVP takes the best four finishes in each of the two disciplines over the five-race season.

For the women, Rebecca Fiegl is currently fifth and Katharine Irwin is currently 10th, and with the lone race left being a giant slalom, that should favor Irwin, who should move up with a good finish.

Nik, Meet Your Teammates

Niklas Rombock wasn't just a Lobo in the opening meet ... he was the lone wolf. Literally. He was the only men's Nordic skier. Well, help has arrived. After Sindre Tungesvik's nutty journey to race, Erlend Nydal had a much saner trip. The UNM Invitational marked the first meet that the Lobos can score a complete set of three marks in all eight races. Nik got to meet the final Nordic teammate Rocardo Izquierdo-Bernier at the Denver Invitational.

Oh Yeah...Girls, This is Hanna

Not to be outdone, after the opening meet in Alaska that saw just Brenna Egan and Carolyn Lucca race, the Lobos added Andrea Klementová to the squad, and she now leads UNM in Nordic points with 56. Well, now those three can meet Hanna Varjus, who will make her Lobo debut this weekend in Crested Butte, giving UNM four women's Nordics.

Brenna's Big Race

Brenna Egan recorded her first career top 10 finish, coming in 10th at the U.S. Championships in the spring competition, her first collegiate top 10, and in fact, her first collegiate top 20. She has added three more top 20s since; in Utah in the 15K freestyle, coming in 19th place and 14th and 17th place finishes at the UNM Invitational.

Sindre Nets First Nordic Podium

Sindre Tungesvik picked up the first Nordic podium of the season, coming in third place at Crested Butte as a part of the 21K freestyle. Tungesvik's podium joined the four podiums posted by Vegard Busengdal and the one by Katharine Irwin.

Greig Earns First RMISA Honor

Rob Greig became the second Lobo skier to be named RMISA male alpine Skier of the Week, earning the honor after setting his career-best mark in the giant slalom and tying career-best mark in the slalom at the Denver Invitational. His teammate Vegard Busengdal was named RMISA male alpine Skier of the Week earlier in January.

Greig scored 55 points on the weekend for UNM, and he ran his streak of top 10 finishes to four straight with a pair of top runs at the Denver Invitational. Greig had a career-best finish in the giant slalom in Denver with a fifth place showing, and then he tied his career-best finish in the slalom with a sixth-place finish.
