After its 38-point victory over San José State on Saturday (94-56), the UNLV men's basketball team will be looking for its fourth straight home win as it hosts New Mexico on Tuesday, Jan. 22 at 7 p.m. at the Thomas & Mack Center.

Tickets to Tuesday's game start at just \$16 when purchased in advance - at UNLVtickets.com, by calling 702-739-FANS (3267) or by visiting the Thomas & Mack Center Box Office. This game is also part of the Eat-All-You-Can 4-Game Package.

UNLV (10-7, 4-1) is off to its first 4-1 start in Mountain West play in seven years and will be looking for a season-series sweep of the Lobos as it won 80-69 at The Pit earlier this month on Jan. 8.

It is Coaches vs. Cancer Week and the coaching staffs will be wearing suits and sneakers during the game in an effort to raise awareness and help save lives by raising funds for the American Cancer Society. Fans are encouraged to wear black and free UNLV tuxedo T-shirts will be given away to the first 500 season ticket holders in attendance and the first 250 general fans.

New Mexico (9-9, 3-3) is coming off an 83-53 home win over Wyoming on Saturday, which snapped a three-game losing skid. The Lobos are 4-3 in their last seven games and are led in scoring by Anthony Mathis' 15.9 ppg.

Tuesday's game will be televised on CBS Sports Network with Carter Blackburn and Pete Gillen calling the action. Jon Sandler, former Runnin' Rebel Robert Smith, and Steve Cofield (sideline reporter) will handle the UNLV radio call, which may be heard live on ESPN Radio 1100 AM and online via the UNLV Gameday App and Tuneln (link at UNLVRebels.com).

THE UNLV RUNNIN' REBELS (10-7, 4-1 MOUNTAIN WEST)

- The 2018-19 season marks the third at UNLV for head coach Marvin Menzies. Prior to coming to UNLV, he spent the previous nine years as head coach at New Mexico State where he compiled a 198-111 (.641) record. His current career record is 239-152 (.611) and he is 41-41 (.500) at UNLV.
Coming to UNLV was actually a return to Las Vegas for Coach Menzies. He spent a year with the Runnin' Rebels on Lon Kruger's staff in 2004-05 as an assistant coach.
The Runnin' Rebels opened the season with seven straight games at the Thomas & Mack Center before traveling to Illinois on Dec. 1. UNLV played eight of its first nine games of the season in Las Vegas (BYU was at T-Mobile Arena on the Las Vegas Strip).
Senior forward Shakur Juiston is UNLV's leading returning scorer from last year's team, but after playing in this season's first eight games, he will miss the rest of the year because of a knee injury. He averaged a double-double with 14.6 points and 10.0 rebounds per game in 2017-18 and shot 63.9 percent from the field, which ranked seventh in the country and No. 5 on the all-time UNLV seasonal chart. He also tallied 15 double-doubles last year, which ranked 20th in the nation. Juiston was named second-team All-Mountain West and second-team All-District 17 (NABC) last year.
UNLV has two other seniors this season: point guard Noah Robotham, a transfer from Akron, who is from Las Vegas, and guard Kris Clyburn, who is in his third season at UNLV.
Last year's team won 20 games, which was its highest win total in four years. It also marked a nine-game improvement in the win column from the previous season. Key losses from last year include Mountain West Freshman of the Year Brandon McCoy and seniors Jovan Mooring and Jordan Johnson. All three averaged double figures in scoring.
This year's team returned seven student-athletes who played last season, which is the most for the program from the previous season in seven years.
This year's roster has a total of 11 freshmen and sophomores. Junior forward Cheickna Dembele will also miss the rest of this season because of a finger injury. With Juiston and Dembele out, nine of the team's available 12 players are freshmen and sophomores.
UNLV was picked to finish sixth in this year's Mountain West race by the media in October.
The Runnin' Rebels are led this season in scoring by Clyburn, who is averaging 13.4 ppg. Freshman forward Joel Ntambwe is close behind at 12.9 ppg, while sophomore guard Amauri Hardy is third at 12.2 ppg. Juiston averaged 10.8 ppg and 8.8 rpg over eight games played. The team's current rebounding leader, sophomore forward Mbacke Diang (6.3 rpg), has missed the last two games with an ankle injury. He also leads the team in blocks (third in the MW) with 1.7 bpg. Robotham is the Runnin' Rebel assist leader (4.3 apg), ranking fifth in the MW.
UNLV leads the MW in offensive rebounding (15.3 orgp, 2nd in the country) and blocks (4.4 per game). The Runnin' Rebels rank second in the league in rebound margin (+8.2, 11th in the country) and rebounds per game (40.9, 18th in the country).
UNLV had won four straight games from Nov. 13-23, then lost three straight before the overtime win vs. BYU on Dec. 15. With the National Finals Rodeo occupying the Thomas & Mack Center and then the holiday tournament in Hawaii, UNLV went 31 days between home games (Dec. 1 - Jan. 2).
UNLV was looking for its second four-game win streak of the season last week, but lost at Air Force.
UNLV was off to its best start to conference play (3-0) in 20 years (1998-99), when it was in its final season in the Western Athletic Conference. Its current 4-1 MW record is its best start to conference play in seven years.

