## **OPENING TIPS**

- The Lady Lions head to Indiana for their first Big Ten road game and first away contest since Nov. 29 when Penn State and the Hoosiers square off on New Years Eve.
- The Lady Lions hung right with #4/4 Maryland for three quarters of Friday's conference opener before the Terrapins used a strong fourth quarter to pull away for a 77-61 victory.
- Four Lady Lions are averaging double-digit points, led by Teniya Page's 20.2 ppg.

## IF PENN STATE BEATS INDIANA

- Penn State would earn its second-straight win against the Hoosiers and pick up a victory in Bloomington, Ind. for the first time since Feb. 13, 2014 when the Lady Lions beat Indiana 71-63.
- The Lady Lions would grab their first true road win in Big Ten play since a 69-62 victory at Wisconsin on Jan. 14, 2018.
- Penn State would improve 1-1 in conference action and 8-5 on the season.

## **B1G** Opener

- Penn State led #4/4 Maryland after three quarters of Friday's Big Ten opener, but the
  preseason Big Ten favorite Terrapins outscored the Lady Lions 21-4 in the final frame,
  including an 18-0 run to close the game, to earn the 77-61 road win.
- Senior guard Teniya Page paced the Lady Lions with 24 points on 10-of-16 shooting (62.5 percent), while sophomore Kamaria McDaniel chipped in 16 points and a careerbest eight rebounds.

#### This Is B1G

- Penn State enters its 27th season as a member of the Big Ten Conference and has enjoyed immense success since becoming a member of the storied conference in 1992-93.
- The Lady Lions own a winning record against nine of the 13 other Big Ten programs.
- The Lady Lions own an all-time mark of 268-163 in Big Ten play, with marks of 160-57at home and 108-106 on the road.
- Penn State's eight regular-season championships since 1993-94 are tied for the most won by any Big Ten team during that span. Ohio State has also won eight regularseason titles during that span. The Lady Lions also own a pair of Big Ten Tournament titles, winning in 1995 and 1996.

## **Non-Conference Wrap Up**

- The Lady Lions wrapped up non-conference action with a 7-4 record and won their last two non-conference games of the season.
- Four of those seven wins came in comeback fashion as Penn State erased at least a nine-point deficit to come back and win in its first four victories of the season.
- The most dominant win of the season came when the Lady Lions took down defending Patriot League Champion and 2018 NCAA Tournament competitor American 80-59 on Dec. 16 in the non-conference finale.

## **No Sophomore Slump Here**

- The sophomore duo of Alisia Smith and Kamaria McDaniel has made a major impact this season as the two have combined for 29.8 percent (252-of-845) of Penn State's points.
- McDaniel is currently the team's second-leading scorer with 11.8 points per game. The Inkster, Mich. native has scored in double figures in six of the last seven games.
- Smith is averaging 10.1 points per game and a team-best 7.4 rebounds per contest. She's shooting a team-best 47.6 percent (39-for-82) from the field.
- Smith has notched three double-doubles and scored in double figures in seven of her 11 appearances.
- Both have made major jumps from last season. McDaniel finished her freshman season averaging 5.0 points per game, while Smith chipped in 5.2 points per contest in her rookie season.

## 70-Point Plateau

- The Lady Lions are 7-1 when scoring 70 or more points this season, while PSU is 0-4 when being held to 69 points or less.
- Penn State's lone loss when scoring 70 or more points was an 81-70 decision to Stony Brook on Nov. 25.

## **Focus On The Free Throw Line**

- Free throw shooting has proven to be crucial for Penn State this season.
- The Lady Lions are 5-1 in games that they've made 15 or more free throws in this season. Penn State is 2-4 when making 14 or less free throws.
- The Lady Lions had their worst showing from the charity stripe Friday against Maryland.
   Penn State shot just 52.6 percent (10-for-19) from the free throw line.

