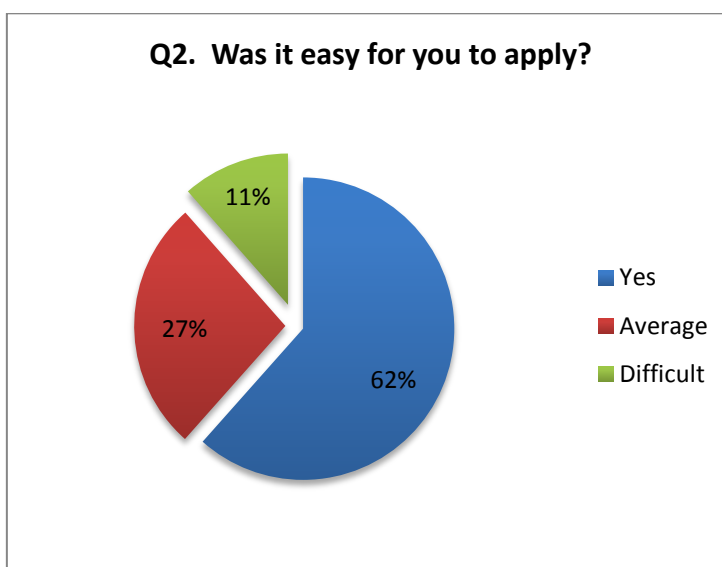
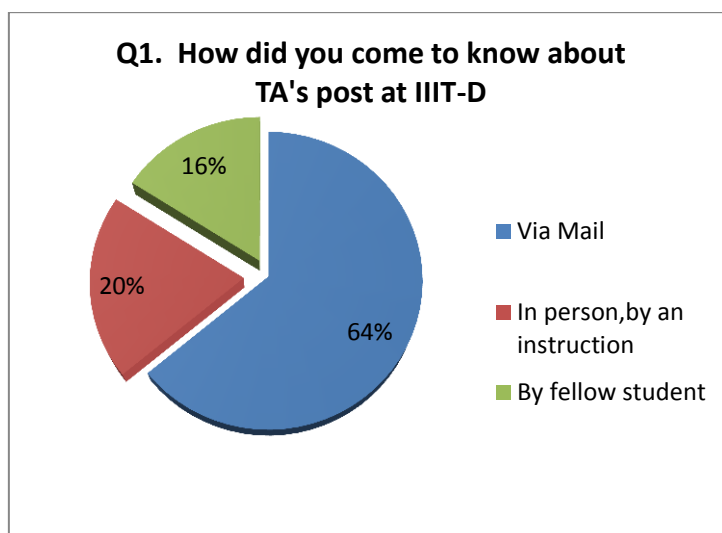


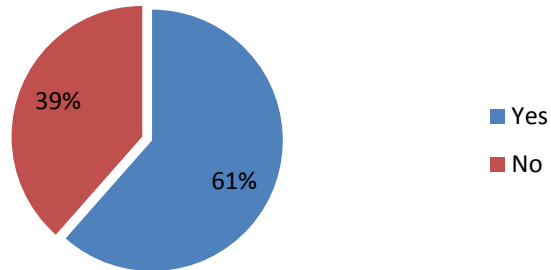
Responses of the Teaching Assistants' Survey

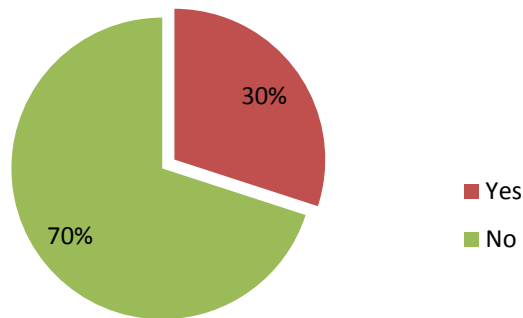
Below are the responses of the online survey:



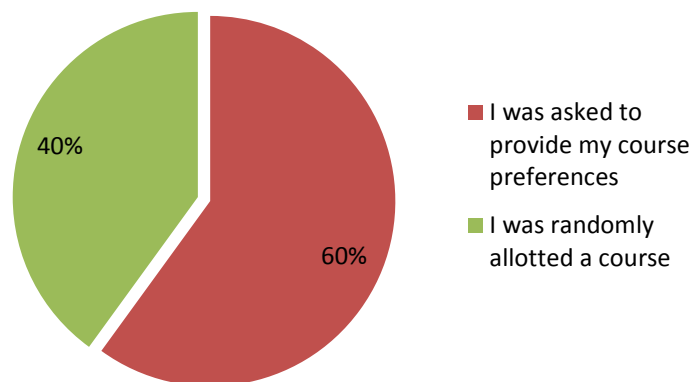
Q3. Were you able to get all the information regarding the course you wanted to teach including the time-table clashes/work load/timing issues?



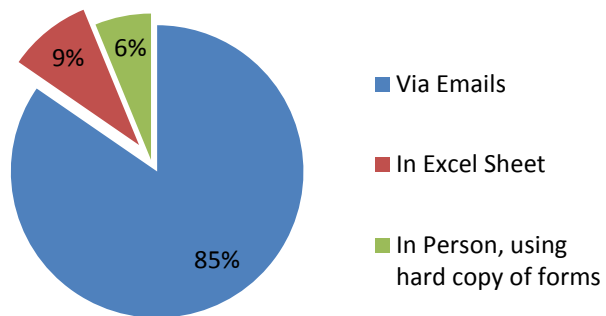
Q4. Did you know about all the work which you would be required to do in that particular course?



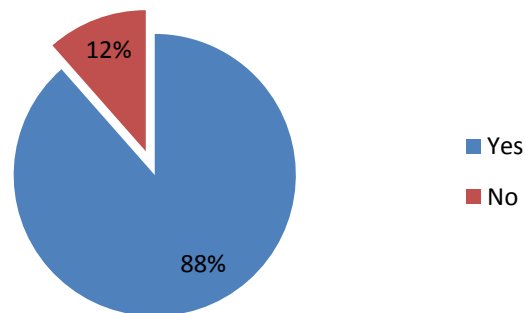
Q5. How was your TAship Allotment done?



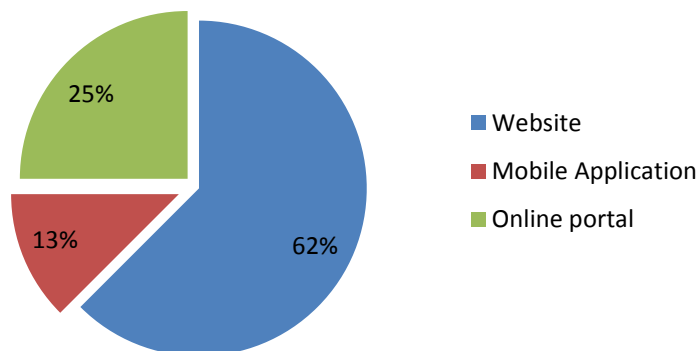
Q6. What was the medium of Information transfer and your Interaction with the Coordinators and other Applicants?
