TIPPING OFF

After playing the last two games on the road, the Lobos return home to face Boise State on Saturday, the first of two-straight home games for UNM.

UNM enters the game after losing a late lead against SDSU, while Boise State enters after beating Fresno State on Thursday night.

Both teams are among the top 3 in the MW in blocks per game with Boise State leading with 98 blocks (5.2 per game) and UNM third at 4.6 blocks per game but second in total blocks at 87. Saturday's game will also feature the top teams in defense, as the Broncos are third in defensive field-goal percentage, holding teams to 37.2%, and the Lobos are second in defensive three-point field-goal percentage, holding opponents to 28.3% from distance.

On the offensive side, UNM is currently third in scoring offense at 72.2 points per game with Boise State fourth at 66.8 points per game.

In conference games, BSU is scoring 59.8 ppg, led by Mya Hansen at 10.0 ppg, and UNM is scoring 69.3 ppg, led by Shaiquel McGruder at 12.8 ppg and LaTascya Duff at 11.3 ppg.

**LAST TIME OUT**

The Lobos led for 33:55 of Thursday's game against San Diego State, but lost the lead late in the 65-61 defeat.

Four Lobos finished in double figures, led by a double-double effort from Shaiquel McGruder on 15 points and a game-high 10 rebounds. LaTascya Duff made five three-pointers and finished with a team-high 16 points, LaTora Duff scored 11 points to go with a game-high five assists and Paula Reus added 10 points.

UNM was hitting from distance early, getting out to an early 11-4 lead in the first five minutes behind two LaTascya three-pointers and a three-pointer and layup by Reus. The Aztecs closed in at 11-10, but an Aniyah Augmon three-pointer kept the Lobos in front, and after SDSU pulled within one at 14-13, Reus answered with a three-pointer. Following two SDSU free throws that closed the gap to within two with 2:02 left in the quarter, Augmon closed with two layups for the Lobos for the 21-15 score at the end of the first.

A McGruder layup to open the second stretched the lead further, with the margin building to 12 on a McGruder three-pointer that made it 33-21 with 5:54 left in the quarter. The lead shrunk to eight before a LaTora three-pointer with 1:38 on the clock provided the final Lobo points and SDSU scored the final points of the frame with 1:16 left for the 38-29 halftime score.

UNM had balanced scoring in the first two quarters with seven of their 15 makes coming from behind the arc and Reus and McGruder reaching double figures with Augmon at seven and LaTascya at six points.

McGruder nearly tallied a double-double in the first 20 minutes with 10 points and eight rebounds and added the final two boards in the third for the double-double, her fifth of the season.

The lead grew to its largest point of the game at 13 following a LaTascya made three-pointer and was fouled in the process, converting the free throw for the four-point play and the 44-31 Lobo lead. A LaTora three-pointer at the 4:25 mark made it 47-38 before SDSU went on a run to close within one. LaTora split a pair of free throws with three seconds remaining for the 48-46 score through three.

SDSU tied the game 10 seconds into the fourth quarter, however, LaTascya answered on the following possession with a three-pointer to put the Lobos back in front. UNM led 59-52 off of a McGruder three point play, but again, the Aztecs used a run to even the score at 59 with 4:26 remaining. LaTora put the Lobos back in the lead at 61-59 with a layup with 4:02 remaining, but were unable to score in the remaining minutes as SDSU tied the game and took the lead.

SOPHOMORES STEPPING UP

Vianè Cumber has stepped into being a reliable three-point shooter and has finished with double figures in seven games with a game with 22 points, 17 against Mississippi State, 16 against South Carolina State, three games with 15 and 12 at UNLV. The Lobo sophomore is averaging 15.9 minutes per game and 7.6 points per game, shooting 47.1% overall and 43.0% from three-point range. Cumber is second on the team in made three-pointers with 34, is third in field-goal percentage, and leads the Lobos in three-point field-goal percentage. She is fifth in the MW in three-pointers per game (1.9).

Aniyah Augmon has stepped into a larger role this season as well, and has finished with three assists in three games with a career-high five assists against Old Dominion, which she matched at Wyoming. She went 4-5 in the game against Arizona and added a steal, and in the last game against NMSU, hit three free throws in the fourth quarter in UNM's 65-64 win. She finished with a then-career-high nine points at Colorado State, which she surpassed in the next game against Nevada, scoring 11 on 4-5 shooting. She tallied a new career high at UNLV with 18 points and tied her career high in rebounds with a season-high 10 for her first career double-double. The guard is averaging 18.6 minutes per game, 5.5 points per game, 3.3 rebounds per game and 1.6 assists per game. She was a perfect 3-3 from three against UNLV and 1-1 at SDSU and is shooting 50.8% from the floor and 42.1% from three-point range.

