## TRANSFERRING CREDIT // <http://admissions.psu.edu/info/future/transfer/transfer-credit-equivalencies/>

Must have received a C or better for credits to transfer. Penn State Transfers credits only. The grade(s) earned from transfer credits will not be used for your Penn State GPA

- Accepted students will receive an evaluation of transferable credits based on transcripts provided.
- Most courses will require the submission of course syllabus for academic departmental review to determine equivalency
  - Send syllabi for all courses to [crediteval@psu.edu](mailto:crediteval@psu.edu) after accepting Offer of Admission.
  - **BEST PRACTICE** — keep a copy of ALL course syllabi
- To receive credit for AP Exams, **Official Grade Reports** must be received by Admissions, directly from College Board. You may send directly to PSU during testing using **AP Code: 2660**

- Email sent from Student Orientation & Transition Programs
- Complete Pre TSO Homework prior to TSO (available within the TSO Reservation System) on LionPATH prior to TSO
- Attend TSO **My TSO Program Date is:** \_\_\_\_\_
- Meet with Morgan Academic Center (MAC) Counselor after scheduling with your college
- Attend New Student-Athlete Orientation prior to the term you start classes,  
• June for summer, August for fall, January for spring, this is separate from TSO

## MISC.

- DOMESTIC STUDENTS** — To be considered for additional student aid, including merit-based scholarships, students must submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). FAFSA becomes available on October 1st and PSU recommends FAFSA be completed by Feb. 15
- Obtain a Penn State +id Card  
• Can be acquired from any Penn State campus. You can acquire prior to your arrival **or** when you attend TSO
