LOBO NOTES

SERIES HISTORY

The Lobos are 12-18, 3-11 in Boise, but have won the last two games in the series. UNM won the first meeting to open Mountain West play, 70-63, jumping out to a 17-4 lead in the first quarter. The Lobos used a 12-0 run over a span of 2:18 in the fourth quarter to turn a 55-49 deficit into a 61-55 lead, with a Nayli Padilla layup with 5:51 left giving the Lobos the lead for the remainder of the game. UNM led for 27:29 of the contest, however, there were also 10 lead changes and seven ties of which five lead changes and six ties occurred in the third quarter. UNM scored 50 points in the paint and outscored the Broncos 17-4 in fast-break points.

Joana Magalhães led with 16 points, one of four Lobos to reach double digits. Alyssa Hargrove scored 12 points and Destinee Hooks and Cacia Antonio each finished with 11 points.

LAST WEEK STATS

UNM went 2-0 with wins against UNLV and Utah State and an +18.0 scoring margin, holding both teams below 60 points. The Lobo defense held the Lady Rebels and Aggies to a combined 14.7% from three-point range and five three-pointers, as well as had a +12.0 rebounding margin.

Three Lobos averaged double figures in Destinee Hooks (11.0), Joana Magalhães (10.5) and Cacia Antonio (10.5), while Jessie Joaquin averaged 13.0 rebounds per game.

UNM trailed for just 0:34 between the two games, which was in the first quarter against Utah State.

Of note, the 33 points scored by Utah State were the fewest allowed in the series with the Aggies, was the fewest points allowed by the Lobos since 2018 (33 points against Stephen F. Austin) and the fewest points allowed by the Lobos in a Mountain West game since 2016 (33 against Air Force). The last time a MW school was held below 35 points prior to Saturday was Feb. 23, 2023 (Utah State, 32 points against UNLV).

Wednesday was also the only time this season that the Lady Rebels never held a lead in a game and the fourth game that the Lobos have never trailed in a game this season. Further, the 11-point margin of victory was the largest against the Lady Rebels since 2020 (16 points) and the largest margin of victory at home in the series since 2016 (14 points).

FAST START

UNM is outscoring opponents 374-287 (+87) in the first quarter, 413-347 (+66) in the second quarter and 787-634 (+153) in the first 20 minutes.

In the conference opener, the Lobos scored the first 14 points against Boise State with six different Lobos contributing to the points, and against Wyoming, the Lobos scored the first 10 points of the game. Against UNLV, the Lobos built a 13-2 lead behind a 10-0 run with the Lobos making five of their first seven shots. Against Utah State, the Lobos used a 9-0 run to lead 9-2 and closed the first quarter on a 6-0 run to build a 12-point lead.

Further, UNM held Wyoming (5), Boise State (4), San José State (4), Nevada (9), UNLV (9) and Utah State (7) to single digits in the first quarter and held San José State (8), Colorado State (2) and Wyoming (8) to single digits in the second quarter.

WIN THE QUARTER

The second quarter is UNM's largest quarter for point production at 413 points, followed by the third quarter (404 points), with the first quarter the largest margin of +87.

UNM has outscored its opponent in the first quarter 14 times (NAU, UNO, UTM, CSU, UA, UH, BSU, UW, SJSU, NEV, SDSU, AFA, UNLV, USU), the second quarter in 11 games this season, the third quarter 13 times (UNO, NAU, NMSU, UTM, UA, UH, UNLV, SJSU, NEV, SDSU, GCU, AFA, UW) and the fourth quarter 14 times (NAU, AT, UTM, UC, Chicago St., UA, BSU, UNLV, UW, SJSU, Colorado St., AFA, UNLV, USU).

The Lobos have also held their opponent below 10 points in a quarter in 13 games this season (five in the fourth quarter against NAU, five in the second quarter against Chicago State, four in the second quarter against NMSU, seven in the second quarter against UTM, nine in the fourth quarter against Houston, four in the first quarter against Boise State, five in the first quarter against Wyoming and seven in the fourth quarter against Wyoming, four in the first quarter at San José State and eight in the second quarter at San José State, two in the second quarter at Colorado State, nine in the first quarter against Nevada, nine in the first quarter against UNLV, seven in the first quarter against Utah State, as well as nine points in the third and six points in the fourth quarter, and eight in the second quarter at Wyoming). The Lobos held the Cowgirls to single digits in two quarters in the first meeting, the first time doing it twice in a game this season, and repeated it the next game against San José State. Against Utah State, the Lobos held the Aggies to single digits in three quarters.

GAME 24: NEW MEXICO vs BOISE ST.

Six times, the Lobos have held their opponent below 20 points at the half: 19 points (Wyoming), 18 points (Utah State), 12 points (San José State), 15 points (New Mexico State), 17 points (Chicago State) and 18 points (UT Martin).

UNM is 12-2 when leading after the first quarter, 16-1 when leading at the half and 14-1 when leading after the third quarter.

While the trend right now is 6-7 and scoring 67 points, for the Lobos the trend is 60-70.

UNM is 12-0 when allowing 60 points or less (7-0 in conference), including holding five opponents below 50 points and four teams to 45 points or fewer. UNM is also 10-1 when scoring 70 or more points.

ALL ABOUT THE THREE

UNM has held nine opponents to four three-pointers or under in a game and five opponents to under 20 percent from three-point range, including New Mexico State (14.3%), UT Martin (16.7%), Cincinnati (18.8%), San José State (19.4%) and Utah State (5.3%). In addition, the Lobos held Colorado and Chicago State to 20 percent with Chicago State making three, three-pointers and Colorado four.