THE NEW MEXICO LOBOS (9-9, 3-3 MOUNTAIN WEST)

- New Mexico is coming off an 83-53 win over Wyoming at home on Saturday, which snapped a three-game losing skid.
The Lobos are 4-3 in their last seven games.
Anthony Mathis leads the team in scoring (15.9 ppg), while Vance Jackson (7.3 rpg) is the team's leading rebounder. Drue Drinnon leads the squad in assists (2.7 apg).
New Mexico is 5-5 at home this year, 4-3 on the road and 0-1 on a neutral court.
The team is scoring 78.3 ppg, while limiting its opponents to 76.9 ppg. New Mexico ranks 27th in the country in 3-pointers per game with 9.8 (2nd in the MW). Mathis is 10th in the nation (1st in the MW) with 3.7 made per contest and 23rd in the country in 3-point percentage at 44.1 (3rd in the MW).
In Saturday's game, six Lobos racked up double digits, led by Carlton Bragg who tied his career-high 16 points, while Jackson posted his fourth double-double of the season, his second in three games.
UNM was 19-15 overall last season, finishing third in the Mountain West with a 12-6 league mark.
The Lobos lost in the Mountain West Tournament's championship game to San Diego State to end their season last year.
Head coach Paul Weir, who was an assistant coach under current UNLV head coach Marvin Menzies at New Mexico State, is in his second season leading the Lobos and has a record of 28-24 (.539) at the school. He is in his third year overall as a head coach with a career mark of 56-30 (.651).
New Mexico returned just four letterwinners, including one starter from last year's team.
The Lobos were picked to finish third in this year's MW preseason poll.

SERIES HISTORY

- This will mark the 60th meeting between UNLV and New Mexico in men's basketball. UNLV leads the all-time series 34-25, including on Jan. 8 at The Pit - an 80-69 Runnin' Rebel win. New Mexico swept the season series last year with an 85-81 win in Las Vegas and a 91-90 victory in Albuquerque. New Mexico won the last game at the Thomas & Mack Center - 85-81 on Jan. 17, 2018. New Mexico has won five of its last six games against UNLV at the TMC. UNLV is 19-11 all-time at home vs. New Mexico. UNLV is 353-169 all-time against teams that currently make up the Mountain West.

UP NEXT

After hosting New Mexico, the Runnin' Rebels will head back out on the road and play at San Diego State on Saturday, Jan. 26. The 5 p.m. game will be televised by CBS Sports Network.

FIRST 3-0 START IN CONFERENCE PLAY IN 20 YEARS

UNLV was 3-0 in Mountain West play this season, which marked the first time in its history. The last time the Runnin' Rebels started conference play 3-0 was during the 1998-99 season, their last in the Western Athletic Conference. UNLV failed to get to 4-0 in MW play this year with the loss at Air Force. It would have been UNLV's best start to a conference season since going 18-0 in the Big West in Coach Tarkanian's last year at UNLV in 1991-92.

4-1 MOUNTAIN WEST RECORD IS BEST IN SEVEN YEARS

UNLV is 4-1 in Mountain West play for the first time in seven years. The last time UNLV started the conference season 4-1 was in 2011-12 when it got to 5-1 before suffering its second loss of the league slate.

OUT-REBOUNDERS

Prior to the game at Air Force, UNLV had recorded more rebounds than its opponent in every game this season (15). With UNLV out-rebounding San José State on Saturday, the Runnin' Rebels have now out-rebounded 16 of its 17 opponents this year. The Runnin' Rebels rank second in the country in offensive rebounds per game (15.3), 11th in rebound margin (+8.2) and 18th in total rebounds per game (40.88).

TRAILING AT THE HALF...

UNLV trailed at the half in each of its first four Mountain West games. The Runnin' Rebels came back to win the first three, but couldn't make the comeback at Air Force on Jan. 16. UNLV led San José State at the half on Saturday, 46-25.

