ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- Friday's game will kick off the 2018 Basketball Hall of Fame Classic in the STAPLES Center in Los Angeles, Calif.
- The Lobos enter Friday's game coming off of a solid road win at Bradley on Saturday, 85-75, and a tough loss at in-state rival NM State on Tuesday, 100-65. Friday's game will cap a three-game road stint within six days.
- Saint Mary's enters the game 5-4 on the season coming off of a pair of home victories against California (84-71) and Bethune-Cookman (93-61).
- Saint Mary's and the Lobos have played one similar opponent so far this season in New Mexico State. The Gaels topped the Aggies in a 15-point victory on Nov. 14, just three days before they traveled to Albuquerque. The final score was 73-58 in Las Cruces.
- The Lobos are 2-0 all-time against Saint Mary's, both games were in Albuquerque. Last time they met was on Dec. 28, 2001 when UNM earned a 72-62 victory. Their first meeting was on Dec. 17, 1968 in which the Lobos came out on top 77-55.
- Friday's game will mark the first time the teams have played in neutral territory.
- The Lobos are led on the season by senior Anthony Mathis (15.7 ppg), redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson (13.0) and junior Corey Manigault (12.8).
- Saint Mary's also has three players averaging in double figures including junior Jordan Ford (22.3), redshirt-sophomore Malik Fitts (14.8) and senior Jordan Hunter (10.2).

SCOUTING SAINT MARY'S

Saint Mary's is coming off of a 30-6 season in which the Gaels advanced to the NIT Quarterfinals. The team kicked off the 2018-19 season on a three-game win streak over McNeese State (87-65), Utah Valley (93-63) and NM State (73-58). The Gaels followed with a four-game losing streak that included a pair of neutral games against Utah State and Mississippi State and a pair of home games against Harvard and UC Irvine. They are on another victorious upswing, entering Friday night's game against the Lobos having won their last two.

Offensive standouts include junior Jordan Ford (22.3 ppg), redshirt sophomore Malik Fitts (14.8 ppg) and senior Jordan Hunter (10.1 ppg). Fitts also leads SMC on the boards with 8.7 rebounds per game.

ABOUT THE BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME CLASSIC

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, in conjunction with the STAPLES Center, is proud to host the 3rd annual Air Force Reserve Basketball Hall of Fame Classic presented by Citi. In this event, the Hall of Fame brings a college basketball triple-header to the entertainment capital of the world featuring some of the best college teams across the country.

Schools participating in this year's BHOF Classic include New Mexico, USC, TCU, No. 20 Arizona State and No. 6 Nevada.

LAST TIME OUT

Friday's game will mark the third Lobo game away from Albuquerque in six days. UNM earned a win over Bradley in Peoria, Ill. in one of the best showings for the Lobos this season. However, UNM followed it up with a rough rivalry contest in Las Cruces, falling to NM State by the largest deficit margin

against the Aggies since Jan. 3, 1959.

Despite the disappointing loss, the Lobos are still ranked ninth in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage (42.7) and 10th in 3-point field goals per game (11.2).

ON THE ROAD THUS FAR

The Lobos have lost just one game on the road this season with their defeat at NM State on Tuesday. Prior to that, UNM was 2-0 on the road with wins at CSUN and Bradley. Last season, Weir's Lobos did not see a road win until January 17 at UNLV.

WHEN OUTSHOOTING

The Lobos have outshot their opponent in four of their six games this season and are 3-1 when doing so. Tuesday's game marked the second time this season UNM has shot lower than its opponent, and the squad is 1-1 when being outshot.

TURNOVERS? NO PROBLEM.

While the Lobos have not done the best job protecting the basketball this season, posting 16.2 turnovers per game for a -1.3 turnover margin, it does not appear to be holding the Lobos back. UNM is 3-1 this season when having more turnovers than its opponent.

In fact, in Tuesday's loss at NM State, the Lobos had the least amount of turnovers than in any other game this season with 11.

"NEXT POSSESSION"

If one listens closely during a Lobo basketball game, he/she can hear "next possession" coming constantly from the bench. The "next possession" mentality focuses on letting go of mistakes from the past and focusing on promise of the future.

Throughout the first five games of the season, the Lobos shot 88.0 points per game and were ranked the 13th-best scoring team in the nation. Despite Tuesday night's tough loss at in-state rival New Mexico State, the Lobos are looking to move forward toward the "next possession."

THROW 'EM OUT

If you throw out UNM's pair of losses to the same team, the NM State Aggies, UNM averages 86.5 points per game for a +6.5 scoring margin and 11.5 3-pointers made per game.

IT'S RAINING THREES

Even in a loss, the Lobos are still shooting 10 or more 3-pointers per game consistently. The Lobos have achieved the feat in all six of their games this season. So far in 2018-19, the Lobos have scored 67 buckets from

behind the arc.

WELL-BALANCED SQUAD

In Tuesday night's game against the Aggies, senior leaders Anthony Mathis and Dane Kuiper were held almost quiet, combining for seven points. In their place, freshman guard Drue Drinnon and redshirt-sophomore guard Vance Jackson picked up the slack, scoring 13 and 11 points, respectively.