Paula Reus has stepped into a starting role this season, starting all 19 games this season, and is averaging 8.5 points per game, 4.9 rebounds per game, 2.2 assists per game and 0.8 steals per game in an average of 27.4 minutes per game. Reus has scored in double figures in nine games this season, including the last three, and finished with double-digit rebounds in two games. Reus led the team in rebounds in five games. She recorded her first career double-double against NMSU with 11 points and 10 rebounds (a career high) and matched her career high of 10 rebounds at Colorado State. Reus is third on the team in rebounds (93) and assists (41) and fourth in three-pointers (22) and in points (161).

THREE FALLING

UNM built an identity last season as a three-point shooting team, and this year's team is trying to reclaim that identity.

The Lobos have finished with 10-plus three-pointers in eight games this season with a season-high 18 against South Carolina State, while shooting a season-high 46.2%. The 18 tied for the third most in a game in program history, only behind 19 and 21 the Lobos made last season against Colorado State and Utah State, respectively.

UNM is averaging 9.1 made three-pointers per game, ranked 12th in the NCAA, with 43.8 percent of UNM's shot attempts three-pointers. The Lobos are

shooting 33.4% from three with 172 makes. LaTascya Duff leads the Lobos with 56 made three-pointers, and is making 31 per game and 15 games of multiple three-pointers. Vianè Cumber is second with 34 made three-pointers, averaging 1.9 per game with 10 games with multiple three-pointers. Cumber is shooting 43.0% from three and Duff 38.1% from three.

In MW games, the Lobos are making 9.3 three-pointers per game to lead the conference, and shooting 36.6% from distance. Duff is shooting 45.9% from three with 17 makes and Cumber is shooting 47.6% with 10 made three-pointers.

FINDING OTHER WAYS TO SCORE

While UNM has had eight games with 10-plus three-pointers, the Lobos are actually 3-5 in those games. The Lobos are 4-2 when making exactly nine and won against Houston when only making two three-pointers.

The Lobos are shooting 43.0 percent from the floor this season and 50.5% (334-661) when excluding three-point attempts. The Lobos are 8-4 when shooting .400 or better and have shot .400 or better in 11 of the last 15 games, including a season-high 54.8% in the game against South Carolina State. UNM shot 54.5% in its game against Nevada for its second-highest percentage of the season.

The Lobos have shot better than 50.0% in three of the last six games and in four games this season (also shot 52.3% against NMSU).

BALANCED ATTACK

UNM has had seven different leading scorers this season in LaTascya Duff, Amaya Brown, LaTora Duff, Vianè Cumber, Shaiquel McGruder, Paula Reus and most recently, Aniyah Augmon.

The game at Nicholls was the first time that there was a repeat leading scorer, with LaTascya scoring a game-high 20 points at Southern Utah and at Nicholls. Duff also led the scoring at SDSU with 16 points. Reus led the team in scoring twice, with 18 at Texas A&M-Commerce and 14 against Arizona. Cumber has led the team in scoring twice with 22 against Western New Mexico and 17 against Mississippi State. Following the game at CSU, Brown has now led the team in scoring twice (16 against Houston, career-high 18 at Colorado State). Augmon led the team in scoring at UNLV with a career-high 18 points.

McGruder has led the Lobos in scoring seven times, scoring 24 against Arizona State, 23 against Abilene Christian and South Carolina State, 22 at Wyoming, 21 against Air Force and 16 against NMSU and Old Dominion.

IN EXCLUSIVE COMPANY

Shaiquel McGruder currently has 1250 points and 767 rebounds, ranking her 12th all-time in points and is sixth in program history in rebounds. She is 51 points away from 11th and 21 rebounds away from fifth. If McGruder matches her production from last season, the Lobo could climb into the top 10 in scoring and as high as third in rebounds.

McGruder also has 160 career blocks, third all-time and 15 away from second. Her 197 career steals ranks her fourth all-time and 11 from third.

