READY FOR THE CHALLENGE

Penn State has won six of its last eight ACC/ Big Ten Challenge matchups and is set for its first road test of the season as this year's Challenge sends the Nittany Lions south to take on Clemson.

The Nittany Lions are 11-10 all-time in 21 Big Ten/ACC Challenge appearances.

Penn State is 5-5 all-time in Challenge road games, including a 75-55 road win at then 15th-ranked Virginia Tech in 2020, the Nittany Lions' most recent Challenge road

All four of Penn State's previous meetings with Clemson have come in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge, the most recent coming in 2005.

6-1

Penn State is off to its first 6-1 start since the 2019-20 season. Three of the Nittany Lions' six wins have come over teams currently ranked in the top 90 of the KenPom rankings, and Penn State's only loss was a two-point neutral site defeat to RV/RV Virginia Tech.

The Nittany Lions opened the season with a pair of 25-point wins over Winthrop (93-68) and Loyola Maryland (90-65). Penn State earned a pair of closer victories over Butler (68-62) and Furman (73-68) before falling to the Hokies (59-61) in the Nittany Lions' first loss of the season. Penn State bounced back in the Charleston Classic finale to take down Colorado State (68-56) before beating Lafayette (70-57) at home on Black Friday.

Five Nittany Lions are averaging 8.6 or more points to lead the Penn State offense. Preseason All-Big Ten selection Jalen Pickett leads the way with 15.1 points, 7.6 assists and 6.6 rebounds per game. Seth Lundy (12.3 ppg), Andrew Funk (10.6 ppg), Camren Wynter (9.6 ppg) and Myles Dread (8.6 ppg) follow.

MAKE IT RAIN

Penn State ranks third in the nation with 12.3 3-pointers made per game. The Nittany Lions are shooting the long ball at a 42.2 percent (86-204) clip, a mark that ranks ninth in the country.

Penn State (12.3/game, 42.2 3FG%) and Utah State (12.8/game, 47.8 3FG%) are the only two teams in the country that average 12 or more 3-pointers per game while shooting at least 40 percent from beyond

The 3-point line has existed in the college game for 36 years. Heading into this season, Penn State had never made more than 15 3-pointers in a single game, but the Nittany Lions did so twice in the first two games of the season. Penn State drilled a program-record 18 3-pointers in the Nov. 7 season opener against Winthrop, besting the previous school mark of 15 that was reached on three occasions, most recently on Nov. 21, 2021 against Cornell. The Nittany Lions followed that up with 16 trevs on Nov. 10 against Loyola Maryland.

Penn State has made double-digit 3-pointers in six of its seven games this season

THE MAESTRO

Preseason All-Big Ten selection Jalen Pickett has put on a show through the first seven games of the season, leading the Nittany Lions in points (15.1 ppg), rebounds (6.6 rpg), assists (7.6 apg), blocks (4) and steals (10).

Pickett ranks third in the country with 53 assists thus far this season (as of Nov. 26), while his 7.6 assists per game rank fifth and his sparkling 5.3 assist-to-turnover ratio ranks sixth.

Pickett put together the second tripledouble and first points-rebounds-assists triple-double in Penn State history Nov. 14 against Butler with his 15 points, 10 rebounds and 11 assists. Penn State's only other triple-double came in 1998 when alltime great Calvin Booth tallied 19 points, 10 rebounds and 10 blocks against Dayton in an NIT game.

Pickett's triple-double was just the eighth turnover-free triple-double by a collegiate player in the last four seasons. It was the first triple-double by a Big Ten player since the 2020-21 season when Ayo Dosunmu of Illinois reached the milestone on Feb. 22.

The Rochester, N.Y. native followed his triple-double performance with a strong three-game showing at the Charleston Classic to earn All-Tournament team honors. He averaged 15.0 ppg, 7.3 rpg and 6.0 apg in Penn State's three tourney games.

THE OPPOSITION

ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE HISTORY

Penn State has won six of its last eight Big Ten/ACC Challenge games and owns an 11-10 overall record in 21 Challenge appearances.

The Nittany Lions are 5-5 all-time in Challenge road games and 1-3 all-time against Clemson in the Challenge.

The Big Ten has won the last three Challenges, posting an 8-6 record in 2021, 7-5 record in 2020 and an 8-6 record in 2019. The leagues split 7-7 in 2018.

1-2 PERIMETER PUNCH

Penn State guards Myles Dread and Andrew Funk have provided a lethal 1-2 punch on the perimeter as the two Nittany Lions both rank in the top 30 in the nation with 20 made 3-pointers thus far into the season (as of Nov. 27).