Opponents on average are making 6.1 three-pointers per game, going 140-467 (30.0%) with an average of 20.3 three-point attempts per game.

For the Lobos, they are making 8.3 per game and shooting 31.8%, led by Laila Abdurraqib with 44 made three-pointers (1.9 per game) and Nayli Padilla with 42 three-pointers. Padilla is shooting 35.6% with Abdurraqib shooting 41.1% from three-point range.

Abdurraqib is fourth in the MW in three-pointers made per game with Padilla sixth. As a team, UNM is second in made three-pointers per game and has made 190, making double-digit three-pointers in six games.

In conference games, the Lobos are second in three-pointers per game at 7.8 with Abdurraqib tied for second in three-pointers per game (2.1) and Padilla 11th (1.5).

Nationally, UNM is tied for 38th in three-pointers per game and 27th in three-point attempts per game (26.0).

OWN THE BOARDS

The Lobos lead the MW in offensive rebounds per game (13.4), rebounding margin (+5.5) and rebounding offense (39.9). UNM is tied for 56th in the NCAA in rebound margin as well as tied for 65th in rebounds per game, tied for 77th in offensive rebounds per game and 93rd in defensive rebounds per game (26.5).

UNM has outrebounded its opponent in 15 games and is 14-1 when doing so (San Diego State was lone loss when outrebounding opponent).

As a team, UNM had a season-high 58 against San José State with the largest rebounding margin against UT Martin (+35). Of note, the 58 rebounds are the most in a game amongst MW teams this season. UNM is led by Jessie Joaquin at 142, followed by Emma Najjuma at 139.

EMERGENCE OF EMMA

Emma Najjuma has recorded double-digit rebounds in four games, with 10 against Chicago State, 11 against Cincinnati, a season-high 16 against Arizona and 15 against Wyoming. Prior to those four games, the redshirt-sophomore's season high was six against North Carolina A&T.

Of her 139 rebounds, 58 are offensive and 81 defensive, and has recorded six offensive rebounds in three games. Najjuma is 13th in the MW in rebounds per game (6.0) and fifth in offensive rebounds per game (2.5). In conference games, Najjuma is fifth in offensive rebounds per game (2.5) and is 14th in rebounds per game (6.3).

She's led the Lobos in rebounds in seven games (North Carolina A&T, Chicago State, Arizona, Boise State, UNLV and Wyoming twice) and tied for the team high in two (Cincinnati and Nevada).

Her 16 rebounds against Arizona are tied for the second most by a MW player this year.

Additionally, she leads the Lobos in blocks (16), ninth in the MW in blocks per game (0.7).

JESSIE'S BOARD

Jessie Joaquin has recorded two double-doubles, the only Lobo to record a double-double this season. In her first start as a Lobo against GCU, the forward led the team with 12 rebounds to go with 12 points. Joaquin has had five games with double-digit rebounds with a season-high 16 against San José State and has led the team in rebounds in seven games.

Joaquin's first double-double came against Houston with 13 points and 12 rebounds off of the bench. In both of her double-doubles, Joaquin went 6-8 from the field.

The Lobo has started the last five games and has averaged 8.8 rebounds per game with three games of double-digit rebounds and has also created multiple steals in two of the games.

She leads the team with 142 rebounds (6.8 per game) with 55 offensive and 87 defensive rebounds and has recorded double-digit rebounds in six games. Joaquin is fifth in the conference in rebounds per game and third in offensive rebounds per game (2.6).

In conference, the forward leads the team with 90 rebounds (averaging 7.5 rebounds per game) and is fourth in the conference, as well as second in the conference in offensive rebounds (3.3).

RELIABLE HOOKS

Destinee Hooks has scored in double figures in 21 games, led the Lobos in scoring in seven games and scored 20 or more points in three. Hooks led the Lobos with a game-high 22 points at Colorado and followed that up with a game-high 20 points

against North Carolina A&T. In the game against UT Martin, Hooks scored a game-high 15 points, scored a game- and season-high 24 points against Texas Tech, 13 against Nevada, a game-high 18 at San Diego State and 17 against Grand Canyon. TTU was the ninth time scoring 20-plus points at UNM.

Hooks went off for 12 points in the second quarter against the Buffs, using a personal 7-0 run in the first 2:03 of the quarter to give UNM a 19-18 lead, and went 5-7 from the floor and 2-3 from three-point range. The Lobo guard continued to pace the Lobos with six points in the third quarter. In addition to leading the team in points, she also led with seven rebounds (four offensive).

Against North Carolina A&T, Hooks scored eight of her 20 points in the second quarter on an 8-0 personal run that included four layups. Hooks also recorded her second steal of the game that led to an Alyssa Hargrove three with four seconds left that gave UNM a 32-26 lead at the break to close a 7-0 UNM run in the final 1:20 (which started with her layup).

This season, Hooks is averaging a team-high 13.5 points per game, shooting 40.5% from the floor. She's also averaging 3.4 rebounds per game, 1.0 assist per game and 1.1 steals per game with a steal in 16 games. Hooks is sixth in the conference in scoring.

In conference, she's averaging a team-high 12.2 points per game, tied for 13th in the MW in scoring.

CALL ON CACIA

Cacia Antonio has led the Lobos in scoring in four games and tied for the team lead in one. Antonio has finished in double figures in 11 games, and posted a season-high 22 at UNLV. UNM is 9-2 when she scores double figures.

The junior is averaging 10.1 points per game, shooting 40.5% and averaging 4.5 rebounds per game, 1.8 assists per game, 1.4 steals per game and 25.4 minutes per game.

