- Penn State looks to stay hot Wednesday night when the Nittany Lions travel to Northwestern for a midweek Big Ten battle.
- The Nittany Lions are coming off a 61-58 win over visiting Indiana Sunday afternoon. The defense led the way in Penn State's first Big Ten win of the season.
- Four Nittany Lions are averaging double-digit points, led by junior Seth Lundy's 14.1 ppg. Seniors Sam Sessoms (13.0 ppg) and Jalen Pickett (12.2 ppg) follow, while grad student John Harrar is averaging a double-double with 10.9 ppg and 10.7 rpg.

IF PENN STATE BEATS NORTHWESTERN

- The Nittany Lions would win their second-straight Big Ten game.
- Penn State would earn its first true road win of the season.
- Penn State would improve to 35-20 all-time against Northwestern.

BACK IN A BIG WAY

Penn State returned from a 22-day layoff from game action Sunday afternoon and the Nittany Lions came back with a vengeance. A strong defensive effort and timely 3-point shooting presence led the Nittany Lions to a 61-58 victory over a previously 10-2 Indiana

The Penn State defense set the tone, holding Indiana nearly 20 points below its season scoring average of 77.2. The Nittany Lions dominated the glass, out-rebounding Indiana 39-29. The Hoosiers entered the game averaging 41.6 boards per contest.

Penn State shot a season-best 50.0 percent (11-for-22) from 3-point range to provide timely offense. Senior Myles Dread led Penn State's barrage from downtown, finishing 4-for-5 from deep.

NITTANY LION LEGEND ON OPPOSITE SIDELINE

Penn State squares off against a familiar face Wednesday night -- Nittany Lion all-time leading scorer Talor Battle, who is an assistant coach on Chris Collins' Northwestern staff

Battle, a 2011 Associated Press honorablemention All-American, is Penn State's alltime leading scorer with 2,213 career points during his four-year career. He helped lead the Nittany Lions to the 2009 National Invitation Tournament championship and the 2011 NCAA Tournament. He led the Nittany Lions in scoring in four-straight seasons and was a two-time All-Big Ten selection. Battle finished his career having set the school record for career starts (131) and the Big Ten record for minutes played (4,799).

Battle spent the 2020-21 season as an assistant coach at Penn State where he began his career in the coaching ranks after spending seven years playing professionally overseas. He spent a month on Micah Shrewsberry's staff as Assistant to the Head Coach, before joining the Northwestern staff where his half-brother Boo Buie is a member of the Wildcats.

DE-FENSE!

Penn State's defense has held six of its last eight opponents at least 10 points under their season scoring averages.

Over the last eight games, Penn State has limited its opponents to a 41.5 percent (195-470) clip from the field and 29.9 percent (53-177) mark from 3-point range.

UNDER 60

Penn State has held five of its first 11 opponents under 60 points, and six of its first 11 foes under 60 points in regulation -- LSU scored 58 in regulation and finished with 68 including overtime.

The last time the Nittany Lions held five of their first 11 foes under 60 points was the 2017-18 season (Fairleigh Dickinson 57, Montana 57, Pittsburgh 54, Oral Roberts 48, George Washington 54). Penn State won an NIT Championship at the conclusion of the 2017-18 season.

You'd have to go back to the 2008-09 season to find the last time Penn State kept six of its first 11 opponents under 60 in regulation, when the Nittany Lions limited William & Mary (51), NJIT (47), New Hampshire (50), Towson (54), Army (45) and Mount St. Mary's (56) to under 60 in 40 minutes of play. Penn State also won an NIT Championship during that 08-09 season.

THREE CAN BE A KEY

Penn State's performance from three-point range has proven to be a key to success through the first 11 games of the season.

The Nittany Lions are shooting 39.6 percent (59-149) from deep with an average of 9.8 made threes per game in Penn State's six

Penn State is shooting 28.1 percent (32-114) from downtown with an average of 6.4 treys per game in the Nittany Lions' five losses.

The Nittany Lions shot a season-best 50 percent (11-22) from deep in Penn State's win over Indiana on Jan. 2.

