CSUN KICKS OFF 62ND SEASON OF MEN'S BASKETBALL

CSUN Men's Basketball completes a short two-game road trip on Saturday night when the Matadors take on New Mexico at 6 p.m. The game will air live on the Mountain West Network while Ghizal Hasan will call the action in an audio broadcast on the CSUN Sports Network presented by Dignity Health.

The Matadors kicked off the 2019-20 season on Tuesday, falling at Oregon State, 87-67. Playing short-handed, the Matadors trimmed a 45-31 lead to 63-57 near the midway mark of the second half but the Beavers took control down the stretch. CSUN went cold for a six-minute stretch, giving Oregon State a chance to pull away for the 20-point win. Tres Tinkle led the way for the Beavers with a double-double (25 points and 10 rebounds).

Junior Terrell Gomez scored a team-high 19 points while sophomore Elijah Harkless scored a career-high 15 points and sophomore Darius Brown II added 13 points and eight rebounds. Gomez knocked down 4-of-8 shots from 3-point range in 36 minutes of play. As a team, the Matadors made 8-of-26 from downtown (30.8 percent) while they converted on 13-of-18 from the free throw line (72.2 percent).

Making their Matador debut on Tuesday, junior Lance Coleman II scored eight points and grabbed five rebounds while freshman Festus Ndumanya played 23 minutes and finished with three assists, two points and two blocks. Redshirt freshman Brendan Harrick also made his first official appearance on the floor, scoring two points in eight minutes of action.

We are now "CSUN" (See-Sun) and request that CSUN be used to refer to the school and its Division I athletic programs. Please do not refer to the school as "Cal State Northridge," "CS Northridge," "CS Northridge," "CS Northridge," and women's programs are the "Matadors" and there is no need to add "Lady" before any women's athletic program

Gomez moved into sole possession of second place on the Matadors' career 3-point field goals made list on Tuesday. He is now up to 186 career 3-pointers, four ahead of Ian Boylan (2001-05) on the list. The Matadors' all-time career 3-point leader Josh Greene (2010-14) made 228 treys, which are 42 ahead of Gomez. With 1,022 career points, Gomez is also in 19th place on the Matadors' career scoring list and 19 points back of Todd Bowser (1986-91) for 18th place.

New Mexico and CSUN have played six times before with the Lobos going 6-0 in those games. The teams met in a thriller at The Matadome in last season's opener, which saw New Mexico escape with an 87-84 win. Lamine Diane scored a game-high 34 points, setting a new school record for points by a debuting player. However, Anthony Mathis hit the game-winning 3-pointer at the buzzer to send the Lobos to victory. CSUN's last game in Albuquerque took place in the 2008-09 season when the Lobos picked up an 85-74 win. The Matadors seek their first win over a Mountain West Conference team since beating Wyoming (74-71) in Dec. 2000.

MATADORS' 2018-19 IN REVIEW

- CSUN posted its most overall wins last season since 2013-14
- The Matadors led the Big West in points per game (76.5), field goal percentage (46.0), steals per game (6.6) and block per game (4.5). CSUN finished second in 3-point percentage (36.1) and assists per game (15.1).
- Swept Cal Poly and UC Riverside during the league season while posting first win over UC Davis since 2014
- CSUN won the Continental Tire Las Vegas Classic Upper Division, beating SIUE and Rider during Christmas weekend. Lamine Diane earned MVP and All-Tournament honors.
- With a win over Pepperdine, the Matadors notched their first win over a West Coast Conference team since Nov. 2012 (San Diego) and their first road non-conference win since Dec. 2015 (Portland State).
- 26 of the Matadors' 34 games were decided by 10 points or fewer including 11 conference games
- Eight players made their CSUN debuts while seven made their Division I debuts. The team boasted seven true freshmen on the roster. **Terrell Gomez** was the only Matador to come into the season averaging at least 10.0 career minutes.