During her career, McGruder is shooting a program-best .600 from the floor and scored 73 points as a freshman, 215 points as a sophomore, 182 as a junior and 512 points last season. She's scored 268 points this season and is shooting 59.2%.

Among MW players, McGruder is in the top 10 in scoring (fourth) and rebounds (fourth), is second in field-goal percentage, seventh in steals per game (2.1) but tied for third in steals (39), and leads the conference in blocks (48) with two more blocks than the next MW player. Nationally, she is 19th in field-goal percentage, fifth in blocks and ninth in blocks per game.

This season, McGruder leads the team in scoring (14.1 ppg), rebounds (7.6 per game), steals (2.1 per game) and blocks (2.5 per game) and is shooting a team-best 59.2% from the floor. She's had three games with 20-plus points and 10-plus rebounds this season.

CONSISTENT TORA DUFF

Returning for another season, LaTora Duff has been the floor general for the Lobos for the past three seasons, starting in every game she's played in. Prior to missing the WNMU game for a family matter, Duff had started in 60-straight games for the Lobos.

Duff has scored in double figures in 10 games, has finished with five rebounds in eight games and recorded multiple steals in eight games but has had at least one steal in 11 with a career-high five at Nicholls. She has played 30-plus minutes in 13 games with three games of 40 or more minutes, including all 40 minutes of regulation at Colorado State.

Against Air Force, she finished with 15 points, seven assists and seven rebounds and against Arizona State, she finished with a double-double of 13 points and 10 assists along with three steals and five rebounds, playing in 42:14.

Duff is averaging 32.0 minutes, 9.8 points, 4.0 rebounds, 4.4 assists and 1.3 steals per game.

She currently has 349 career assists, 10th all-time in program history, and is 38 from ninth.

TRIPLE THREAT TAY

There is no one better in the MW and very few better in the country when it comes to three-pointers than LaTascya Duff.

The San Diego State game was the 55th career game at UNM for Duff with multiple three-pointers and the Nicholls game was the 16th time that Duff has scored 20 or more points as a Lobo.

She currently has a career three-point percentage of .407, third all-time in program history, and 205 career three-pointers, third all-time in program history, 13 away from second and 16 away from tying the program record. She is just the third player all-time to make 200 career three-pointers.

The super senior leads the MW in three-point field-goal percentage at .381 (with a 2.5 3FG/G average), in three-pointers per game at 3.1 and made three-pointers (56), 17 more than the second-highest player in the MW. Nationally, she is fourth in the NCAA in three-pointers per game and ninth in three-pointers.

Duff has had at least one three-pointer in the last 13 games with multiple three-pointers in 12 of the last 13 games. On the season, has had 15 games with multiple three-pointers, including five games with four made threes, four with two, three with five, two with three and one with six.

Duff made at least one three-pointer in all but one game last season and had a streak of 29 games with a three, the longest streak in program history, which ended in the Feb. 16 game against Utah State.

Last season, she finished with 97 three-pointers, the second most in a single season in program history, and made multiple three-pointers in 28 games, making a three-pointer in all but one game. In addition, she made five or more three-pointers in six games and four or more in nine games. She shot 42.7 percent from three-point range, the fifth-best percentage in a single season in program history.

Duff led the MW in three-pointers made, made per game (2.77) and in three-point field-goal percentage on the season. She also led the MW in three-point percentage (.422), made three-pointers (46) and three-pointers per game (2.56) in conference games.

Among the NCAA, Duff ranked seventh in three-pointers made, 13th in three-point field-goal percentage and 17th in made three-point goals per game.

ALL-AROUND AMAYA BROWN

Redshirt-senior Amaya Brown has shown her all-around ability to impact the game.

She has scored 10 or more points in seven games this season and recorded multiple steals in seven games, including a career-high five at Nicholls. She's had a steal in 15 games, has led the team in rebounds three times and in scoring twice.

Tasked with guarding Air Force's leading scorer Kamri Heath, who entered the game averaging 15.6 points per game and hadn't scored fewer than nine points in a game this season entering the game, Brown held Heath to 1-6 shooting on the afternoon and just three points.

Against Houston, she finished with a team- and then-career-high 16 points and team- and career-high 11 rebounds for her first career double-double, and added two steals, a block and went a career-best 8-for-8 from the free-throw line.

In the game at Colorado State, Brown made a career-high four three-pointers on six attempts and went 2-2 at the line to finish with a career-high 18 points.