In conference games, Antonio is averaging 10.3 points per game, shooting 41.7% with 4.5 rebounds per game, 1.8 assists per game and 1.4 steals per game.

Defensively, she's registered a steal in 16 games (11 in conference) with nine games with multiple steals and a steal in the last nine games.

WHAT A STEAL

The Lobos are averaging a conference-best 10.3 steals per game behind 11 games with double-digit steals: 19 against Chicago State and Air Force, 18 against New Orleans, 16 against North Carolina A&T, 14 against Northern Arizona, San José State and Grand Canyon, 12 against Houston and Boise State, 11 against Wyoming and 10 against New Mexico State.

In the game at Air Force, UNM tied its season high with 19 steals. Eight Lobos were credited with a steal, led by five from Alyssa Hargrove and four from Joana Magalhães. The Lobos created six steals in the first quarter, seven in the third quarter and five in the fourth quarter.

In the first three games, Magalhães was credited with six steals twice. The sophomore is averaging 1.8 steals per game and has recorded a steal in 18 games with eight games with multiple steals. Her season high last season was four, which she did twice, and finished the season with 44 steals.

Hargrove had a career-best seven steals in the game against New Orleans with UNM creating 18 steals as a team. Her seven are tied for the most by a MW player this season.

Additionally, Hargrove has recorded a steal in 16 games with 12 games with multiple steals and five games with three or more steals. She is averaging 1.7 steals per game, eighth in the MW. In conference games, Hargrove is tied for eighth in steals per game (1.5) with multiple steals in five games.

As a team, UNM is 58th in the NCAA in steals per game and in conference games, UNM is averaging 9.4 steals per game with 113 steals, leading the MW.

For comparison, UNM reached double-digit steals in 11 games last season, with the season high of 15, and averaged 7.9 steals per game.

PADILLA PRODUCTION

Nayli Padilla has started eight games after starting one game last season, and has made the most of her increased minutes this season.

In the eight games, the sophomore averaged 8.1 points per game with 4.0 rebounds per game, 1.5 steals per game and 2.3 assists per game in 28.1 minutes per game. In addition, in the eight games, she's scored in double figures three times with multiple steals in five of the games, five rebounds in three and four assists in two.

On the season, she is averaging 8.5 points per game, 3.6 rebounds per game, 1.7 assists per game, 1.4 steals per game in 26.0 minutes. Further, she has made three or more three-pointers in seven games and recorded at least a steal in 17 games with 10 games with multiple steals. Padilla tied her career best of four steals against Grand Canyon and has been credited with a steal in 10 of the last 12 games.

For comparison, last season she averaged 3.7 points per game, 2.2 rebounds per game, 1.6 assists per game and 0.6 steals per game in 25 games.

In the game against North Carolina A&T, she scored a then-career-high 15 points, the second-most points by a Lobo in the game, with a then-career-high three, three-pointers.

The Spaniard scored eight of her points in the fourth quarter, with a three-pointer that gave UNM a 58-57 lead and another three-pointer 37 seconds later to put UNM up by four. When the Aggies were within two at 64-62, Padilla drove to the basket and dished it off to Jessie Joaquin for the layup and added a free throw with five seconds left for the final point. She also added two steals, four rebounds, two assists and block in the win.

She also started at UNLV and finished with 10 points, two steals, two three-pointers, three rebounds and an assist. In the game against Wyoming, Padilla scored 11 points with a team-high four assists, to go with two steals and four rebounds.

GAME 24: NEW MEXICO vs BOISE ST.

Even when she comes off the bench, her production remains as she led the Lobos in scoring against New Orleans (with 17 points), at New Mexico State (14 points), against Cincinnati (with a career-high 19 points behind a career-best seven made field goals and career-best five three-pointers) and at Wyoming (13 points). She added a season-high six rebounds and tallied three assists against the Aggies. Padilla went 4-5 from three-point range against NMSU. She also created a career-best four steals against Chicago State.

The sophomore has scored in double figures in nine games with the Lobos 7-2 when she does, and leads the Lobos in minutes at 26.0 per game, is second on the team in three-pointers (42) and assists (40), and third in steals (33), defensive rebounds (73) and in points per game. Padilla is sixth in the MW in three-pointers per game (1.8) and 11th in conference games (1.5).

In conference games, Padilla is ninth in the MW in steals per game (1.5) and is averaging 7.3 points per game, 3.3 rebounds per game, 1.7 assists per game and 24.3 minutes per game with a three-pointer in all but two games.

NEWCOMER NOTES

Newcomers have scored 614 points on the season (38.7% of the total points), led by Cacia Antonio at 201. On the boards, the newcomers have recorded 462 rebounds, 50.3% of the team total, with Jessie Joaquin leading with 142 and Emma Naijuma second at 139.

Laila Abdurraqib is fourth in the MW in made three-pointers per game (1.9) and scored a season- and game-high 25 points at Colorado State. Her seven three-pointers in the game are the most made by a player in a MW game this season. In conference games, she's tied for second in three-pointers per game at 2.1. Two UNM newcomers are among the top 20 in rebounds per game in MW games (Naijuma 14th at 6.3 and Joaquin fourth at 7.5).

SHARE THE WEALTH

In 14 of UNM's wins, the Lobos have had three or more players score in double figures. Five times (UT Martin, New Orleans, Chicago State, Houston and Boise State), the Lobos have had four players reach double digits. UNM had a season-best five reach double figures at San José State. Only at UNLV has UNM had three players score in double figures and lost, and only at Air Force and against Utah State has UNM had two players finish in double figures and won.