AN ALL-BIG WEST FIRST TEAMER

Junior Terrell Gomez was named to All-Big West First Team in 2018-19

- Led the league in 3-point field goals made (117) and minutes per game (37.7)
- Finished second in the Big West in points per game (19.2), third in free throw percentage (87.7), fifth in 3-point percentage (41.9) and 10th in assists per game (2.8)
- His 3-point total and minutes per game average both ranked eighth-best in the nation.
- Broke the Matador school record for 3-pointers made in a single season; Ranks second on the career list
- Scored the second-most points (652) in a season in team history in 2018-19
- Scored a career-best 32 points twice against the likes of UC Riverside (1/9/19) and Hawai'i (3/2/19)

DIANE AMONG THE NATION'S BEST

Sophomore Lamine Diane was named an AP All-American and Big West Player of the Year last season

- Became first Big West player to win Player of the Year, Freshman of the Year and Newcomer of the Year awards all in the same season
- Also took home USBWA and NABC All-District IX honors
- Led the nation in field goals made (340) and finished sixth in points per game (24.8) and rebounds per game (11.3)
- Only player in the country to average above 24 points, 10 rebounds and two blocks (2.2)
- Led all freshmen in the country in rebounds per game and ranked second in points per game
- Broke school record for points (818), rebounds (368), field goals made, blocks (72) and double-doubles (20)
- Topped 30 points seven times and grabbed 15 or more rebounds in six games
- Tied a CSUN Division I record with 39 points on 17-of-33 shooting at Cal State Fullerton (1/31/19)
- Posted 35 points with 15 rebounds, four blocks and four steals vs. Yale (1/5/19)

BACK FOR MORE

- Sophomore quard Elijah Harkless saw action in 18 games including two starts as a freshman. He averaged 3.9 points, 2.5 rebounds 2.1 assists for the year. Harkless posted career highs in points (13), rebounds (7), assists (6) and steals at Utah Valley (3/19/19).
- Sophomore center Michael Ou started 13 of 29 games last season, averaging 4.2 points and 2.4 rebounds. Ou shot 56.0 percent from the field over 16.1 minutes per game. He scored a season-high 12 points in an overtime win at Cal Poly (1/12/19). His best rebound effort came against Morgan State with nine (12/29/18).
- Redshirt sophomore forward Jared Pearre played in 30 games, making 13 starts primarily at center. He averaged 2.9 points and 2.7 rebounds while shooting 65.5 percent from the floor. Pearre posted his first career double-double in a win over Long Beach State (1/23/19) with 10 points and 10 rebounds.
- Sophomore forward Ron Artest III joined the Matadors at the beginning of Big West play last season and finished the year averaging 2.4 points and 2.1 rebounds over 12.4 minutes per game. Son of former NBA veteran Metta World Peace, Artest III scored a season-high nine points in a win at Hawai'i last season.
- Senior center Mahamadou Kaba-Camara saw action in 17 games last season, averaging 1.5 rebounds and 0.9 blocks per game. Kaba-Camara has played in 66 career games with the Matadors, averaging 1.2 points and 1.5 rebounds over 10.5 minutes per game.
- Junior guard Alex Sokol played in a career-high 72 minutes in 2018-19, averaging 1.6 points per game. His career-high in scoring came against New Mexico (11/6/18) with a five-point effort.

EXPERIENCED COACHING STAFF LEADING THE MATADORS

- Mark Gottfried has 11 NCAA Tournament appearances in his 21-year head coaching career. He spent six seasons at NC State, helping the Wolfpack advance to the Sweet Sixteens twice. Gottfried also guided Alabama to five NCAA Tournament trips including one Elite Eight. He won a National title as an assistant at UCLA in 1995.
- Assistant coach Jim Harrick led four schools to the NCAA Tournament including UCLA, Pepperdine, Rhode Island and Georgia. A former National Coach of the Year, Harrick guided UCLA to a NCAA Championship in 1995.
- Assistant coach Jeff Dunlap served as a head coach of the St. John's Edge of the National Basketball League of Canada. He worked as an assistant to Gottfried and Harrick in his extensive 31-year career.
- Assistant coach Mo Williams won an NBA Championship with the Cleveland Cavaliers in 2016, capping a 13-year career. A National Freshman of the Year, Williams played for Gottfried for two seasons at Alabama.

A CLOSER LOOK AT NEW MEXICO

The Lobos won their opening night game, 92-71 over Eastern New Mexico on Wednesday. New Mexico finished 14-18 last season and tied for seventh place in the Mountain West Conference with a 7-11 record. The team returns nine letterwinners from last season including three starters. Head coach Paul Weir is in his third season at the helm.

