**BIG OPENERS**

Penn State opens Big Ten play at home for just the third time in the last 13 years Sunday when the Nittany Lions host Ohio State at the Bryce Jordan Center.

Penn State is 7-22 all-time in Big Ten Conference openers.

The Big Ten Conference was the first to move to a 20-game league schedule and began the new format for the 2018-19 season. The first year of early December Big Ten Conference games in 2017-18 sent Penn State to Iowa and gave the Nittany Lions their first conference-opening win since 2010.

**BATTLES AGAINST THE BUCKEYES**

Penn State is 4-6 in its last 10 meetings with the Buckeyes.

Of those 10 contests, one was a 32-point loss on the road, but the other nine contests were decided by an average of just six points.

The Nittany Lions' last win over the Buckeyes came on Jan. 18, 2020, a 90-76 win inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

**STIFLING DEFENSE**

Penn State's defense has held each of its last four opponents 10-plus points under their season scoring averages.

**UNDER 60**

Penn State held three of its first six opponents under 60 points, and four of its first six foes under 60 points in regulation -- LSU scored 58 in regulation and finished with 68 including overtime.

The last time the Nittany Lions held three of their first six foes under 60 points was the 2017-18 season (Fairleigh Dickinson 57, Montana 57 and Pittsburgh 54).

You'd have to go back to the 2010-11 season to find the last time Penn State kept four of its first six opponents under 60 in regulation, when the Nittany Lions limited Lehigh (56), Saint Joe's (57), Fairfield (49) and Furman (49) to under 60 in 40 minutes of play. Penn State went on to make an NCAA Tournament appearance that season.

**HOME SWEET HAPPY VALLEY**

The home court advantage has been friendly the the Nittany Lions, as Penn State is 57-26 (.687) when playing inside the Bryce Jordan Center over the last six seasons. The Nittany Lions are 34-50 (.405) when playing away from the friendly confines of the Jordan Center over the last six seasons.

**DEFENSE SETS THE TONE AT THANKSGIVING TOURNEY**

Penn State's identity on the defensive end set the tone on the Nittany Lions' trip to the Emerald Coast Classic over Thanksgiving weekend.

The Nittany Lions first faced an LSU team that came into Friday's game averaging 85.4 points per game. Penn State held the undefeated Tigers to 58 points in regulation, 27.4 points less than its season-long average. The Tigers finished the game with 68 points thanks to the extra five minutes of overtime, but shot just 34.8 percent (24-69) from the field during the entirety of the contest - 15.2 percent less than the 50.0 percent field goal percentage that LSU entered the game with.

The Nittany Lions turned out their best defensive effort of the season in the tournament finale against Oregon State, holding the 2021 Elite Eight team to just 45 points. It marked the first time Penn State held a team to 45 or fewer points since Jan. 17, 2018 when Penn State limited Rutgers to 43 points. The Beavers entered Saturday's game averaging 69.2 points per game, meaning Penn State kept Oregon State 24.2 points below its season average.

**MAKE IT RAIN**

The Nittany Lions made just an average of 5.0 three-pointers per game in their first three games of the season, but have since averaged 11.3 treys per contest over Penn State's last four games.

Penn State made a program-record tying 15 3-pointers in its win over Cornell on Nov. 22. It has happened twice before, against Purdue in 2001 (2/7/01) and again against Hartford in 2008 (11/20/08). The Nittany Lions entered that game not having made more than six three-pointers in a contest this season.

Senior Myles Dread has contributed a team-best 11 three-pointers over the last four games, while senior Jalen Pickett and junior Seth Lundy have each added nine.

**DEFENDING THE ARC**

In addition to Penn State's offensive three-point threat over the last few games, the Nittany Lions have also stepped up on the defensive end of the arc.

The Nittany Lions allowed their opponents to shoot 43.4 percent (23-53) from downtown over the first two games of the season, with an average of 11.5 three-pointers made per game. Since then, Penn State has held its last five opponents to just a 27.5 percent (33-120) clip from deep with an average of 6.6 made treys per contest.

### AGE & EXPERIENCE

The average age of Penn State's 15-man roster on the official Nov. 9 start date of the 2021-22 college basketball season (Penn State opened on Nov. 10) was 21.61 years old. Penn State is believed to be the sixth-oldest Division I team in the country this season, oldest Power 5 team, and oldest team in the Big Ten.