Ten different Lobos have scored 10+ points in a game, led by Destinee Hooks with 21, followed by Cacia Antonio (11), Nayli Padilla (9) and Laila Abdurraqib (8). Alyssa Hargrove has scored in double figures in seven games, Joana Magalhães in five games, Drew Jordon and Jessie Joaquin in two games and Clarissa Craig and Kaia Foster once.

UNM has also had nine different leading scorers in a game with Hooks leading in seven games, Antonio in four, Padilla in four, Magalhães in three and Hargrove, Abdurraqib, Joaquin and Craig in one game each. Foster tied Antonio for the team lead in one game.

The Lobos are 7-0 when Hargrove reaches double figures, 7-1 when Abdurraqib scores double figures, 9-2 when Antonio reaches double figures, 7-2 when Padilla does and 4-1 when Magalhães reaches double figures.

Further, of UNM's 586 made field goals, 295 were assisted (50.3%) with a season high of 21 against New Orleans.

Against NAU, 10 Lobos scored with three reaching double figures and 18 of the 28 made baskets were assisted.

In the game against New Orleans, UNM had 21 assists on 35 made field goals, and at New Mexico State, 10 different Lobos scored, assisting on 16 of the made field goals (55.2%). Ten Lobos again scored against UT Martin, with 15 of the made baskets assisted on (55.6%). At Arizona, 15 of the 26 made field goals were assisted on (57.7%) with nine Lobos scoring and six with eight or more points. Against Wyoming, eight different Lobos scored with three in double figures and half of the made baskets were assisted on. All 11 players who dressed at San José State scored with 18 of the 32 baskets (56.3%) assisted on, led by a season- and game-high six from Tyler Jones.

Hargrove leads the team with 61 assists (2.7 per game) and is ninth in the conference in assists per game.

BENCH WORK

On the season, the bench has scored 596 points, accounting for 37.6% of the points. UNM is 31st in the NCAA and leads the MW in bench points per game (25.9).

Laila Abdurraqib has led the bench in scoring in nine games, Nayli Padilla eight times, Jessie Joaquin twice, Destinee Hooks, Kaia Foster, Joana Magalhães and Drew Jordon once.

Against New Orleans, UNM's bench accounted for 51 points (51.5%), with two players in double figures, 21 rebounds (51.2%), nine assists (42.9%) and nine steals (50.0%).

In the game at NMSU, the bench scored 36 of the 77 points (46.8%), with Padilla leading the team in scoring coming off the bench. The bench also accounted for 20 rebounds, six three-pointers and half of UNM's steals (five). Against UT Martin, the Lobo bench scored 25 points (32.5%), led by 11 from Abdurraqib, and registered 26 rebounds (46.4%) led by a game-high 10 from Joaquin.

At the Florida Gulf Classic, the bench scored half of UNM's points against Chicago State, led by 16 from Jordon and 11 from Padilla, and recorded 23 rebounds with Emma Naijuma leading the team with a game-high 10 rebounds. The bench was also credited with nine steals. In the second game against Cincinnati, UNM's bench accounted for 48.3% of the points, led by Padilla's game-high 19. Naijuma also added a game-high 11 rebounds.

Against Houston, Joaquin led the team in points (13) and rebounds (12) off of the bench, accounting for half of the bench points. The bench also had seven of UNM's 12 steals with two each from Padilla, Abdurraqib and Jordon. At San José State, the bench scored 43 points (48.3%) of the points with Foster tied for the team lead with 15 points (which all came in the span of 2:41 in the fourth quarter) and

Abdurraqib scoring 10 points off the bench. In addition, Joaquin led the team in rebounds (16) off of the bench and Tyler Jones led the team in assists (six) off of the bench.

In the game at Colorado State, Abdurraqib scored a team-high 25 points of the bench's 34 points and accounted for 37.9% of UNM's total points, while Joaquin led the team in rebounds (seven) off of the bench. Abdurraqib scored the final 10 points for the Lobos.

At San Diego State, the bench scored half of UNM's points (28) with Abdurraqib leading the bench with 13 points and Padilla leading the team with six rebounds off of the bench. At Wyoming, the bench accounted for half of UNM's points (29) with Padilla leading the Lobos in scoring off of the bench with 13 points and Abdurraqib second in scoring with 12.

FIRST AWARD OF THE SEASON

Tyler Jones was selected the Old Trapper Mountain West Freshman of the Week as announced on Nov. 17.

Jones earned the honor after a season-high six points, season-high three rebounds and season- and game-high four assists at New Mexico State, in which she also registered two steals to tie her season high in UNM's win against the Aggies and played a season-high 22 minutes.

In addition, she scored four points, was credited with two steals, two rebounds and two assists in the win against New Orleans.

On the week, the Memphis, Tennessee native averaged 5.0 points per game, 2.5 rebounds per game, 2.0 steals per game and 3.0 assists per game in 20.5 minutes per game.

TWO FOR FRESHMEN

A season-high performance led to Laila Abdurraqib's first conference honor as the freshman was selected as the Mountain West Freshman of the Week on Dec. 8.

In UNM's win at Arizona, the Indiana native led the Lobos off the bench with a season-high 13 points, the fifth game this season doing so. Abdurraqib went 3-5 from behind the arc, tying her season high in three-pointers and the third time this season making three.