Brown is currently second on the team in rebounds (97, 5.1 per game) and is also averaging 1.4 steals per game and 7.9 points per game.

She has also been reliable at the free-throw line, going 8-8 against Houston and in the fourth quarter against the Aggies, Brown went 4-4, including two free throws that tied the game at 57. She's been perfect at the line in six games and is shooting 86.0% (37-43) from the line, leading the Lobos in makes and second in attempts.

SHAI SHOW

For the second time in four weeks, Shaiquel McGruder earned Mountain West Player of the Week on Jan. 2, and in the process became the second Mountain West player to win the award multiple times this season.

It was the third career weekly conference award for McGruder and the second this season after being named player of the week on Dec. 12.

The Lobo tallied 22.0 points per game, 10.5 rebounds per game, 3.5 blocks per game and 2.0 steals per game while shooting 76.9 percent from the floor on 20-26 shooting in the last week's wins over South Carolina State and Air Force.

McGruder recorded her fourth double-double of the season in Sunday's conference opener against Air Force, reaching the feat in the first 20 minutes with 12 points and 11 rebounds in 17:35 on the court. In addition, the Ohio native had two blocks and one steal by the break, finishing with a game-high 21 points, game-high 13 rebounds, game-high four blocks and two steals. Sunday

was also the fourth time that the Lobo forward finished with 20-plus points, 12th game in double figures, 10th game registering multiple blocks and 11th game registering multiple steals this season. She's had at least one steal and one block in 12 games this season and has had a block in all 14 games this season.

The week started with 23 points to go with eight rebounds, three blocks and two steals in Thursday's win against South Carolina State, setting the game highs in points, rebounds and blocks in 23:16 of play. On the week, McGruder scored in double figures in two of the quarters, with 11 points in the fourth quarter of Thursday's win after going 4-4, and 10 points in the second quarter of Sunday's game against Air Force, going 5-6.

Following a week in which she averaged 19.5 points per game, 8.0 rebounds per game, 3.0 steals per game and 3.0 blocks per game and shot 83.3 percent from the floor, Shaiquel McGruder was named Mountain West Player of the Week on Dec. 12.

It was the second career weekly conference award for McGruder and she became the first Lobo to be selected this season.

The Lobo forward had a sensational week, scoring in double figures in both games against Abilene Christian and New Mexico State, highlighted by a perfect 9-9 shooting against ACU.

McGruder finished with a game-high 23 points in the win against the Wildcats to go with a game-high 13 rebounds for her third double-double of the season, and added a game-high four steals and game-high five blocks. It was the seventh-straight game with multiple blocks and second game this season with five, and the sixth game with multiple steals. Against the Aggies, the Ohio native recorded a team-high 16 points and added two steals and a block to her weekly total, playing 35:08 and all but 53 seconds of the third and fourth quarters.

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

In the 43 seasons and previous 1294 games of the Lobo women's basketball program, the New Mexico State and Arizona State games were the first time that the Lobos have played consecutive overtime games. In the 2010-11 season, UNM had two, two overtime games in the span of three games.

PRESEASON EXPECTATIONS

The Lobo women's basketball team was picked to finish second in the Mountain West predicted order of finish, with UNM also placing three on the preseason All-Mountain West team, as announced by the conference on Wednesday.

As a team, New Mexico received 264 points and two first-place votes, while Shaiquel McGruder was named to the All-Mountain West team, Amaya Brown was named Preseason Newcomer of the Year and Hannah Robbins was selected as the Preseason Freshman of the Year.

It is the second-straight season that the Lobos were picked to finish second in the preseason poll, with UNM finishing second in the conference last season, and the third time in head coach Mike Bradbury's tenure.

Brown joins LaTascya Duff in earning the preseason newcomer accolade, with Duff earning the honor in 2020-21. An Albuquerque native, Brown returns home to play for the Lobos after spending the last three years at Florida State. During her time with the Seminoles, the redshirt-senior played in 44 games and recorded 55 rebounds, 37 assists, 17 steals and six blocks.

Robbins is the first Lobo to be named preseason freshman of the year since N'Dea Flye in 2017, and the fourth overall, joining Mykiel Burleson in 2016 and Jannon Otto in 2015. Out of Phoenix, Arizona and PHH Prep, the Lobo guard averaged 16.5 points, 7.4 rebounds, 3.1 steals and 1.1 blocks per game as a sophomore and 16 points, eight rebounds, three steals and two blocks per game her junior year.

