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- Create a MyPennState Profile <http://admissions.psu.edu> (You can create this at any time!)\*\*
- Apply for Admission to Penn State — Click *Apply Online* to start  
Fall/Summer Admission opens August 1                      Spring Admission opens June 1
- \$65 nonrefundable application fee\*\*
- Complete and submit a Self-Reported Academic Record (SRAR)
- After submitting your application, print out a counselor form. Complete and send with the below record.

Use the following codes during testing for scores to come directly to PSU:

- ACCEPT** your offer of admission for Summer/Fall enrollment by May 1

- Send **FINAL OFFICIAL** High School Transcript to Penn State (must include graduation date)\*\*

- BY FALL of your Senior Year — Submit Official High School Transcripts and Test Scores to the NCAA Eligibility Center. \*\*

- Log in to eLiving to accept your contract & indicate your housing preferences (location, roommate, etc.)
- If you are attending Summer Bridge, you will have 2 housing contracts — one for the summer and one for the fall and spring

## NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION (NSO) – REQUIRED\*\* // <https://orientation.psu.edu/up>

**After March 1** — After accepting your offer of admissions and paying acceptance fee

- Received NSO Invitation email. (Occurs daily after March 1)
- Complete Math Assessment (ALEKS) on LionPath ([orientation.psu.edu/testing](https://orientation.psu.edu/testing))

**In April** — Must have completed ALEKS to move to these steps

- Email sent explaining how to sign up for your available NSO programs
  - Program dates are based on the semester of admission and availability of your selected college. The sooner you attend NSO, the sooner you can schedule classes!
- Complete Pre NSO Homework prior to NSO (available within the NSO Reservation System)
- Attend NSO **My NSO Program Date Is:** \_\_\_\_\_
- Meet with Morgan Academic Center (MAC) Counselor at the end of NSO Day 2 (after scheduling with your college)
- Attend New Student-Athlete Welcome prior to the term you start classes,
  - June for summer, August for fall, January for spring, **this is separate from NSO**

## MISC. (if applicable)

- DOMESTIC STUDENTS** — To be considered for additional student aid, including merit-based scholarships, students must submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). FAFSA becomes available on Oct. 1 and PSU recommends FAFSA to be completed by Feb. 15.
- To receive credit for AP Exams, **Official Grade Reports** must be received by Admissions, directly from College Board. You may send directly to PSU during testing using **AP Code: 2660**
