LOBOS RETURN TO NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR THIRD STRAIGHT YEAR

- The Lobos are making three consecutive trips to the NCAA Championships for the first time since a four-year span from 2002-05
- New Mexico advanced to La Costa with a third place finish last week at the Tallahassee Regional, its highest regional finish since winning the 2013 Columbus Regional
- UNM is the only non-power conference school to advance to the NCAA Championships in each of the past three years

NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP HISTORY

- New Mexico is making its 45th NCAA Championship appearance
- The Lobos finished 27th at last year's championship at La Costa
- UNM's best NCAA finish came in 1973 when it finished T-4th
- In the current format, New Mexico has made match play once at the NCAA Championship, finishing 6th in stroke play in 2013 before falling to eventual champion Alabama in the match play quarterfinals
- New Mexico has 11 top-10 finishes at the event
- Tommy Armour III owns the best NCAA individual finish by a Lobo, earning a T-5th mark at the 1981 Championship at Stanford

THREE IN A ROW

- New Mexico is one of 12 schools to advance to the last three NCAA Championships and the only non-power conference school to do so
- The other 11 schools to participate in each of the last three NCAAs were all top-five seeds in all three regionals, but the Lobos advanced as a No. 8 seed twice (2023, 2025) and a No. 4 seed (2024)
- UNM's 6.7 average regional seed over the past three years is the highest of any team that has reached the last three NCAAs (next highest is 3.3 (Georgia Tech))

SEASON REVIEW

- New Mexico enters the NCAA Championship ranked No. 42 nationally, their highest ranking since October
- The Lobos have seven top-five finishes this season, including in five of the last six events
- UNM has had three players tie for an individual title this season (Alvaro Portillo won a playoff vs. Carson Herron at the William H. Tucker Intercollegiate, while Herron also was in a playoff at the ASU Thunderbird Collegiate)
- New Mexico shot a season-best 30-under at the Mountain West Championship
- The Lobos have shot a combined 87-under over their last four tournaments

NOTABLE

- 2024 Mountain West Coach of the Year in first season at New Mexico
- Led the Lobos to two wins and seven top three finishes in 2023-24
- Came to UNM after 10 seasons at Little Rock, leading the Trojans to three straight NCAA Regionals (2021-23) and the school's first NCAA Championship appearance (2021)
- 2023 Ohio Valley Coach of the Year
- 2022 Sun Belt Coach of the Year
- Started his career at South Mountain Community College in Arizona, winning NJCAA National Championships in 2010, 2012 and 2013
- 2010 and 2012 Dave Williams National Coach of the Year (top junior college coach)
- 2013 and 2024 coach of Team USA at Toyota Junior Golf World Cup in Japan

THE ROSTER

- The Lobos lost three veterans (Bastien Amat, Albert Boneta and Matthew Watkins) from last year's squad that fell in a playoff at the Mountain West Championship and helped UNM advance from regionals to the NCAA Championships for the second straight season
- Amat and Boneta are currently on the DP World Tour
- Replacing them in the lineup are transfers Mesa Falleur and Wyatt Provence, along with freshman Clark Sonnenberg
- Falleur was the Summit League champion and Player of the Year last year at Kansas City, while Provence was the Division II National Champion at West Texas A&M

SHOOTING LOW

- Mesa Falleur leads New Mexico with a stroke average of 70.88 this season
- That average is currently the 10th best single-season stroke average in program history

TOP OF THE MOUNTAIN

- Mesa Falleur and Carson Herron were both named to the All-Mountain West Team
- It was Falleur second-straight all-conference honor (last season in the Summit League), while it was Herron's first
- It marked the fifth straight year the Lobos had two selection on the 10-player team

HERRON LOOKS TO FOLLOW IN FATHER'S FOOTSTEPS

- Senior Carson Herron looks to match the success his father, Tim, had in NCAA Championships in the early 1990s for the Lobos
- Tim Herron, before going on to a lengthy pro career on the PGA Tour and currently on the PGA Champions Tour, played in four NCAA Championships for New Mexico (1990-93), posting three top-25 finishes, including a T-7th as a senior in 1993, the second-best individual finish for a Lobo at the championship
- Herron becomes the 19th Lobo to play in three NCAA Championships (first since 2005), joining his father who played in four NAAs

HERRON CAPS HIS CAREER AT NAAs

- Carson Herron concludes his collegiate career at the NCAA Championships
- He enters the tournament with a 72.27 career stroke average, the eighth best average in New Mexico history
- His 78 career rounds of par or better rank T-3rd in program history (with Sam Choi, 2019-22), trailing only Bastien Amat (94 from 2021-24) and Gavin Green (91 from 2012-15)
- He has posted seven top-10 finishes in his career, including two runner-up finishes in playoffs this season

SHOOTING LOW

- The Lobos' 286.06 stroke average this season is on pace for one of the five best averages in program history
- Each of the four lowest averages have come in the past four years, including the school record 283.14 in 2022-23