Penn State made a program-record tying 15 3-pointers in its win over Cornell on Nov. 22. It has happened twice before, against Purdue in 2001 (2/7/01) and again against Hartford in 2008 (11/20/08).

NON-CON AT A GLANCE

Penn State wrapped up non-conference play with a 5-3 record.

All five of Penn State's non-conference victories came by double digits - Youngstown St. (75-59), St. Francis Brooklyn (74-59), Cornell (85-74), Oregon State (60-45) and Wagner (74-54).

Penn State fell on the road to UMass (56-81) in the second game of the season, but the NIttany Lions' other two non-conference losses were close five-point games. Penn State took LSU, a team currently ranked #21 in the AP Poll, to overtime before falling 63-68. The Nittany Lions fell to Miami in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge 58-63.

Seth Lundy and Sam Sessoms both contributed a team-best 14.5 points per game through Penn State's eight nonconference contests.

AGE & EXPERIENCE

The average age of Penn State's 15-man roster on the offical Nov. 9 start date of the 2021-22 college basketball season (Penn State opened on Nov. 10) was 21.61 years old. Penn State is believed to be the sixth-oldest Division I team in the country this season, oldest Power 5 team, and oldest team in the Big Ten.

4,332 TRANSFER POINTS

Penn State's eight newcomers, seven of whom have played college basketball at their previous schools, combine to bring 4,332 career points to Happy Valley, which is believed to rank fourth in the nation in 2021-22 incoming transfer class scoring.

KEEP IT CLASSY

John Harrar was named a top 30 candidate for the Senior CLASS Award, which celebrates notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.

Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry had this to say about Harrar in the post-game press conference after Sunday's Ohio State game: "What that kid does every day - in practice, in the film room, in the locker room, on the court - that's Penn State. When I got here and people started telling me about it - I've got people on my staff from Penn State, and people in the community tell me about Penn State - what I hear that Penn State is, I see it every day and I see it in John and what he does and who he is.'

Harrar elected to return to Penn State to utilize his fifth year of eligibility despite a coaching change in March 2021. He is a threetime Academic All-Big Ten selection and two-time winner of the Big Ten Sportsmanship Award.

Harrar has been actively involved in a number of community service initiatives throughout his time in Happy Valley including the State College Area Down Syndrome Society Buddy Walk, Coaches vs. Cancer-Penn State initiatives, and volunteering at the Centre County United Way Day of Caring where he and the Nittany Lions have served breakfasts to the 1,500 volunteers.

THE OPPOSITION

SCOUTING NORTHWESTERN

- Northwestern owns an 8-3 overall record and 1-1 mark in Big Ten play.
- The Wildcats fell in a down-to-the-wire 73-67 battle against #10 Michigan State Sunday afternoon in their most recent matchup. Northwestern earned a 67-61 road win at Maryland in its conference opener on Dec. 5.
- Four Wildcats are averaging double figures, led by Pete Nance and his team-best marks of 16.0 ppg and 7.8 rpg.
- Boo Buie (14.6 ppg), Chase Audige (11.3 ppg) and Ryan Young (10.6 ppg) are also major offensive contributors.
- NU averages 77.9 points per game while outscoring its opponents by an average of 16 points per game.

AGAINST THE WILDCATS

- The Nittany Lions own a 34-20 edge in the all-time series between the two teams and Penn State has won four of the last five meetings.
- The Nittany Lions won last season's lone meeting 81-78 on Jan. 23, 2021 inside the Bryce Jordan Center. Penn State withstood a furious second-half shooting performance from Northwestern. The Wildcats shot 70 percent (14-20) from the field through the first 13:18 of the period, but Penn State's defense anchored down and held the Wildcats to a 1-7 mark in the final 4:02.

B1G JOHN

Penn State graduate student John Harrar and Illinois All-American Kofi Cockburn are the only two Big Ten men's basketball players averaging a double-double thus far into the season.

Harrar owns season-long marks of 10.9 points and 10.7 rebounds per game. His 10.7 rebounds per game ranks seventh nationally. as of Monday, Jan. 3.

The Wallingford, Pa. native has tallied five double-doubles thus far, pulled down double-digit rebounds in eight of 11 contests, and is shooting a blistering 69.6 percent (48-69) from the field. Harrar owns 11 career double-doubles, making him one of just 17 Penn State players all-time to register double-digit double-doubles in their Penn State career.

