LOBO NOTES

- All UNM needed was one goal on Thursday night to secure three points with Alejandra Puerto's goal in the
 - The Lobos were outshot 19-5 in the contest, 6-2 in shots on goal, but a sliding tackle by Nicole Anderson to steal the ball started the Lobo attack, with the ball going directly to Alysa Whelchel. A perfect lead pass from Whelchel up ahead to Puerto allowed the senior to find the back of the net for her team-high eighth goal of the season.
- Alyson Campbell and the Lobo defense withstood the Cowgirls for the remainder of the match with Campbell making six saves for her fourth shutout of the season. Of the 19 shots, 11 were taken in the second half, however only two were on target.
- UNM is 4-1-0 on the season in one-goal matches, 2-1-0 against MW opponents.

WHAT A DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES

- The Lobos have surpassed their production from last season, surpassing the 2024 goal total in the win against Grand Canyon on Oct. 9.
- The Lobos have scored 31 goals to date with 28 assists, with the Lobos scoring 23 goals with 17 assists last season. The Lobos are averaging 5.56 points per match with UNM averaging 3.5 last season. In addition, the Lobos have taken more shots this season, averaging 14.7 per match compared to 14.4 last season and 6.4 shots on goal per match compared to 6.1 last season.
- UNM has had eight different goal scorers this season, six with multiple goals with Alysa Whelchel (5), Nicole Anderson (7) and Alejandra Puerto (8) surpassing their goal production last season.

 Anderson has doubled her point production from a season ago with seven goals and three assists (17) points), Allie Anderson recorded her first collegiate assists this season (3), Kennedy Brown scored her first collegiate goals this season (2), Mercedes Morris has a career-best six points this season behind a goal and a career-best four assists, Puerto is having her best season as a Lobo with 16 points (8 goals) and Whelchel has surpassed her goal (5) and point total (13) from last season.

WHERE THEY STAND

- With two matches left to play, the Lobos are tied for third in the Mountain West standings with Utah State at
- Boise State leads with 23 points and Air Force sits second with 16 points, with both clinching a spot in the MW Tournament. Colorado State (12), Fresno State (11), San Diego State and Grand Canyon (10) are below the Lobos.

WHERE THEY STAND: PART 2

- As a team and individually, the Lobos rank amongst the best in the Mountain West and the NCAA in several statistical categories.
- To date, UNM is: tied for 62nd in scoring offense (1.9), tied for 54th in goal differential (15) and tied for 76th in assists per match (1.7). Additionally, the Lobos are 68th in points per match (5.56), 74th in shots per
- match (14.7) and 61st in save percentage (.818). On an individual level, Nicole Anderson is 29th in shots per match (3.8) and 62nd in shots on goal per match (1.6), while Alejandra Puerto is 64th in total goals (8). Fiona Jenkins is 40th in total assists (7) and 10th in assists per match (0.6). Alyson Campbell is 23rd in save percentage (.855) and 56th in saves per match (4.8).
- UNM is first in the MW in points (90), goals (31), goals per match (1.9), and goal differential (15), as well as second in assists (29) and shots per match (14.7) and tied for second in shutouts (7). Puerto is tied for second in the MW in goals (8) with Anderson tied for fourth. Mercedes Morris is tied for

sixth in assists (4). QUITE THE START

- UNM's unbeaten start to conference play was the first time since 2011 that the Lobos went undefeated
- through their first six matches (UNM went 4-0-2). It was just the third time that the Lobos have gone unbeaten through their first six matches (also done in the aforementioned 2011 and 2010).

- The Lobos are outscoring opponents 13-7 in MW play with seven goals in the second half (6-4 and 7-3).
- Additionally, the Lobos have a 14.3-13.4 advantage in shots and are scoring 1.6 goals per MW match while allowing 0.88 goals per MW match.