## **Among The NCAA's Elite**

• The Lady Lions have collected 943 wins since the program's inception in 1965, an all-time win mark that ranks as the 18th-most in NCAA history. Penn State is one of only 16 schools with at least 25 NCAA Tournament appearances, joining Connecticut, Georgia, Iowa, Louisiana Tech, LSU, Maryland, North Carolina, Notre Dame, Ohio State, Old Dominion, Purdue, Stanford, Tennessee, Texas and Vanderbilt.

## **Tracking Teniya**

- Teniya Page, a 2018 Consensus Preseason All-Big Ten Selection, has proven to be one of the strongest guards in the Big Ten from the
  day she stepped on campus. The guard has collected All-Big Ten accolades in each of her first three years, earning first team honors
  as both a sophomore and junior. Page was named a WBCA All-America honorable mention selection in 2016-17 following her standout
  sophomore campaign.
- Page has totaled 1,831 career points, putting her just 169 points away from hitting the 2,000-point mark. She would become the sixth Lady Lion to reach the milestone if she hits the 2,000-point mark. With 17 regular-season games left and at least one postseason contest guaranteed (Big Ten Tournament), Page will need to average 9.4 points per game for the rest of the season to reach the milestone. She averaged 15.3 points per game as a freshman, 19.9 as a sophomore and 18.4 as a junior.
- Her 1,831 career points rank eighth all-time on the Penn State career scoring charts and is 16th amongst all active Division I players.
- With 34 points against Stony Brook on Nov. 25, Page now stands alone in second place for the most career 30-plus point games (8) in Lady Lion history. She was previously tied with Maggie Lucas (2011-14) at 7.
- The standout has already etched her names into several of Penn State's record books. Her 18.1 points per game career scoring average ranks No. 4 all-time. She is one of five Penn Staters with 1,500 career points and 300 career assists. She's averaged 35.5 minutes per game throughout her career, a mark that ranks second in the Lady Lion history books.

## **SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION**

### **2018-19 INDIANA HOOSIERS**

- The Hoosiers are 12-1 on the season and 1-0 in Big Ten play and enter Monday night's game receiving votes in both major national polls.
- Indiana took down Illinois 85-83 in an overtime thriller Friday night in the Hoosiers' conference opener. All Patberg led the team with 20 points, seven rebounds and six assists.
- The Hoosiers' lone loss this season came against Grambling State (65-62) on Dec. 20 in the second of three games at the Puerto Rico Classic.
- Patherg leads Indiana for the season with 17.8 points per game and 65 assists. Brenna Wise (13.6 ppg), Jaelynn Penn (11.8 ppg) and Bendu Yeaney (10.8) are also averaging double-digit points.

## **AGAINST THE HOOSIERS**

- · Penn State leads the all-time series against Indiana 33-13, including an 11-8 edge in games played in Bloomington, Ind.
- The Lady Lions won last year's meeting, 77-74, on Jan. 3, 2018 in Happy Valley to snap a four-game skid to the Hoosiers.
- With the game on the line, tied at 74-74, Siyeh Frazier laid in a shot under the basket with 15 seconds left to give Penn State the lead and eventually a 77-74 victory over Indiana in last season's meeting.
- Five Lady Lions finished in double-figures, led by Amari Carter's 26 points and six assists. Jaida Travascio-Green followed with 11 points, while Frazier, Teniya Page and Alisia Smith chipped in 10 apiece.