PICKETT PICKING IT UP

After adjusting in the first three games of the season, senior transfer Jalen Pickett has since picked up his pace. The senior is averaging 14.1 ppg, 5.1 rpg and 4.6 apg over the last seven contests.

Pickett put together his best performance in a Penn State uniform in the Big Ten opener against Ohio State in which he scored a game-high 23 points, 13 of which came in the second half. Pickett added four rebounds and three assists against the Buckeyes.

Pickett owned career averages of 15.0 points, 6.1 assists and 4.9 rebounds per game through three seasons at Siena, where he earned MAAC Player of the Year honors as a sophomore in 2019-20 and MAAC Rookie of the Year honors as a freshman in 2018-19. The Rochester, N.Y. native was a three-time first-team All-MAAC selection with the Saints.

LUNDY'S LEAP

Junior Seth Lundy is the team's leading scorer through the first 11 games of the season, averaging 14.1 points per game in addition to his 6.4 rebounds per contest that ranks second on the squad.

Lundy has scored in double figures in nine of 11 games this season and has led the Nittany Lions in scoring in four games thus far.

He notched his fifth and sixth-career 20-point games in the season opener against Youngstown State and on Nov. 22 against Cornell.

SESSOMS' STEP UP

Senior Sam Sessoms has stepped into a larger role this season and currently ranks second on the team with 13.0 points and 3.3 assists per game.

Sessoms put together his best two games in a Penn State uniform against Cornell on Nov. 22 and St. Francis Brooklyn on Nov. 18 The Philadelphia native drilled six of seven 3-point attempts and finished with 22 points, six rebounds and four assists in Penn State's victory over Cornell. He tallied a gamehigh 26 points on 10-of-13 shooting and a 6-for-7 clip from the charity stripe against St. Francis Brooklyn. The two 20-plus point efforts were the 29th and 30th of his career, but first two in a Penn State uniform.

He registered his first double-double in a Penn State uniform against LSU on Nov. 26 at the Emerald Coast Classic, chipping in 13 points and a team-best 10 rebounds against the Tigers.

DREAD FROM DEEP

Senior Myles Dread's 199 career 3-pointers currently ranks tied for seventh in the Penn State career record books. Dread needs seven treys to match Titus Ivory's sixth-best mark of 206 career 3-pointers.

HIGHEST-RANKED RECRUITING **CLASS IN PROGRAM HISTORY**

It took head coach Micah Shrewsberry and his staff less than eight months to make history in Happy Valley, as the staff recently signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history on Signing Day 2021.

Penn State's five-member class currently ranks 24th in the nation according to 247Sports, 25th according to ESPN, and 29th according to Rivals.

The five-member class is comprised of Jameel Brown (Philadelphia, Pa.), Kanye Clary (Virginia Beach, Va.), Demetrius Lilley (Philadelphia, Pa.), Evan Mahaffey (Cincinnati, Ohio) and Kebba Njie (Centerville, Ohio). The five new Nittany (Cincinnati, Lions, who will join the program as the Class of 2026, will bring accomplished athletic and academic pedigrees to Penn State.

CORE RETURNEES

Penn State returns a number of familiar faces for the 2021-22 season. Graduate student John Harrar returns to utilize the extra year of eligibility granted by the NCAA due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Harrar earned honorable mention All-Big Ten honors last season after leading the Nittany Lions with 8.8 rebounds per game and a 54.9 field goal percentage.

Junior Seth Lundy is the team's returning leading scorer from a season ago. Lundy tallied 10.1 points per game, including two 30-plus point contests in his sophomore campaign.

Seniors Myles Dread and Sam Sessoms will play large roles in the backcourt once again. Dread ranked first or second on the team in three-pointers made in each of his three years as a Nittany Lion. Sessoms is set for his second season at Penn State after playing two years at Binghamton. The Philadelphia native ranked second on the team in steals a season ago and tallied nine double-digit scoring games.