NOT SHAI'ING AWAY FROM EXPECTATIONS

UNM super senior forward Shaiquel McGruder was named to the preseason watch list for the 2023 Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year Award presented by Her Hoop Stats.

McGruder is one of 25 players on the preseason list, and joins Colorado State's McKenna Hofschild as representatives from the Mountain West.

It is the second preseason accolade for the Ohio native, who was named to the Mountain West preseason MW team on Oct. 12.

McGruder earned her first preseason conference honor after being named to the MW All-Conference and All-Defensive teams last season. Last season, the Ohio native led the conference in field-goal percentage, shooting 60.8 percent from the floor, and scored in double figures in 25 games with seven games with 20-plus points. Her .608 field-goal percentage is the second best in a single season in program history.

Defensively, she recorded multiple steals in 20 games, and at least one steal in 28 games including in every conference game but five. Additionally, she had at least one block in 23 games, including twice registering five blocks, a game with four blocks and five games with three blocks. She finished fourth in the MW in steals per game at 1.83 per game, as well as second in blocked shots



and blocked shots per game with 49 and 1.36, respectively.

Last season, McGruder produced the best numbers in her career as a Lobo in points, rebounds, steals, blocks, assists, made three-pointers, made baskets and free throws. She also led the team in steals, rebounds and made baskets and was second in scoring.

PLANS CHANGE

In a decision made by coaches and players and their families, freshmen Natalia Chavez and Hannah Robbins have decided for the time being to redshirt this season. Plans can change in that the redshirt could be pulled, but neither Chavez or Robbins have dressed in any games.

Further, sophomore Mackenzie Curtis has also decided to redshirt this season.

PRIDE OF NEW MEXICO

The Lobos have five New Mexico natives on the roster in freshmen Natalia Chavez and Jaelyn Bates, sophomore Viané Cumber, redshirt-senior Amaya Brown, and while her hometown is listed as Phoenix, Arizona, Hannah Robbins was born in Albuquerque.

In addition, the Lobos have two New Mexico Gatorade Player of the Year winners in Brown and Cumber, with Brown winning in 2015-16 and 2017-18 and Cumber winning in 2019-20 and 2020-21.

The player who won in 2016-17: recently graduated Jaedyn De La Cerda, meaning the winner in five of the last seven years were Lobos.

LIKE FATHER, LIKE DAUGHTER

UNM has two players on the 2022-23 roster who are continuing the Lobo legacy as their fathers also played for New Mexico.

Hannah Robbins (Rob Robbins) and Amaya Brown (Greg Brown) look to create their own legacy in the Cherry and Silver, which the groundwork has already started before the season even tipped off as Robbins was named the MW Preseason Freshman of the Year and Brown the MW Preseason Newcomer of the Year.

Greg Brown played at UNM from 1992-94, leading the Lobos in scoring in 1993-94 in points (599, 19.3 points per game) en route to WAC Player of the Year. Rob Robbins played basketball at New Mexico from 1987-91. Robbins led the Lobos in three-point percentage in the 1990-91, 1988-89, 1987-88 seasons, in three-pointers in each of his four seasons and in free-throw percentage in the 1988-89, 1989-90 and 1990-91 seasons. Robbins is currently ninth in career scoring leaders with 1,739 points, averaging 13.1 points per game, and eighth in career field-goal leaders with 583 made baskets and a .464 field-goal percentage. He currently also holds the program record with consecutive made free throws with 52 during the 1989-90 season.

When Robbins signed last November, she noted her father in her reasons for wanting to become a Lobo. "Growing up in New Mexico, it has always been a dream to play in The Pit. The facilities along with the coaching staff are unmatched and I am extremely excited to follow in my dad's footsteps at UNM." Of note, Robbins wears #42, the number her father wore as a Lobo and is often referred to as Rob's daughter.

LOBOS GOING NATIONAL

The University of New Mexico women's basketball team will have two Mountain West games broadcast nationally on FS1 or CBS Sports Network, as announced by the conference.

The Lobos' home game against Air Force to open conference play has been moved from New Year's Eve to New Year's Day with a 2 p.m. MT tip time on CBS Sports Network, while their game at UNLV on Saturday, Jan. 14 was selected by FS1 for a 6 p.m. PT/ 7 p.m. MT tip time.