The Lobo squad is so balanced that nine of UNM's 11 players who have touched the court so far this season have scored in double figures at least once in the first six games.

AND THEN THERE WERE NONE ...

Sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk started the first four games for the Lobos and was the only consistent starter - until Saturday. Saturday's lineup against Bradley featured three freshman, senior Dane Kuiper and sophomore Makuach Maluach. The Lobos officially no longer have a single player that has started in all of their games.

In addition, senior Dane Kuiper marks the lone starter to return from last season and Saturday's game was his first time starting this season.

DOUBLE-DIGIT FIRSTS

Freshman Drue Drinnon and junior Karim Ezzeddine shined for UNM in a bleak overall performance at NM State Tuesday. The pair racked up their first double-digit games of the season - and of their career with the Lobos.

STANDOUT DRINNON

Rivalry games are typically full of nerves for freshmen, especially true freshmen. But freshman Drue Drinnon stepped up and stood out on Tuesday night while the rest of the Lobo squad struggled. He put up 13 points in the second half to try to power the Lobos to a comeback. UNM was outscored

by just seven points in the second half in the 35-point loss.

MATHIS 6TH IN THE NATION

Lobo senior Anthony Mathis is currently ranked sixth in the nation in 3-point field goals per game (4.0) and eighth in 3-point field goal percentage (55.8).

COUNTDOWN TO 1,000

With 387 points to go, it may seem a bit premature to begin counting down to 1,000 points for senior Anthony Mathis, but consider this: he has scored 94 points in just his first six games of the season. Last year, he finished his junior campaign scoring 433 at 12.7 per game, so far this season he is averaging 15.7 points per game.

Mathis currently has 613 career points.

LOBOS IN THE NATION

COMEBACK LOBOS CAN TRAIL

Saturday night's game against Bradley marked the first time all season that UNM had been leading at the half. So far this season, UNM has been tied at the break twice and been trailing three times. In three of those five games, the Lobos found a way to pull ahead or come back for the victory.

BREAKOUT KUIPER

In his past three seasons, senior Dane Kuiper has averaged 6.4, 6.0 and 1.5 points per

game, respectively. Last season, as a junior, he served as the squad's most consistent defender. As the lone returning starter from last year's squad, Kuiper is now averaging just south of double figures at 9.0 points per game over the first six contests of the season. He is shooting 46.3 percent (19-41) from the floor and 39.1 percent (9-23) from 3-point range.

ABOUT THE 2018-19 LOBOS

The 2018-19 Lobos have just four returning letterwinners from the 2017-18 squad, including leading-scorer Anthony Mathis (12.7 ppg) who finished fourth in the nation in 3-point percentage and broke the UNM record for most 3-point field goals in a conference season (66) as a junior. The squad also adds nine newcomers and returns a pair of sitting transfers to the team that finished third in Mountain West regular-season play last season.

In addition to Mathis, UNM's returners include senior Dane Kuiper, who is the lone returning starter, and sophomores Makuach Maluach and Vladimir Pinchuk. Maluach finished his inaugural season averaging 9.6 points per game and ranks fourth all-time on the Lobo freshman single-season scoring list.

REMEMBERING LAST SEASON

The 2017-18 Lobos were picked to finish ninth in league play, but shocked everyone when they pulled off a third-place finish in regular-season play, earned the MW Tournament bye and took on San Diego State in the Championship game, falling by just seven points.

The Lobos also ranked 15th out of 351 NCAA Division I teams in turnover percentage last season.

RECORDS ARE MEANT TO BE BROKEN

En route to their first appearance in the league championship since 2014, the Lobos broke the program records for 3-pointers in a season (367), most 3-point field goals attempted (979) and highest free throw percentage (77.7%). For reference, the previous records were 301, 782 and 75.7%, respectively.

As a team, the Lobos also broke the record for most points in a game (147 vs Northern New Mexico), most points in a conference game (119 at Wyoming) and most points in a conference season (1,507). Old records for the above: 136, 113 and 1,373, respectively.

STELLAR SCHEDULE

The Lobos are taking on a field of top-notch teams this season including five squads that advanced to the 2018 NCAA Tournament. Last season's Big Dance squads include New Mexico State, Iona, Penn, San Diego State and Nevada. With UNM facing NMSU, SDSU and Nevada twice apiece, that makes for eight games against NCAA post-season opponents, not to mention a matchup with last season's CBI tourney winner, North Texas.

UNDER THE RADAR

This offseason, the Lobos were ranked by the NCAA's Andy Katz as one of five "under the radar" teams to watch this season.

SHARP SHOOTER

Senior Anthony Mathis blew expectations out of the water last season after more than fiftupleing his career point production as a junior - that's right, in two seasons at UNM, Mathis scored just 86 points in 228 minutes, and multiplied that total by five in his junior season. In 2017-18, Mathis took the term "breakout" to a whole new level, dropping 433 points in 760 minutes on the floor. His shot from 3-point range couldn't be stopped as he finished the season with a program-

record 66 3-pointers in conference play. He also fired from behind the arc at a clip of 47.3%, ranking fourth in the nation among other NCAA DI players.