Dread is shooting a Big Ten-best 52.6 percent (20-38) from downtown, a mark that ranks 21st amongst Division I players.

Dread returned to Penn State for his fifth season to utilize his extra year of eligibility and already has his name etched in the Penn State record books. Dread has drained 252 career 3-pointers, the fifth-most in Penn State history. Funk, a graduate transfer, came to Penn State after a stellar four-year career at Bucknell. He owns 1,304 career points and 210 career 3-pointers.

1,500/500/500

Jalen Pickett (1,658 points, 552 rebounds, 651 assists) and Camren Wynter (1,724 points, 512 rebounds, 593 assists) are two of just three active Division I players with career marks of 1,500+ points, 500+ rebounds and 500+ assists.

Wyoming's Hunter Maldonado (1,795 points, 696 rebounds, 533 assists) is the only other active DI player to have reached the multifaceted achievement.

BEWARE OF THE BACKCOURT

Penn State boasts a strong and experienced backcourt for the 2022-23 season. The six upperclassmen of Jalen Pickett, Myles Dread, Andrew Funk, Dallion Johnson, Seth Lundy and Camren Wynter have combined for 6,630 career points, 2,187 career rebounds and 1,718 career assists throughout their collegiate careers.

- The Tigers are 5-2 on the season, including a 4-0 mark at
- Clemson is coming off a 1-1 trip to the Emerald Coast Classic over the weekend. The Tigers dropped a tight 71-74 decision to Iowa Friday evening in the tournament opener before bouncing back with a 67-59 win over Cal Saturday.
- Clemson's only other loss of the season came on Nov. 11, a 58-60 setback at South Carolina.
- The Tigers have also defeated The Citadel (80-69), USC Upstate (81-70), Bellarmine (76-66) and Loyola Maryland (72-41).
- Chase Hunter leads the Tigers with 16.6 points per game, 5.3 assists per game and a team-best 18 3-pointers. Hunter Tyson (12.7 ppg) and Brevin Galloway (11.1 ppg) are also averaging double-digit points.

AGAINST THE TIGERS

- Penn State and Clemson are set to meet for the fifth time in program history and first time since 2005.
- All four of the previous meetings between the two teams have come in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge, with the Tigers owning a 3-1 advantage in the all-time series.
- The Nittany Lions won the first-ever meeting on Dec. 1, 1999, but Clemson has won the last three matchups.

THE CAPTAINS

Four Nittany Lions were elected as captains for the 2022-23 season. Jalen Pickett, Seth Lundy, Myles Dread and Andrew Funk will each hold the captain title this season.

Coach Shrewsberry had this to say about his four captains: "Jalen, Seth, Andrew and Myles have each been great leaders for our program throughout the summer and fall. Not only have they served as on-court leaders for their teammates, but each of them has also helped drive and enforce the culture of our program. All four of them play an important role for our team this year and are very deserving of the captain title."

BACK-TO-BACK TOP 30 CLASSES

Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry has signed his second-straight top-30 recruiting class, as three highly-touted signees inked their National Letters of Intent on National Signing Day Nov. 9.

Penn State's three-member class currently ranks 24th in the nation according to 247 sports and 27th according to ESPN. It marks the first time in program history that the Nittany Lions have signed back-to-back top-30 recruiting classes, both of which have come under Shrewsberry.

The three-member class is comprised of Carev Booth (Englewood, Colo.), Logan Imes (Zionsville, Ind.) and Braeden Shrewsberry (State College, Pa.).

Booth is an ESPN Top 100 recruit (No. 75). and ranked as the No. 15 power forward in his class per 247 Sports. He is the secondhighest ranked recruit in program history behind Tony Carr and the highest-ranked recruit of Shrewsberry's tenure. Booth is Shrewsberry's second ESPN Top 100 signee (also Kebba Njie).

Imes is an ESPN four-star prospect who ranks as the No. 24 combo guard in the 2023 class and No. 6 overall player in the state of Indiana per 247 Sports.

Braeden Shrewsberry, Micah's oldest son, is an ESPN four-star prospect and ranked as the No. 33 shooting guard in the 2023 class and No. 4 player in the state of Pennsylvania per 247 Sports.

TWO OF THE TOP SEVEN

Jalen Pickett and Camren Wynter rank No. 2 and No. 7 respectively in career assists amongst active Division I players. Pickett owns 651 assists while Wynter has 593.

YEAR TWO

Penn State enters its second season under head coach Micah Shrewsberry in 2022-23. Shrewsberry came to Penn State with a wealth of experience and success at both the collegiate and NBA levels, having coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs and two NBA Conference Finals.