### 4,332 TRANSFER POINTS

Penn State's eight newcomers, seven of whom have played college basketball at their previous schools, combine to bring 4,332 career points to Happy Valley, which is believed to rank fourth in the nation in 2021-22 incoming transfer class scoring.

### GRADUATION SUCCESS RATE ABOVE NATIONAL AVERAGE

Penn State student-athletes continue to register record-breaking graduation rates and perform well above their peers nationwide. The Nittany Lions recorded a fifth consecutive record-tying or record-breaking academic performance with a 92% graduation success rate, according to data reported by the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA).

The NCAA's annual graduation rates report of Division I institutions across the nation revealed Penn State student-athletes at the University Park campus earned a Graduation Success Rate (GSR) of 92% to tie the school's all-time record of 92, which was previously set in the 2020 NCAA report. Nittany Lion students posted a 92% graduation rate compared to the 89% average for all Division I institutions for students entering from 2011-12 through the 2014-15 academic year.

Penn State student-athletes have logged a Graduation Success Rate in the 88-92% range during each of the past 15 NCAA reports, improving from 88% in the 2015 report to a record-breaking 92% report in 2020 and 2021.

Sixteen of the Nittany Lions' 27 teams (men's and women's track and field/cross country teams combined) earned a Graduation Success Rate at or above the Division I national GSR average for their respective sport.

## THE OPPOSITION

### SCOUTING OHIO STATE

- The Buckeyes are ranked as one of the top receiving votes teams in both major polls and come to Happy Valley fresh off a 71-66 upset of No. 1 Duke Tuesday night in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.
- Ohio State used a 14-1 run over the game's final five minutes to knock off the top-ranked Blue Devils in Columbus.
- The Buckeyes are 5-2 overall on the season, with another notable win over Seton Hall (79-76). Ohio State's two losses have come at the hands of Xavier (65-71) and Florida (68-71).
- E.J. Liddell leads the team with 21.3 points and 7.3 rebounds per contest.
- Zed Key is the only other Buckeye averaging double-digit points with 10.9 per game.

### AGAINST THE BUCKEYES

- Ohio State owns a 41-19 lead in the all-time series, but Penn State has fared far better at home, sitting at 10-15 all-time when playing the Buckeyes in Happy Valley.
- OSU has won four of the last five meetings, and six of the last 10.
- The Buckeyes swept last year's regular-season meetings.

**THE BIG THREE**

Penn State's returning veteran trio of John Harrar, Seth Lundy and Sam Sessoms lead the way for the Nittany Lions through the first seven games of the season.

The trio of returning Nittany Lions has combined for 59.4 percent of Penn State's scoring production (280 of 471 points) while shooting a combined 53.5 percent (106-of-198) from the field.

Harrar, Lundy and Sessoms are also contributing 58.7 percent (152 of 260) of Penn State's rebounding.

**BIG JOHN**

Graduate student John Harrar currently leads the Big Ten and ranks 10th in Division I with 10.9 rebounds per game through the first seven contests.

Harrar is averaging a double-double with 10.6 points and 10.9 boards per contest. The Wallingford, Pa. native has tallied three double-doubles thus far, pulled down double-digit rebounds in five of seven contests, and is shooting a blistering 75.0 percent (30-40) from the field.

Harrar is coming off a 2020-21 season that saw him earn All-Big Ten Honorable Mention laurels as he led the team with 8.8 rebounds per game and a 54.9 field goal percentage.

**SESSOMS' STEP UP**

Senior Sam Sessoms has stepped into a larger role this season and currently ranks second on the team with 14.3 points and 3.57 assists per game.

Sessoms put together his best two games in a Penn State uniform against Cornell on Nov. 22 and St. Francis Brooklyn on Nov. 18. The Philadelphia native drilled six of seven 3-point attempts and finished with 22 points, six rebounds and four assists in Penn State's victory over Cornell. He tallied a game-high 26 points on 10-of-13 shooting and a 6-for-7 clip from the charity stripe against St. Francis Brooklyn. The two 20-plus point efforts were the 29th and 30th of his career, but first two in a Penn State uniform.