HOME IS WHERE THE GOALS ARE

- In the eight home matches, UNM is outscoring opponents 24-8 and outshooting opponents 118-106 (14.8-13.3 average) with a 59-45 advantage in shots on goal. Alejandra Puerto has scored six goals, Alysa Whelchel and Nicole Anderson have scored five goals
- and Savanah Sanchez has scored three goals. Six Lobos have scored multiple goals at home (Kenne-
- dy Brown, Gabby Beaudry). Of the 24 goals, 14 were scored in the first half, outscoring opponents 14-5 in the first 45 minutes and 10-3 in the second half
- Additionally, the Lobos are outshooting opponents 56-53 in the first half and 62-53 in the second half.

THE FIGHT OF THE LOBOS

- UNM scored three goals in the second half, tying the match in the 58th minute and again in the 66th minute behind goals from Alejandra Puerto before taking its only lead of the match in the 89th minute off of a header from Gabby Beaudry in the MW opener against Colorado College. UNM led for only the final 1:50 of Thursday's match. Allie Anderson tallied a career-high two assists in the match with Celina Frentz accounting for an
- assist on the first goal for her third of the season.

 Trailing 1-O at the half, UNM responded, led by a senior in Puerto and a freshman in Frentz, who happened to be in the right spot at the right time. A cross into the box from Puerto resulted in a deflected shot by Nicole Anderson in the 57th minute, which led to a corner kick and ultimately the
- Alysa Whelchel took the corner, and while the initial pass to A. Anderson was unable to be brought in, Macie Harris was there to retain possession for the Lobos. Harris' shot was blocked but ricocheted to
- Frenz, who kicked it ahead to an unmarked Puerto on the left side. Puerto turned, took a dribble and poked it bottom right and past the approaching Tiger keeper for the goal.

 A. Anderson struck the ball close to midfield near the Lobo bench side, floating it into the middle of the field just outside of the 18-yard box. While a Tiger got a piece of the ball, it fortuitously bounced right to Puerto, who found space amongst two CC defenders and shot it past the diving keeper for her second goal of the night and her sixth of the season. It was her second multi-goal match of the season.
- The score held as UNM goalkeeper Alyson Campbell recorded consecutive saves in the 69th and 70th minutes and a shot by A. Anderson in the 79th minute was inches wide left of the top corner post.
- A corner kick set up by a Frentz cross that was kicked out of play by the Tigers in the 88th minute provided the final goal. Frentz found an open A. Anderson outside the top right corner of the box, with the Lobo able to gather it and chip it to Beaudry, who headed it top right and into the net at 88:10 on the clock. For Anderson, it was her second assist of the night, third of the season, and for Beaudry, her third goal of the season and second game-winner.

PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

- The Lobos were picked seventh in the Mountain West Preseason Women's Soccer Coaches' Poll with
- two first-place votes and 80 points, one of five teams to receive first-place votes. The Lobos play three teams picked ahead of them in the polls at home and don't play one of the
- teams picked in the top three.
 Utah State, which the Lobos will host on Oct. 16, was the preseason favorite with six first-place votes and 128 points. Boise State, which the Lobos host on Oct. 19, was picked to finish second with three first-place votes and 121 points. Colorado State (111, one first-place vote) and San Diego State (109 points, one first-place vote) round out the top four with new MW member Grand Canyon, which UNM
- hosts on Oct. 9, picked fifth at 93 points. UNLV was picked sixth at 87 points, with Wyoming (59 points), Nevada (55 points), Colorado College (54 points), Fresno State (50 points), Air Force (44 points) and San José State (23 points) picked below UNM.
- In addition, Nicole Anderson, Kennedy Brown and Fiona Jenkins were among the Mountain West Women's Soccer Watch List, comprised of three players from each school that is expected to lead their respective programs.
- The trio started all 18 matches for the Lobos a season ago with Anderson the second-best goal scorer from 2024 behind four goals. Jenkins played 90 minutes in 12 of the 18 matches, playing the most minutes of any position player, and scored her first collegiate goal and was credited with her first collegiate assist against conference opponents last season. Brown played 90 minutes in seven matches and also was credited with her first collegiate assist in 2024.