THE STUDENT BECOMES THE MASTER

After posting a breakout inaugural season of his own last year, sophomore Makuach Maluach is expected to be a high-profile returner for the Lobos this year. He's been ranked on several preseason lists and even made the cover of Lindy's Sports Magazine in August. Most recently, the soft-spoken sophomore was ranked 19th on the Mountain West Wire's Top 25.

CONSISTENCY IS OVERRATED

Last season, the Lobos debuted the most starting lineups in NCAA Division I with 21. Coach Weir made it clear in his first season that starting lineups would be determined by the numbers of deflections a player accumulated in the previous game, hence the sky-high number of lineup combos.

MW PRESEASON NEWCOMER OF THE YEAR

Redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson was named 2018 Mountain West Preseason Newcomer of the Year following the league's media poll in October. Jackson transferred from UCONN where he shot 40.9 percent from the field, 39.7 from behind the arc as a freshman in 2016-17. He reached double figures in 13 games and led the team twice in scoring in his inaugural collegiate season.

WE'RE NOT IN KANSAS ANYMORE ...

The Lobos return a pair of transfers that sat out last year and also welcome five more, including the highly-anticipated Carlton Bragg (Kansas/ASU transfer) who is currently eligible for conference play. Joining Bragg will be Juco transfers Corey Manigault, Keith McGee and Karim Ezzeddine who are all set to play at the start of the season.

Redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson (UCONN) will finally get his chance to don the Cherry and Silver this season and was named 2018 MW Newcomer of the Year. Jackson's fellow bench-warmer last season, Ohio State transfer JaQuan Lyle, suffered an Achilles injury during practice in September and is expected to miss the 2018-19 season. Two more transfers of note include Towson's Zane Martin, who will be sitting out in 2018-19 due to NCAA transfer rules, and redshirt-freshman Clay Patterson. A native of Rio Rancho, N.M., Patterson transferred back home from NCAA DII Fort Lewis. He is eligible to compete in 2018-19.

BRINGING PEOPLE TOGETHER

The Lobo squad is as varied as it gets when it comes to hometown pride. Each player on

the team is from not only a different town, but a different state or country entirely! With the late addition of walk-on Clay Patterson, the only exception is a pair of native New Mexicans. States and countries represented include: Pennsylvania, Maryland, California, New York, Florida, Australia, Indiana, Alaska, Germany, Georgia, France, Oregon, New Mexico and Ohio.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

The famous home of Lobo basketball enters its second year under the name "Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit" as part of an exciting renaming of both of UNM's largest-capacity athletic venues.

This July, "The Pit" was tabbed #17 on the top-30 list of best arena atmospheres in college hoops by the NCAA.

"The Pit" has also been consistently recognized nationally as one of the nation's top basketball venues. Sports Illustrated has ranked it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico men's basketball program. Since the Mountain West conference began in 1999-2000, New Mexico has ranked in the top two in home attendance among MW teams in every year except one, including 12 seasons as the top-ranked MW team in overall attendance.

WHAT'S THAT SOUND?

The new name for The Pit instated in 2017 is not the only change to come for Dreamstyle Arena in the Paul Weir era. This season, after popular fan demand, the sound system in the historic arena has been updated to feature an entirely new fan experience for the 2018-19 season!

Lobos Toppled by Aggies in Las Cruces

LAS CRUCES, N.M. --- Despite being outscored by just seven points in the second half, the first-half deficit was too great to overcome as The University of New Mexico men's basketball team fell on the road to the New Mexico State Aggies by a final score of 100-65. Freshman Drue Drinnon led the Lobos with a career-high 13 points in the second half.

"When you get absolutely dismantled like that, you're just shocked," head coach Paul Weir said. "It's probably one of the most shocking games since Boise State last year ... I thought their defense was terrific, (JoJo) Zamora was exceptional and their rebounding was really good to keep us off the glass .. There are so many different parts to this game that they just beat us."

"We have another game in three days, and it's my job to get us ready to play in three days."

The 35-point deficit marks the most for the 13th-ranked team in the nation in scoring offense in the Rio Grande Rivalry since Jan. 3, 1959 when the Lobos fell the Aggies 96-59 (37 points) in Albuquerque.

NM State (7-1) got off to a hot start with an 11-0 lead and held the Lobos (4-2) silent for the first five and a half minutes. The Lobos answered with four points off of layups from junior Karim Ezzeddine and redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee and held the Aggies scoreless for 2:47. NMSU reclaimed its' offensive dominance, however, and followed with an 18-0 run over 5:20 (from the 8:05 - 2:45 marks) to put the game out of reach 41-12.

Senior Anthony Mathis broke the streak with a pair of free throws. UNM closed the final 2:05 of the first half with threes from Mathis and Ezzeddine, along with a layup by sophomore Makuach Maluach.

