

PENN STATE TRAVELS TO INDIANA ON FRIDAY

The Penn State men's soccer team, under fifth-year head coach Jeff Cook, head to Bloomington, Ind. for a conference match up against Indiana. The game will be nationally televised on the Big Ten Network and will kick off at 6:30 p.m.

Senior forward Liam Butts was named to the National Team of the week and earned Big Ten Offensive Player of the Week for the second time in his career and third for the Nittany Lions this season.

Penn State is ranked 25th in Top Drawer Soccer's Poll this week.

LAST TIME OUT

- » Penn State's most recent contest resulted in a 4-1 victory over Michigan State on Friday, Oct. 7.
- » Penn State scored all four goals in the first half of the game.
- » Peter Mangione scored the first goal of the game, five minutes into the first half.
- » Butts scored two of the four goals for the Nittany Lions less than three minutes apart, both using his head. His first goal resulted from a blocked shot attempt by Sean Bettenhausen that Butts headed into the net. His second, came after a cross from Andrew Privett that Butts redirected past the Spartans' keeper for the third goal of the game.
- » Van Danielson added to the tally at the end of the period with another header goal off assists from Privett and Alex Stevenson.
- » Butts joins Mangione in being the only two players for Penn State to score more than one goal in a game this season.
- » Three of the four goals were scored with the head of a Penn State player and two of the goals were assisted by Privett.

PENN STATE-INDIANA MOST RECENT

- » Penn State and Indiana faced off twice last season, once in the regular season, once in the championship of the Big Ten Tournament.
- » The Hoosiers claimed a 1-0 victory in the regular season.
- The Nittany Lions won the Big Ten Championship with their
 3-0 result against Indiana later that season.
- » Seth Kuhn scored the first goal of the game, Tyger Evans and Pierre Reedy added insurance goals in the second half.
- » Kris Shakes got the shutout in goal marking his fourth last season.

2022 ACCOLADES

- » Penn State is ranked 25th in the Top Drawer Soccer Weekly Poll.
- » Liam Butts was named Big Ten Offensivde Player of the Week and was selected to College Soccer New National Team of the Week (Oct. 11).
- » United Soccer Coaches ranked the Nittany Lions 21st in the country in their Preseason Poll.
- » Mangione was selected as a United Soccer Coaches Forward to Watch.
- » Mangione, Kuhn and Femi Awodesu were named Big Ten Players to Watch.
- » Mangione was named to the Hermann Award Trophy List.

2021 IN REVIEW

- » The Nittany Lions finished the 2021 season 13-7-1 overall, 6-2 conference.
- » They were Big Ten regular season and tournament Champions for the first time in program history.
- » Penn State made its 35th NCAA Tournament appearance when they hosted Hofstra in the second round of the tournament after earning the automatic bid from the conference championship.
- » Andrew Privett led the Nittany Lion offense last season scoring nine goals with four assists and 22 points.
- » Junior Peter Mangione was not far behind Privett with seven goals on the season, with four eventual game-winners.
- » Mangione was named the 2021 Big Ten Offensive Player of the Year, the second Big Ten Player of the Year award under head coach Jeff Cook.
- » Cook was named 2021 Big Ten Coach of the Year in a unanimous vote.
- » Cook and his coaching staff were selected as the North Region Staff of the Year
- » Six Nittany Lions were honored in Big Ten season awards along with Cook and Mangione. Brandon Hackenberg and Mangione were named to All-Big Ten First Team. Andrew Privett, Seth Kuhn and Pierre Reedy were selected to All-Big Ten Second Team and Alex Stevenson was awarded Penn State's Sportsmanship Award.
- » Four Nittany Lions landed on the 2021 All-North Region Teams. Pete Mangione made first team, Hackenberg and Kuhn made second and Andrew Privett was selected to third-team.

2022 NEWCOMERS

» Penn State welcomed nine new players to the team this year. The freshmen include goalkeeper Ryan Aiken, defenders Sam Ovesen and Ben Ofori and Kaleb Alva, and midfieders Cohen Weaver, and Sebastian Vainstein. The Nittany Lions secured two transfers; sophomore forward from Portland Atem Kato and fifth year defender from Michigan State Olu Ogunwale.