Not only was she efficient from three-point range, it was when her points came that was crucial. Her first three-pointer came in the second quarter to expand UNM's lead to 29-21 and later added two free throws in the quarter to build UNM's lead from four to six. She made her second three-pointer in the third quarter as part of a 5-0 Lobo run that turned a 48-46 lead into a 53-46 lead, and her third three-pointer with 7:08 remaining in the game to push the Lobo lead past a possession at 64-58. The point guard followed the three with a jumper 1:33 later to push it to an eight-point margin, finishing with five points in the fourth quarter.

MAKE IT TWO FOR LAILA

For the second time this season, New Mexico freshman Laila Abdurraqib was selected as the Old Trapper Mountain West Freshman of the Week on Feb. 2.

The Fishers, Indiana native averaged 8.5 points between UNM's two wins over UNLV and Utah State, making multiple three-pointers in each game.

In Wednesday's game, Abdurraqib was instrumental in the fourth quarter, scoring eight consecutive Lobo points in a span of 1:58 to build UNM's lead from five to 13. With the Lobos holding a 55-50 lead, the freshman made a layup and 35 seconds later grabbed a defensive rebound that led to her making a three-pointer. With 4:06 to play and UNM leading 60-50, Abdurraqib grabbed her third rebound leading to another made three-pointer, giving her double digits in the game.

The Lobo went 3-5 in the fourth quarter and scored 11 points between the third and fourth quarter to lead the Lobos off of the bench for the ninth time this season.

Against Utah State, she recorded two steals and made two three-pointers in the win. After making a three-pointer in the first quarter that put UNM in front by seven, her steal in the second quarter led to a Nayli Padilla three-pointer to stretch the lead to 18, also registering an assist on the play. In the fourth quarter, she grabbed a defensive rebound that led to her three-pointer to push the lead back to 18 points.

PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

Destinee Hooks was selected to the Preseason All-Mountain West Team and the Lobos were picked to finish fifth in the Mountain West Preseason Poll.

UNM received two first-place votes and finished with 207 points, one of three teams to receive multiple first-place votes and one of six teams to receive a first-place vote. UNLV was picked as the preseason favorite with 19 first-place votes and 281 points with San Diego State second with 240 points and received three first-place votes. Colorado State was picked third with 236 points and one first-place vote and Boise State narrowly edged out the Lobos for the fourth spot in the order of finish with 210 points and received one first-place vote.

The separation between fifth and sixth was 13 points with Wyoming projected to finish sixth with new conference opponent Grand Canyon picked seventh with one first-place vote and 177 points. Air Force (132 points), Fresno State (95 points), Nevada (92 points), Utah State (54 points) and San José State (44 points) rounded out the order of finish.

For Hooks, the Lobo was one of 10 players selected for the preseason team, and comes after she earned Mountain West Honorable Mention following her first season as a Lobo.

Against conference opponents in 2024-25, Hooks reached double figures in 15 games, averaging 14.2 points per game, with two games of 20 or more points, including 27 points against UNLV. In addition, Hooks led the Lobos in scoring in eight conference games and finished 11th in the conference in scoring and 10th in field goal percentage (.420). Defensively, Hooks recorded a steal in 10 games with multiple steals in six.

Of note, while the Lobos were picked fifth, in the last five years, UNM finished second three times, won the league once and tied for fourth last season. Only twice in Coach Bradbury's previous nine seasons has UNM finished lower than fifth.

GAME 24: NEW MEXICO vs BOISE ST.

MADE FOR TV

The Lobos will have two nonconference games and four conference games broadcast on Altitude Sports.

UNM's game against Texas Tech on Nov. 23 and against Houston on Dec. 13 were broadcast on Altitude, the leading regional sports network in the Rockies. In addition, games against Nevada (Jan. 10), Utah State (Jan. 31), Colorado State (Feb. 14) and Air Force (Feb. 21) will also be aired on Altitude. The announcement continues a partnership between UNM and the network, which includes four Lobo football games and nine men's basketball games airing on the network.

Josh Suchon and Lobo women's basketball alum Nikki Lobato will serve as the broadcast team for Altitude.

BIG 12 SCHEDULE

There was a common theme among the nonconference schedule this season and that's the presence of the Big 12 Conference.

Of UNM's 11 nonconference games, five opponents were from the Big 12. Colorado was the first team the Lobos faced in their second game of the season, and hosted Texas Tech on Nov. 23. UNM has three consecutive Big 12 opponents in Cincinnati on a neutral court in Naples, Florida on Nov. 29, Arizona (in Tucson on Dec. 7) and at home against Houston to close the nonconference schedule on Dec. 13.

UNM picked up wins against Arizona and Houston to close nonconference and lost to Cincinnati by three.

RELYING ON THE RETURNERS

Heading into the season, the Lobos returned a core of six players, led by junior Destinee Hooks, senior Alyssa Hargrove and sophomore Joana Magalhães, with the trio starting in over 30 games last season.

Hooks is UNM's returning leading scorer, averaging 15.0 points per game, shooting 45.3% from the floor, and finished in double figures in 26 games with 20-plus points in six games, while starting in 31 games. Further, the Indiana native, who earned Mountain West Honorable Mention following her first year as a Lobo, recorded two double-doubles and finished third on the team in assists (58) and steals (28).

Hargrove started all 32 games in her first year as a Lobo, averaging 8.3 points per game, 3.7 rebounds per game, 2.2 steals per game and 0.9 blocks per game in 31.2 minutes per game. The Ohio native finished in double figures in 13 games and recorded her first double-double with 11 rebounds and 10 assists against Boise State, becoming the first Lobo to register an assist and rebound double-double since 2016. Strong on the defensive end, Hargrove recorded a steal in 28 games with 18 games with multiple steals and seven games with four or more steals, finishing second in the Mountain West in steals and steals per game and third in assists and assists per game.