In the first half, the Lobos were outscored 50-22, outrebounded 31-12 and outshot 44.1 percent to 21.2 percent from the field (41.7 - 26.7 from 3-point range).

The Lobos were outscored by just seven points in the second frame, 50-43. Drinnon led the second-half Lobo squad going 4-for-6 from the field, 3-for-4 from behind the arc and 2-for-4 from the foul line - all in just 10 minutes. He also fueled an 8-0 run over 1:33 that included five straight points on a 3-pointer and a layup with less than four minutes left to play.

On the night, UNM was led by three players scoring in double figures including Drinnon, Ezzeddine (11) and redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson (11). Ezzeddine and Jackson also led the Lobos in rebounds with six and eight, respectively. NMSU was led by JoJo Zamora who scored 27 points, followed by Ivan Aurrecochea (23) and Eli Chuha (13). Chuha and Aurrecochea finished with double-doubles, posting 10 and 11 boards, respectively.

The Lobos are set to return to action on Friday to finish off their three-game road stint with a contest against Saint Mary's in the Basketball Hall of Fame Classic at the STAPLES Center in Los Angeles, Calif. Tipoff is scheduled for 5 p.m MT.

Hunter's Career-Night Propels Gaels To Largest Win Of Season

MORAGA, Calif. — The Gaels recorded the win against Bethune-Cookman on Tuesday with their biggest victory margin of the season with a 93-61 final. Jordan Hunter had the biggest night of his career while picking up highs in multiple categories and helping Saint Mary's to their fifth win.

HOW IT HAPPENED

The Gaels' big man completed a career-night in three categories against the Wildcats. Hunter recorded a career-high 24 points, ten rebounds, and four assists, as well as a season-high three blocks for his first double-double of the season. He played a total of 28 minutes while shooting 8-for-10 from the field and 8-for-12 from the free-throw line.

Jordan Ford was a big piece of the Gaels offense as well and recorded 23 points while shooting 8-for-10 and collected two rebounds, two steals, and an assist. Tommy Kuhse stepped up in his second career-start for Saint Mary's as he notched 11 points for a new career-high, four rebounds and six assists.

Hunter continued his productive night for the Gaels as he scored the first bucket of the second half, and started a run for the team. Saint Mary's turned up the offense and shot 4-for-6 from the three point line with each shot coming from a different Gael player and made nine of ten shots in a row from the field with just over 12 minutes. SMC broke open a 26-point lead over the Wildcats while maintaining a 16-2 run into the final ten minutes of the match.

With seven minutes left in the first half, the teams remained within two points of each other. Shortly after, Saint Mary's went on a 10-2 run to take a seven-point lead over the Wildcats with Hunter and Kuhse leading the run. The Gaels ended the half with a 36-31 lead over Bethune-Cookman and were outshooting their opponent 53 percent to 48.

The Gaels and the Wildcats traded baskets through the first five minutes of the match on Tuesday. Hunter had the first seven points for the Gaels, as well as went 4-for-4 from the free-throw line in the first ten minutes of the game. Saint Mary's went on a 9-0 run towards the middle of the half to reclaim the lead, while Hunter continued to lead the charge and collected five more points.

Malik Maitland led Bethune-Cookman's offense on Tuesday night with 13 points and shot 6-for-9 during the match. He collected one rebound and one assist over 26 minutes of play. Cletrrell Pope led the Wildcats in rebounds with 10, including three on offense.

THE GREATEST GAME EVER PLAYED

The Pit was the site of one of the greatest college basketball games ever played. It hosted the 1983 national championship game that saw the NC State Wolfpack upset Hakeem Olajuwon, Clyde Drexler and the Houston Cougars. Coach Jimmy Valvano and the Wolfpack downed the Cougars on a last second put back by Lorenzo Charles. The iconic shot of the late Valvano running onto the court looking for a hug is one of the lasting images in college basketball history.

- The Lobos have averaged an astounding 15,410 fans the past 49 years, an amazing 95% of capacity
- The Pit has ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally nearly every season since the 1966-67 season with 35 seasons in the top ten in the NCAA in attendance
- Led the Mountain West in attendance in 10 of the conference's 15 years of existence
- The floor is named Bob King Court in honor of the former head coach who led the Lobos from 1963 to 1972.

Lobos Win Opener on Mathis 3-Point Buzzer-Beater

NORTHRIDGE, Calif. --- Senior Anthony Mathis of The University of New Mexico men's basketball team hit a buzzer-beating three to lift the Lobos over the CSUN Matadors on Tuesday night, officially opening the 2018-19 season with an exciting 87-84 victory. Four Lobos scored in double figures on the night that saw UNM's new squad shoot 50.9 percent from the floor and 42.3 percent from 3-point range.

The Lobos (1-0) and the Matadors (0-1) battled throughout 40 minutes with 13 lead changes and six ties.