Sophomores Caleb Dorsey, Dallion Johnson and Andy Christos also return looking to make a jump in their second year in Happy

NEW FACES IN NEW PLACES

Eight new faces pair with seven returners to comprise Penn State's 15-man roster.

Five new Nittany Lions joined the team via the transfer portal in Jaheam Cornwall (Gardner-Webb), Greg Lee (Western Michigan), Jalen Pickett (Siena), Jevonnie Scott (South Plains College), and Jalanni White (Canisius). Three others joined as walk-ons, two of whom have played college basketball in previous years, in Dan Conlan (Dickinson), Irekefe Oweh (St. Thomas Aquinas) and Ishaan Jagiasi.

A NEW SHERIFF IN TOWN

Peter and Ann Tombros Endowed Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry was announced as the 14th men's basketball head coach in Penn State history on March 15, 2021. He came to Penn State after two years as the associate head coach at Purdue, his second stint with the Boilermakers, that followed a six-year run as assistant coach with the Boston Celtics under head coach Brad Stevens. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-toback appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018.

Shrewsbery's first stint at Purdue came during the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons, in which he helped the Boilers reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Prior to that, he spent four seasons at Butler under Stevens, helping guide the Bulldogs to three NCAA Tournaments and two Final Four appearances.

Prominent players coached by Shrewsberry include Jaylen Brown (Celtics), Jayson Tatum (Celtics), Isaiah Thomas (Celtics), Al Horford (Celtics), Kyrie Irving (Celtics), Marcus Smart (Celtics), Rajon Rondo (Celtics), Gordon Havward (Butler). Shelvin Mack (Butler). and Robbie Hummel (Purdue).

PALPABLE BUZZ

With fans set to return to the Bryce Jordan Center for the first time since the 2019-20 season, and the excitement surrounding first-year head coach Micah Shrewsberry, the buzz in Happy Valley is palpable.

Penn State sold nearly 2,800 student season tickets, the most ever sold in the history of Penn State Basketball student season ticket sales.

STAFF TIES

Shrewsberry was tasked with assembling his first staff immediately upon arrival in Happy Valley. While this group has never all worked together, there are some key connections to both each other and the University.

Associate Head Coach and Penn State alumnus Adam Fisher '06 returns for his third stint in Happy Valley. He was the Nittany Lions' head student manager from 2003-06 during his undergraduate days. He later returned for the 2011-12 season as video coordinator and 2012-13 season as director of player development. Fisher spent the last eight years with the Miami Hurricanes.

Assistant Coach Aki Collins and Shrewsberry were on the same staff at Marshall from 2003-05, where the two coached current Assistant to the Head Coach Tre Whitted. Shrewsberry also coached current Director of Player Development Mike Green at Butler as Green earned All-America honors under Shrewsberry's tutelage. Shrewsberry worked on the same staff as current Video Coordinator Grady Eifert for each of the last two seasons, as the former Boilermaker standout was serving as a graduate assistant at Purdue

PETER AND ANN TOMBROS ENDOWED HEAD COACH

MICAH SHREWSBERRY

Penn State Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics Sandy Barbour announced the hiring of Purdue Associate Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry as the 14th men's basketball head coach in Penn State history. Shrewsberry comes to Penn State with a wealth of experience as an assistant coach for a pair of nationally ranked programs and in the NBA. He also has two years of head coaching experience.

Shrewsberry spent the last two seasons with Big Ten foe Purdue University as the associate head coach. As the offensive coordinator, Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a fourth-place finish with a 13-6 Big Ten record in 2020-21. Purdue finished with an 18-9 overall mark and earned an NCAA Tournament berth. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivev were All-Freshman Team selections.

Prior to his time at Purdue, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018. Under Shrewsberry, Boston ranked sixth in the NBA in 3-pointers made and seventh in 3-point field goal percentage in the 2018-19 season and was second in 3-point field goal percentage in 2017-18, behind the NBA champion Golden State Warriors.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of Jaylen Brown and Jayson Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors. Shrewsberry was also an assistant coach in the 2017 NBA All-Star Game.

