LOBO NOTES

GETTING STARTED

- The Lobos open the season with three consecutive home matches and will play five of their first six matches at home, not counting the two exhibitions at home.
- The series with the Red Raiders has been evenly matched with Texas Tech holding a 6-5-2 lead in the series but UNM holding a 19-18 advantage in goals scored.

SEASON OPENERS vs. TEXAS TECH

- The Lobos have played Texas Tech in season openers five times previously, the last in the 2019 season, winning 1-0.
- This is the fourth time under Coach Dyche that UNM opens the season against Texas Tech.
- UNM is 2-3 in season openers against TTU, 1-2 under Coach Dyche.

FIGHT FOR 4

- New Mexico is coming off its third consecutive conference title, becoming the first MW school to achieve that feat since San Diego State won four straight from 2012-15.
- The Lobos were picked to finish third in the MW preseason poll.
- New Mexico received one first place vote and 97 points, with the narrowest of margins separating 1-3 in the poll. San Diego State received one point more than the Lobos with four first-place votes for 98 points and Wyoming was tabbed the preseason favorite with 100 points behind four first-place votes. San José State was fourth in the predicted order of finish with 92 points and received three first-place votes.
- It marked the fifth consecutive year that the Lobos were picked by the conference coaches to finish in the top three of the conference standings and the sixth time in head coach Heather Dyche's tenure at UNM with Dyche entering her ninth season at the helm. The Lobos were also picked third in the spring 2021 season, also receiving one first-place vote and 97 points, ultimately going on to finish 10-1-0 en route to a conference regular season championship.
- UNM enters the season following a 7-3-9 record overall and a 5-1-5 conference campaign in 2022, in which the Lobos claimed their third consecutive Mountain West regular-season championship.
- In the previous eight seasons under Dyche, the Lobos have gone 54-22-12 against MW opponents and have won four MW titles.

HOME STATS

- The Lobos were 4-2-5 at home last season.
- UNM outscored opponents 16-9 and outshot opponents 218-134.
- New Mexico was 4-0-2 when scoring first last season.
- Of UNM's 17 regular season matches, 11 are at home in addition to having two exhibitions at home.
- Historically, UNM is 139-75-32 (.630) at home, 41-16-8 during Coach Dyche's tenure.

EXHIBITION NOTES

- The Lobos opened with UTEP, playing 80 minutes to a 1-1 draw before moving to penalty kicks in which the Lobos had the 5-3 advantage. Preseley Devey scored at the 2:23 mark off of a blocked penalty kick, tracking down the ball and burying it in the back of the net. UNM held a 21-7 advantage in total shots and 8-3 edge in shots on goal against the Miners.
- UNM concluded its exhibition schedule against CSU Pueblo on Monday and had three different goal scorers in a 3-0 win. Natalie DeGagne opened the scoring with an unassisted goal at 16:15, with Alysa Whelchel adding a second goal at 62:02 and Sariah Brady closing the match with a final goal at 86:29. Mia Leon assisted on Brady's goal. Against CSU Pueblo, UNM had a 37-5 edge in shots and 16-2 in shots on goal.

WHAT'S NEW WITH UNM

- UNM has 10 newcomers on the 2023 roster with seven freshmen and three transfers.
- New Mexico added a goalkeeper in Mariah Scott (UTEP), a player who can play both defender and midfield in Brae Cole (Washington State) and a forward in redshirt junior Margaux Clarke (Washington).
- The Lobos lost their top two goal scorers in Jadyn Edwards and Leilani Baker who led with eight and seven goals, respectively, and top two leaders in assists in Edwards and Karlee Maes (four).

SOMETHING TO RELY ON

- The Lobos return eight players who played in all 19 matches last season, including three who started in all 19 in Sophia Roberts, Myah Isais and Alli Davis.
- Davis finished with seven shutouts in her first season in net and the defense finished the season with six consecutive shutouts and an ongoing streak of 602 minutes without conceding a goal.
- Davis' 0.70 goals against average in 2022 was tied for the fourth best in a single season in program history and her 597:51 shutout streak set the program record.
- Isais is entering her senior season and coming off of being named to the MW All-Tournament Team and Roberts and Davis are both entering their junior and sophomore seasons, respectively, after making the MW All-Newcomer Team.
- Last season, the Lobos allowed 0.83 goals per game, which was the fewest since 2011 (0.68).
- The eight shutouts were the most since 2016, when the Lobos also recorded eight.