He registered his first double-double in a Penn State uniform against LSU on Nov. 26 at the Emerald Coast Classic, chipping in 13 points and a team-best 10 rebounds against the Tigers.

**LUNDY'S LEAP**

Junior Seth Lundy leads the team with 15.1 ppg in addition to his 6.0 rpg that ranks second on the squad. Lundy notched his fifth and sixth-career 20-point games in the season opener against Youngstown State and on Nov. 22 against Cornell.

Lundy has scored in double figures in six of seven games this season and has led the Nittany Lions in scoring in three games thus far.

He went off for 30-plus points on two occasions during his sophomore season - 32 vs. VCU on Dec. 2, 2020 and 31 at Maryland on March 7, 2021.

**PICKETT PICKING IT UP**

Jalen Pickett was one of the most highly-touted transfers in the portal, coming in at No. 21 on ESPN's transfer rankings this spring. Shrewsberry secured the big pick up who announced his commitment to Penn State on April 25.

After adjusting in the first three games of the season, Pickett has since picked up his pace. The senior is averaging 11.8 ppg, 6.0 rpg and 5.0 apg over the last four contests.

Pickett owned career averages of 15.0 points, 6.1 assists and 4.9 rebounds per game through three seasons at Siena, where he earned MAAC Player of the Year honors as a sophomore in 2019-20 and MAAC Rookie of the Year honors as a freshman in 2018-19. The Rochester, N.Y. native was a three-time first-team All-MAAC selection with the Saints.

**HIGHEST-RANKED RECRUITING CLASS IN PROGRAM HISTORY**

It took head coach Micah Shrewsberry and his staff less than eight months to make history in Happy Valley, as the staff recently signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history on Signing Day 2021.

Penn State's five-member class currently ranks 24th in the nation according to 247Sports, 25th according to ESPN, and 29th according to Rivals.

The five-member class is comprised of Jameel Brown (Philadelphia, Pa.), Kanye Clary (Virginia Beach, Va.), Demetrius Lilley (Philadelphia, Pa.), Evan Mahaffey (Cincinnati, Ohio) and Kebba Njie (Centerville, Ohio). The five new Nittany Lions, who will join the program as the Class of 2026, will bring accomplished athletic and academic pedigrees to Penn State.

**CORE RETURNEES**

Penn State returns a number of familiar faces for the 2021-22 season. Graduate student John Harrar returns to utilize the extra year of eligibility granted by the NCAA due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Harrar earned honorable mention All-Big Ten honors last season after leading the Nittany Lions with 8.8 rebounds per game and a 54.9 field goal percentage.

Junior Seth Lundy is the team's returning leading scorer from a season ago. Lundy tallied 10.1 points per game, including two 30-plus point contests in his sophomore campaign.

Seniors Myles Dread and Sam Sessoms will play large roles in the backcourt once again. Dread ranked first or second on the team in three-pointers made in each of his three years as a Nittany Lion. Sessoms is set for his second season at Penn State after playing two years at Binghamton. The Philadelphia native ranked second on the team in steals a season ago and tallied nine double-digit scoring games.

Sophomores Caleb Dorsey, Dallion Johnson and Andy Christos also return looking to make a jump in their second year in Happy Valley.

**NEW FACES IN NEW PLACES**

Eight new faces pair with seven returners to comprise Penn State's 15-man roster.

Five new Nittany Lions joined the team via the transfer portal in Jaheam Cornwall (Gardner-Webb), Greg Lee (Western Michigan), Jalen Pickett (Siena), Jevonnie Scott (South Plains College), and Jalanni White (Canisius). Three others joined as walk-ons, two of whom have played college basketball in previous years, in Dan Conlan (Dickinson), Irekefe Oweh (St. Thomas Aquinas) and Ishaan Jagiasi.

**A NEW SHERIFF IN TOWN**

Peter and Ann Tombros Endowed Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry was announced as the 14th men's basketball head coach in Penn State history on March 15, 2021. He came to Penn State after two years as the associate head coach at Purdue, his second stint with the Boilermakers, that followed a six-year run as assistant coach with the Boston Celtics under head coach Brad Stevens. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018.