Shrewsberry's first stint as an assistant coach at Purdue spanned the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons where he helped the Boilers reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament. He played an integral role in helping Purdue's offense lead the country in fewest turnovers per game with 8.74 in 2011-12. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the Big Ten in 2011-12, improving his field goal percentage by nearly 13 percent and upping his scoring average by more than five points per game from his freshman to sophomore year.

The Indianapolis native spent four seasons at Butler University under head coach Brad Stevens. He started his time with the Bulldogs as the coordinator of basketball operations before serving as an assistant coach for three seasons. With Shrewsberry on the bench, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles, and made three NCAA Tournament appearances.

During Shrewsberry's time at Butler, the Bulldogs reached the 2010 and 2011 National Championship games. He aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year in 2010 and on the Final Four All-Tournament Team in 2010. Havward was selected as the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz. Shrewsberry was the head coach at Indiana University-South Bend from 2005-07. He served as the Chicagoland Collegiate Athletic Conference (CCAC) Division I Men's Basketball Chair in 2006-07. In his second season at the helm, the Titans showed a nine-game improvement from his inaugural season.

He was also the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At De-Pauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

As player, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain at Hanover College. He led the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference in free throw shooting (.833) and assists (4.4) in 1998-99.

Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree in sports management from Indiana State in 2003. He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.







SHREWSBERRY ERA BEGINS WITH 75-59 WIN OVER YOUNGSTOWN STATE

The Penn State men's basketball team opened its highly-anticipated 2021-22 campaign presented by Highmark Health with a 75-59 win over Youngstown State on Wednesday evening inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

The win marked the first under the leadership of Peter and Ann Tombros Endowed Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry.

Junior Seth Lundy led all players with a game-high 23 points on 9-of-15 shooting and 3-of-5 from beyond the arc. Senior Sam Sessoms added 17 points, with 14 coming in the second half, to go along with five rebounds and a game- and team-best eight assists.

Graduate student John Harrar registered his seventh career double-double with 16 points and a tied career-best 14 rebounds. Harrar was a perfect 7-for-7 from the field, making him the first Nittany Lion to shoot 100% from the field with at least 7 FGA since Mike Watkins was a perfect 8-for-8 at Iowa on March 5, 2017.

After an initial five-point advantage for the Nittany Lions less than two minutes in, the next 10 or so minutes would see a back-andforth contest with seven lead changes. The Nittany Lions broke the trend by going on an 18-5 run in the final 10:57 of the stanza, holding the Penguins to shoot 2-of-14 from the field, to take a 35-26 lead at the break.

Penn State started the second half the way it ended the first, going on a 10-4 run with five points by Jalen Pickett in the first four minutes.

Youngstown State was able to cut the deficit back down to single digits and get within six points with 7:12 remaining before the Nittany Lions went on a 10-0 run in a three-minute span to go back up by 16 and force the Penguins to call a timeout. Down the stretch, the Penn State defense held the visitors to 2-of-12 from the field for an 16-point victory.

PENN STATE FALLS TO HOT-SHOOTING UMASS TEAM ON THE ROAD

The Penn State men's basketball team fell to the UMass Minutemen, 81-56, Monday evening at the Mullins Center in the first road test of the 2021-22 campaign presented by Highmark Health.

Junior Seth Lundy led the team in scoring for the second-straight game, finishing with 14 points. Senior Sam Sessoms added 12 points while graduate student John Harrar recorded a game-high 12 boards.

After an opening 3-pointer by Seth Lundy, Penn State struggled to get shots down through the first nearly five minutes, going 2-of-8 from the field to trail 10-5 at the first media timeout.

The Nittany Lion defense then held the Minutemen to just one field goal in the next three minutes as they would go on a 7-2 run to tie the game at 12-12 at the under-12 timeout.

The final three minutes of the half would finish with an 8-0 run by UMass and then a 5-0 run by Penn State after a 30-second half to get within four, 37-33, at the break. The Nittany Lions scored 11 points from the free throw line and had 12 second-chance points thanks to seven offensive boards in the first 20 minutes.

UMass started the second half on a 20-4 run to take a double-digit lead that would remain for the rest of the game.

Penn State held a 26-14 edge in points in the paint, but the Minutemen were hot from deep, shooting 44.8 percent (13-for-29) from 3-point range and scoring 39 points off the 3-pointer.