In total, the Lobos will be featured in half of the Mountain West women's basketball regular season games broadcasted nationally this season.

NON-CONFERENCE PREP WORK

The Southern Utah game marked the start of a challenging non-conference schedule as New Mexico had three Power 5 programs scheduled in Arizona State, Arizona and Mississippi State, although the Lobos had the benefit of home court against the Arizona schools. The Lobos also hosted Houston out of the American (a 68-61 win) and faced Old Dominion on a neutral court in December.

Three opponents (Arizona, Texas A&M-Commerce and Old Dominion) all finished with 20-plus wins last season with seven finishing with a winning record.

The Lobos played six non-conference games on the road and seven games in The Pit.

REWRITE THE RECORD BOOK

The Lobos are coming off of a historic season, setting several program marks.

To start, the Lobos won 26 games, tying the program record for single-season wins. UNM has won 26 games just two other times in program history, the last time being the 2004-05 season (26-5). The other time was the 1997-98 season (26-7).

The Lobos went 17-1 at home, with the last time the Lobos had just one home loss was in that 2004-05 season, going 19-1.

Further history was made as a team last season, as the Lobos set the program record for most three-pointers in a season with 346.

Individually, several Lobos are re-writing the record book with single-season stats. LaTascya Duff currently has made 92 three-pointers this season, tied for second all-time in single-season three-pointers. Her 42.2% accuracy from three ranks sixth in single-season percentage. Shaquell McGruder has made 212 field-goals this season, fourth all-time and her field-goal percentage of 61.4% ranks second in single-season field-goal percentage. LaTora Duff has 188 assists this season, placing her sixth and four away from fifth.

In the WNIT win against Grand Canyon, the Lobos set some postseason records as well, with the 27 assists and 14 three-pointers setting the record. The 92 points were the second-most scored and the 34 made field goals tied the program record (last done against Rice in 2018). LaTora's 13 assists set the program postseason record and McGruder's six steals ranked second in individual steals in a postseason game. LaTascya's 27 points ranked as the third-most points scored by a player in a postseason game.

HISTORY MADE IN LOGAN

The Lobo women's basketball team put on a three-point clinic on Jan. 6 against Utah State, setting a program record with 21 made three-pointers in a 98-83 victory.

The previous record was 18, made against Illinois in 2017, which the Lobos already surpassed in the third quarter.

In addition, the 21 three-pointers also broke the MW record of 20, that was achieved three times previously- by Colorado State in 2016, Wyoming in 2010 and BYU in 2001. Of those, only one was against a MW school, Wyoming against Air Force in 2010.

LaTascya Duff and Jaedyn De La Cerda hit seven three-pointers each with De La Cerda finishing with a game-high 27 points and Duff with 24 points. LaTora Duff made three, three-pointers, finishing with 13 points, Antonia Anderson made two three-pointers and Viané Cumber and Kath van Bennekom each made a three. De La Cerda's seven tied her career high, while LaTascya's set a career high, besting the six that she made last year against Utah State. It also extended her three-point streak to 18 games and was her fourth game this season with 20-plus points.

Anderson made it officially the record with a three-pointer with 36 remaining in the third quarter, with the Lobos making seven three-pointers in the first, six in the second and six in the third quarter, shooting 66.7 percent in the second quarter and 60 percent from three in the third quarter.

LaTora also tallied a double-double with a career-high 14 assists to go with her 13 points for her second double-double of the season coming close to a triple-double with a team-high eight rebounds, and Anderson tied her season high with five blocks, the second time this season that the senior has blocked five shots in a game. It was also the third-straight game against the Aggies that the Lobos have neared the 100-point mark, scoring 93 points, 97 points and now 98 points in the last three meetings. In those three games, the Lobos made 15, 16 and 21 three-pointers.

KNOW YOUR OPPONENT

Boise State enters the game 8-11 on the season, 3-3 in conference following a 60-53 win against Fresno State on Thursday. The Broncos are 1-4 on the road.

The Broncos are averaging 66.8 points per game, led by Elodie Lalotte at 10.6 points per game. BSU is allowing 63.5 points per game, with opponents shooting 37.2% and 33.1% from three.

Abby Muse leads the team in rebounds (156, 8.2 per game) and in blocks (46), and is one of three players with 15 steals for the team high.

Lalotte, Muse, Mary Kay Naro and Dani Bayes have started all 19 games for Boise State, with Mya Hansen starting 17 and Anna Ostlie starting two.