Shrewsberry's first stint at Purdue came during the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons, in which he helped the Boilers reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Prior to that, he spent four seasons at Butler under Stevens, helping guide the Bulldogs to three NCAA Tournaments and two Final Four appearances.

Prominent players coached by Shrewsberry include Jaylen Brown (Celtics), Jayson Tatum (Celtics), Isaiah Thomas (Celtics), Al Horford (Celtics), Kyrie Irving (Celtics), Marcus Smart (Celtics), Rajon Rondo (Celtics), Gordon Hayward (Butler), Shelvin Mack (Butler), and Robbie Hummel (Purdue).

**PALPABLE BUZZ**

With fans set to return to the Bryce Jordan Center for the first time since the 2019-20 season, and the excitement surrounding first-year head coach Micah Shrewsberry, the buzz in Happy Valley is palpable.

Penn State sold nearly 2,800 student season tickets, the most ever sold in the history of Penn State Basketball student season ticket sales.

**STAFF TIES**

Shrewsberry was tasked with assembling his first staff immediately upon arrival in Happy Valley. While this group has never all worked together, there are some key connections to both each other and the University.

Associate Head Coach and Penn State alumnus Adam Fisher '06 returns for his third stint in Happy Valley. He was the Nittany Lions' head student manager from 2003-06 during his undergraduate days. He later returned for the 2011-12 season as video coordinator and 2012-13 season as director of player development. Fisher spent the last eight years with the Miami Hurricanes.

Assistant Coach Aki Collins and Shrewsberry were on the same staff at Marshall from 2003-05, where the two coached current Assistant to the Head Coach Tre Whitted. Shrewsberry also coached current Director of Player Development Mike Green at Butler as Green earned All-America honors under Shrewsberry's tutelage. Shrewsberry worked on the same staff as current Video Coordinator Grady Eifert for each of the last two seasons, as the former Boilermaker standout was serving as a graduate assistant at Purdue.

# MICAH SHREWSBERRY

Penn State Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics Sandy Barbour announced the hiring of Purdue Associate Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry as the 14th men's basketball head coach in Penn State history. Shrewsberry comes to Penn State with a wealth of experience as an assistant coach for a pair of nationally ranked programs and in the NBA. He also has two years of head coaching experience.

Shrewsberry spent the last two seasons with Big Ten foe Purdue University as the associate head coach. As the offensive coordinator, Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a fourth-place finish with a 13-6 Big Ten record in 2020-21. Purdue finished with an 18-9 overall mark and earned an NCAA Tournament berth. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections.

Prior to his time at Purdue, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018. Under Shrewsberry, Boston ranked sixth in the NBA in 3-pointers made and seventh in 3-point field goal percentage in the 2018-19 season and was second in 3-point field goal percentage in 2017-18, behind the NBA champion Golden State Warriors.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of Jaylen Brown and Jayson Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors. Shrewsberry was also an assistant coach in the 2017 NBA All-Star Game.

Shrewsberry's first stint as an assistant coach at Purdue spanned the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons where he helped the Boilers reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament. He played an integral role in helping Purdue's offense lead the country in fewest turnovers per game with 8.74 in 2011-12. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the Big Ten in 2011-12, improving his field goal percentage by nearly 13 percent and upping his scoring average by more than five points per game from his freshman to sophomore year.

The Indianapolis native spent four seasons at Butler University under head coach Brad Stevens. He started his time with the Bulldogs as the coordinator of basketball operations before serving as an assistant coach for three seasons. With Shrewsberry on the bench, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles, and made three NCAA Tournament appearances.

During Shrewsberry's time at Butler, the Bulldogs reached the 2010 and 2011 National Championship games. He aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year in 2010 and on the Final Four All-Tournament Team in 2010. Hayward was selected as the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz. Shrewsberry was the head coach at Indiana University-South Bend from 2005-07. He served as the Chicagoland Collegiate Athletic Conference (CCAC) Division I Men's Basketball Chair in 2006-07. In his second season at the helm, the Titans showed a nine-game improvement from his inaugural season.

He was also the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

As player, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain at Hanover College. He led the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference in free throw shooting (.833) and assists (4.4) in 1998-99.

Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree in sports management from Indiana State in 2003. He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.