Twenty-six points from senior Sam Sessoms and the second double-double of the season from graduate student John Harrar helped lead the Penn State men's basketball team to a 74-59 victory over St. Francis Brookyln Thursday evening inside the Bryce Jordan Cen-

Sessoms led all players with 26 points, a personal best as a Nittany Lion for the second-year transfer. Harrar posted his second double-double of the season and eighth of his career with 14 points on 5-of-6 from the field and a game-high 13 rebounds.

Junior Seth Lundy added 11 points while senior Jalanni White made his first start as a Nittany Lion and recorded eight points off a 4-of-5 from the field with seven rebounds.

After initially trailing 6-2 to start the contest, Penn State went on a 12-5 run through the under-12 media timeout to take a 14-11 lead and never looked back.

The Nittany Lions led by nine, 24-15, midway through the first half thanks to two quick 3-pointers by Lundy prior to the under-8 media timeout.

Sam Sessoms would then score Penn State's final six points of the half, and totaled 14 in the final six minutes, to put the home team ahead by 13 at the break, 40-27.

The second half started with back-and-forth scoring as the Nittany Lions would lead by as much as 16.

Both teams would see periods of scoring droughts through the second half as Penn State outscored Saint Francis Brooklyn, 34-32, in the second stanza to maintain a double-digit lead into victory.

PENN STATE TOPS PREVIOUSLY UNDEFEATED CORNELL, 85-74

Three-point firepower and a 21-7 game-closing run in the final six minutes led the Penn State men's basketball team to a gritty 85-74 come-back victory over previously unbeaten Cornell Monday night inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

Penn State trailed 67-64 with six minutes to play before a trey from senior Jalen Pickett was followed by three more Nittany Lion three-pointers, two from senior Sam Sessoms and one from senior Myles Dread, to comprise a 12-4 streak that turned Penn State's three-point deficit into a five-point lead at the 3:38 mark. The Nittany Lions' free-throw shooting and defense took it from there, as Penn State shot 9-for-10 from the charity stripe in the final three minutes and held the Big Red to a 1-for-8 clip from the field en route to the 85-74 victory.

Sessoms and junior Seth Lundy accounted for 11 of the Nittany Lions' 15 3-pointers, as Sessoms went 6-7 and Lundy went 5-8 from beyond the arc, respectively.

Lundy finished with a game-high 23 points, his second 20-plus point performance of the season and sixth of his career. He added a season-high seven rebounds plus a block and a steal. Sessoms added 22, all from either beyond the arc or the charity stripe, for his second-straight game with at least 20 points, plus six rebounds, four assists and a steal to stuff the stat sheet.

Senior transfer Jalen Pickett was the third Nittany Lion in double digits with a season-high 15 points, plus six assists, four rebounds, a block and a steal.

Graduate student John Harrar had a game-high 12 rebounds to now record double-digit boards in each game this season.

PENN STATE FALLS TO LSU IN OVERTIME THRILLER

The Penn State men's basketball team took the undefeated LSU Tigers to overtime following a last-second game-tying layup by junior Seth Lundy, but the Nittany Lions ultimately fell in extra time, 68-63, in the opening game of the 2021 Emerald Coast Classic.

The back-and-forth defensive battle saw seven lead changes, five ties, and neither team lead by more than five points in regulation.

Senior guard Jalen Pickett led the Nittany Lions in scoring with 14 points, including four 3-pointers, for his second-straight game in double digits. He also added a season-high eight rebounds, three assists, a block and a steal to his stat line.

Senior Sam Sessoms recorded a double-double on 13 points and 10 rebounds, his first double-double as a Nittany Lion and the fourth of his career. All of Sessoms' points came in the second half plus the overtime period. He also added a game-high five assists plus a block. Senior Myles Dread had 11 points of his own with three 3-pointers for a season high.

The Penn State defense held LSU almost 20 points below its seasonscoring average of 85.4 points. The defense also held the Tigers to just a 34.8 percent (24-69) clip from the field and 16.7 percent from beyond the arc (4-24), far below their respective season averages of 50.0 and 38.4.

