### OPENING TIPS

- Penn State hosts Butler Monday night in the 2022 Gavitt Tipoff Games to close a three-game, season-opening homestand.
- The potent Penn State offense has scored 90 or more points in both of its games this season while averaging 17.0 made 3-pointers on a 50.0% (34-68) clip from deep.
- Preseason All-Big Ten pick Jalen Pickett is averaging 14.0 points and 8.0 assists per game to lead five Nittany Lions in double figures. Camren Wynter (13.5 ppg), Andrew Funk (12.5 ppg), Myles Dread (12.0 ppg) and Seth Lundy (10.0 ppg) follow.

### IF PENN STATE BEATS BUTLER

- Penn State would improve to 3-0 on the season for the first time since 2019-20.
- The Nittany Lions would improve to 3-1 all-time in Gavitt Tipoff Games matchups.
- Penn State would even the all-time series with Butler at 2-2.

**FROM BULLDOGS TO NITTANY LIONS**

Penn State head coach Micah Shrewsberry spent four seasons on the Butler sideline under head coach Brad Stevens. He started his time with the Bulldogs as the coordinator of basketball operations before serving as an assistant coach for three seasons. With Shrewsberry on the bench, the Bulldogs reached the 2010 and 2011 National Championship games, compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles, and made three NCAA Tournament appearances. He aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year in 2010 and on the Final Four All-Tournament Team in 2010.

Penn State Director of Player Development Mike Green is one of Butler’s all-time great players. Green amassed numerous accolades as two-year starter for Butler, including 2007-08 Horizon League Player of the Year, Most Outstanding Player of the 2008 Horizon League Tournament, 2007-08 Horizon League All-Defensive Team, Associated Press All-America honorable mention, 2007-08 Frances Pomeroy Naismith Award winner, 2007-08 Chip Hilton Award winner and 2006-07 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year.

**GAVITT TIPOFF GAMES**

Penn State is 2-1 all-time in Gavitt Games matchups and makes its return to the event for the first time since 2019 when the Nittany Lions earned a dominant 81-66 win at Georgetown. Penn State’s previous three Gavitt Games contents are below:

The Gavitt Tipoff Games is a unique early-season series played between the Big Ten and the BIG EAST, and named in honor of Hall of Famer Dave Gavitt, founder of the BIG EAST and basketball visionary. The Big Ten has won the series twice, the BIG EAST claimed victory once, and the two conferences tied 4-4 in the event on three occasions.

**PROJECT 44**

Penn State will help raise awareness for Project 44 ahead of and during Monday night’s game. Project 44 is a non-profit organization created in honor of former Butler basketball player Andrew Smith who passed away in 2016 from blood cancer. Andrew was a member of Butler’s NCAA Finals teams in 2010 and 2011 while Penn State head coach Micah Shrewsberry was an assistant coach with the Bulldogs. Project 44’s mission is to save lives by raising awareness and support for bone marrow donation.

**FIRING ON ALL CYLINDERS**

Penn State has scored 90 or more points in both of its games this season as the Nittany Lions are 2-0 on the young season. Penn State has made 34 3-pointers and tallied 45 assists on 66 made baskets between the first two games.

The 2022-23 season is less than a week old, but here’s a look at where Penn State’s offensive marks rank nationally as of Nov. 12:

**MAKE IT RAIN**

The 3-point line has existed in the college game for 36 years. Heading into this season, Penn State had never made more than 15 3-pointers in a single game, but the Nittany Lions have done so twice in the first two games of the season.

Penn State drilled a program-record 18 3-pointers in Monday night’s season opener against Winthrop, besting the previous school mark of 15 that was reached on three occasions, most recently on Nov. 21, 2021 against Cornell. The Nittany Lions followed that up with 16 treys Thursday night against Loyola Maryland.

Penn State is shooting 50.0 percent (34-68) from deep and the Nittany Lions are the only team in the country shooting 50 percent or better with at least 30 3FG makes thus far into the season (as of 11/20).

**90+**

Penn State’s 90 points against Loyola Maryland and 93 points against Winthrop marks the first time since December 2016 that Penn State has scored 90 points in back-to-back games (92 in win over St. John’s on Dec. 18, 2016 and 96 in win over Morgan State on Dec. 21, 2016).