LEAD ON

- The Lobos have seven players on the team leadership council. Among the group are Paris Dalton, Dalis Bruce, Zaria Katesigwa, Natalie DeGagne, Alli Davis, Myah Isais and Callie Droitsch.

30 YEARS

- UNM Soccer is celebrating 30 years of its soccer program in 2023.
- Amy Allmann was the coach in the inaugural season, leading the Lobos to an 11-5-1 record in 1993.
- UNM won its first match as a program, a 1-0 win over Regis on Sept. 4, 1993 and won its first five matches.
- The Lobos have gone 278-228-74 (.543) overall in the 30 years and have won six conference titles (all in the MW: 2011, 2012, 2018, 2020, 2021, 2022).

- Dyche is also a technical advisor for USL team New Mexico United (one of only two women in the country involved with men's professional team staffing)
- Vice president of United Soccer Coaches and set to be named the president of the organization in 2026
- Has been involved with U.S. Soccer as a coach with numerous youth national team programs and as part of the U.S. Women's National Team staff for the 2017 World Cup in Canada, 2019 World Cup in France and 2021 World Cup Qualifying in Monterrey, Mexico.

COACHING STAFF

Heather Dyche joined the Lobo family in 2015 as the fourth head women's soccer coach at The University of New Mexico. The 2023-24 academic year marks her ninth season in charge of the Lobos.

CAREER SUMMARY

Dyche was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in back-to-back seasons, in 2020 and 2021. She has led New Mexico to six Mountain West Tournament appearances, including three championship games. The Albuquerque native owns an 86-47-22 (.626) overall record and a 54-22-12 (.682) mark in Mountain West play. Under her guidance, UNM has won four regular season titles (2018, 2020, 2021, 2022), the 2021 Mountain West Championships title, and made back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances (2020 & 2021).

Dyche's 86 wins are second-most in UNM history behind Kit Vela, who went 122-105-45 (.529) from 2001-2014. Her seven postseason wins are also second-most behind Vela's 12. Dyche's .626 winning percentage is the best ever by a UNM head coach, as is her postseason winning percentage of .559.

Overall, she has coached 35 All-Mountain West selections (14 First Team, 12 Second Team), 16 All-MW Tournament Players, seven All-Region players, 14 CoSIDA Academic All-District selections, three CoSIDA Academic All-America, 18 Mountain West Players of the Week, 123 Mountain West All-Academic selections and 109 Mountain West Scholar-Athletes. Four student-athletes that she coached signed professional contracts under her tenure.

2022 - Mountain West Regular-Season Champions - Mountain West Championships Semifinal

Dyche guided the Lobos to a share of their third-consecutive Mountain West regular-season title in 2022, with the team going 7-3-9 overall and 5-1-5 in conference play. The Lobos hosted the Mountain West Championships, falling to San José State in penalty kicks in the semifinals of the tournament. UNM broke the program record for consecutive shutout minutes with 602:51, ending the season with the streak intact. UNM's team goals-against average of .082 was the lowest the program had seen since a mark of .068 during the 2011 season.

2021 - Mountain West Regular-Season Champions - Mountain West Championships Champions - NCAA Championship First Round

The 2021 season followed in the 2020 season's success. The Lobos won their first Mountain West Tournament championship since 2011. Dyche led the Lobos to many records, including a program-high eight-game winning streak and nine-game conference winning streak (dating back to the 2020 season). She guided the team to the second-most single-season wins as they finished the season with 14 wins, also going undefeated in conference play at home. In typical MW Coach of the Year fashion, she coached the Newcomer of the Year and Offensive Player of the Year.

2020 - Mountain West Regular-Season Champions - NCAA Championship Second Round

The 2020 season saw records fall as UNM advanced to the second round of the NCAA College Cup and winning its first outright Mountain West title since 2011. The program went 10-2-1 under Dyche as she was named the Mountain West's Coach of the Year. The Lobos blasted their way into the record books by averaging 2.38 goals per game (scoring 31 in just 13 games). The team turned in a 0.90 goals against average, the lowest in seven years, and UNM was nearly unstoppable in the regular season, allowing just three goals in 10 games leading up to the title game. The Lobos of 2020 advanced to the NCAA Tournament after a thrilling 3-2 overtime win over San Diego State in front of a capacity crowd in Albuquerque. UNM then got past Navy in the opening round, winning 4-2 in penalties after tying 1-1 in regulation.