Shrewsberry immediately put his stamp on the Nittany Lion program during his first season at the helm. He engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense in 2021-22 and guided the Nittany Lions to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in 11 years. The Nittany Lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games. The regular season saw Penn State earn a number of statement wins, including victories over 19th-ranked Michigan State, Big Ten Tournament champion Iowa, and NCAA Tournament participants Indiana and Rutgers.

CORE RETURNEES

An experienced group of returnees headline the 2022-23 roster as Penn State returns four starters and eight letterwinners from the 2021-22 campaign.

The Nittany Lions' 2021-22 leading scorer returns in Jalen Pickett. The guard led Penn State in scoring (13.3 ppg), assists (135), steals (35) and minutes played (37.2 mpg) a season ago. Senior Seth Lundy is coming off a 2021-22 season in which he finished as the team's second-leading scorer (11.9 ppg) and third-leading rebounder (4.9 ppg) while emerging as the team's top defender.

Myles Dread sits in the top five in program history in career 3-pointers made and returns to utilize the extra year of eligibility granted by the NCAA due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Penn State also returns junior Dallion Johnson who broke into the starting lineup for the final 14 games of the 2021-22 season, in addition to classmate Caleb Dorsey.

TRANSFER HAUL

The Nittany Lions added three highlyaccomplished graduate transfers this spring who brought 3,666 career points, 1,236 career rebounds and 901 career assists to Happy Valley.

Guards Andrew Funk (Bucknell) and Camren Wynter (Drexel) each averaged doubledigit points in their final three seasons at their respective previous institutions and are primed to bolster an already strong backcourt. Forward Mikey Henn (Denver) will add experience to an otherwise young frontcourt.

HIGHEST-RANKED **CLASS PROGRAM HISTORY**

Penn State's five-man freshman class, Shrewsberry's first recruiting class, is the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history and ranks as a consensus top-30 class in the nation by all major recruiting services.

The five-man class is comprised of quards Jameel Brown (Philadelphia, Pa.), Kanye Clary (Virginia Beach, Va.), wing Evan Mahaffey (Cincinnati, Ohio), and forwards Demetrius Lilley (Philadelphia, Pa.) and Kebba Njie (Centerville, Ohio).

DE-FENSE!

The Nittany Lions led the Big Ten in scoring defense a season ago, allowing just 65.0 points per game. Penn State's mark of 66.2 points allowed per conference game also led the Big Ten.

Penn State's 65.0 points per game allowed was its best defensive mark since the 2010-11 team surrendered just 62.5 points per contest.

THE 2022-23 SLATE

Penn State hosts 16 home games inside the Bryce Jordan Center to highlight the 2022-23 schedule.

The Nittany Lions played their first three games of the season at home before heading to the Charleston Classic for three tournament contests. Penn State's only true road game of non-conference play comes on Nov. 29 in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge at Clemson.

The Nittany Lions open conference play at home on Dec. 7 when Penn State hosts Michigan State. Five weekend games inside the Bryce Jordan Center highlight the Nittany Lions' home conference slate, while Penn State will also host Purdue in the historic Palestra on Sunday, Jan. 8.

BACK TO PHILLY

Penn State makes its return to the historic Palestra on Sunday, Jan. 8, when the Nittany Lions host Purdue in the City of Brotherly Love. General public tickets for the contest are already sold out.

The Nittany Lions have won both Big Ten games they've previously hosted in the "Cathedral of College Basketball", defeating Michigan State in 2017 and Iowa in 2020. Penn State has played 60 total games in The Palestra dating back to 1927.

The 2022-23 Nittany Lion roster includes several student-athletes with Philadelphiaarea ties including Seth Lundy (Paulsboro, N.J.; Roman Catholic), Jameel Brown (Philadelphia, Pa.; Westtown School), Andrew Funk (Warrington, Pa.; Archbishop Wood), Demetrius Lilley (Philadelphia, Pa.; Lower Merion) and Camren Wynter (transfer from Drexel.)

PETER AND ANN TOMBROS ENDOWED HEAD COACH

MICAH SHREWSBERRY

Micah Shrewsberry was announced as the 14th men's basketball head coach in Penn State history on March 15, 2021, and enters his second season in Happy Valley in 2022-23. Shrewsberry came to Penn State with a wealth of experience and success at both the collegiate and NBA levels, having coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs, and two NBA Conference Finals.