**SHARING THE ROCK**

The Nittany Lions dished 21 assists Thursday against Loyola Maryland after tallying 24 in Monday night’s season opener. It marks the first time Penn State has recorded 20-plus assists in back-to-back games since Jan. 2, 2018 (20 at Maryland) and Dec. 30, 2017 (22 vs. Coppin State).

**NITTANY LION DEPTH**

The Penn State bench has scored 61 points through the first two games.

Seven Nittany Lions are averaging 6.5 or more points per game. All 13 scholarship players have scored so far this season, while 10 different players have made a 3-pointer.

**1,500/500/500**

Jalen Pickett (1,580 points, 514 rebounds, 614 assists) and Camren Wynter (1,684 points, 500 rebounds, 583 assists) are two of just three active Division I players with career marks of 1,500+ points, 500+ rebounds and 500+ assists.

Wyoming's Hunter Maldonado (1,732 points, 676 rebounds, 526 assists) is the only other active DI player to have reached the multi-faceted achievement.

**TWO OF THE TOP SIX**

Jalen Pickett and Camren Wynter rank No. 1 and No. 6 respectively in career assists amongst active Division I players. Pickett owns 614 assists while Wynter has 583.

**BEWARE OF THE BACKCOURT**

Penn State boasts a strong and experienced backcourt for the 2022-23 season. The six upperclassmen of Jalen Pickett, Myles Dread, Andrew Funk, Dallion Johnson, Seth Lundy and Camren Wynter have combined for 6,347 career points, 2,071 career rebounds and 1,650 career assists throughout their collegiate careers.

**PRESEASON NODS FOR PICKETT**

Guard Jalen Pickett was named to the 2022-23 Preseason All-Big Ten Team heading into the 2022-23 season.

Pickett is coming off a 2021-22 season in which he led the Nittany Lions in scoring (13.3 ppg), assists (135) and steals (35). The guard ranked second on the team in blocks (19), third in rebounds (133) and served as one of the Nittany Lions' toughest defenders. He led the Big Ten and ranked 11th in all of Division I with 37.2 minutes per game and ranked second in the conference and 27th in the country with a 2.45 assist-to-turnover ratio.

**LOCKED IN ON LUNDY**

Senior Seth Lundy emerged as one of the Big Ten's best defenders during the 2021-22 season and was consistently tasked with guarding the opposing team's top scoring threat. He finished his junior campaign as the team's second-leading scorer (11.9 ppg) and third-leading rebounder (4.9 ppg), while leading the team in blocks (20) and finishing third in steals (30). Lundy shot a team-best (min. 10 att.) 86.7 percent (52-60) from the free-throw line and drained a team-leading 64 3-pointers.

Lundy is now in his fourth year with the Nittany Lion program, but it's the first time in his collegiate career that he's playing for the same head coach in back-to-back years. Both Lundy and Shrewsberry have noted that Lundy looks and feels much more comfortable this year than he has in the past thanks to the continuity in systems between year one and year two under Shrewsberry.

**DREAD FROM DEEP**

Myles Dread returns to utilize his extra year of eligibility and already has his name etched in the Penn State record books. Dread has drained 240 career 3-pointers, the fifth-most in Penn State history.

The Detroit, Mich. native has proven to have a knack for clutch shots throughout his Nittany Lion career. He hit game-winning 3-pointers in the final minute vs. Yale (11/23/19), Rutgers (2/26/20) and VCU (12/2/20), and the game-tying 3-pointer to send game to double-overtime vs. Iowa (1/31/22).

Dread shot a career-best 40.7 percent (55-135) from 3-point range during the 2021-22 season and ranked second on the team with 55 made 3-pointers despite battling a season-long injury.

