PREGAME REPORT

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. - HBU kicks off the season on the road against FBS Mountain West foe New Mexico Thursday at 7:06 p.m. CDT at University Stadium.

The Husky Sports Network audio broadcast with Garrett Jones will be available on HBUHuskies.com and the game will be shown on the Mountain West Network.

The Huskies will be revamped on offense under new coordinator Cedric Cormier. Sophomore Blaise Bentsen is poised to make his first collegiate start, the first new Husky to start at quarterback since 2016. Junior center Christian Hood is a returning all-conference selection and senior running back Dreshawn Minnieweather, who has 1,289 rushing yards and 17 touchdowns for his career, was a preseason all-conference pick. Junior wide receiver Vernon Harrell is the veteran of a young receiving corps.

Senior linebacker Brennan Young has been one of the most productive tacklers in the FCS over the last three seasons. He was joined on the Preseason All-Southland Conference Teams by senior safety Patrick Wolfe, senior defensive lineman Segun Ijiyera and junior defensive lineman Philip Ossai.

On special teams, HBU returns junior kicker Gino Garcia and added FBS transfer punter Brady Buell from Central Michigan. Sophomore receiver Tyson Thompson will handle return duties.

UNM is expected to start graduate transfer Terry Wilson at quarterback. He started the last 25 games of his career at Kentucky. The Lobos return leading rusher Bobby Cole, while receiver Mannie Logan-Greene is the leading returning receiver.

The Lobos return their leading tackler in Tavian Combs, while Joey Noble led the team with four sacks and Jerrick Reed led the team with four interceptions.

Thursday marks the first meeting between HBU and UNM in football. The Huskies are 0-8 all-time against FBS opponents.

HBU will host FCS Big Sky foe Northern Colorado in the home opener Saturday, Sept. 11 at 6 p.m. at Husky Stadium.

STORYLINES

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

HBU had six selection to the Preseason All-Southland Conference Teams. Junior center Christian Hood and senior safety Patrick Wolfe were automatic selections as first-team all-conference honorees last season and were joined by senior running back Dreshawn Minniweather, senior defensive lineman Segun Ijiyera, junior defensive lineman Philip Ossai and senior linebacker Brennan Young.

NEW LOOKS

The Huskies have a new offensive coordinator in Cedric Cormier and also a new defensive coordinator in Shane Eachus. Although the scheme will remain basically the same, the offense will look different with only junior center Christian Hood, senior running back Dreshawn Minniweather and senior wide receiver Vernon Harrell returning as starters. The defense only lost two starters, linebacker Caleb Johnson and safety Tra Fluellen.

JOHNSON JOINS BEARS

Linebacker Caleb Johnson became the first HBU football player to sign a professional contract with an NFL team when he joined the Chicago Bears in the spring. The undrafted free agent turned heads in the preseason, making 15 tackles and two fumble recoveries in the Bears' three preseason contests.

LINEBACKER U

HBU has produced the leading tackler in the Southland Conference each of the last five seasons, including the top two leading tacklers in 2019, and a top-five tackler nationally each of those seasons. Caleb Johnson led the league and ranked fourth nationally with 12.2 tackles per game in 2020. Brennan Young led the league and ranked fifth in the FCS with 11.3 tackles per game, while Johnson ranked second in the Southland and 10th nationally with 10.4 tackles per game in 2019. In 2018, Langston Tunson led the conference and ranked fourth in the nation and in both 2016 and 2017, Garrett Dolan led the conference and ranked second in the nation. In 2015, Dolan was second in the league and 13th nationally as a sophomore. Young returns as the active leader in tackles in the Southland.

TAKING THE REINS

Sophomore quarterback Blaise Bentsen has been named the Huskies' starter for Week 1 at New Mexico. The Sherman, Texas, native spent his first two years at HBU as a backup to Bailey Zappe, who threw for more than 10,000 yards and 78 touchdowns as a Husky. Bentsen saw action in all four games last year, competing his only pass attempt for five yards and rushing six times for 22 yards and a touchdown. His most extended action came against Texas Wesleyan in 2019, when he completed 6-of-16 passes for 82 yards, a touchdown and an interception.

SOMETHING TO PROVE

Senior running back Dreshawn Minniweather enters the 2021 as the Huskies' active leader 1,289 rushing yards and 17 total touchdowns. In 2019, he led the Southland with 90.4 rushing yards per game, scored seven rushing touchdowns and added three more receiving. However, he missed all or most of five games in 2019 and missed the first three games of the 2020 season.

FINDING A HOME

After Azusa Pacific dropped its football program last year, the Huskies picked up defensive lineman Joe Marino and running back Xzavier Ford, who were on campus for spring practice. Head coach Vic Shealy won the NAIA National Championship as head coach of the Cougars in 1998.

FAMILY TIES

Junior defensive lineman Philip Ossai's brother, Joseph, was drafted out of the University of Texas by the Cincinnati Bengals in the third round of the 2021 NFL Draft. Sophomore safety Isaiah Cash's father, Kerry, and his uncle, Keith, each played football at the University of Texas, and his mother, Kim, played soccer for the Longhorns. This year will be the first season senior running back Ean Beek is not playing at HBU with his brother, Ethan, who graduated. Their mother, Karla, played volleyball for the Huskies. Senior wide receiver Jaylon Johnson's brother, Cameron, is a wide receiver at Rice. Senior tight end Coleman Robinson's father, Rusty, was a defensive back at Texas Tech. Junior long snapper Garrett Scott's brother, Joel, played football at Arkansas. Isaiah Williams' father, Terrence, was an NCAA champion in the 4x400-meter relay. After having multiple sets of brothers on the team for the last few years, the Huskies have only one set on this year's squad, Deandre and Desmond Malone.

FORMER HUSKIES IN THE FBS

HBU lost seven players to the FBS ranks following the 2020 season. Quarterback Bailey Zappe and wide receivers Jerreth and Josh Sterns and Ben Ratzlaff are all at Western Kentucky. Safety Tra Fluellen is at Middle Tennessee, offensive lineman Reynard Burnett is at Florida International and offensive lineman Doro Omerhi is at New Mexico State.
