MYPAS is a dynamic, values-driven organisation supporting the health and wellbeing of young people. We recently completed a successful competitive tendering process, winning the contract to deliver the Schools Counselling Service on behalf of Scottish Borders Council.

We are now seeking an experienced therapeutic professional to lead this newly created service in the Scottish Borders. This is a rare opportunity to shape a growing service, support a dedicated team, and make a measurable difference to the lives of children and young people aged 10–18 in the Scottish Borders.

This post is initially funded until March 2028. The contract has the potential to be extended for another two years before a re-tendering process.

The postholder will be expected to lead, manage and develop MYPAS's School Counselling Service in the Scottish Borders, ensuring high-quality, safe, and accessible support for children and young people. This includes direct line management of the staff team, service planning and improvement, and a small caseload. Our ambition is to secure further funding to enable development of additional therapeutic support for young people and the service manager would be expected take an active role in securing funding, developing services, and managing staff associated with these projects.