DEFENDERS GO THE DISTANCE

- The Lobo defense has been a display of stamina, with six defenders playing the full 90 minutes multiple times this season.
- Morgan Juran and Ashley Moody have played 90 minutes in 12 matches (including the last nine for Moody), Macie Harris in five, Allie Anderson in eight matches, Fiona Jenkins in seven matches, and Kennedy Brown has played 90 in 14 matches this season.
- Juran (1345) and Brown (1410) have played in 93% of the minutes, with Brown playing in over 97% of the minutes.

THROUGH THE NONCONFERENCE

- UNM scored 18 goals through its nonconference schedule, with UNM needing 14 matches last season to reach that total (Oct. 17 vs. Fresno State).
 The 18 goals are five shy of the total goals scored last season (23).
- The Lobos went unbeaten through their first six matches (4-0-2) with the last time the Lobos achieved this back in 2010 (4-0-2).

 Their 2-0-2 record through the first four matches of the season was the second time in three years that the Lobos have gone unbeaten in their first four games to start the season (2023, UNM also went
- 2-0-2).
 UNM outshot opponents 121-105 and 60-37 in shots on goal. The Lobos had the edge in shots in three
- of the matches, but in on goal in four.
- As a defensive unit, the Lobos allowed 13.1 shots a match, 37 shots on goal (4.6 per match), shutting out opponents in four matches.

ALL FOR ALE

- Following a brace in the Mountain West opener against Colorado College, Alejandra Puerto was selected as the MW Offensive Player of the Week, as announced on Sept. 29. The senior led the Lobos to a 3-2 victory with her goals tying the match in the 58th minute and again
- in the 66th minute.
- A cross into the box from Puerto led to a corner kick and ultimately the first Lobo goal, with the Honduras native poking it bottom right and past the approaching Tiger keeper for the equalizer. For her second goal, the Lobo forward found space amongst two CC defenders and shot it past the diving keeper for her second goal of the night and her sixth of the season. It was her second multi-goal match of the season.
- Puerto played 42 minutes and took four shots against the Tigers, three on goal. She leads the Lobos and is tied for the Mountain West lead with her six goals, but leads the MW with a .67 goals per match average, needing only nine matches to reach the tally. Against conference opponents, she is one of three MW players to score two goals in the opening weekend and one of two players to score two in a match.
- The selection marks the first conference weekly award for Puerto, the second MW Offensive Player of the Week award for the Lobos and the fourth conference weekly award overall this season.

- After assisting on the game-winning goal at Oregon, Savanah Sanchez was selected as the Mountain West Freshman of the Week on Monday.
 The Albuquerque native played 129 minutes between the Oregon and Oregon State matches, including a season-high 79 minutes at Oregon. She was credited with her first collegiate assist against Oregon, which proved to be the game-winning goal in the 68th minute. She also took two shots in the match, both on goal.
- Sanchez has started all five matches and has one goal and one assist to date. In addition, she's taken six shots, all on goal, which included two shots on goal against both Oregon and Oregon State.

MAKE IT BACK-TO-BACK

- Behind a brace against New Mexico State, Savanah Sanchez has earned Mountain West Freshman of the Week for the second-straight week as announced by the conference on Monday.
- The Albuquerque native led the Lobos with two goals, including the game-winning goal, in the win over the Aggies. Her first goal came at 20:52, going unmarked in the box and getting a foot on a floating ball from Allie Anderson, and sending the ball into the back of the net. She followed with her second goal at 34:09 off of a Fiona Jenkins corner kick, heading the ball into the top left corner and past the leaping Aggie goalkeeper for her first multi-goal match as a Lobo. Sanchez was 2-2 in shots on goals turning into goals, playing 64 minutes in the win.

