JOB OVERVIEW

As Stores and Facilities Officer, you will work closely with colleagues across Venture Trust to ensure we have the kit and equipment we need, maintained to a high standard, and available for our delivery teams when they need it.

You will support our teams with their kit, equipment and vehicle requirements for their community and wilderness-based activities.

You will take pride in your role and encourage others to do the same. By proactively seeking ways to improve efficiency you'll ensure Venture Trust is sustainable. By conducting regular health and safety checks and keeping records up to date, you will contribute to keeping our staff and participants safe.



In addition to this, you will ensure that our facilities have regular safety and security checks, including building maintenance, liaising with contractors and health and safety compliance.

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

Kit and Equipment:

- Prepare and pack kit for our outdoor programmes, ensuring all equipment is clean and in working order
- Process returning kit from programmes, making sure equipment is cleaned fully and stored in line with Venture Trust stores processes
- Maintain, oversee, and review Venture Trust equipment inventory system, including the kit replacement schedule, carrying out regular inspections
- Review and update stores and equipment procedure in line with organisational need
- Take pride in maintaining high standards, keeping stores and equipment clean, tidy and in good working order, as well as motivate others to look after equipment
- Coordinate preventative maintenance and repair work as required
- Ensure that appropriate scheduled maintenance takes place for all personal protective equipment (PPE)

Vehicles

- Manage Venture Trust vehicle fleet bookings
- Ensure vehicles are booked for scheduled maintenance, MOT and required repair work
- Take pride in maintaining high standards, keeping Venture Trust van fleet clean, tidy and in good working order

Relationships

- Work closely with colleagues across the organisation, communicating well to ensure efficient kit management to meet all delivery needs
- Maintain a high level of professional engagement and build positive relationships with all visitors to stores, including staff from across the organisation and freelance instructors
- Support the smooth running of Venture Trust operations and programmes e.g. driving the minibus for local programmes

Health and safety:

- Ensure appropriate safety standards are maintained in the stores and vehicle storage area
- Ensure goods and hazardous chemicals are stored as per health and safety requirements
- Maintain clean and efficient premises
- Ensure all tasks are conducted in accordance with health and safety policies and procedures, and safe working practices
- Undertake regular health and safety checks and escalate any required maintenance
- Undertake regular maintenance jobs to Venture Trust premises as required



Facilities

- Responsibility for facilities at the Stirling base, liasing with Senior Outdoor Coordinator and senior leadership team
- Ensure the building remains compliant with Health & Safety regulations
- Responsibility for the building's fire systems
- Responsibility for the building's intruder security systems
- Ensuring utilities, janitorial supplies and waste management is monitored effectively
- Responsibility for building recycling and refuse disposal

Other:

- Undertake training and professional development as required
- Undertake any other reasonable duties as may be required