NTAMBWE COMING ON STRONG

After not scoring in double figures in each of the season's first seven games, freshman forward Joel Ntambwe has caught fire. He has scored in double figures in each of his last 10 games, including a career-high 31 points on Jan. 5 vs. Wyoming. Over the last 10 games, he has averaged 18.5 points and 8.3 rebounds per game. With 10 rebounds vs. the Cowboys, he registered his fourth double-double of the season.

HARDY STARTING

Sophomore guard Amauri Hardy was moved into the starting lineup for the first time in his career in UNLV's MW opener vs. Colorado State on Jan. 2. In five starts, he has tallied 30 assists with just five turnovers, while averaging 12.8 ppg. He recorded a career-high nine assists vs. the Rams.

SENIORS DURING CONFERENCE PLAY

Senior guards Kris Clyburn and Noah Robotham have also had strong starts to MW play. Clyburn has averaged 15.6 ppg over the five games with a career-high 25 points at New Mexico. He is also has averaged 6.2 rpg in league play. Robotham has recorded 33 assists with just six turnovers, while averaging 10.2 ppg over the five contests.

FROM THE FREE-THROW LINE

Prior to the game at Illinois, senior guard Kris Clyburn had made 20 of his 21 free-throw attempts (95.2 percent). He is currently 60 of 64 on free throws for the season for 78.1 percent, which ranks eighth in the MW. UNLV freshman forward Joel Ntambwe is currently the team leader in free throws at 81.3 percent (52 of 64), which ranks fourth in the league. UNLV made 20 of 24 free throws (83.3 percent) in its MW opener vs. CSU, 76.2 percent (16 of 21) vs. Wyoming and 85.7 percent (18 of 21) at New Mexico.

THE MARVIN MENZIES ERA AT UNLV

The 2018-19 season marks the third for UNLV under head coach Marvin Menzies. He officially became the 13th full-time head coach in the history of Runnin' Rebel basketball in April of 2016 after returning to Las Vegas after nine years as the head coach at New Mexico State, going 198-111 (.641) with the Aggies. Now in his 12th year overall as a head coach, his career record is 239-152 (.611) and he is 41-41 (.500) leading the Rebels. He led his team to the postseason in each of his last five seasons at NMSU and six of the last seven. He was an assistant coach on Lon Kruger's staff at UNLV in 2004-05.

### ROSTER MAKEUP

UNLV returns seven student-athletes who played last season, which is the most for the program from the previous season in seven years. The Runnin' Rebels have been led this year by seniors Shakur Juiston (out for the rest of the season with a knee injury), a second-team All-Mountain West honoree in 2017-18, Noah Robotham, a Las Vegas who transferred from Akron, and Kris Clyburn, who is in his third year at UNLV. The team has welcomed six freshmen this season. In all, the young team has a total of 11 freshmen and sophomores on this year's roster.

### "3-POINT GOAL..." - UNLV HOLDS NCAA RECORD

UNLV holds the NCAA record for most consecutive games scoring at least one 3-pointer. Since the 3-point field goal was adopted by the NCAA in 1986-87, UNLV has converted at least one 3-pointer in all 1,056 games played.

### NTAMBWE EARNS UNLV'S FIRST MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONOR

Freshman forward Joel Ntambwe was named Mountain West Men's Basketball Player of the Week on Dec. 17. It was his first career weekly honor and also the first for a Runnin' Rebel player this season. Originally from Kinshasa, Democratic Republic of the Congo, he scored a career-high 22 points in UNLV's thrilling overtime buzzer-beating victory against BYU on Dec. 15 at T-Mobile Arena. He recorded the first double-double of his career with a game-high-tying 11 rebounds. The win snapped a three-game losing streak for UNLV. Ntambwe sank two free throws with 27 seconds left to send the game into overtime, tied at 83. For the game, he went 6 for 8 (75 percent) from the field, including 3 for 4 (75 percent) from 3-point range. He also made 7 of 8 (87.5 percent) free throws.

### ROBOTHAM EARNS OUTSTANDING REBEL OF THE WEEK AWARD

Senior guard Noah Robotham was named the DC Solar Outstanding Rebel of the Week, UNLV announced Dec. 19. The award goes to the student-athlete who turned in the best individual performance during the previous week of competition from Monday through Sunday as voted on by the UNLV Athletic Communications department. Robotham, a local product out of Bishop Gorman High School, delivered the game-winning shot to lift the Runnin' Rebels to a 92-90 overtime victory over BYU at T-Mobile Arena last Saturday. With UNLV trailing 90-89 with under five seconds remaining in overtime, sophomore Amauri Hardy attempted to drive but instead found Robotham on the right wing, who launched a fallaway 3-pointer that hit nothing but net right as the final buzzer sounded, giving UNLV the two-point win. Robotham was one of five Runnin' Rebels to score in double figures, finishing with 12 points in the victory. The buzzer-beater also came in at No. 4 on SportsCenter's Top-10 Plays of the Day.