## **Cardiac Kids**

- Penn State has rallied from nine-plus point deficits in four of its seven wins this season.
- Penn State erased a 14-point fourth quarter deficit by outscoring Providence 23-9 in the final 10 minutes to claim a thrilling 76-74 victory in the season opener on Nov. 8.
- It marked the first time that Penn State rallied from a 15-point deficit to win in six years. The
  last time the Lady Lions erased a 15-point deficit was on Nov. 24, 2012 in an 85-73 win at
  Cal State Northridge. Penn State trailed by 17 with 5:52 left in the first half in that game.
- Penn State put together another gutsy comeback performance at Fordham on Nov. 14. The
  Lady Lions trailed by 12 with 8:19 to play in the second quarter, but outscored the Rams
  34-11 in the second half en route to a 72-55 victory.
- PSU trailed Princeton 48-39 with 8:28 to play in regulation on Nov. 18. Penn State used a 24-15 run to force overtime before outscoring the Tigers 16-8 in the extra frame to earn the 79-71 OT victory.
- The Lady Lions did it once again on Nov. 21 against North Dakota. The Fighting Hawks held a 64-53 lead with 4:49 to play, but Penn State closed the game on a 22-4 run to erase the 11-point deficit and come back for a 75-68 victory.

## The Big 200

- Head Coach Coquese Washington picked up her 200th career win with PSU's 79-71 overtime victory against Princeton on Nov. 18.
- Over her 11-plus seasons on the Penn State sidelines, Washington has enjoyed three Big Ten regular-season championships and seven national postseason appearances, including four NCAA Tournament berths
- Washington became the sixth active Big Ten women's basketball coach to earn 200-plus victories at their current institution. She joined lowa's Lisa Bluder, Maryland's Brenda Frese, Michigan State's Suzy Merchant, Purdue's Sharon Versyp, and Rutgers' C. Vivian Stringer.

## **Block Party**

- Penn State set a program record with its 15 blocks against Jacksonville on Dec. 2.
- The Lady Lions' 15 block shots bested the previous program record of 14. The 14 blocks were recorded three times in school history: vs. Purdue on Jan. 12, 2014, vs. Boston University on Jan. 22, 1982, and vs. Delaware on Feb. 15, 1980.
- Siyeh Frazier led the team with a career-high four blocks on the day.
- The 15 blocked shots were by far the most of any Big Ten team in a single game this season.
- The 15 blocks are the second most by any Division I team so far this season. South Carolina and New Mexico have both recorded 16 blocks in a single game this year.

## **Lady Lions On The Biggest Stage**

- Three former Lady Lions suited up in the 2018 WNBA playoffs as Penn State's power was felt on the sport's biggest stage.
- Alex Bentley ('13) averaged 15.6 points per game in the WNBA Semifinals as her secondseeded Atlanta Dream team dropped a tight 3-2 series to the Washington Mystics.
- WNBA veteran Tanisha Wright ('05) suited up for the Minnesota Lynx in their first-round action at the Los Angeles Sparks. Maggie Lucas ('14) joined the Dallas Wings for the team's first-round playoff game at Phoenix.
- Under head coach Coquese Washington, Penn State has seen four pupils drafted Bentley,
   Tyra Grant, Nikki Greene and Lucas and three more sign free agent contracts Ariel Edwards, Kam Gissendanner and Zhaque Gray.
- Overall, Penn State has seen 15 Lady Lions selected in the WNBA Draft, including seven picked in the first 20 selections of the event.

#### iHola España!

- Penn State enjoyed a once in a lifetime experience this summer when the Lady Lions embarked on a 10-day tour of Spain. It marked the first foreign tour for the Lady Lions since a 2012 trip to Italy and France.
- Penn State spent time in the famous cities of Madrid, Valencia and Barcelona, while also
  playing three exhibition games against foreign competition. The Lady Lions went 2-1 on the
  trip with wins over CD CREF Madrid (108-81) and the Valencia All-Stars (87-80) and a narrow
  76-70 loss to reigning Slovenian/Adriatic League Champion ZKK Cinkarna Celje.

Press credentials can be picked up at Media Will Call, which is located at the Media/Team entrance, on the south side of the Bryce Jordan Center, across from the Penn State Lacrosse Complex.

