ALL-TIME SERIES

The Lobos lead the all-time series against Air Force 153-61, with an 88-21 record in matchups in Albuquerque and a 56-36 record on the road. They only faced for one weekend series last season, with the Lobos dropping two of three on the road in Colorado Springs (3-12, 6-5, 7-18 [7]).

LOBOS EDGE LOPES IN MIDWEEK SLUGFEST

New Mexico launched four home runs and used a pair of five-run frames to knock off Grand Canyon 12-10 in high-scoring midweek nonconference action at home on Tuesday night at Santa Ana Star Field, marking the Lobos' first win over the Lopes in five years.

Trailing 4-2 entering the bottom of the fifth, UNM erupted for five runs in the frame to take the lead for good. The Lobos tacked on five more in the seventh, holding off a late push from GCU (14-10. 2-1 WAC) to win their seventh home game in a row.

Akili Carris (2-for-4, HR, 5 RBI, 2B) fueled the offensive outburst with two clutch hits that sparked both five-spots for UNM, delivering a three-run double in the fifth before crushing

his first career homer to drive in three runs in the seventh and notch a new career-high with 5 RBI.

Jordy Oriach (3-for-4, HR, 3 RBI, 2B) also had a big night at the plate, collecting three hits and matching McAlister with his eighth big fly of the year as part of the Lobos' five-run fifth.

New Mexico finished with nine hits, with Josh McAlister (1-for-3, HR, RBI, BB) going yard for the eighth time this season and Andrew Neil (1-for-5, HR, RBI) adding a solo shot – his fourth in his last five games – to give the Lobos their third game of the season with four or more homers.

RHP Josh Barnhouse (1.0 IP, 2 H, 0 ER) and RHP Ty Cunningham (1.0 IP, 2 H, 0 ER, Save) locked things down over the final two frames, with Cunningham earning his fifth save of the season.

LAST WEEKEND (at Nevada, 3/21-23)

New Mexico dropped two of three to suffer its first Mountain West series loss of the year at Nevada last weekend, hitting .292 as a team while scoring 15 runs on 33 hits. UNM outlasted the Wolf Pack in Friday's 12-inning weekend opener (6-4) thanks to some shutdown pitching from Daxton Purser, Ty Cunningham and Diego



Last time at Santa Ana Star Field (March 16), the Lobos walked off UNLV with a three-run homer in the bottom of the ninth from Andrew Neil to complete the weekend sweep.

Alvarez, but was walloped in Game Two 20-4 and downed late in Game Three (7-5).

The Lobos slugged seven doubles, one triple, and five home runs, posting a .504 slugging percentage and .367 on-base percentage. Defensively, UNM recorded a .991 fielding percentage, committing just one error in three games.

- **Khalil Walker** (.600, 6-for-10, 3 R, 3B, RBI, .800 SLG, .692 OBP) led the team in batting average and on-base percentage, recording six hits and a triple.
- **Brodey Williams** (.556, 5-for-9, 2 2B, 7 TB, .778 SLG) provided extra-base power with two doubles on Saturday while hitting over .500 in two starts.
- **Andrew Neil** (.400, 4-for-10, 1 HR, 3 RBI, .800 SLG) kept his hot streak going in a pair of starts in left, delivering a clutch home run and tying for the team lead in RBIs.
- **Ethan Ott** (.364, 4-for-11, 1 HR, 1 2B, 1 RBI, .727 SLG) added another home run — his fourth of the year — while anchoring the Lobos' lineup with a pair of hits on both Friday and Saturday.
- **Josh McAlister** (.333, 4-for-12, 1 HR, 1 RBI, .583 SLG) consistently reached base and contributed a home run. **Jordy Oriach** (.200, 2-for-10, 1 2B, 2 RBI) — Provided timely hits in two games, driving in two runs with his RBI double on Sunday.

On the mound, the Lobos kept things in reach on Friday and Sunday but the Wolf Pack's 20-run effort on Saturday ballooned their team ERA on the weekend to a 10.73.

