### ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- The Lobos open the 2018-19 season on the road for the first time since 2007 on Tuesday in Northridge.
- The last time the Lobos opened the season on the road was on Nov. 9, 2007 at Colorado. The Lobos earned a 54-47 victory in the contest.
- UNM returns just one starter and three other letterwinners from last year's squad that went on a 7-1 run to close the season in the Mountain West title game.
- CSUN also returns just four players from last season's squad that finished 6-24 overall, 3-13 in conference play, under its previous coaching staff.
- The Matadors have already played a pair of exhibition games under first-year head coach Mark Gottfried, formerly of NC State.
- CSUN claimed both exhibition contests to start 2018-19, the first on Oct. 25 against Antelope Valley (88-77), the second over Cal State LA on Nov. 1 (89-87).
- Last time the Lobos met the Matadors was on Nov. 25, 2016 in Fullerton, Calif. as part of a tournament.
- The Lobos are 5-0 over CSUN in program history, dating back to Dec. 1, 1969, which was a 99-82 win.
- UNM has never traveled to play CSUN in Northridge but has played CSUN in The Pit four times (4-0).

**SCOUTING CSUN**

CSUN enters its 2018-19 opener coming off of a pair of exhibition wins under first-year head coach Mark Gottfried, formerly of NC State. The Matadors have just four letterwinners from last year's squad including 2017-18 Big West Freshman of the Year Tarrell Gomez who averaged 11.7 points, 3.6 assists and 2.4 rebounds per game while shooting 46.1 percent from behind the arc.

**FRESH OUT OF THE LOCKER ROOM**

While most squads take on another team in exhibition play prior to the season's tipoff, the Lobos have not competed against another team in front of a crowd since the Mountain West Championship contest on March 10. So far to prepare for the 2018-19 season the Lobos have played just a Cherry & Silver scrimmage and a closed scrimmage, but do not have their first exhibition game scheduled until Nov. 10.

**GET IT OFF THE SHOULDER**

Last season, the Lobos dropped their first eight games away from Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit before executing an exciting 84-81 victory on the road at UNLV. Kicking off the 2018-19 season with a road win would knock away that road pressure carryover from 2017-18.

**ABOUT THE 2018-19 LOBOS**

The 2018-19 Lobos have just four returning letterwinners from the 2017-18 squad, including leading-scorer Anthony Mathis (12.7 ppg) who finished fourth in the nation in 3-point percentage and broke the UNM record for most 3-point field goals in a conference season (66) as a junior. The squad also adds nine newcomers and returns a pair of sitting transfers to the team that finished third in Mountain West regular-season play

last season.

In addition to Mathis, UNM's returners include senior Dane Kuiper, who is the lone returning starter, and sophomores Makuach Maluach and Vladimir Pinchuk. Maluach finished his inaugural season averaging 9.6 points per game and ranks fourth all-time on the Lobo freshman single-season scoring list.

**REMEMBERING LAST SEASON**

The 2017-18 Lobos were picked to finish ninth in league play, but shocked everyone when they pulled off a third-place finish in regular-season play, earned the MW Tournament bye and took on San Diego State in the Championship game, falling by just seven points.

The Lobos also ranked 15th out of 351 NCAA Division I teams in turnover percentage last season.

**RECORDS ARE MEANT TO BE BROKEN**

En route to their first appearance in the league championship since 2014, the Lobos broke the program records for 3-pointers in a season (367), most 3-point field goals attempted (979) and highest free throw percentage (77.7%). For reference, the previous records were 301, 782 and 75.7%, respectively.

As a team, the Lobos also broke the record for most points in a game (147 vs Northern New Mexico), most points in a conference game (119 at Wyoming) and most points in a conference season (1,507). Old records for the above: 136, 113 and 1,373, respectively.

**STELLAR SCHEDULE**

The Lobos are taking on a field of top-notch teams this season including five

squads that advanced to the 2018 NCAA Tournament. Last season's Big Dance squads include New Mexico State, Iona, Penn, San Diego State and Nevada. With UNM facing NMSU, SDSU and Nevada twice apiece, that makes for eight games against NCAA post-season opponents, not to mention a matchup with last season's CBI tourney winner, North Texas.

**UNDER THE RADAR**

This offseason, the Lobos were ranked by the NCAA's Andy Katz as one of five "under the radar" teams to watch this season.