Despite a shaky start full of first-game-of-the-season-nerves, UNM outshot CSUN in every category including from the floor (51.9 - 45.8 percent) from behind the arc (42.3 - 35.0 percent) and from the free throw line (75.9 - 52.4 percent).

In his first game as a Lobo, junior Corey Manigault led the squad on the night with 16 points going 4-for-6 from the floor and 8-for-9 from the charity stripe. Senior Dane Kuiper and sophomore Makuach Maluach followed with 15 points apiece. Kuiper went 5-for-5 from behind the arc, 5-for-8 from the floor and Maluach was 5-for-9 from the floor with three and four free throws.

Mathis was the fourth player to score in double figures, registering 12 points with a 4-for-7 performance from 3-point range.

CSUN freshman Lamine Diane led all players on the night with 34 points going 15-for-28 from the field. Diane scored 30 and 23 points in CSUN's exhibition matchups.

"Ball control was clearly an issue for us tonight," head coach Paul Weir said. "Our size was almost a problem tonight (because CSUN was so quick), but you've got to tip your cap to CSUN, they played their hearts out. Diane is a tremendous player, puts a lot of pressure on defenses, particularly on the glass, and they were able to go out and show that tonight."

The Lobos opened Tuesday night's contest with a 2:54 drought before sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk registered UNM's first points on a pair of free throws with 17:06 on the clock to make it 6-2 CSUN. A minute later, Manigault shot a pair of free throws to make it 6-4 but the Lobos did not score from the floor until 5:08 into the game when Kuiper hit a jumper to make it 8-6 Matadors.

Kuiper's jumper was followed by a three-pointer just 32 seconds later to spark a Lobo 10-0 run over 2:57, putting UNM on top 16-10.

Both teams continued to respond and with CSUN leading by one at the conclusion of the half, a foul was called at the buzzer that sent Maluach to the line. He hit the shot and tied it 42-42 heading into the locker room.

Over the first half, UNM was out-rebounded 21-15.

Once again it was Kuiper in the second half to give the Lobo offense life as he came out of the locker room with the first six points for UNM on a pair of three split by a jumper by Diane, 48-44.

The fifth tie of the game occurred at the 4:07 mark when redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson hit a free throw to tie it up 77-77. The Lobos built a four-point lead, 84-80 before a layup by CSUN's Cameron Gottfried made it 84-82 with just 30 seconds left on the clock.

The Lobos attempted to keep the ball and run down the clock but a UNM turnover allowed the Matadors to have one more possession that ended in another jumper by Diane to make it 84-84 with 6.1 seconds left.

The Lobos gained possession with the clock winding down and took about 4.5 seconds to cross half-court. Mathis looked up, saw the clock and took a long three from the right wing and sunk it for the win, 87-84.

On the night, CSUN dominated in the paint, 44-24 and registered 25 points off of turnovers compared to 22 for UNM. CSUN also tallied 13 second-chance points to just four for the Lobos and 12 on the fast break.

The Lobos are set to return to action on Saturday, Nov. 10 when they take on Northern New Mexico in exhibition competition as part of the second-annual New Mexico Classic tournament hosted by UNM.

Game 2 - New Mexico 90, Iona 83 Nov. 13, 2018 | Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit

Lobos Open 2-0 With 90-83 Win over Iona

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- Two Lobos racked up double-doubles on Tuesday night as The University of New Mexico men's basketball team earned a 90-83 win over the visiting Iona Gaels to start the 2018-19 season 2-0. Junior Corey Manigault and redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson led the Lobos with 20 and 18 points, respectively while collecting 10 and 12 boards apiece.

The victory marks the 16th straight season in which the Lobos came away with the win in their home opener.

After a slow start offensively, seniors Anthony Mathis and Dane Kuiper closed the game, combining for the thrilling final 10 points, including a pair of fast-break layups, to keep the Lobos on top throughout the final three minutes.

"The depth that we have, the way we spread our minutes and the style that we play allowed us to break away at the end and get a big win," head coach Paul Weir said. "It was a good basketball team that we beat, and we have come a long way in the last 12 months. We have not arrived and we have a lot of work to do the next few days in order to continue to get better, but just to get a win against a good basketball team early in the year shows our progression as a program."

The Lobos held the lead for 24:35 of the game that had nine lead changes and five ties. On the night, UNM outshot Iona from the floor 50.9 - 40.0 percent and 40.0 - 34.6 percent from behind the arc. Five Lobos scored in double figures including Manigault (20), Jackson (18), Mathis (14), redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee (13) and sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk (10).

Pinchuk's 10 points went along with seven rebounds, one steal, three assists and two blocks in a new career-high 30 minutes.

With just 7:05 left in the game and the Lobos down by one, 72-71, Manigault poked the ball out of the hands of Iona's Isaiah Still, raced to the other end of the court unguarded and slammed a crowd-pleasing dunk to put the Lobos back on top for the final time, 73-72.