HEAD COACH MARK GOTTFRIED

Second Season • Alabama, 1987 • 415-262 Overall Division I Record

An 11-time NCAA Tournament coach, Mark Gottfried enters his second season leading the Matador men's basketball program in 2019-20. Gottfried is the sixth head coach in the history of the program.

Gottfried ushered in a new era of

Matador basketball this past season. He orchestrated a seven-game turnaround and guided CSUN to its most overall wins (13) and conference wins (7) in five seasons. The Matadors also played in a national postseason tournament for the first time since 2009 with an appearance in the College Basketball Invitational.

In 2018-19, CSUN's high-powered offense led the Big West in a host of categories including points per game (76.5), field goal percentage (46.0) and field goals made per game (28.5) while it finished second in 3-point percentage (36.1) and assists per game (15.1). The Matadors also paced the league in two defensive categories: steals per game (6.6) and blocks per game (4.5). During the year, the Matadors made team history by registering new records in field goals made (968) and blocks (154).

Under Gottfried, freshman Lamine Diane earned All-American honors and was named Big West Player of the Year, Freshman of the Year and Newcomer of the Year. Sophomore Terrell Gomez and Diane also earned All-Big West First Team accolades in Gottfried's first season.

Coaching in the Power Five Atlantic Coast and Southeastern conferences, Gottfried has a rich basketball background and track record of success in 21 seasons as a head coach, which includes stints at the University of Alabama, North Carolina State University and Murray State University. Prior to CSUN, Gottfried served as an assistant coach and scout with the Dallas Mavericks.

Gottfried has strong ties to the West Coast as an assistant coach under Jim Harrick at UCLA when the Bruins won the 1995 national championship.

Gottfried spent six seasons with NC State from 2011-17 where he led the Wolfpack to four NCAA Tournament appearances. He coached NC State to the Sweet Sixteen in his first season and back-to-back 24-win seasons in 2011-12 and 2012-13. In his second season at the helm, Gottfried guided NC State to a victory over top-ranked Duke, 84-76. He would lead the team to another Sweet Sixteen trip in 2014-15 after eliminating No. 1 seed Villanova.

Prior to NC State, he coached his alma-mater Alabama for 11 seasons as the Crimson Tide won two SEC championships and advanced to five NCAA Tournaments over that time. After coaching Alabama to an NIT runner-up finish in 2000-01, Gottfried led the team to a 27-win season and a conference championship. For his efforts, Gottfried was named 2002 SEC Coach of the Year. The next season, Alabama earned a No. 1 ranking in the AP poll for the first time in school history. In the 2003-04 campaign, Alabama upset top-ranked and top-seeded Stanford in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, and then defeated national champion Syracuse to reach the school's first-ever Elite Eight.

He began his head coaching career at Murray State where he became the first coach to win three Ohio Valley Conference titles in his first three years. The Racers advanced to the NIT in his first season and the NCAA Tournament in back-to-back years in 1997 and 1998. Murray State ranked 25th in the final AP poll with a record of 29-4 in 1997-98.

Gottfried's time on the sidelines began at UCLA as an assistant.

After making six-straight trips to the Big Dance, the Bruins won their first National Championship in 20 seasons in Gottfried's final year in Westwood. He also helped coach UCLA to the Elite Eight in 1992 and the Sweet Sixteen in 1990.

Gottfried began his collegiate playing career at Oral Roberts in 1983. In his only season with the Golden Eagles, Gottfried earned freshman All-American honors. He transferred to Alabama, where he started 98 consecutive games and helped the Crimson Tide advance to the Sweet Sixteen three-straight seasons. Gottfried left Alabama as the school record holder for the most 3-point field goals in a single game (8) and the all-time leader in 3-point field goal percentage (.485). After his collegiate career, Gottfried was selected in the seventh round by the Detroit Pistons in the 1987 NBA Draft.

He earned a degree in communications from Alabama in 1987. Gottfried received the Hayden Riley Top Scholar Award and the Bryant Award as the school's top scholar-athlete in his senior campaign.