In her freshman season, Magalhães started 30 games and played in all 32, earning a spot on the Mountain West All-Freshman Team. The guard averaged 7.1 points per game, 3.9 rebounds per game, 2.5 assists per game, 1.4 steals per game and scored in double figures in 11 games with a season-high 20 points at Colorado State. Further, she had five or more assists in four games with a season-high six against Morehead State and recorded a steal in 22 games with multiple steals in 14 games.

This season, Hooks leads the team in points (311) and Hargrove leads in assists (61) and steals (40).

GLOBAL LOBOS

The Lobos bring an international flair to the roster with players representing three continents and seven countries (Angola, Uganda, Portugal, Spain, Mozambique, The Netherlands and the United States). Further, while from three different countries, four players speak Portuguese (Joana Magalhães, Cacia Antonio, Leonor Peixinho and Jessie Joaquim).

Antonio played for the Angola National Team, Peixinho played for Portugal over the summer and Emma Najjuma played for the Uganda National Team.

NONCONFERENCE NOTABLES

The Lobos closed nonconference with consecutive wins over Big 12 opponents, defeating Houston 63-41 and Arizona 72-69. The Lobos are the first MW team with multiple wins over Big 12 opponents in the same season since TCU in 2009-10. The other teams with multiple wins over the Big 12 this season are Southern and Texas A&M, with two each.

UNM's win marked the fourth in last five games in the series with Houston as well as the second time under Coach Mike Bradbury that the Lobos have won two games against Power 4 teams in the same season (2017-18, Illinois and Texas Tech). It was also the sixth win that the Lobos have had over a Power 4 school under Bradbury.

The 22-point win was the second-largest margin of victory for UNM in the series (23 in 2001) and was the fewest points allowed in a game in the series. Further, it was the third-largest margin of victory over a Power 4 team in Bradbury's tenure at UNM.

The 41 points were a season low for Houston, as was its 13 field goals and 22.8% field goal percentage.

Further, UNM's 99 points against New Orleans were the most scored by a MW team in a game this season, as were the 56 rebounds against UT Martin. The 35 made field goals against New Orleans are tied for the second most by a MW team this season.

UNM finished nonconference 8-3 with a +11.1 scoring margin, averaging 72.0 points per game, and a +6.5 rebounding margin, averaging 42.3 rebounds per game. The 8-3 record is UNM's best nonconference record since the 2018-19 season, when the Lobos went 10-1.

NOW THAT'S A STAT

UNM's 89-51 win at San José State was its second road win by at least 30 points this season (also won by 32 points at New Mexico State).

STATEMENT WIN

A dominant second quarter by New Mexico in which the Lobos outscored New Mexico State 28-4 and held the Aggies scoreless for 7:18 in the contest led the way for a 77-45 Lobo road win.

The 45 points were the fewest points allowed by the Lobos in the series since allowing 44 in 2012, also in Las Cruces, and tied for the third-largest margin of victory in the series (32, also done in 2008 and 1979). However, it is the largest margin of victory by UNM in Las Cruces in the series.

Nayli Padilla led the Lobos for the second straight game with 14 points behind a career-high four three-pointers, and was one of three Lobos to reach double figures with Destinee Hooks and Cacia Antonio scoring 10 points each.

UNM finished with a season-high 10 three-pointers and shot a season-best 53.7% from the field and a season-best 45.5% from behind the arc.

The Lobos opened the second quarter on a 12-2 run that included an 8-0 run with three-pointers from Hargrove and Hooks to give the Lobos a 22-13 lead less than three minutes into the quarter. A Padilla three and layup by Antonio extended the run to 13-0 over a span of 3:45. UNM shot 68.8% in the quarter, holding NMSU to 12.5% shooting, making five three-pointers and shooting 71.4% from behind the arc.

The momentum continued in the third quarter as the Lobos stretched the lead to 36 at 57-21 at the 3:52 mark using a 14-0 run over a span of 2:45. Hooks started the run with a jumper, Antonio made a three-pointer, Hooks completed a three-point play, Abdurraqib made a three-pointer and Antonio closed the run with another three-pointer. The 36-point margin held through the end of the quarter with UNM outscoring the Aggies 23-10 and outshooting the Aggies 69.2% to 21.4%. Through the first three quarters, NMSU went 0-11 from three-point range with UNM making eight three-pointers on 15 attempts.

Between the second and third quarters, UNM outscored NMSU 51-14.

99 POINTS ON THE BOARD

The Lobos scored 99 points against New Orleans, shooting 52.2% in the game, including 68.6% in the first half.

Nayli Padilla led the Lobos in scoring with 17 points while coming off the bench, besting her career high from the last game against North Carolina A&T of 15 points, while tying her career high of three, three-pointers. Destinee Hooks finished with 16 points and Cacia Antonio and Drew Jordon each contributed 10 points.

As a whole, the bench accounted for 51 of UNM's total points and as a team, the Lobos tallied 21 assists on the 35 made field goals. At the line, the Lobos were an efficient 20-23, making their first eight free throws and behind the arc made nine three-pointers.

The 99 points are the most points scored by a MW team this season to date with 35 made field goals.

CLOSE THE DOOR

The Lobos trailed 57-53 with 6:16 left in the fourth quarter against North Carolina A&T and went on a 10-0 run behind two free throws by Destinee Hooks, back-to-back three-pointers by Nayli Padilla and a layup by Alyssa Hargrove in 1:49.