### **PHOTOGRAPHERS**

A photo pass must be issued to gain access courtside in the Bryce Jordan Center. Please contact Chelsea Vielhauer one week in advance for photo passes. Courtside photographers must follow NCAA guidelines, which prohibit entry to the bench areas and the stands, and must remain seated at all times.

## Head Coach - 12th Season Overall Record: 204-156

## 7 National Postseason Tournament Appearances in 11 Years

Upon arriving on the University Park campus as the fifth head coach in Penn State women's history - and first female African-American head coach in Penn State history - Coquese Washington quickly returned the program to national prominence with her up-tempo, aggressive style of play. Entering her 12th season on the sideline in Happy Valley, her passion for creating a winning culture, predicated on innovative coaching techniques, tireless recruiting, cultivating meaningful relationships with studentathletes and an unmatched enthusiasm for teaching the game she loves, Washington is in the conversation as one of the nation's top head coaches.

Washington has seen success at every level of basketball and in every role she has filled on the sidelines. She became the first player at Flint Central High School to earn a starting position all four seasons and helped her squad to the program's first Saginaw Valley League and district championships, while earning all-state honors on two occasions.

She went on to earn four varsity letters at the University of Notre Dame, leading the team in steals four times and assists on three occasions, before moving on to professional basketball where she was a member of the 2000 WNBA Champion Houston Comets squad.

On the sidelines, she has appeared in the postseason 15 times, with 12 of those being NCAA Tournament appearances. She helped the Lady Lions to four-straight berths in the NCAA Tournament - including a pair of Sweet Sixteen appearances - and was an assistant coach on Notre Dame's 2001 NCAA National Championship team. Her three-straight Big Ten Championships make her one of just four coaches in Big Ten history with three-or-more consecutive Big Ten regular-season championships (Jim Foster, Ohio State; C. Vivian Stringer, Iowa & Tara VanDerveer, Ohio State), taking home outright crowns in 2012 and 2013, while sharing the 2014 title.

## **Growing the Game**

Washington is currently serving on the WBCA Board of Directors and held the role of President from 2015-17 with the organization that is tasked with solving issues, preserving the history and growing the game of women's basketball. She was also the Vice President/ President-Elect from 2013-15.

Her service to the game also includes time with USA Basketball, the Kay Yow Cancer Fund and the NCAA Women's Basketball Issues Committee. She won a gold medal with Team USA in Kazan, Russia at the 2013 World University Games and served on the USA Basketball Women's Junior National Committee from 2009-12. Her work with the Kay Yow Cancer Fund Board of Directors ran from 2012-15 and she served five years on the NCAA Women's Basketball Issues Committee.

Of her many accomplishments, Washington was the founding President of the WNBA Players Association in 1999 and was a primary force in negotiating the association's first two collective bargaining agreements.

### **Dancing Shoes**

In 19 years as a collegiate coach, Washington has laced up her dancing shoes and headed to the postseason on 15 occasions, including 12 trips to the NCAA Tournament. While coaching the Blue and White, Washington has guided the program to four NCAA Tournament berths and three appearances in the WNIT.

From 2011-14, the Lady Lions advanced to the NCAA Tournament each season, reaching at least the second round on all four occasions. The 2012 and 2014 squads moved on to the Sweet Sixteen with a pair of postseason wins, before falling to top-five ranked opponents.

The 2017-18 and 2016-17 squads made a pair of WNIT apperances, with the 16-17 squad advancing to the third round.



#### **Trophies & All-Americans**

Washington's competitive side shines brightest on the biggest stages and that is a trait that her teams have taken on during her tenure on the University Park campus, as well. Washington's teams have advanced out of the first round of the NCAA Tournament in all four trips, while earning berths to the Sweet Sixteen twice.

From 2012-14, the Lady Lions claimed three-straight Big Ten regular-season titles, making them one of just four teams in conference history to win three-or-more regular season crowns in a row. Washington's squads took the title outright in 2012 and 2013, while sharing the crown in 2014.