Gwen Maly was one of five players to earn First Team All-Mountain West honors, and she became the first women's soccer player in the history of the Mountain West to be named Mountain West Female Scholar-Athlete of the Year, the highest individual honor bestowed to a student-athlete in the league.

2019 - Mountain West Championships Semifinal

The 2019 season saw the Lobos go 11-8-1 overall and finish 6-4-1 in the Mountain West, good for fourth place. The Lobos for the second straight season placed five players on the All-Mountain West squad and it gave UNM 36 wins over the previous three seasons, the second-best three-year win total in school history. One of those wins was a 1-0 season opening win over No. 22 Texas Tech at the UNM Soccer Complex, UNM's first win over a ranked opponent since 2010.

2018 – Mountain West Regular-Season Champions – Mountain West Championships Final

Dyche’s 2018 Lobo team set a program record for goals scored with 45 and posted second-best program marks in assists (33) and points (123). In terms of individual player accolades, three standouts received All-Pacific Region honors from the United Soccer Coaches, which was a program record. From the Mountain West, the 2018 team had five honorees, three of which were first team selections. The Lobos won the Mountain West regular season title this season.

2017 – Mountain West Championships Final

The Lobos posted double-digit wins in 2017, going 12-8-2 overall and placing fourth in the Mountain West standings with a league record of 7-2-2. The Lobos advanced their way to the Mountain West Championships title game by virtue of two successful penalty kick shootouts, before falling to San Diego State in the title match.

2016

Dyche led UNM to another winning season in 2016, as the Lobos went 9-7-3 overall and finished 5-5-1 in league play to tie for seventh place.

2015 – Mountain West Championships Semifinal

In her first season, Dyche became the third coach in Lobo women’s soccer history to begin her career with double-digit victories by going 10-8-2 in 2015. That record included a 7-3-1 record in Mountain West play and a run to MW Tournament semifinals.

BEYOND UNM

Along with leading the Lobos, Dyche is also a technical advisor for USL team New Mexico United. She is one of only two women in the country involved with men’s professional team staffing. She is also the vice president of United Soccer Coaches and set to be named the president of the organization in 2026.

She is on the US Soccer Senior Instructional Staff as one of two women teaching the National A and B license, awarding licenses to candidates. Dyche is currently the only American woman on the FIFA Women’s Development Team as a Technical Expert.

Dyche traveled to Brazil to assist the U.S. Women’s National Team during the 2016 Summer Olympic Games – assisting with scouting and analyzing opponents. She also served as an assistant coach for the U-18 U.S. Women’s National Team’s trip to Australia in the summer of 2017. She also was on the U.S. Women’s National Team staff for the 2017 World Cup in Canada, 2019 World Cup in France and 2021 World Cup Qualifying in Monterrey, Mexico.

Dyche is also a coach, instructor, and scout with the United States Soccer Federation (USSF). Dyche is an assistant coach for the U14, U15, U16, U17, U18, U19 and U20 US Youth National Teams. She helped lead the U20 team to a victory in the CONCACAF World Cup qualifier in the Dominican Republic. She also serves on the USSF instructional staff, instructing USSF B- and USSF C-licensed national coaching schools across the country.

Dyche’s footprint at the elite level spans past the national stage, as she has also assisted for national teams from Antigua, St. Kitts and Nevis and Grenada. Dyche serves on the instructional staff for The Confederation of North, Central American and Caribbean Association Football (CONCACAF), teaching CONCACAF courses and licensing coaches throughout our confederation.

Dyche is a US Youth Region IV ODP head coach. There, she coaches the team at Olympic Development Interregional events and identifies top players in the region to participate in the Olympic Development Program Regional Team.

She is also the co-founder and head coach of LEAD Academy (Leadership and Empowerment through Athletic Development Soccer) – an all-girls soccer leadership training school located here in Albuquerque.

Prior to joining the University of New Mexico, Dyche was a presenter at the National Soccer Coaches Association of America/U.S. Youth National Conference in 2013 and at the U.S. Soccer National Symposium in 2011.