When the Aggies pulled within two at 64-62 with 2:27 left, a layup by Jessie Joaquin off of a Padilla assist and a Joana Magalhães steal and layup immediately following kept the Lobos in front. Two free throws by Hargrove with 17 seconds left allowed UNM to build a seven-point lead at 70-63 and each team made one free throw with Padilla making the final free throw for the final score.

Padilla scored eight points in the fourth quarter, going 2-4 from three-point range and added two free throws. As a team, UNM outscored A&T 21-16.

In addition, the Lobos closed the season opener against Northern Arizona on a 10-1 run in the final 5:40 and held the Lumberjacks to five points in the fourth quarter to pull away for the 77-59 victory.

Against Boise State, UNM trailed 53-44 with 7:44 to go in the game and went on a 12-0 run while holding the Broncos scoreless for 3:10 to turn the deficit into a lead, which the Lobos held the remainder of the game.

In the game against Wyoming, UNM held the Cowgirls the final 4:17 without a point, closing the game on a 9-0 run.

Trailing 48-42 in the fourth quarter at Colorado State, UNM went on a 14-2 run over a span of 3:22 to give the Lobos the 56-50 lead.

Against Utah State, the Lobo defense held the Aggies 5:26 without a point during a 10-0 run in the fourth quarter and without a point in the final 1:55, holding USU to six points in the quarter.



MIKE BRADBURY

RECORD AT UNM: 196-110 (10TH SEASON)

CAREER RECORD: 374-227 (19TH SEASON)

NOTEWORTHY:

- Led UNM to 25 wins in 2017-18; tied for second-most wins in program history
- Led UNM to 20+ wins in five seasons, and .500 or better in seven
- Earned his 100th win at UNM on Nov. 30, 2021; only the second coach in program history to reach 100. Earned his 300th career win on Nov. 22, 2022 against Western N.M.

Mike Bradbury enters his ninth season as head coach for The University of New Mexico women's basketball team. In his previous eight seasons at the helm, Bradbury has guided the Lobos to a 162-89 (.645) and 89-51 (.636) in conference and became just the second coach in UNM history to win 100 games with a win over Grambling on Nov. 30, 2021.

Five times in his tenure (2017-18, 2018-19, 2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24) the Lobos eclipsed the 20-win mark, with the Lobos tying the program record for most wins in a single season with 26 in 2021-22. Further, the 25 wins in 2017-18 were tied for the second-most wins in program history. The consecutive 20-plus win seasons under Bradbury in 2017-18 and 2018-19 were the first for the program since the 2007-08 – 2008-09 seasons.

Further, the last time the Lobos finished with 20-plus wins in three consecutive seasons was 2006-07, 2007-08 and 2008-09.

Of note, there are only three Mountain West teams that have won 20 games in each of the last three years (UNM, UNLV and CSU), and in the last four years, only two MW teams that have won 10 or more conference games all four years (UNM and UNLV).

The Lobos have sustained success under Bradbury as historically, UNM has finished either first or second in the conference in scoring offense in six of the last seven years (four times first). In Bradbury's time at UNM, the Lobos have finished with 15 or made three-pointers 11 times and hold the top-five spots in three-pointers per game in program history.

During the most recent season, the Lobos were among the most consistent defensive teams in the country, ranking 14th in defensive rebounds per game and 10th in the fewest fouls per game. On an individual level, the Lobos garnered several awards with five Mountain West Player of the Week selections, the most since the 2018-19 season, as well as earning MW Newcomer of the Year (Nyah Wilson), MW Defensive Player of the Year (Aniyah Augmon), two All-Mountain West Team selections in Augmon and Wilson, an All-Defensive Team selection for Augmon and a MW Coach of the Year selection for Bradbury.

Wilson became the seventh Lobo to earn Newcomer of the Year and the fourth under Bradbury, with the last one back in 2018-19. Augmon became only the second Lobo to win Defensive Player of the Year, joining Porche Torrance who won in 2011-12. The

selection marked the first Coach of the Year award for Bradbury and the third for a New Mexico coach.

In his time at UNM, Bradbury has coached 19 All-Mountain West performers, six on the All-Defensive Team and three on the All-Newcomer/Freshman Team.

In terms of major individual awards, Bradbury coached the league's Newcomer of the Year each of his first three seasons in charge of the Lobos with Richelle van der Keijl earning the award in 2016-17, Tessa Buck in 2017-18 and Aisia Robertson in 2018-19. Additionally, Bradbury has coached the MW Player of the Year in Jaisa Nunn (2018-19) and the Freshman of the Year in Jayla Everett (2018-19) as well as Sixth Person of the Year in LaTascya Duff (2020-21).

Further, a Lobo has been named Mountain West Player of the Week 20 times during his tenure, with four named Freshman of the Week.

In the 2022-23 season, UNM finished 15th in the NCAA in made three-pointers per game at 8.5 per game, with 12 games with double-digit three-pointers. Of the 12 games, UNM made 18 (against South Carolina State) and three games with 16 (twice against Utah State and at Fresno State).

During the 2021-22 season, the program established several program records. UNM set the program record in made three-pointers (346), a program-best 171 made three-pointers in conference season, as well as a program-record 596 assists on the season and 292 in conference games. In addition, the Lobos made a program-high 523 field goals in conference and scored the most points in conference in program history with 1,413 points. On Jan. 6 at Utah State, the Lobos set the program record and the MW record in made three-pointers in a game with 21, and three games later made 19 three-pointers for the second most in a game in program history. The Lobos also went on a nine-game win streak, the second longest in program history.



