

REMINDER Parking Deck Information for Athletic Events at Rec Hall:

For parking at the Nittany Deck, Intercollegiate Athletics, in partnership with Transportation Services, sponsors a period of free parking for Men's and Women's Gymnastics attendees that begins 1.5 hours before the start of each meet and ends approximately 1.5 hours after the meet has ended. For any additional time parked before or after the meet, each attendee will be responsible for the standard \$1 per hour parking fee.*

With upgrades to the equipment installed last year at the Nittany Deck, please note the procedures for visitor parking:

- Take a ticket at the entry lane and park in any non-reserved space (KEEP TICKET WITH YOU!). All lanes are available for entry.
- When ready to exit the deck after the meet, visit one of the pay-on-foot machines on the ground floor of the Parking Deck and submit your entry ticket.
 - If no fee is due, the ticket will be returned to you as validated, and you may then proceed to your vehicle to exit.
 - If a fee is due, you will be prompted to pay by credit card (Visa, MasterCard, Discover) or cash. Once payment has been received, your ticket will be returned to you as paid and you may proceed to your vehicle to exit.
- Submit your paid or validated ticket at the exit lane machine to raise the gate. All lanes are available for exit. **PLEASE NOTE: cash is NOT accepted at the exit gate (pay stations only).**
- If you have a University issued parking permit, simply scan your permit on the way in and then scan your permit on the way out. If you came in before 4:00 p.m. (unless your permit is valid for the Deck for normal business hours) then you will owe \$1 per hour upon exit. **Remember no cash is accepted at the exit gate – credit cards only.**

Other Lots:

Intercollegiate Athletics will continue to provide parking free of charge in parking lot Red-A located at the intersection of White Course Drive and Atherton Street beginning one-hour prior through 2:00 a.m. No special permit is needed. **Media or Event Staff working past the 1.5 hours post-meet should park in Red-A to avoid the parking overage fee at the Nittany Parking Deck. * PLEASE NOTE: if you have any University issued parking permit, you can park in Nittany Parking Deck free of charge after 4:00 p.m. and all day on Saturday and Sunday. If there is Event Parking in place at Red-A, please let the attendant know you are there for Gymnastics.*

Similar/additional information has been/will be distributed for Wrestling and Men's and Women's Volleyball.

For your information:

Intercollegiate Athletics fans who visit campus frequently during evening and weekend hours, a monthly permit providing access to most campus parking areas (including Nittany Deck) on weekdays after 4 p.m. and all day on weekends is available from the Parking Office for just \$6 per month.