When the Gaels reduced the Lobo lead back to one, 75-74, sophomore Makuach Maluach sunk a dagger of a three at 5:28 that put the Lobos back up by four, 78-74. Iona was able to take a five-point lead to just two, 80-78, at the 2:59 mark on a Still three before Mathis nailed his fourth 3-pointer of the night to put the Lobos back up by five, 83-78, and spark a Lobo offensive surge through the final minutes.

The Gaels would get no closer than three as Kuiper drilled his lone three of the night - a big one - with 1:52 left, 86-80, followed by a pair of fast-break layups from Mathis and Kuiper to keep the crowd of over 10,000 fans roaring through the end.

The Lobos forced 15 turnovers and posted five blocks, including two from Pinchuk. UNM also collected 19 assists to just 15 for Iona.

UNM went down by as much as five points in the back-and-forth first half that featured a 10-0 Iona run at the 13:43 mark. UNM battled back and responded with a 11-0 run with just 5:30 left in the first half to head into the locker room tied 39-39.

The Lobos came out of the halftime break with the first six points to take a commanding 45-39 lead before Iona whittled it back down to one with 16:20 on the clock.

Overall the teams finished relatively even in points off of turnovers (15-14 UNM), points in the paint (28 apiece), second-chance points (13-12 UNM), fast-break points (31-29 Iona) and bench points (29-20 UNM).

The Lobos return to action on Saturday, November 17 when they take on in-state rival New Mexico State for a 4 p.m. clash in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit. The game will be the Lobos' Nike TV contest featuring the highly-anticipated turquoise uniforms and will be televised on AT&T SportsNet.

Game 3 - New Mexico 94, NM State 98 Nov. 17, 2018 | Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit

Late Comeback Falls Short, Three score 20+ Points

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- After falling behind by as much as 19 points with just 9:08 left to play, The University of New Mexico men's basketball team put on an impressive show in a comeback attempt that saw the Lobos rack up a 13-0 second-half run in front of over 14,000 fans inside Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit. The run fell short however, as NM eventually suffered a four-point loss, 98-94, to the Aggies in the Rio Grande Rivalry matchup.

A trio of Lobos racked up 20 points or more including redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson (27), senior Anthony Mathis (22) and junior Corey Manigault (20). The game marks Manigault's second straight in which he has netted 20 points. The fourth Lobo to score in double figures was senior Dane Kuiper, who posted 10.

Jackson added a team-high six rebounds to his 27 points and drew nine fouls on the night. He was also one of six Lobos to accumulate four or more fouls.

The Lobos outshot NMSU in every category including 59.6 - 56.6 percent from the field, 55.0 - 52.2 percent from behind the arc and 70.0 - 66.7 percent from the foul line, but the Aggies' redshirt-junior AJ Harris went an unstopable 9-for-11 from the field, 6-for-6 from 3-point range and 7-for-10 from the free throw line to total 31 points, leading NMSU to victory. NMSU also knocked in 26 free throws compared to 21 for UNM, accounting for the four-point differential.

"First, thank you so much to all of the fans that came out today," head coach Paul Weir said in a press conference. "It was an exceptional sign of how far I think we've grown and where our program is hopefully headed. Unfortunately, the result is not what we wanted. It's incredibly disappointing, and inevitably that falls on me."

The teams remained within three points over the first five minutes until the Lobos began to pull ahead on a Mathis three and a jumper by sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk, making the score 13-5 for an eight-point lead, the most for UNM of the day.

The Aggies closed the gap and claimed a one-point advantage, 14-13, with 9:46 left in the first half and extended it to six at the break, 44-38. It was the first time the Lobos have been down at the half so far this season as UNM has tied its opponents heading into the break in both of its first two regular-season games.

Mathis cut the six-point deficit to three within the first 12 seconds of the second half (44-41) to set the tone, but NMSU took off on a 16-3 run over the ensuing 4:34 to get back out to a commanding 16-point lead, 60-44.

It was then that Manigault took the game into his own hands, scoring the next 10 points for the Lobos on three field goals and four free throws. Manigault scored eight points in 56 seconds including a 5-0 run to reduce the deficit to 11-49, before he was substituted at the 13:02 mark with NMSU leading by 13, 65-52.

Manigault was off the floor for 1:42 during which the Lobos endured a scoring drought and allowed the Aggies to pull back ahead by 19. Manigault returned and hit a jumper at the 10:36 mark to cut it back to 17 as UNM continued to battle.

With the Aggies up by 19 for the third time in the contest, the Lobos erupted for a 16-5 run over 3:15 to cut the score back to single digits, 80-72, with 5:12 on the clock. After suffering another barrage of Aggie points, UNM cut another 14-point deficit down to eight over 1:15 on a pair of threes by Mathis and Jackson, as well as a pair of Mathis free throws with 1:10 left, 92-84.

The score was 96-89 with just 34 seconds left on the clock and the game looked over until Jackson hit a huge three to make it a four-point game followed by a Weir timeout.

Mathis notched a layup out of the timeout to make it a two-point game with seven seconds left but with little time left on the clock, the Lobos were forced to play the foul game, allowing for a pair of free throws from NMSU for the 98-94 final.