 Sanchez has seven points on the season on three goals and one assist, scoring three goals on eight shots on goal. Sunday's game-winner was her second of the
- season, tying her for 30th in the NCAA, and tied for third in the Mountain West.
 Following Monday's award, the Lobos have won three Mountain West awards this season with Sanchez selected Freshman of the Week twice and Nicole Ander-
- son Offensive Player of the Week to start the season.

- Nicole Anderson was selected as the Mountain West Offensive Player of the Week on Aug. 18.
 The accolade marked Anderson's first weekly conference honor, which comes after the junior forward was named one of the three Players to Watch for the Lobos before the season started.
- Anderson recorded her first collegiate hat trick in the season opener against Texas Southern, with all three goals in the first 36 minutes of the match. The Lobo scored an unassisted goal at the 9:40 mark to make it 2-0 and followed up with consecutive goals at 17:58 and 35:10 to complete the hat trick. Additionally, Anderson was 3-3 in the first half in shots going for goals and was her second multi-goal match as a Lobo.

 Of note, Anderson was one of four players in the NCAA to have three or more goals in a match in their season opener, and the only player from the MW with a
- hat trick. When taking into account the opening week matches, Anderson was one of seven players in the NCAA with three or more goals in a match, and again the only player from the MW. Following the first week, she tied for fourth in the NCAA in total goals, tied for 19th in goals per match and tied for 27th in point per match this season, leading the MW in all three categories.

- UNM scored eight goals in the season opener, the most goals scored in a season opener in program history with the previous record seven goals scored against Montana in 2010, as well as the most in a match since the Lobos scored nine against Troy on Sept. 29, 2002. It was also the first shutout in a season opener since 2019, a 1-0 win over No. 22 Texas Tech. UNM recorded five assists in the match, the most since UNM had five against Wyoming on Sept. 24, 2021.

- Fiona Jenkins accounted for three of UNM's five assists, becoming the first player in program history to have three assists in a game. With eight goals and five assists, UNM tallied 21 points, the most in a match by a Lobo team since UNM had 22 against Central Arkansas on Sept. 28, 2008.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS

- Nine Lobos saw their first minutes in the season opener while three Lobos recorded their first points in their first appearance.
- Celina Frenz, Gabby Beaudry, Ainsley Capps, Sherry Diep, Ayla Dils, Jasmin Gonzalez-Rutt, Savanah Sanchez, Laila Magaña Carter and Claire Roybal all registered their first minutes in a Lobo uniform, with four of them doing so in their freshman season and four after redshirting last season.
- Frenz, Beaudry and Sanchez all tallied points as Frenz assisted on Nicole Anderson's third goal, Beaudry scoring a goal in the 13th minute and Sanchez opening the match with a goal in the 7th minute. In addition to the three mentioned above, Alejandra Puerto tallied her first points as a Lobo with two goals.

- Gonzalez-Rutt registered her first career shutout in her first appearance in net.

 Alyson Campbell started the second half at Texas A&M-Corpus Christi for her first collegiate appearance. She earned her first collegiate start at Oregon State, making six saves to get her first shutout and win.

HOME GROWN

- The Lobos feature eight players from The Land of Enchantment on the 2025 roster.
 Five Lobos are local Lobos, hailing from Albuquerque (Ayla Dils, Mercedes Morris, Savanah Sanchez, Kennedy Brown and Ainsley Capps), with two from Santa Fe (Laila Magaña Carter and Jasmin Gonzalez-Rutt) and one from Las Cruces (Mia Barela).
 Barela was named the 2024 Gatorade Player of the Year for New Mexico after leading Las Cruces HS to the Class 5A state final, scoring 31 goals with 12 assists on
- Head Coach Heather Dyche is also a New Mexico native, a 1997 graduate of Eldorado High School and was a four-year all-state defender, a two-time district Player of the Year and the 1996 Defensive Player of the Year. She also played basketball for the Eagles and was a first-team all-state performer two years.