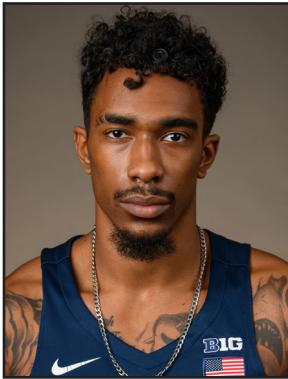

**SHREWSBERRY ERA BEGINS WITH 75-59 WIN OVER YOUNGSTOWN STATE**

The Penn State men's basketball team opened its highly-anticipated 2021-22 campaign presented by Highmark Health with a 75-59 win over Youngstown State on Wednesday evening inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

The win marked the first under the leadership of Peter and Ann Tombros Endowed Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry.

Junior Seth Lundy led all players with a game-high 23 points on 9-of-15 shooting and 3-of-5 from beyond the arc. Senior Sam Sessoms added 17 points, with 14 coming in the second half, to go along with five rebounds and a game- and team-best eight assists.

Graduate student John Harrar registered his seventh career double-double with 16 points and a tied career-best 14 rebounds. Harrar was a perfect 7-for-7 from the field, making him the first Nittany Lion to shoot 100% from the field with at least 7 FGA since Mike Watkins was a perfect 8-for-8 at Iowa on March 5, 2017.

After an initial five-point advantage for the Nittany Lions less than two minutes in, the next 10 or so minutes would see a back-and-forth contest with seven lead changes. The Nittany Lions broke the trend by going on an 18-5 run in the final 10:57 of the stanza, holding the Penguins to shoot 2-of-14 from the field, to take a 35-26 lead at the break.

Penn State started the second half the way it ended the first, going on a 10-4 run with five points by Jalen Pickett in the first four minutes.

Youngstown State was able to cut the deficit back down to single digits and get within six points with 7:12 remaining before the Nittany Lions went on a 10-0 run in a three-minute span to go back up by 16 and force the Penguins to call a timeout. Down the stretch, the Penn State defense held the visitors to 2-of-12 from the field for an 16-point victory.

The Penn State men's basketball team fell to the UMass Minutemen, 81-56, Monday evening at the Mullins Center in the first road test of the 2021-22 campaign presented by Highmark Health.

Junior Seth Lundy led the team in scoring for the second-straight game, finishing with 14 points. Senior Sam Sessoms added 12 points while graduate student John Harrar recorded a game-high 12 boards.

After an opening 3-pointer by Seth Lundy, Penn State struggled to get shots down through the first nearly five minutes, going 2-of-8 from the field to trail 10-5 at the first media timeout.

The Nittany Lion defense then held the Minutemen to just one field goal in the next three minutes as they would go on a 7-2 run to tie the game at 12-12 at the under-12 timeout.

**PENN STATE TOPS PREVIOUSLY UNDEFEATED CORNELL, 85-74**

Three-point firepower and a 21-7 game-closing run in the final six minutes led the Penn State men's basketball team to a gritty 85-74 come-back victory over previously unbeaten Cornell Monday night inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

Penn State trailed 67-64 with six minutes to play before a trey from senior Jalen Pickett was followed by three more Nittany Lion three-pointers, two from senior Sam Sessoms and one from senior Myles Dread, to comprise a 12-4 streak that turned Penn State's three-point deficit into a five-point lead at the 3:38 mark. The Nittany Lions' free-throw shooting and defense took it from there, as Penn State shot 9-for-10 from the charity stripe in the final three minutes and held the Big Red to a 1-for-8 clip from the field en route to the 85-74 victory.

Sessoms and junior Seth Lundy accounted for 11 of the Nittany Lions' 15 3-pointers, as Sessoms went 6-7 and Lundy went 5-8 from beyond the arc, respectively.

Lundy finished with a game-high 23 points, his second 20-plus point performance of the season and sixth of his career. He added a season-high seven rebounds plus a block and a steal. Sessoms added 22, all from either beyond the arc or the charity stripe, for his second-straight game with at least 20 points, plus six rebounds, four assists and a steal to stuff the stat sheet.

Senior transfer Jalen Pickett was the third Nittany Lion in double digits with a season-high 15 points, plus six assists, four rebounds, a block and a steal.