The Lobos caught 14 turnovers, committing 15, and collected eight steals to six for NMSU. The Aggies capitalized on turnovers for 23 points compared to 18 for UNM while the Lobos outscored NMSU 32-30 in the paint.

UNM has a week to recuperate before returning to action on Saturday, Nov. 24 when it hosts UTEP at 5:30 p.m. on the Mountain West Network.

Lobos Move to 3-1 with 84-78 Win Over UTEP

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- Over 11,000 Lobo fans got another close one to watch on Saturday night as The University of New Mexico men's basketball team pulled off an 84-78 victory over the visiting UTEP Miners inside Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit. Senior Anthony Mathis led UNM with 18 points while racking up four 3-pointers for the fourth straight game.

Mathis entered the matchup ranked 15th in the nation in 3-pointers per game at 4.0. The game also marked the fourth straight in which the Lobos (3-1) have had at least four players score in double figures. Mathis led the pack and was followed by sophomore Makuach Maluach (13), redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson (12) and sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk (10).

"Great game on a lot of levels. Obviously to get over the disappointment of our last home game, but to get a crowd like that today, meant a lot," head coach Paul Weir said. "It meant a lot to me personally and it meant a lot to our guys. Quite honestly, I prefaced them all week that we might have lost some fans with what we did last weekend. To have our fans respond like that, it's just a blessing to be a Lobo."

Weir registered his 50th career win with Saturday night's victory over UTEP, his 22nd as a Lobo.

UNM held the Miners (2-3) to just seven points over the first 7:04 but offensively started just as slow. The Lobos failed to register a single point until a Jackson three at the 12:23 mark, meaning UNM fans stood for 7:37 in anticipation of a Lobo point.

"I'd be lying if I said I loved where we are at, but we're winning and this was a game a year ago that quite frankly we would have lost. So, there is growth in that regard and hopefully we'll be able to grow here as the season progresses," Weir said.

For the fourth straight game, Jackson led UNM in rebounds with five, tied with Pinchuk, while Jackson and freshman Drue Drinnon each posted four assists. Drinnon's team-high four assists came in just 11 minutes on the court. Last game he racked up a team-best four assists in 14.

Following Jackson's first Lobo bucket, UNM went scoreless for another 3:11 while UTEP got out to its biggest lead of the game, 11 points (14-3), with 9:27 left in the first half. The teams went back-and-forth but the Lobos entered the locker room down five after a Drinnon layup with 36 seconds left, 34-29.

At the end of the first frame, the best shooting team in the Mountain West (54.1 percent) was shooting just 23.3 percent from the field (7-30), but still firing 42.9 percent from behind the arc (3-7). The first half also saw both teams combine for 25 fouls including a trio of technicals (one was a double).

UNM opened the second half on a 9-5 scoring advantage capped by Maluach's third 3-pointer of the night to cut the UTEP lead to two, 40-38, at the 16:56 mark. The Miners again extended their lead to seven before the Lobos cut it back to two and ultimately took the lead.

Down by four, 53-49, with 12:36 left to play, Mathis drilled back-to-back threes within 21 seconds, his first and second of the game, to close the UTEP lead to one, 53-52, and then take the lead 55-53. The teams would tie it twice before the end of 40 minutes, but the Lobos did not trail again.

Mathis' three was part of a 14-4 run that ended with a Jackson free throw and a four-point Lobo advantage, 57-53. During the 4:05 span, UNM went 4-for-5 from the floor including a momentum-turning dunk by redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee. Pinchuk collected a steal at the other end of the floor, tossed it to Drinnon who drove toward the basket but at the last second, passed to McGee who went up for two (47-49 UTEP).

The teams tied the score at 57-57 and again at 59-59 before the Lobos began to pull away with a 7-0 run that was capped by another Mathis three to make it 67-60 at the 6:28 mark. Mathis scored just two points in the first half and finished with 16 in the second.

UTEP got it as close as two with 2:03 left, 74-72 Lobos, but a three from senior Dane Kuiper stretched UNM's lead back to five, 77-72. With 43 seconds left on the clock, UTEP cut it back to three, 79-76, but Mathis' fourth three of the night with 20 seconds left proved to be a dagger for the Lobos, 82-76 UNM. UTEP's Nigel Hawkins made a layup at the other end with 13 seconds left but a Miner foul sent Mathis to the line for two more and the 84-78 final.

On the night, UNM finished shooting 44.8 percent from the floor, marking the first time this season that the Lobos have shot under 50 percent. Maluach shot 4-for-9 from the floor, 3-for-4 from behind the arc while Mathis was 5-for-7 overall, 4-for-4 from 3-point range and 4-for-5 from the free throw line.

The Lobos once again debuted a new starting lineup consisting of a pair of freshmen, a pair of sophomores and one senior leader in Mathis. The lineup marked the first official starts for freshmen Drue Drinnon and Jordan Arroyo. Arroyo started in UNM's exhibition contest against Northern New Mexico, but this was his first that will count in the books. Pinchuk remains the only consistent starter for the Lobos as the only player to have started all four games this season.