**SHARP SHOOTER**

Senior Anthony Mathis blew expectations out of the water last season after more than fiftupleing his career point production as a junior - that's right, in two seasons at UNM, Mathis scored just 86 points in 228 minutes, and multiplied that total by five in his junior season. In 2017-18, Mathis took the term "breakout" to a whole new level, dropping 433 points in 760 minutes on the floor. His shot from 3-point range couldn't be stopped as he finished the season with a program-record 66 3-pointers in conference play. He also fired from behind the arc at a clip of 47.3%, ranking fourth in the nation among other NCAA DI players.

**THE STUDENT BECOMES THE MASTER**

After posting a breakout inaugural season of his own last year, sophomore Makuach Maluach is expected to be a high-profile returner for the Lobos

this year. He's been ranked on several preseason lists and even made the cover of Lindy's Sports Magazine in August. Most recently, the soft-spoken sophomore was ranked 19th on the Mountain West Wire's Top 25.

**CONSISTENCY IS OVERRATED**

Last season, the Lobos debuted the most starting lineups in NCAA Division I with 21. Coach Weir made it clear in his first season that starting lineups would be determined by the numbers of deflections a player accumulated in the previous game, hence the sky-high number of lineup combos.

**MW PRESEASON NEWCOMER OF THE YEAR**

Redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson was named 2018 Mountain West Preseason Newcomer of the Year following the league's media poll in October. Jackson transferred from UCONN where he shot 40.9 percent from the field, 39.7 from behind the arc as a freshman in 2016-17. He reached double figures in 13 games and led the team twice in scoring in his inaugural collegiate season.

**WE'RE NOT IN KANSAS ANYMORE ...**

The Lobos return a pair of transfers that sat out last year and also welcome five more, including the highly-anticipated Carlton Bragg (Kansas/ASU transfer) who is currently eligible for conference play. Joining Bragg will be Juco transfers Corey Manigault, Keith McGee and Karim Ezzeddine who are all set to play at the start of the season.

## New Mexico Defeats CSUN, 105-89

**FULLERTON, Calif.** – The University of New Mexico men’s basketball team capitalized on four players scoring in double-digits to defeat CSUN Friday afternoon, 105-89 on the second day of the Wooden Legacy Classic. The Lobos improve to 4-1 on the season.

Senior Tim Williams and junior Elijah Brown each finished with 21 points. Williams led the Lobos with six rebounds and was 7-for-12 from the field and perfect 7-for-7 from the foul line. Brown finished the game 7-for-11 from the field, 3-for-5 from the three and 4-for-6 from the foul line. Brown also finished with seven assists. Brown’s 21 points was a season high for him.

Sam Logwood and Obij Aget were the other Lobo players that finished in double figures. Logwood finished with 13 points and Aget finished with a career-high 16 points. Logwood was 5-for-6 from the field and 3-for-4 from the foul line while Aget was perfect from the field, 6-for-6 and 4-for-5 from the foul line.

The Lobos shot 64.9 percent (37-57) for the game, which was a Wooden Legacy Classic record for shooting percentage in a single game. They shot 69 percent in the first half and 60.7 percent in the second half.

The game started out hot for the Lobos as they were shooting 83 percent through the first media timeout, taking a 14-10 lead over the Matadors. Sophomore Jordan Hunter pushed that lead to 17-10 and the Lobos went up 20-10 after a three from Brown.

The Matadors began to work their way back into the game cutting the lead to two with 9:33 left in the half. The Lobos pushed their lead back up to six at the 8:02 mark after a layup from Damien Jefferson. The Matadors worked their way back in again but the Lobos went up by as much as 14 with 1:25 left in the half. Hunter finished off the half with two free throws, giving the Lobos a 54-45 lead.

The second half was much the same as the first as the Lobos took a bigger lead. CSUN was right there to climb its way back in though. The Lobos went up by 11 after a Williams two with 13:58 left to play. The Matadors cut the lead down to two on a couple of occasions, including at the 7:50 mark. But the Lobos really took the game in the final two minutes, finishing the game on a 12-5 run. Logwood put the final two points of the game in on a monster dunk with 13 seconds left.

The Lobos took advantage of CSUN in the paint, outscoring the Matadors 50-28. The Lobos also outscored the Matadors 26-13 off turnovers, 8-0 on fast breaks and 25-19 off the bench.

Joe Furstinger came off the bench for the second time in three games and sparked the Lobos. He finished with six points. Xavier Adams also came off the bench and scored six. Hunter finished with nine points and four assists.