STRONG DEFENSE LEADS PENN STATE TO 60-45 WIN **OVER OREGON STATE**

The Penn State men's basketball team closed out Thanksgiving week with a strong defensive performance in a 60-45 win over Oregon State in the final game of the 2021 Emerald Coast Classic Saturday afternoon at Raider Arena.

The Penn State defensive effort was impressive as the Nittany Lions held the Beavers to a 31.4 percent (16-51) clip from the field and 23.5 percent (4-17) mark from 3-point range. The Nittany Lions kept Oregon State to 45 points, marking the first time Penn State held an opponent to 45 or less points since Jan. 17, 2018 when Penn State kept Rutgers to 43 points.

Senior guard Jalen Pickett led the Nittany Lions in scoring for the second consecutive game with a game-high 14 points. Pickett also added four rebounds and tied his season best with seven assists.

Junior Seth Lundy and senior Myles Dread also contributed double-digit points with a respective 13 and 12. Dread hit four shots from beyond the arc, a season best, while Lundy pulled down seven boards on the defensive end.

The Penn State defense held Oregon State to just 17 points on 7-28 shooting (25.0 percent) in the first half, the fewest points allowed in a half this season

Penn State allowed Oregon State to score 45 total points, the lowest for an opponent since allowing 43 against Rutgers in the 2017-18 season (1/27/18).

The Nittany Lions turned the ball over just seven times, a season low.

NITTANY LIONS FALL TO MIAMI IN TIGHT BIG TEN/ACC **CHALLENGE MATCHUP**

The Penn State men's basketball team fell to the Miami Hurricanes in a tight 63-58 matchup in the 2021 Big Ten/ACC Challenge Wednesday evening inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

The annual Big Ten/ACC Challenge game saw 11 lead changes and six tie scores, with no lead larger than eight by the Hurricanes. Both teams shot 43 percent from the field after shooting under 39 percent in the first half.

Graduate student John Harrar led all players on the floor with 16 points and 12 rebounds for his third double-double of the season and ninth in his career.

Junior Seth Lundy added 14 points, a season-high eight rebounds and a block, while senior Myles Dread had nine points, all from beyond the arc.

Penn State dominated the glass, outrebounding Miami, 38-27. The Nittany Lions have outrebounded their opponents in five of seven games this season and have grabbed at least 35 rebounds in every game.

The Nittany Lion defense also controlled the paint, keeping the Hurricanes to 20 points in the paint, well under their season average of 32.6. Penn State also held Miami 10 points below its seasonscoring average of 73.3.

Harrar shot a perfect 6-of-6 from the floor to tie his season high of 16 points, previously set in the season opener against Youngstown State (11/10/21).

COMEBACK BID FALLS SHORT AGAINST OHIO STATE

The Penn State men's basketball team trimmed an 18-point secondhalf deficit down to six points in the final minutes, but wasn't able to complete the comeback attempt in a 76-64 loss to RV/RV Ohio State Sunday night in the Big Ten opener at the Bryce Jordan Center.

Senior transfer Jalen Pickett led the Nittany Lions with a season-high 23 points, 13 of which came in the second half. Graduate student John Harrar tallied his fourth double-double of the season with 12 points and 12 rebounds. Ten of Harrar's points and 11 of his rebounds came in the second half. Junior Seth Lundy followed with 13 points, 11 of which came in the first half.

Ohio State scored the game's first five points, but Penn State answered right back with a 12-0 spurt thanks to nine points from Lundy and a Pickett 3-pointer that gave the Nittany Lions an early 12-5 lead less than four minutes into the game.

The Buckeyes got hot from downtown over the next seven minutes, shooting 6-for-9 from deep to pull ahead 27-19 with 9:57 left on the first-half clock. Ohio State didn't make a 3-pointer for the remainder of the opening term, but Penn State wasn't able to find an offensive rhythm as the Buckeyes took a 41-30 lead into halftime.

The Buckeyes spent the first 3:31 of the second half on an 11-4 run to stretch their advantage to 52-34. The Nittany Lions strung together a 9-3 streak starting at the 14:50 mark that pulled Penn State back within 12 at 57-45 with 12:22 to play.