After four straight home contests, the Lobos are set to hit the road next Saturday with the Missouri Valley/Mountain West Challenge game at Bradley on Dec. 1. At Saturday's game in Illinois, Lobo assistant coach Jerome Robinson will be inducted to his alma mater's Hall of Fame.

Mathis Nets Seven Threes to Lead UNM Past Bradley

PEORIA, Ill. --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team earned an 85-75 victory over Bradley University on the road on Saturday night. Senior Anthony Mathis, who averaged 4.0 3-pointers per game prior to Saturday, scored seven on the night en route to 23 points to lead the Lobos.

With the victory, UNM improves to 4-1 while Bradley slips to 6-3.

Saturday's game also marked the finale of the 2018 Mountain West / Missouri Valley Challenge. Prior to the game, the Mountain West was down 5-4, but the Lobo victory made it 5-5 and marked the third consecutive season that the challenge resulted in a tie.

Also of note on the night, Lobo assistant coach and Bradley alum Jerome Robinson was officially inducted into the Braves' Hall of Fame for his outstanding accomplishments during his time at Bradley.

Mathis led UNM with his 23 points, 18 of which came on six 3-pointers in the first half, to finish just two points short of his career high (25). He was followed by junior Corey Manigault who scored 18 and fellow senior Dane Kuiper who tallied 15. Manigault registered the only double-double on the floor for the night with 18 points and 11 rebounds. He went 4-for-9 from the floor and 10-for-11 from the free throw line. Kuiper was 6-for-10 from the floor, 2-for-5 from behind the arc and 1-for-1 from the stripe.

Much like the first few games of the season, the Lobos started out slow on Saturday and even got behind by as much as 11 points before roaring back to take the lead and claim the victory.

"You have to tip your cap to Bradley, I thought the first five or so minutes of the game was terrific and I thought the last 8-10 minutes was a very good basketball team working to get back," head coach Paul Weir said. "Fortunately that 20-25 minutes or so in the middle, we were really able to establish our style of play and do it in such a way that it overcame that last 15 minutes that we still have to improve upon."

Bradley entered the contest on an 11-0 run over the first 2:34 on a starting lineup that consisted of a trio of freshmen, Tavian Percy, Drue Drinnon and Jordan Arroyo, along with Kuiper and sophomore Makuach Maluach. A jumper from sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk, who until Saturday night was UNM's lone consistent starter, at the 16:44 mark started the scoring for UNM.

The Lobos were quick to get back in it, however, taking a 10-point Brave lead (14-4) down to two (16-14) within 2:56 on a 10-2 run. The run included a pair of threes from Mathis.

A three from Bradley's Nate Kennel at the 8:28 mark put the Braves up by four, 22-18, but a Mathis 3-pointer just 38 seconds later brought the Lobos within one, 22-21.

Mathis followed with another less than a minute later to give the Lobos their first lead of the game, 24-22. Bradley's Dwayne Lautier-Ogunleye made a jumper to tie it at 24-24 before Mathis followed with yet another from behind the arc, his fifth of the game to take a three-point lead that the Lobos never again relinquished.

UNM extended the first-half lead to eight with 2:46 left on a jumper and a dunk by Manigault before Bradley whittled it back to four, 36-32.

The Lobo seniors closed the first half in style as Dane Kuiper dunked with 46 seconds left and Mathis hit his sixth three of the night with nine seconds on the clock for a nine-point lead at the half, 41-32.

UNM held onto a double-digit advantage for most of the second half en route to the 85-75 victory. It was Kuiper and Manigault that led the Lobos in the second frame. Kuiper scored 11 points including a pair of 3-pointers while Manigault scored twice from the floor and added eight free throws for 12 second-half points.

The Lobos turned Bradley over 15 times, including - in a two-minute span during UNM's first-half run.

For just the second time this season, UNM out-rebounded its opponent, 40-33. The Lobos also out-rebounded their opponent in every category: UNM was 43.3 percent (26-60) from the field, 37.5 percent (12-32) from 3-point range and 87.5 percent (21-24) from the free throw line.

UNM held Bradley to 43.1 percent from the floor (25-58), 35 percent from three (35 percent) and Bradley shot 62.1 percent from the free throw line.

Bradley outscored the Lobos in the paint 32-24 and off of turnovers 17-15, but UNM held the advantage in second-half points, 16-11, and in points off of the bench, 60-11. Mathis' 23 points ranks him tied for 13th in program history with most points off the bench.

Both the Braves and the Lobos had three players score in double figures. Mathis led all players on the night but the other 20-point scorer on the floor was Bradley's Darrell Brown, who pounced 20 on 7-for-15 from the field and 3-for-6 from behind the arc. Lautier-Ogunleye followed with 16 and standout Elijah Childs was held to 13.

The Lobos return to action on Tuesday, Dec. 4 when they take on New Mexico State in Las Cruces. Tipoff is set for 7 p.m.