Graduate student John Harrar had a game-high 12 rebounds to now record double-digit boards in each game this season.

**PENN STATE FALLS TO LSU IN OVERTIME THRILLER**

The Penn State men's basketball team took the undefeated LSU Tigers to overtime following a last-second game-tying layup by junior Seth Lundy, but the Nittany Lions ultimately fell in extra time, 68-63, in the opening game of the 2021 Emerald Coast Classic.

The back-and-forth defensive battle saw seven lead changes, five ties, and neither team lead by more than five points in regulation.

Senior guard Jalen Pickett led the Nittany Lions in scoring with 14 points, including four 3-pointers, for his second-straight game in double digits. He also added a season-high eight rebounds, three assists, a block and a steal to his stat line.

Senior Sam Sessoms recorded a double-double on 13 points and 10 rebounds, his first double-double as a Nittany Lion and the fourth of his career. All of Sessoms' points came in the second half plus the overtime period. He also added a game-high five assists plus a block. Senior Myles Dread had 11 points of his own with three 3-pointers for a season high.

The Penn State defense held LSU almost 20 points below its season-scoring average of 85.4 points. The defense also held the Tigers to just a 34.8 percent (24-69) clip from the field and 16.7 percent from beyond the arc (4-24), far below their respective season averages of 50.0 and 38.4.

**STRONG DEFENSE LEADS PENN STATE TO 60-45 WIN OVER OREGON STATE**

The Penn State men's basketball team closed out Thanksgiving week with a strong defensive performance in a 60-45 win over Oregon State in the final game of the 2021 Emerald Coast Classic Saturday afternoon at Raider Arena.

The Penn State defensive effort was impressive as the Nittany Lions held the Beavers to a 31.4 percent (16-51) clip from the field and 23.5 percent (4-17) mark from 3-point range. The Nittany Lions kept Oregon State to 45 points, marking the first time Penn State held an opponent to 45 or less points since Jan. 17, 2018 when Penn State kept Rutgers to 43 points.

Senior guard Jalen Pickett led the Nittany Lions in scoring for the second consecutive game with a game-high 14 points. Pickett also added four rebounds and tied his season best with seven assists.

Junior Seth Lundy and senior Myles Dread also contributed double-digit points with a respective 13 and 12. Dread hit four shots from beyond the arc, a season best, while Lundy pulled down seven boards on the defensive end.

The Penn State defense held Oregon State to just 17 points on 7-28 shooting (25.0 percent) in the first half, the fewest points allowed in a half this season.

Penn State allowed Oregon State to score 45 total points, the lowest for an opponent since allowing 43 against Rutgers in the 2017-18 season (1/27/18).

The Nittany Lions turned the ball over just seven times, a season low.

**NITTANY LIONS FALL TO MIAMI IN TIGHT BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE MATCHUP**

The Penn State men's basketball team fell to the Miami Hurricanes in a tight 63-58 matchup in the 2021 Big Ten/ACC Challenge Wednesday evening inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

The annual Big Ten/ACC Challenge game saw 11 lead changes and six tie scores, with no lead larger than eight by the Hurricanes. Both teams shot 43 percent from the field after shooting under 39 percent in the first half.

Graduate student John Harrar led all players on the floor with 16 points and 12 rebounds for his third double-double of the season and ninth in his career.

Junior Seth Lundy added 14 points, a season-high eight rebounds and a block, while senior Myles Dread had nine points, all from beyond the arc.

Penn State dominated the glass, outrebounding Miami, 38-27. The Nittany Lions have outrebounded their opponents in five of seven games this season and have grabbed at least 35 rebounds in every game.

The Nittany Lion defense also controlled the paint, keeping the Hurricanes to 20 points in the paint, well under their season average of 32.6. Penn State also held Miami 10 points below its season-scoring average of 73.3.

Harrar shot a perfect 6-of-6 from the floor to tie his season high of 16 points, previously set in the season opener against Youngstown State (11/10/21).

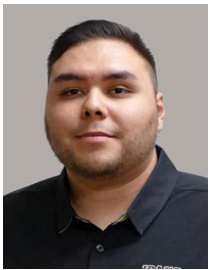