In conference play, BSU is scoring 59.8 points per game with opponents scoring 61.7 points per game. The Broncos have wins over San Jose State (73-62), Utah State (73-56) and Fresno State, and losses to Colorado State (71-50), San Diego State (55-42) and UNLV (73-61).

The Broncos have started the same five in all six conference games in Hansen, Bayes, Muse, Lalotte and Naro. Hansen leads the team in scoring at 10.0 points per game, as well as in assists (21) and steals (four), and Lalotte leads on the boards with 8.2 rebounds per game. Muse has 15 blocks against MW opponents.

Boise State is third in the MW in defensive field-goal percentage, fourth in scoring offense and fourth in scoring defense, and leads the conference in blocks (98) and blocks per game (5.2). Muse is third in rebounds per game, with Lalotte seventh, and is second in blocks with 46 (2.4 per game).

MIKE BRADBURY
RECORD AT UNM: 130-74 (7TH SEASON)
CAREER RECORD: 308-191 (16TH SEASON)

NOTEWORTHY :

- Named the sixth head coach in program history on March 31, 2016
- 26 wins this season tied for most wins in program history
- Led UNM to 25 wins in 2017-18; tied for second-most wins in program history
- Led UNM to 20+ wins in three seasons including 2021-22, and .500 or better in five
- Earned his 100th win at UNM on Nov. 30, 2021; only the second coach in program history to reach 100. Earned his 300th career win on Nov. 22, 2022 against Western N.M.

Mike Bradbury enters his sixth season as head coach for The University of New Mexico women's basketball team. In his previous five seasons at the helm, Bradbury has guided the Lobos to a 94-55 (.631) overall record. Twice in his tenure, in 2017-18 and 2018-19, the Lobos eclipsed the 20-win mark and totaled 49 victories over that time. The consecutive 20-plus win seasons under Bradbury are the first for the program since the 2007-08 – 2008-09 seasons.

In his most recent season at the helm of the Lobos, Bradbury led the Lobos to a Mountain West regular season championship, the first outright in program history and the first regular season title since the 2004-05 season. In addition, the Lobos were selected for the WNIT for the third time in four years.

The Lobos produced one of the most prolific offenses not only in the conference, but in the country, finishing among the top 25 in several categories. Among them, UNM finished fourth in the NCAA in made three-pointers per game (10.2), sixth in assist-turnover ratio (1.40), ninth in scoring offense (81.2 points per game), 14th in fewest turnovers per game (12.0) and assists per game (16.8) and 22nd in scoring margin (12.7). The Lobos led the Mountain West in scoring offense, scoring margin, assists per game, turnover margin, assist-turnover ratio and made three-pointers as well as second in field-goal percentage and steals per game.

UNM set a program record in scoring with 120 points against Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Dec. 17, 2020 and in the process, made 17 three-pointers, falling just one short of tying the program record. Further, the Lobos registered 90-plus points in five games and 80-plus points in 11 of the 20 games on the season.

Four Lobos finished the 2020-21 season averaging double figures in points per game with six players finishing in double figures in scoring in two games (the only times it has been accomplished in program history), five players in five games and four in seven games.

As a result of UNM's successful season, five players were named to the All-Mountain West Team with LaTascya Duff also earning the superlative of Sixth Person of the Year. Duff was just the second Lobo to win the sixth person award. Making the all-conference team for the first time were Duff, Jaedyn De La Cerda and Antonia Anderson, as well as Shaiquel McGruder earning all-defensive and Ahlise Hurst earning the honorable mention distinction.

In his third year at the helm, Bradbury continued to put his mark on the program while also continuing to bring Lobo women's basketball back to national prominence. Overall, Bradbury's 2018-19 team went 24-7 and earned a bid to the WNIT for a second-straight season. It marked the first time since the 2008-09 – 2009-10 seasons that the program made consecutive trips to the postseason.



After dropping a one-possession game to Auburn in the preseason WNIT, the 2018-19 Lobos ripped off 11-straight wins to tie the program record and were on the cusp of cracking the national top-25 rankings as well by receiving votes from the WBCA during that stretch. Bradbury would also receive an individual plaudit from the WBCA last season as he was named as one of 13 finalists for the 2019 United States Marine Corps/WBCA National Coach of the Year Award. Impressively, Bradbury was the only coach from a non-Power 5 conference to be a finalist.