- Following the season-opening win over Texas Southern and Thursday's win at Oregon, Head Coach Heather Dyche earned her 100th win at UNM. The New Mexico native's first win came on Aug. 26, 2015 vs. New Mexico State and her 50th win Oct. 4, 2019 vs. Nevada. She is just the second coach at UNM to reach 100 wins, joining Kit Vela, who finished with 122 wins after coaching the Lobos from 2001-14.

- The Lobos will be without their leading goal scorer and starting goalkeeper from a season ago as Presley Devey and Callie Droitsch will be redshirting this season due to injury.
- Devey accounted for eight of UNM's 23 goals (34.8%) in 2024 with the Lobos also losing seven goals to graduation (three, Natalie DeGagne; two, Ellie Robinson; one each from Sophia Roberts and Margaux Clarke).
- UNM returns goal scorers in Nicole Anderson (second on the team with four goals), Alysa Whelchel (tied for third with three goals) and Fiona Jenkins (one goal), with the trio combining to equal Devey's production.
 Equally important, the Lobos will look to find a replacement in net with three possible options in junior Alyson Campbell, junior Jasmin Gonzalez-Rutt and fresh-
- man Avah Snodgrass. Gonzalez-Rutt earned her first collegiate start against Texas Southern. Campbell didn't appear in a match in her time at LSU and Gonzalez-Rutt joined the UNM roster in spring 2024 after playing on the club team at UNM.
- In the season opener, UNM had five different goal scorers with Anderson recording a hat trick, Alejandra Puerto recording a brace, Sanchez and Gabby Beaudry scoring their first collegiate goals and Whelchel scoring one.

 With Ayla Dils' goal at Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, Kennedy Brown scoring against the Colorado School of Mines and Mercedes Morris scoring against Grand Canyon, the Lobos have had eight different goal scorers this season. UNM has six players with multiple goals, led by seven for Puerto.

 Through the first three matches, Anderson already matched her season best in goals at four and Jenkins already surpassed her season assist total from last seasons with four control of the control of the
- son with four.
 UNM's eight goals in the season opener accounted for 34.8% of the total goals scored last season, with UNM recording its eighth goal six matches into last sea-
- son, which came against UTEP on Sept. 8.
 In net, Gonzalez-Rutt recorded her first collegiate shutout, facing two shots on goal with TSU taking just five shots in the match. Campbell recorded her first collegiate shutout at Oregon State, facing 17 shots and making six saves for her first win.

- 18 Lobos were named Mountain West Scholar-Athletes following the 2024-25 academic year as well as 18 named to the MW All-Academic Team. The Lobos turned in a 3.82 GPA in the fall semester and a 3.74 GPA in the spring.
- Historically, UNM has recorded 18 consecutive semesters (out of 20) above a 3.6 GPA.

COACHING STAFF

Heather Dyche joined the Lobo family in 2015 as the fourth head women's soccer coach at The University of New Mexico. The 2025 season marks her 11th season in charge of the Lobos.

CAREER SUMMARY

Dyche was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in back-to-back seasons, in 2020 and 2021. She has led New Mexico to six Mountain West Tournament appearances, including three championship games. Under her guidance, UNM has won four regular season titles (2018, 2020, 2021, 2022), the 2021 Mountain West Championships title, and made back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances (2020 & 2021).

Dyche's 98 wins are second-most in UNM history behind Kit Vela, who went 122-105-45 (.529) from 2001-2014. Her seven postseason wins are also second-most behind Vela's 12. Dyche's .606 winning percentage is the best ever by a UNM head coach, as is her postseason winning percentage of .559.

Overall, she has coached 35 All-Mountain West selections (14 First Team, 12 Second Team), 16 All-MW Tournament Players, seven All-Region players, 14 CoSIDA Academic All-District selections, three CoSIDA Academic All-America, 19 Mountain West Players of the Week, 123 Mountain West All-Academic selections and 109 Mountain West Scholar-Athletes. Four student-athletes that she coached signed professional contracts under her tenure.