### AT THE THOMAS & MACK CENTER

The 2018-19 season marks the 36th year of Runnin' Rebel basketball in the Thomas & Mack Center. UNLV has posted an all-time record of 485-121 (.800) in the arena since it opened in 1983.

### 20 WINS LAST SEASON

In Coach Menzies' second year at the helm of the UNLV program (2017-18), the Runnin' Rebels recorded 20 wins, which was their highest win total in four years. It also marked a nine-game improvement in the win column from the previous season.

### MORE ON LAST SEASON

The Runnin' Rebels finished the 2017-18 season with an overall record of 20-13 ... UNLV had four players average double figures in scoring and was led by freshman forward Brandon McCoy's 16.9 points per game ... He also led the team in rebounding at 10.3 rebounds per contest ... Shakur Juiston also averaged a double-double with 14.6 ppg and 10.0 rpg ... Jordan Johnson was the team's assist leader with 6.0 per game ... McCoy was named the Mountain West Freshman of the Year and declared for the NBA Draft ... UNLV led the MW in scoring (83.4 ppg) and rebounding (40.5 rpg), ranking 13th and 10th in the nation, respectively.

### GETTING IT DONE IN THE CLASSROOM

The Runnin' Rebels have recorded a collective grade point average of at least 3.0 in three consecutive semesters, which is a first for the program. The team set a GPA record with a 3.17 in the spring of 2018.

### MOUNTAIN WEST'S SECOND-BEST RECRUITING CLASS

This year's UNLV men's basketball recruiting class has been ranked as high as No. 2 in the Mountain West.

### 61ST YEAR OF RUNNIN' REBEL BASKETBALL

The 2018-19 year marks the 61st season of Runnin' Rebel basketball at UNLV. Since the program's inception in 1958-59, the Runnin' Rebels have posted an all-time record of 1,281-560 (.696).

### FIFTH-WINNINGEST PROGRAM EVER

With an all-time record of 1,245-543 (.696) against four-year American institutions (entering the 2018-19 season), UNLV ranks as the fifth-winningest program by percentage in NCAA Division I history (min. 25 years in Div. I). The only schools ahead of UNLV are Kentucky, North Carolina, Kansas and Duke.

### A WINNING PROGRAM

UNLV has finished the season with a winning percentage above .500, 55 times in its 60-year history.



### **NBA DRAFT PICKS**

UNLV had a total of four NBA Draft picks over a four-year span from 2013-16: Anthony Bennett (No. 1 overall in 2013 by the Cleveland Cavaliers), Rashad Vaughn (No. 17 overall in 2015 by the Milwaukee Bucks), Patrick McCaw (No. 38 overall in 2016 by the Golden State Warriors) and Stephen Zimmerman Jr. (No. 41 overall in 2016 by the Orlando Magic).

### **RUNNIN' REBELS IN THE NBA**

As of October, there were six former Runnin' Rebels on NBA rosters. They were Khem Birch (Orlando Magic), Derrick Jones Jr. (Miami Heat), Patrick McCaw (Golden State Warriors), Brandon McCoy (New Orleans Pelicans), Rashad Vaughn (Dallas Mavericks) and Christian Wood (Milwaukee Bucks). Birch, Jones Jr., McCoy and Wood all went undrafted, while McCaw was a second-round selection in 2016 and Vaughn was picked in the first round in 2015.

### **NEW VIDEO BOARD IN THE THOMAS & MACK CENTER**

As part of a \$5 million, multi-year commitment from Boyd Gaming Corporation – the largest corporate commitment in the history of UNLV Athletics - the Thomas & Mack Center has a brand new larger state-of-the-art center-hung video board. We (the coaches) knew we were up for a challenge, however I'm not sure the players knew what they were in store for and I think they got a little shell-shocked at the other team's energy. It's a great opportunity to win and get a lot of lessons - probably more lessons than I wanted. I always want to make incremental improvement and I felt like we did in some areas but in other areas we either went back or stayed the same, which is a little disappointing. But we got the win and now we have to prepare for two really tough teams next week." - UNLV Head Coach Marvin Menzies UNLV and Southern Utah have faced each other in each of the last six seasons.
