

POST GAME NOTES: NEW MEXICO 105, CSUN 89

Team Notes:

- The Lobos are now 4-1 on the season
- Head coach Craig Neal is 63-39 (.617) in his career
- The Lobos shot 64.9 percent on the game which is a Wooden Legacy Classic record for shooting percentage in a single-game
- The Lobos are now 2-0 when shooting above 50 percent
- The last time the Lobos scored 100 points or more in a game was on Nov. 17, 2013 (109 against Charleston Southern)
- The Lobos are now 2-0 in the white jerseys
- The Lobos are 4-0 when they have more bench points than its opponent

Wooden Legacy Notes:

- New Mexico set the Wooden Legacy/Anaheim Classic single-game points record with 105.
 - Michigan State posted a 99-68 win over Boston College in the 2015 Wooden Legacy
 - UCLA posted a 99-77 win over Portland last night.
- The 194 combined points is a Wooden Legacy/Anaheim Classic single-game points record
 - The previous two-team single game mark was 176 when CS Fullerton defeated Charlotte 92-84 in overtime in 2008.
 - The most for two teams in regulation was 166.
- The 54 points by New Mexico sets a record for most points in the first half of a Wooden Legacy/Anaheim Classic game.
- The 54 points by New Mexico also ties the record for most points in any half.
 - Santa Clara had 54 points in the second half of a 2011 game with Oklahoma.
 - UCLA had 54 points in the second half of last night's game with Portland.
- New Mexico's 64.9 percent (37-57) sets a Wooden Legacy/Anaheim Classic single-game field goal percentage record. The previous best was 62.7 (37 of 59) by Michigan State in 2015 against Boston College.

Individual Game Notes

- Obij Aget had a career-high of 16 points.
- Tim Williams finished with 21 points for his fifth straight game in double-figures.
- Elijah Brown finished with 21 points for his third straight game in double-figures.