2024-The Lobos went 7-6-5, 3-5-3 in conference, which included a win over Oregon, their third win over a Power conference opponent under Dyche and the second over an (at the time) Big Ten team in program history. In addition, in UNM's 5-2 win against Nevada, Presley Devey paced the Lobos with a hat trick, registering a brace in the first 5:59, the first Lobo to record a hat trick since Jadyn Edwards did it against Cal State Bakersfield in 2022. Nicole Anderson recorded her first brace with a goal in the 29th minute and in the 55th minute for a career high in goals for the sophomore. Additionally, Anderson accounted for the game-winning goal, with both of her game-winning goals coming against Nevada. Of note, it was the first time UNM had two multiple-goal scorers in a match since Sept. 28, 2008 against Central Arkansas (Kate Wyrick and Zaneta Wyne) and the first time the Lobos scored five goals against Nevada since Oct. 14, 2018 (5-1) and the most goals scored since Sept. 9, 2021 when the Lobos scored six goals against NAU.

UNM had three players earn Player of the Week honors in Devey (Offensive Player of the Week , Ashley Moody (Freshman of the Week) and Callie Droitsch (Defensive Player of the Week), as well as two earn all-conference awards as Devey earned All-Conference Second Team and Moody was named to the Mountain West Women's Soccer All-Newcomer Team.

2023-The Lobos went 5-6-6, 2-5-4 in conference, which included a win over New Mexico State to extend the win streak to four matches and her record against the Aggies to 6-1. In addition, the Lobos opened the season with a 1-1 tie against Texas Tech, extending the unbeaten streak in the series against the Red Raiders to three matches, part of a four-match unbeaten streak to start the campaign.

2022 - Mountain West Regular-Season Champions - Mountain West Championships Semifinal Dyche guided the Lobos to a share of their third-consecutive Mountain West regular-season title in 2022, with the team going 7-3-9 overall and 5-1-5 in conference play. The Lobos hosted the Mountain West Championships, falling to San José State in penalty kicks in the semifinals of the tournament. UNM broke the program record for consecutive shutout minutes with 602:51, ending the season with the streak intact. UNM's team goals-against average of .082 was the lowest the program had seen since a mark of .068 during the 2011 season.

2021 - Mountain West Regular-Season Champions - Mountain West Championships Champions - NCAA Championship First Round

The 2021 season followed in the 2020 season's success. The Lobos won their first Mountain West Tournament championship since 2011. Dyche led the Lobos to many records, including a program-high eight-game winning streak and nine-game conference winning streak (dating back to the 2020 season). She guided the team to the second-most single-season wins as they finished the season with 14 wins, also going undefeated in conference play at home. In typical MW Coach of the Year fashion, she coached the Newcomer of the Year and Offensive Player of the Year.

2020 - Mountain West Regular-Season Champions - NCAA Championship Second Round The 2020 season saw records fall as UNM advanced to the second round of the NCAA College Cup and winning its first outright Mountain West itle since 2011. The program went 10-2-1 under Dyche as she was named the Mountain West's Coach of the Year. The Lobos blasted their way into the record books by averaging 2.38 goals per game (scoring 31 in just 13 games). The team turned in a 0.90 goals against average, the lowest in seven years, and UNM was nearly unstoppable in the regular season, allowing just three goals in 10 games leading up to the title game. The Lobos of 2020 advanced to the NCAA Tournament after a thrilling 3-2 overtime win over San Diego State in front of a capacity crowd in Albuquerque. UNM then got past Navy in the

opening round, winning 4-2 in penalties after tying 1-1 in regulation.

Gwen Maly was one of five players to earn First Team All-Mountain West honors, and she became the first women's soccer player in the history of the Mountain West to be named Mountain West Female Scholar-Athlete of the Year, the highest individual honor bestowed to a student-athlete in the league.

