#### PENN STATE TRAVELS TO NORTHWESTERN ON SUNDAY

The Penn State men's soccer team, under fifth-year head coach Jeff Cook, travel to Evanston, III. for its third conference match of the year.

Penn State is ranked 20th this week in the United Soccer Coaches Poll and 13th in Top Drawer Soccer Poll.

Junior midfielder Tyger Evans was selected as the Big Ten Offensive Player of the Week with one goal and two assists against two ranked opponents last week.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- Penn State lost its most recent game 1-0 to Villanova on the road on Wednesday.
- Liam Butts had four of the team's seven shots.
- On Sunday (Sept. 25), the Nittany Lions defeated #15 Akron, 1-0 on Senior Night.
- Senior forward Liam Butts was responsible for the only goal and eventual game-winning goal of the game in the 44th minute. Tyger Evans carried the ball down the field and sent it in the air to the box. Butts headed it past the Akron goalie to take the lead for the Nittany Lions.
- There was a 90-minute lightning delay before the game was resumed with 35 minutes left to play in the second half.
- This was Butts' third goal of the season and eighth of his
- Kris Shakes made four crucial saves in goal to record a clean sheet and his 14th career shutout.
- The Nittany Lions outshot the Zips 11-7.

#### **2022 ACCOLADES**

- Penn State is ranked 20th in the United Soccer Coaches Poll and 13th in the Top Drawer Soccer Weekly Poll.
- Evans was tabbed as the Big Ten Offensive Player of the Week (Sept. 27) after one goal and two assists against two ranked opponents that week.
- Penn State was ranked first in the Big Ten in the preseason
- United Soccer Coaches ranked the Nittany Lions 21st in the country in their Preseason Poll.
- Mangione was selected as a United Soccer Coaches Forward to Watch.
- Mangione, Kuhn and Femi Awodesu were named Big Ten Players to Watch.
- Mangione was named to the Hermann Award Trophy List.

#### **2021 IN REVIEW**

- The Nittany Lions finished the 2021 season 13-7-1 overall, 6-2 conference.
- They were Big Ten regular season and tournament Champions for the first time in program history.
- Penn State made its 35th NCAA Tournament appearance when they hosted Hofstra in the second round of the tournament after earning the automatic bid from the

- conference championship.
- Andrew Privett led the Nittany Lion offense last season scoring nine goals with four assists and 22 points.
- Junior Peter Mangione was not far behind Privett with seven goals on the season, with four eventual game-winners.
- Mangione was named the 2021 Big Ten Offensive Player of the Year, the second Big Ten Player of the Year award under head coach Jeff Cook.
- Cook was named 2021 Big Ten Coach of the Year in a unanimous vote.
- Cook and his coaching staff were selected as the North Region Staff of the Year
- Six Nittany Lions were honored in Big Ten season awards along with Cook and Mangione. Brandon Hackenberg and Mangione were named to All-Big Ten First Team. Andrew Privett, Seth Kuhn and Pierre Reedy were selected to All-Big Ten Second Team and Alex Stevenson was awarded Penn State's Sportsmanship Award.
- Four Nittany Lions landed on the 2021 All-North Region Teams. Pete Mangione made first team, Hackenberg and Kuhn made second and Andrew Privett was selected to third-team.

#### **2022 NEWCOMERS**

Penn State welcomed nine new players to the team this year. The freshmen include goalkeeper Ryan Aiken, defenders Sam Ovesen and Ben Ofori and Kaleb Alva, and midfieders Cohen Weaver, and Sebastian Vainstein. The Nittany Lions secured two transfers; sophomore forward from Portland Atem Kato and fifth year defender from Michigan State Olu Ogunwale.