**THE OPPOSITION**

**SCOUTING BUTLER**

- The Bulldogs are 1-0 on the young season and haven't played since opening night on Nov. 7.
- Butler took down New Orleans 89-53 at home last Monday night. The Bulldogs shot 56.3 percent (36-64) from the field, but just 16.7 percent (4-24) from 3-point range in the victory.
- Six-foot-eleven center Manny Bates had a 25-point, 11-rebound double-double in the Bulldog victory, while Chuck Harris added 17 points.
- Butler is in its first season under head coach Thad Matta. Matta returned to his alma as head coach for the second time as he also guided the Bulldogs during the 2000-01 season. Matta owns a stellar 440-154 record in his 17-plus years as a head coach, which includes stints at Butler, Ohio State and Xavier.

**AGAINST THE BULLDOGS**

- Penn State and Butler meet for the fourth time in program history and the first time in 30 years.
- The Nittany Lions and Bulldogs last met in a home-and-home series in 1992, which was Penn State's independent year between its time in the Atlantic 10 and Big Ten. The home team won each of the meetings in that home-and-home set.

**THE CAPTAINS**

Four Nittany Lions were elected as captains for the 2022-23 season. Jalen Pickett, Seth Lundy, Myles Dread and Andrew Funk will each hold the captain title this season.

Coach Shrewsberry had this to say about his four captains: "Jalen, Seth, Andrew and Myles have each been great leaders for our program throughout the summer and fall. Not only have they served as on-court leaders for their teammates, but each of them has also helped drive and enforce the culture of our program. All four of them play an important role for our team this year and are very deserving of the captain title."

**BACK-TO-BACK TOP 30 CLASSES**

Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry has signed his second-straight top-30 recruiting class, as three highly-touted signees inked their National Letters of Intent on National Signing Day Wednesday.

Penn State's three-member class currently ranks 24th in the nation according to 247 sports and 27th according to ESPN. It marks the first time in program history that the Nittany Lions have signed back-to-back top-30 recruiting classes, both of which have come under Shrewsberry.

The three-member class is comprised of Carey Booth (Englewood, Colo.), Logan Imes (Zionsville, Ind.) and Braeden Shrewsberry (State College, Pa.).

Booth is an ESPN Top 100 recruit (No. 75), and ranked as the No. 15 power forward in his class per 247 Sports. He is the second-highest ranked recruit in program history behind Tony Carr and the highest-ranked recruit of Shrewsberry's tenure. Booth is Shrewsberry's second ESPN Top 100 signee (also Kebba Njie).

Imes is an ESPN four-star prospect who ranks as the No. 24 combo guard in the 2023 class and No. 6 overall player in the state of Indiana per 247 Sports.

Braeden Shrewsberry, Micah's oldest son, is an ESPN four-star prospect and ranked as the No. 33 shooting guard in the 2023 class and No. 4 player in the state of Pennsylvania per 247 Sports.

**YEAR TWO**

Penn State enters its second season under head coach Micah Shrewsberry in 2022-23. Shrewsberry came to Penn State with a wealth of experience and success at both the collegiate and NBA levels, having coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs and two NBA Conference Finals.

Shrewsberry immediately put his stamp on the Nittany Lion program during his first season at the helm. He engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense in 2021-22 and guided the Nittany Lions to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in 11 years. The Nittany Lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games. The regular season saw Penn State earn a number of statement wins, including victories over 19th-ranked Michigan State, Big Ten Tournament champion Iowa, and NCAA Tournament participants Indiana and Rutgers.

**CORE RETURNEES**

An experienced group of returnees headline the 2022-23 roster as Penn State returns four starters and eight letterwinners from the 2021-22 campaign.

The Nittany Lions' 2021-22 leading scorer returns in Jalen Pickett. The guard led Penn State in scoring (13.3 ppg), assists (135), steals (35) and minutes played (37.2 mpg) a season ago. Senior Seth Lundy is coming off a 2021-22 season in which he finished as the team's second-leading scorer (11.9 ppg) and third-leading rebounder (4.9 ppg) while emerging as the team's top defender.

Myles Dread sits in the top five in program history in career 3-pointers made and returns to utilize the extra year of eligibility granted by the NCAA due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Penn State also returns junior Dallion Johnson who broke into the starting lineup for the final 14 games of the 2021-22 season, in addition to classmate Caleb Dorsey.

**TRANSFER HAUL**

The Nittany Lions added three highly-accomplished graduate transfers this spring who brought 3,666 career points, 1,236 career rebounds and 901 career assists to Happy Valley.