2019 - Mountain West Championships Semifinal

The 2019 season saw the Lobos go 11-8-1 overall and finish 6-4-1 in the Mountain West, good for fourth place. The Lobos for the second straight season placed five players on the All-Mountain West squad and it gave UNM 36 wins over the previous three seasons, the second-best three-year win total in school history. One of those wins was a 1-0 season opening win over No. 22 Texas Tech at the UNM Soccer Complex, UNM's first win over a ranked opponent since 2010.

2018 - Mountain West Regular-Season Champions - Mountain West Championships Final

Dyche's 2018 Lobo team set a program record for goals scored with 45 and posted second-best program marks in assists (33) and points (123). In terms of individual player accolades, three standouts received All-Pacific Region honors from the United Soccer Coaches, which was a program record. From the Mountain West, the 2018 team had five honorees, three of which were first team selections. The Lobos won the Mountain West regular season title this season.

2017 - Mountain West Championships Final

The Lobos posted double-digit wins in 2017, going 12-8-2 overall and placing fourth in the Mountain West standings with a league record of 7-2-2. The Lobos advanced their way to the Mountain West Championships title game by virtue of two successful penalty kick shootouts, before falling to San Diego State in the title match.

2016-Dyche led UNM to another winning season in 2016, as the Lobos went 9-7-3 overall and finished 5-5-1 in league play to tie for seventh place.

2015 - Mountain West Championships Semifinal

In her first season, Dyche became the third coach in Lobo women's soccer history to begin her career with double-digit victories by going 10-8-2 in 2015. That record included a 7-3-1 record in Mountain West play and a run to MW Tournament semifinals.

BEYOND UNM

Along with leading the Lobos, Dyche is also a technical advisor for USL team New Mexico United. She is one of only two women in the country involved with men's professional team staffing. She is also the vice president of United Soccer Coaches and set to be named the president of the organization in 2026.

She is on the US Soccer Senior Instructional Staff as one of two women teaching the National A and B license, awarding licenses to candidates. Dyche is currently the only American woman on the FIFA Women's Development Team as a Technical Expert.

Dyche traveled to Brazil to assist the U.S. Women's National Team during the 2016 Summer Olympic Games – assisting with scouting and analyzing opponents. She also served as an assistant coach for the U-18 U.S. Women's National Team's trip to Australia in the summer of 2017. She also was on the U.S. Women's National Team staff for the 2017 World Cup in Canada, 2019 World Cup in France and 2021 World Cup Qualifying in Monterrey, Mexico.

Dyche is also a coach, instructor, and scout with the United States Soccer Federation (USSF). Dyche is an assistant coach for the U14, U15, U16, U17, U18, U19 and U20 US Youth National Teams. She helped lead the U20 team to a victory in the CONCACAF World Cup qualifier in the Dominican Republic. She also serves on the USSF instructional staff, instructing USSF B- and USSF C-licensed national coaching schools across the country.

Dyche's footprint at the elite level spans past the national stage, as she has also assisted for national teams from Antigua, St. Kitts and Nevis and Grenada. Dyche serves on the instructional staff for The Confederation of North, Central American and Caribbean Association Football (CONCACAF), teaching CONCACAF courses and licensing coaches throughout our confederation.

Dyche is a US Youth Region IV ODP head coach. There, she coaches the team at Olympic Development Interregional events and identifies top players in the region to participate in the Olympic Development Program Regional Team.

She is also the co-founder and head coach of LEAD Academy (Leadership and Empowerment through Athletic Development Soccer) – an all-girls soccer leadership training school located here in Albuquerque.

Prior to joining the University of New Mexico, Dyche was a presenter at the National Soccer Coaches Association of America/U.S. Youth National Conference in 2013 and at the U.S. Soccer National Symposium in 2011.