Shrewsberry immediately put his stamp on the Nittany Lion program during his first season at the helm. He engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense in 2021-22 and guided the Nittany Lions to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in 11 years. The Nittany Lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games. The regular season saw Penn State earn a number of statement wins, including victories over 19th-ranked Michigan State, Big Ten Tournament champion lowa, and NCAA Tournament participants Indiana and Rutgers.

Shrewsberry's efforts on the recruiting trail were felt immediately as he and the Penn State staff signed the highest ranked recruiting class in Penn State men's basketball history in November 2021, less than eight months into his tenure in Happy Valley. The 2022 signing class ranks as a consensus top-30 class in the nation by all major recruiting services.

Prior to Penn State, Shrewsberry spent the previous two seasons with Big Ten foe Purdue as the associate head coach. As the offensive coordinator, Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a fourth-place finish with a 13-6 Big Ten record in 2020-21. Purdue finished with an 18-9 overall mark and earned an NCAA Tournament berth in 2021. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections.

Before his time at Purdue, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018. Under Shrewsberry, Boston ranked sixth in the NBA in 3-pointers made and seventh in 3-point field goal percentage in the 2018-19 season and was second in 3-point field goal percentage in 2017-18, behind the NBA champion Golden State Warriors.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of current NBA stars Jaylen Brown and Jayson Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors. Shrewsberry was also an assistant coach in the 2017 NBA All-Star Game.

Shrewsberry's first stint as an assistant coach at Purdue spanned the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons where he helped the Boilers reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament. He played an integral role in helping Purdue's offense lead the country in fewest turnovers per game with 8.74 in 2011-12. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the Big Ten in 2011-12, improving his field goal percentage by nearly 13 percent and upping his scoring average by more than five points per game from his freshman to sophomore year.

The Indianapolis native spent four seasons at Butler University under head coach Brad Stevens. He started his time with the Bulldogs as the coordinator of basketball operations before serving as an assistant coach for three seasons. With Shrewsberry on the bench, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles, and made three NCAA Tournament appearances.

During Shrewsberry's time at Butler, the Bulldogs reached the 2010 and 2011 National Championship games. He aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year in 2010 and on the Final Four All-Tournament Team in 2010. Hayward was selected as the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz.

Shrewsberry was the head coach at Indiana University-South Bend from 2005-07. He served as the Chicagoland Collegiate Athletic Conference (CCAC) Division I Men's Basketball Chair in 2006-07. In his second season at the helm, the Titans showed a nine-game improvement from his inaugural season.

He was also the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

As player, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain at Hanover College. He led the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference in free throw shooting (.833) and assists (4.4) in 1998-99.

Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree in sports management from Indiana State in 2003. He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.

PENN STATE DRILLS PROGRAM-RECORD 18 3-POINTERS IN OPENING NIGHT WIN

Penn State drained a program-record 18 3-pointers en route to a dominant 93-68 victory over Winthrop in the 2022-23 season opener at the Bryce Jordan Center.

Penn State put together a dominant offensive effort to the tune of 93 points, its most in a single game since putting up 95 against Nebraska on Feb. 19, 2019. The Nittany Lions' single-game record 18 3-pointers came on a blistering 47.4 percent (18-38) clip from beyond the arc.

Guard Jalen Pickett led Penn State with 23 points on 9-of-13 shooting, five rebounds and five assists. Guard Andrew Funk drilled six three points and shot 8-for-12 from the field to put up 22 points in his Penn State debut. Myles Dread (12) and Seth Lundy (10) also finished in double figures. A total of 10 Nittany Lions scored in the balanced team effort.

The Nittany Lions had 24 assists on 33 made field goals, their most since recording 24 against Central Connecticut State on Dec. 20, 2019

The Nittany Lions shot 55.0 percent (33-for-60) from the field, their best single-game field goal percentage since shooting 60.0 percent against Bucknell on Nov. 19, 2019.

Penn State scored 28 points off 17 Winthrop turnovers. The Nittany Lion defense collected eight steals and five blocks.

WELL-BALANCED TEAM EFFORT LEADS NITTANY LIONS **TO 90-65 WIN**

Penn State got contributions from up and down the lineup in another highly-efficient offensive performance as the Nittany Lions took down Loyola University Maryland 90-65 inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

Eleven different Nittany Lions scored as Penn State shot a blistering 57.9 percent (33-57) from the field and 53.5 percent (16-30) from 3-point range. The Penn State bench contributed 46 points in the full-team effort.

Camren Wynter led the Nittany Lions with 18 points, while Myles Dread and Kebba Njie each had 12 and Seth Lundy chipped in 10. Jalen Pickett facilitated all night long, dishing 11 of Penn State's 21 assists.