Penn State then used seven points from Pickett and a 5-for-5 effort from the charity stripe to pull all the way back within six at 67-61 with 2:39 to play.

The Buckeyes answered with a three-pointer before an and-one from Pickett put the score at 70-64 with 50 seconds to play, but Ohio State scored the game's final six points to thwart Penn State's comeback bid and walk away with the 76-64 win.

PENN STATE USES SECOND-HALF SURGE TO SOAR PAST SEAHAWKS, 74-54

The Penn State men's basketball team used a 22-4 run over a 6:27 span in the second half to pull away for a dominant 74-54 win over Wagner Wednesday night inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

The Nittany Lion defense shined once again, holding Wagner 15 points under its season scoring average and forcing 15 Seahawk turnovers. The Penn State offense fired on all cylinders in the second half and the Nittany Lions finished the game with a season-high 18 assists. Six Penn State players finished with eight or more points, led by seniors Jalen Pickett and Sam Sessoms with 16 apiece.

A slow offensive start for both sides had the game in an 8-8 tie before Sessoms drilled back-to-back 3-pointers to give the Nittany Lions a 14-8 edge with 11:41 left on the first-half clock. Penn State was ahead 21-14 following a pair of Harrar free throws and a Pickett trey at 7:38, but the Seahawks used a 7-0 run to knot the score at 21-all just over two minutes later. A pair of White free throws broke a 23-23 tie and sparked a 9-4 Penn State run that included a key 3-pointer from Dread as the Nittany Lions took a 32-27 lead into halftime.

Pickett scored six of Penn State's first eight points in the second half as the Nittany Lions worked their lead to 40-33 just over four minutes into the term. After the Seahawks trimmed the lead to five, a Sessoms 3-pointer at the 14:41 mark then sparked the gamechanging 22-4 run. Penn State was 8-for-10 from the field and 4-for-4 from 3-point range during the streak that saw baskets from six different Nittany Lions. The 22-4 run gave Penn State a 62-39 lead with 8:37 left to play and the Seahawks wouldn't get closer than 17 the rest of the way as Penn State picked up the dominant 20-point win.

The Penn State men's basketball team started out strong before it found itself in a hole it could never get out of in a tough 80-64 defeat at #19/20 Michigan State Saturday afternoon.

Junior Seth Lundy scored a game-high 18 points and added seven rebounds to lead four Nittany Lions in double figures. Graduate student John Harrar recorded his fifth double-double of the young season with 16 points and 11 rebounds. Senior Jalen Pickett added 13 points and five assists, while senior Sam Sessoms chipped in 12 points and four rebounds.

A back-and-forth start to the game saw Penn State make 11 of its first 22 shots as eight points from both Pickett and Lundy and seven from Harrar helped make it at two-point game at 27-25 with just over six minutes left in the opening term. NITTANY LIONS WIN 61-58 NAILBITER OVER INDIANA

It came down to the wire, but the Penn State men's basketball team rode a strong defensive effort to a 61-58 win over the Indiana Hoosiers Sunday afternoon inside the Bryce Jordan Center as the Nittany Lions returned from a 22-day layoff to earn their first Big Ten victory of the season.

In a nailbiter that saw eight tie scores and nine lead changes, Penn State led by as much as 10 points midway through the second half before Indiana clawed back to make it a traditional close game between the two teams. The last 11 contents between Penn State and Indiana have been decided by an average of just 4.9 points.

Senior Jalen Pickett led the Nittany Lions with 15 points while classmates Myles Dread and Sam Sessoms also contributed doubledigits off the bench with 12 and 10, respectively. Dread was 4-for-5 from three-point range.

Penn State dominated the glass, out-rebounding Indiana 39-29, led by a game-high 12 rebounds by graduate student and big man John Harrar.

Penn State held Indiana nearly 20 points below its season scoring average of 77.2. The Nittany Lions have held six of their last eight opponents at least 10 points under their season scoring average.

The Nittany Lions controlled a 39-29 rebound advantage. Indiana entered the game averaging 41.6 boards per contest.

Penn State shot a season-best 50.0 percentage (11-for-22) from 3-point range. Dread led the Nittany Lions in that effort, finishing 4-for-5 (80 percent) from deep.