Washington is a three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year (2012, 2013 & 2014), a two-time WBCA Region Six Coach of the Year (2012 & 2013) and a two-time finalist for WBCA National Coach of the Year (2012 & 2013). She was also selected as the 2011 and 2014 Black Coaches Association (BCA) Female Coach of the Year.

## **BIG Things Happening**

In 11 seasons on the sideline, Washington has seen 17 players earn All-Big Ten laurels on 30 occasions, along with three each earning Big Ten All-Freshman Team and Big Ten All-Defensive Team honors. Among the All-Big Ten honorees, five of Washington's pupils account for 11 first team selections and Penn State has seen multiple players earn all-conference in 10 of her 11 seasons on the sideline.

#### **Play to Your Strengths**

Washington's style of play lends itself to being up-tempo and high scoring, which has enabled the program to rise to new heights and return to the national spotlight. As a member of the Big Ten Conference, her teams are playing one of the toughest conference slates in the country, but that doesn't stop Washington from scheduling key non-conference games against the nation's best teams – home and on the road.

In each of Washington's first six years, Penn State improved its Big Ten win total and the Lady Lions posted three consecutive 25-win seasons, joining the 1993-94, 1994-95 and 1995-96 squads as the only teams in program history to accomplish the feat.

During Washington's first 11 seasons, Penn State has toppled ranked opponents in nine of those seasons; winning multiple games against ranked foes during eight of those campaigns.

#### **Double Domer**

Washington was a four-year starting point guard for Notre Dame under Muffet McGraw and was the team captain on Notre Dame's first-ever NCAA Tournament team. She was a two-time All-Midwestern Collegiate Conference (MCC) selection and led the Irish to three MCC Tournament titles. Washington led the team in steals in each of her four seasons and was top on the squad in assists three times.

Washington is first on UND's all-time steals per game list (2.7), third in career steals (307) and sixth in assists (554).

The epitome of a student-athlete, Washington graduated from Notre Dame in 1992, a full year ahead of schedule, with a bachelor's degree in history. She went on to attain "Double Domer" status in 1997 after earning her Juris Doctorate from the Notre Dame Law School.

#### **The Consummate Professional**

Washington juggled finishing her law degree with the start of her professional basketball career, returning to the hardwood as a professional in 1997-98 with the ABL's Portland Power before spending a two-year stint with the WNBA's New York Liberty (1998-99) and playing in the WNBA Finals in 1999.

Moving to Houston in 2000, Washington played an instrumental role in leading the Comets to the WNBA title. Her solid season in 2001 with the Comets for Hall of Fame coach Van Chancellor, saw her finish ninth in the WNBA in assists and fourth in steals as Houston earned its fifth consecutive playoff berth. Washington started the 2002 campaign in Houston before being traded to the Indiana Fever at the midway point of the season. Washington guided the Fever to their first-ever playoff berth, helping her become the first player in WNBA history to lead three different teams to the postseason. She retired from the WNBA in 2003 as a member of the Fever.

Utilizing her law degree, Washington was a central figure in helping create the WNBA Players Association (WNBPA), serving as the founding president of the WNBPA from 1999 until 2001. She also served as the Executive Vice President of the WNBPA from 2001 until her retirement in 2003.

#### **Serving the Community**

Be it on the hardwood, on the golf course, or out on a speaking engagement, Washington is among the most active Penn State coaches in the community. Her annual efforts include Coquese's Drive for the Centre County Women's Resource Center, championing the fight against breast cancer for the Penn State Play4Kay game and supporting her team during their many hours of giving back to the Centre region.

#### The Personal Side

Washington and her husband, Raynell Brown, have a son, Quenton (13), and a daughter, Rhaiyna (9). Raynell is an Adjunct Professor of Law at Penn State Law School and is a former partner at Hicks & Brown Sports Agency, where he represented athletes in the NFL, FIBA, NBA and WNBA. They reside in Port Matilda.