Penn State raced out to an early lead before the Greyhounds pulled within two at 21-19 with 8:49 left in the first-half clock. A trio of Myles Dread 3-pointers helped the Nittany Lions answer with a 14-4 streak over the next 5:39 and Penn State never looked back as it cruised to the 25-point win.

Penn State's 90 points against Loyola Maryland and 93 points in the season opener marks the first time since December 2016 that Penn State has scored 90 points in back-to-back games (92 in win over St. John's on Dec. 18, 2016 and 96 in win over Morgan State on Dec. 21, 2016). Penn State shot 70.4 percent (19-27) from the field in the second half. It marks the first time that the Nittany Lions have shot over 70 percent in a half since Jan. 15, 2018 against Northwestern (70.8%).

PENN STATE TAKES DOWN BUTLER 68-62 IN GAVITT **TIPOFF GAMES**

Penn State earned a hard-fought 68-62 win over Butler in the Gavitt Tipoff Games to move to 3-0 on the season inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

Senior+ guard Jalen Pickett recorded just the second triple-double in Penn State history, finishing with 15 points, 10 rebounds and 11 assists. It marks the first triple-double for a Nittany Lion since all-time great Calvin Booth had 19 points, 10 rebounds and 10 blocks in the NIT at Dayton on March 16, 1998.

Penn State's defense set the tone for the victory as the Nittany Lions held Butler to a 34.3 percent (23-for-67) mark from the field and 21.7 percent (5-for-23) clip from 3-point range. The Nittany Lions out-rebounded the Bulldogs 40-36 and held a 30-24 edge in points in the paint.

Pickett led the Nittany Lions offensively, while senior guards Andrew Funk and Camren Wynter added 11 points apiece and Seth Lundy chipped in 10.

The Nittany Lions have now shot 44-for-92 (47.8%) from 3-point range through the first three games.

Penn State moves to 3-0 for the first time since the 2019-20 season. The Nittany Lions are now 3-1 all-time in Gavitt Tipoff Games matchups. The Nittany Lions evened the all-time series with Butler at 2-2.

PENN STATE HOLDS OFF FURMAN FOR 73-68 WIN IN **CHARLESTON CLASSIC OPENER**

Penn State men's fended off a furious Furman comeback attempt as the Nittany Lions earned a 73-68 win over the Paladins in the opening game of the Charleston Classic at TD Arena.

The Nittany Lions got off to a hot start and led by as much as 21 in the first half. Furman heated up in the second half, slowly chipping away at the Penn State lead until it was a one-point game in the final two minutes. The Penn State defense held on, however, and added four clutch points from Seth Lundy in the final 1:22 to close out the 73-68 victory.

Lundy finished with 20 points and a team-best seven rebounds, while senior+ guard Jalen Pickett finished with 20 points and teambest seven assists. Myles Dread knocked down three triples for nine points.

Penn State moved to 4-0 to start the season 4-0 for the first time since the 2019-20 season.

PENN STATE TAKES DOWN LAFAYETTE, 70-57

Penn State improved to 6-1 on the season with a 70-57 win over Lafayette on Black Friday inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

The Nittany Lions used a 38-12 run from the 5:18 mark of the first half to the 7:34 mark of the second half to find the separation they would need to pull away from the Leopards. Penn State was stellar defensively after finding its footing in the early going as Lafayette shot just 22.2 percent (8-36) from the field in the game's final 26 minutes.

Jalen Pickett led Penn State with 18 points to go along with eight assists and six rebounds. Seth Lundy tallied 15 points and seven rebounds. Camren Wynter chipped in 11 points to round out the double-digit scorers.

Penn State got off to a slow start, finding itself down 19-12 just under eight minutes into the game before a Dallion Johnson 3-pointer at the 12:35 mark sparked a 33-16 Nittany Lion run to close the first half. The Nittany Lions shot 61.9 percent (13-21) from the field and 50 percent (5-10) from downtown in the final 12:35 of the half, while the Penn State defense thwarted Lafayette's hot start to limit the Leopards to just 16 points in the final 12-plus minutes as Penn State controlled a 42-32 lead heading into the locker room.

Penn State was red hot to open the second half as the Nittany Lions spent the first 5:16 of the term on a 15-2 run to stretch their lead to 57-34. The PSU defense kept the Leopards scoreless for a 6-minute stretch during the streak, while five different Nittany Lions scored to put the game out of reach for Lafayette.

The Leopards wouldn't get closer than 17 until there were less than four minutes to play and Lafayette scored the game's final 10 points, but Penn State walked away with the 70-57 win.