New Mexico ranked in the top 10 in the NCAA in made three-pointers (third), made three-pointers per game (fifth, 9.6 per game) and in assists (10th). In total, UNM ranked in the top 30 in nine categories, including scoring offense (14th, 76.7 points per game), assists per game (16th, 16.6 per game), assist/turnover ratio (18th, 1.21), field-goal percentage (19th, 45.1 percent), blocked shots (25th, 147) and three-point field-goal percentage (30th, 35.1 percent).

GAME 24: NEW MEXICO vs BOISE ST.

UNM added six postseason Mountain West honors with a conference-high three all-conference players in Antonia Anderson, Shaiquel McGruder and Jaedyn De La Cerda, an honorable mention in LaTora Duff, an all-defensive player in McGruder and an all-freshman in Paula Reus. The Lobos have had 12 conference selections in the last two seasons.

Further, five Lobos finished the 2021-22 season averaging double figures in points per game.

In the 2020-21 season, Bradbury led the Lobos to a Mountain West regular season championship, the first outright in program history and the first regular season title since the 2004-05 season. In addition, the Lobos were selected for the WNIT for the third time in four years.

The Lobos produced one of the most prolific offenses not only in the conference, but in the country, finishing among the top 25 in several categories. Among them, UNM finished fourth in the NCAA in made three-pointers per game (10.2), sixth in assist-turnover ratio (1.40), ninth in scoring offense (81.2 points per game), 14th in fewest turnovers per game (12.0) and assists per game (16.8) and 22nd in scoring margin (12.7). The Lobos led the Mountain West in scoring offense, scoring margin, assists per game, turnover margin, assist-turnover ratio and made three-pointers as well as second in field-goal percentage and steals per game.

UNM set a program record in scoring with 120 points against Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Dec. 17, 2020 and in the process, made 17 three-pointers, falling just one short of tying the program record. Further, the Lobos registered 90-plus points in five games and 80-plus points in 11 of the 20 games on the season.

Four Lobos finished the 2020-21 season averaging double figures in points per game with six players finishing in double figures in scoring in two games (the only times it has been accomplished in program history), five players in five games and four in seven games.

As a result of UNM's successful season, five players were named to the All-Mountain West Team with LaTascya Duff also earning the superlative of Sixth Person of the Year. Duff was just the second Lobo to win the sixth person award. Making the all-conference team for the first time were Duff, Jaedyn De La Cerda and Antonia Anderson, as well as Shaiquel McGruder earning all-defensive and Ahlise Hurst earning the honorable mention distinction.

In his third year at the helm, Bradbury continued to put his mark on the program while also continuing to bring Lobo women's basketball back to national prominence. Overall, Bradbury's 2018-19 team went 24-7 and earned a bid to the WNIT for a second-straight season. It marked the first time since the 2008-09 – 2009-10 seasons that the program made consecutive trips to the postseason.

Prior to coming to Albuquerque, Bradbury built a successful nine year run as a Division-I head coach with stops at Morehead State (Morehead, Ky.) and Wright State (Dayton, Ohio). Most recently with the Raiders, Bradbury led his squad to five 20-win seasons, including each of his final three seasons. During that time, Wright State has amassed a 75-28 record, the best amongst the 13 Division I programs in the state of Ohio.

Overall at Wright State, Bradbury had five winning seasons, all of which were 20-plus win seasons, in six years – a feat made all the more remarkable as Wright State had just one winning season in the previous 22 before his arrival. In the previous 37 seasons of women's basketball at Wright State, the Raider program had tallied 20 wins just once before Bradbury led the team to 20 wins in five of his six seasons.

His most prominent three-year run at Wright State started in 2013-14, when the Raiders won a school-record 26 games on the way to a 26-9 season and the program's first-ever appearance in the NCAA Tournament. That season saw the Raiders finish second in the Horizon League and win its first Horizon League Tournament. It also featured the program's first road win at perennial league power Wisconsin-Green Bay. Kim Demmings was named the Horizon League Player of the Year and Tournament MVP, and it marked the first time in school history the program had a pair of first team All-Conference selections.

He followed up that by earning Horizon League Coach of the Year in 2014-15 after a 25-9 season that saw his squad lose its Horizon League Preseason Player of the Year less than two minutes into the season opener. The Raiders just missed a second straight NCAA Tournament appearance, falling in overtime in the conference championship game. The team did make its first appearance in the Women's NIT as the league's automatic qualifier, and in 2015-16, the team made it back-to-back WNIT appearances after a 24-11 season, earning the program's first at-large bid.

Those three seasons are the three winningest seasons in the history of Wright State women's basketball.

In his first two seasons at Wright State, he led the team to a 20-13 campaign and a 21-13 mark and berths in the Women's Basketball Invitational, the first NCAA Division I postseason berths for the program. Overall, Bradbury has coached three Horizon League Players of the Year (all in his last three seasons), six first-team All-Horizon League players, three second-team members and four All-Freshman team members.

Prior to his time at Wright State, Bradbury was the head coach at Morehead State where he led the Division I program to a 50-44 mark in three seasons, including a watershed 22-11 season, which was the second-most wins in Morehead State history and the most wins by the Eagles in the previous 38 years.

At Morehead State he coached one Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year, along with one first-team All-OVC pick (two seasons) and three second-team All-OVC picks.

Bradbury also spent time as an assistant coach at Xavier (2002-06), Cincinnati (1996-02), VCU (1995-96), East Tennessee State (1994-95) and Chattanooga (1991-94). In his 30 seasons as an assistant and as a head coach, Bradbury's teams have finished below .500 only three times.