In his time at UNM, Bradbury has coached 13 All-Mountain West performers with Cherise Beynon, Jayla Everett, Jaisa Nunn, Aisia Robertson and Richelle van der Keijl joining De La Cerda, Duff, McGruder, Hurst and Anderson in making the All-Mountain West Team. Tasha Buck, Mykiel Bureson and Nike McClure have also earned MW recognition with Buck being the 2017-18 Newcomer of the Year, Bureson being named to the All-Freshman team in 2016-17 and McClure landing on the All-Defensive team in 2018-19.

In terms of major individual awards, Bradbury has coached the league's Newcomer of the Year each of his first three seasons in charge of the Lobos with van der Keijl earning the award in 2016-17, Buck in 2017-18 and Robertson in 2018-19. Additionally, Bradbury has coached the MW Player of the Year in Nunn (2018-19) and the Freshman of the Year in Everett (2018-19) as well as Sixth Person of the Year in Duff (2020-21).

Further, a Lobo has been named Mountain West Player of the Week 11 times during his tenure.

In year two under Bradbury the Lobos had a breakout season, especially offensively as they ended the 2017-18 season averaging 80.4 points per game while also posting an impressive +9.7 scoring margin. Both marks led the Mountain West and the point-per-game total was 16th-best in NCAA DI last season. A significant reason for the jump in offensive production was the fact that the Lobos were one of the most potent three-point shooting threats in the country. For the season, the Lobos attempted the eighth-most overall trifectas in DI hoisting 932 long distance shots. Successful 34% of the time, the Lobos made the 11th most 3's burying 319.

Prior to coming to Albuquerque, Bradbury built a successful nine year run as a Division-I head coach with stops at Morehead State (Morehead, Ky.) and Wright State (Dayton, Ohio). Most recently with the Raiders, Bradbury led his squad to five 20-win seasons, including each of his final three seasons. During that time, Wright State has amassed a 75-28 record, the best amongst the 13 Division I programs in the state of Ohio.

Overall at Wright State, Bradbury had five winning seasons, all of which were 20-plus win seasons, in six years- a feat made all the more remarkable as Wright State had just one winning season in the previous 22 before his arrival. In the previous 37 seasons of women's basketball at Wright State, the Raider program had tallied 20 wins just once before Bradbury led the team to 20 wins in five of his six seasons.

His most prominent three-year run at Wright State started in 2013-14, when the Raiders won a school-record 26 games on the way to a 26-9 season and the program's first-ever appearance in the NCAA Tournament. That season saw the Raiders finish second in the Horizon League and win its first Horizon

League Tournament. It also featured the program's first road win at perennial league power Wisconsin-Green Bay. Kim Demmings was named the Horizon League Player of the Year and Tournament MVP, and it marked the first time in school history the program had a pair of first team All-Conference selections.

He followed up that by earning Horizon League Coach of the Year in 2014-15 after a 25-9 season that saw his squad lose its Horizon League Preseason Player of the Year less than two minutes into the season opener. The Raiders just missed a second straight NCAA Tournament appearance, falling in overtime in the conference championship game. The team did make its first appearance in the Women's NIT as the league's automatic qualifier, and in 2015-16, the team made it back-to-back WNIT appearances after a 24-11 season, earning the program's first at-large bid.

Those three seasons are the three winningest seasons in the history of Wright State women's basketball.

In his first two seasons at Wright State, he led the team to a 20-13 campaign and a 21-13 mark and berths in the Women's Basketball Invitational, the first NCAA Division I postseason berths for the program. Overall, Bradbury has coached three Horizon League Players of the Year (all in his last three seasons), six first-team All-Horizon League players, three second-team members and four All-Freshman team members.

Prior to his time at Wright State, Bradbury was the head coach at Morehead State where he led the Division I program to a 50-44 mark in three seasons, including a watershed 22-11 season, which was the second-most wins in Morehead State history and the most wins by the Eagles in the previous 38 years.

At Morehead State he coached one Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year, along with one first-team All-OVC pick (two seasons) and three second-team All-OVC picks.

Bradbury also spent time as an assistant coach at Xavier (2002-06), Cincinnati (1996-02), VCU (1995-96), East Tennessee State (1994-95) and Chattanooga (1991-94). In his 29 seasons as an assistant and as a head coach, Bradbury has had 27 winning seasons.