New Mexico will take Saturday off, before playing in the final round of the Wooden Legacy Classic on Sunday. The Lobos will be playing for fifth place against the winner of Dayton/Portland on Sunday at noon MT/ 11 a.m. PT. The game will broadcast on ESPNU and will be available on the radio on 770 KKOB.

### Matadors Outlast Cal State LA in Exhibition

**NORTHRIDGE, Calif.** --- CSUN Men's Basketball withstood a late charge from Cal State LA to earn an 89-87 victory in an exhibition game on Thursday at The Matadome. For the second-straight game, Lamine Diane posted a double-double as he registered 23 points and 14 rebounds to go with five blocks. Off the bench, Alex Sokol knocked down five 3-pointers en route to finishing with 21 points while Terrell Gomez added 14 points and three assists.

"You always want to win. We did a lot of things well but we've got to get a lot better, obviously defensively we took our foot off the pedal," said head coach Mark Gottfried. "I liked the fact we scored 89. We've scored 88 and 89 in the two exhibition games. I think defense, foul shooting and rebounding are right now the three things for us more than anything where we've got to figure out how to get these young guys to step up in those areas."

"He's been doing that every day in practice," added Gottfried about Sokol's performance. "It's interesting, guys that work really hard, usually end up getting better, and he's one of those guys. He just works hard and he's gotten better. I thought he saved us in the first half and gave us lift by making a couple big shots. He also jumped in there and got five rebounds, which was important too. He had a really good game."

In the first half, the teams went back-and-forth in the early going as the Golden Eagles staked to a 13-9 lead before the Matadors evened the score at the first media timeout on a layup from Elijah Harkless. The tide would turn when Sokol entered the contest at the 12:59 mark as the sophomore knocked down 3-pointers on three-straight possessions to give CSUN a 26-19 edge. Diane later found Sokol in transition for an easy basket followed by a driving layup from Darius Brown II.

Sokol capped off a 17-0 run with a pair of made free throws, giving the Matadors a 34-19 lead. CSUN built its biggest lead of 18 points (40-22) after Diane scored four-straight points including a coast-to-coast slam dunk in transition. The Matadors led 44-27 with 4:48 left to play before the Golden Eagles forged an 11-4 run to trim the lead to 10 points. After Diane gave the Matadors a 13-point lead with nine seconds remaining, Cal State LA's Devin Means would score a layup at the buzzer to trim the CSUN lead to 54-43 at the break.

Shooting 61.5 percent in the first half, the Matadors would only hit 37.5 percent of their field goals following halftime as the Golden Eagles fought back into the game.

Cal State LA scored the first five points in the second half until Sokol nailed a jumper at the 17:18 mark. Diane pushed the lead to 12 points on back-to-back shots, and later Gomez knocked down a shot from long range that made it a 67-52 game. From there, the Golden Eagles went on a 10-2 run, pulling to within six points on a dunk from Ja'Sean Lewis.

Sokol hit another 3-pointer at the 6:14 mark, putting CSUN on top by double digits but the Matadors went without a field goal for nearly three minutes. Shacquille Dawkins capped off a 10-2 run with a layup to trim the CSUN lead to 83-80. Diane gave the Matadors some breathing room with a layup before the Golden Eagles cut the lead to 86-84 with 1:11 on the clock. Following a Cal State LA foul, Diane went 1-for-2 at the free throw line. Seconds later, after two missed free throws from Brown, the Golden Eagles were whistled for a costly technical foul after calling a timeout when they had none remaining. Gomez then hit two-straight at the free throw line with five seconds left to ice the game.

The Matadors finished shooting 50.7 percent from the floor including 7-of-18 from 3-point range (38.9 percent) while the Golden Eagles were held to 43.7 percent shooting for the night. CSUN went 10-for-21 at the free throw line (47.6 percent) compared to Cal State LA, which hit 14 of its 18 shots from the charity stripe (77.8 percent). The Matadors also out-rebounded the opposition 43-39.

CSUN now turns its attention to the regular season set to kick off against New Mexico on Tuesday, Nov. 6. The Matadors are hosting the Lobos for the first time in program history and their first Mountain West Conference team since the 2000-01 season. Tip-off at The Matadome is slated for 7 p.m.

- The Pit has ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally nearly every season since the 1966-67 season with 35 seasons in the top ten in the NCAA in attendance
- Led the Mountain West in attendance in 10 of the conference's 15 years of existence
- The floor is named Bob King Court in honor of the former head coach who led the Lobos from 1963 to 1972.