- **Daxton Purser** (6.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 11 K, .100 BAA) dominated in his start, striking out a career-high 11 batters in six shutout innings
- **Ty Cunningham** (3.1 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 2 K, .091 BAA) delivered a strong relief outing to keep the Lobos in contention in their 12-inning slugfest on Friday.
- **Diego Alvarez** (4.1 IP, 2 H, 3 ER, 3 BB, 5 K) made two appearances in relief, earning

the team's only save of the series.

- **Dayne Pengelly** (4.1 IP, 6 H, 4 ER, 6 BB, 6 K) battled through a tough start while striking out six on Sunday, exiting with the game tied.

LONG BALL LOBOS

Through 24 games this season, 12 different players have combined for 37 home runs, exiting the ballpark five times last weekend in Reno and four more times on Tuesday. Jordy Oriach and Josh McAlister lead the way with eight homers each, with Ethan Ott (4), Will Asby (3), Caleb Herd (3) and Andrew Neil (4) all going yard last weekend. McAlister has already exceeded his homer total from the 2024 season (31 games played).

Walker & Asby Named Preseason All-MW; Lobo Baseball Tabbed Fourth in Coaches' Poll:

• Outfielders Khalil Walker and Will Asby were named to the All-Conference Preseason Team and New Mexico was one of three teams tied for fourth in the Mountain West Preseason Coaches' Poll released Monday ahead of the 2025 baseball season.

- Walker and Asby — who both were All-MW

selections after their first season at UNM in 2024 – make UNM one of four teams with multiple preseason all-league selections.

- With 27 points, the Lobos tied for fourth alongside UNLV (1 first-place vote) and San Diego State, the third season in a row in which they've improved their preseason rank.

Asby Named to D1Baseball.com's Top 100 Outfielders:

- Senior Will Asby clocked in at No. 91 in the nation on D1Baseball.com's National Outfielders Rankings released last week. In his first season with the Lobos in 2024, Asby entered the outlet's midseason Top 100 Outfielder rankings at No. 94.
- Last season, Asby ranked second in the league in runs scored (59), eighth in slugging (.601) and ninth in total hits (71), breaking the program record for single-season grand slams with four – he needs one more to match Mark Wulfert's career record of five.

ESTABLISHED HITTING PROGRAM

UNM holds the nation's 2nd-ranked batting average since 2014, a .307 clip in the last 10 seasons. The Lobos hit .319 to rank 7th nationally in 2024.

COACH BROWN'S PROGRAM-BUILDING RESUME

– In his first five seasons as head coach at North Dakota State, Brown's teams improved their winning percentage in each season, going from 15-30 (.333) in his first season in 2008 to 40-20 (.667) in 2012 and finishing each of the next nine seasons above .400. The Bison reached the Summit League tournament eight times in that span, advancing to NCAA Regionals in 2014 and 2021.

– He's done the same in each of his first three years in Albuquerque, improving from 21-33 (10-20 MW) in 2022 to 26-25 (13-17 MW) in 2023 to 28-26 (17-13 MW) in 2024.

– In Brown's second season at UNM, the Lobos improved to 26-25 from 21-33 the year prior, with the highest team batting average since 2013 (.328) and lowest team ERA since 2016 (5.95). They finished 28-26 on the season (28-24 in regular-season games) the following season in 2024.

2024 IN REVIEW / 2025 PREVIEW

The Lobos improved their overall record for the second year in a row in 2024 en route to their first Mountain West Tournament berth since 2017, going 28-26 and 17-13 in Mountain West play. UNM wrapped up the season ranked among the nation's most productive offensive teams, posting the seventh-highest team batting average (.319) in the nation while ranking among the Top 50 in team slugging (No. 31, .515), on-base percentage (No. 13, .421), doubles per game (No. 17, 2.24), triples per game (T-No.40, 0.30) and runs per game (No. 25, 8.4).

Heading into Head Coach Tod Brown's fourth year at the helm, the Lobos return four of their top six batters by average as well as three starting pitchers that saw significant weekend action last season.