Guards Andrew Funk (Bucknell) and Camren Wynter (Drexel) each averaged double-digit points in their final three seasons at their respective previous institutions and are primed to bolster an already strong backcourt. Forward Mikey Henn (Denver) will add experience to an otherwise young frontcourt.

**HIGHEST-RANKED CLASS IN PROGRAM HISTORY**

Penn State's five-man freshman class, Shrewsberry's first recruiting class, is the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history and ranks as a consensus top-30 class in the nation by all major recruiting services.

The five-man class is comprised of guards Jameel Brown (Philadelphia, Pa.), Kanye Clary (Virginia Beach, Va.), wing Evan Mahaffey (Cincinnati, Ohio), and forwards Demetrius Lilley (Philadelphia, Pa.) and Kebba Njie (Centerville, Ohio).

**DE-FENSE!**

The Nittany Lions led the Big Ten in scoring defense a season ago, allowing just 65.0 points per game. Penn State's mark of 66.2 points allowed per conference game also led the Big Ten.

Penn State's 65.0 points per game allowed was its best defensive mark since the 2010-11 team surrendered just 62.5 points per contest.

**THE 2022-23 SLATE**

Penn State hosts 16 home games inside the Bryce Jordan Center to highlight the 2022-23 schedule.

The Nittany Lions play their first three games of the season at home before heading to the Charleston Classic for three tournament contests. Penn State's only true road game of non-conference play comes on Nov. 29 in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge at Clemson.

The Nittany Lions open conference play at home on Dec. 7 when Penn State hosts Michigan State. Five weekend games inside the Bryce Jordan Center highlight the Nittany Lions' home conference slate, while Penn State will also host Purdue in the historic Palestra on Sunday, Jan. 8.

**BACK TO PHILLY**

Penn State makes its return to the historic Palestra on Sunday, Jan. 8, when the Nittany Lions host Purdue in the City of Brotherly Love. General public tickets for the contest are already sold out.

The Nittany Lions have won both Big Ten games they've previously hosted in the "Cathedral of College Basketball", defeating Michigan State in 2017 and Iowa in 2020. Penn State has played 60 total games in The Palestra dating back to 1927.

The 2022-23 Nittany Lion roster includes several student-athletes with Philadelphia-area ties including Seth Lundy (Paulsboro, N.J.; Roman Catholic), Jameel Brown (Philadelphia, Pa.; Westtown School), Andrew Funk (Warrington, Pa.; Archbishop Wood), Demetrius Lilley (Philadelphia, Pa.; Lower Merion) and Camren Wynter (transfer from Drexel.)

# MICAH SHREWSBERRY

Micah Shrewsberry was announced as the 14th men's basketball head coach in Penn State history on March 15, 2021, and enters his second season on Happy Valley in 2022-23. Shrewsberry came to Penn State with a wealth of experience and success at both the collegiate and NBA levels, having coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs, and two NBA Conference Finals.

Shrewsberry immediately put his stamp on the Nittany Lion program during his first season at the helm. He engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense in 2021-22 and guided the Nittany Lions to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in 11 years. The Nittany Lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games. The regular season saw Penn State earn a number of statement wins, including victories over 19th-ranked Michigan State, Big Ten Tournament champion Iowa, and NCAA Tournament participants Indiana and Rutgers.

Shrewsberry's efforts on the recruiting trail were felt immediately as he and the Penn State staff signed the highest ranked recruiting class in Penn State men's basketball history in November 2021, less than eight months into his tenure in Happy Valley. The 2022 signing class ranks as a consensus top-30 class in the nation by all major recruiting services.

Prior to Penn State, Shrewsberry spent the previous two seasons with Big Ten foe Purdue as the associate head coach. As the offensive coordinator, Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a fourth-place finish with a 13-6 Big Ten record in 2020-21. Purdue finished with an 18-9 overall mark and earned an NCAA Tournament berth in 2021. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections.

Before his time at Purdue, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018. Under Shrewsberry, Boston ranked sixth in the NBA in 3-pointers made and seventh in 3-point field goal percentage in the 2018-19 season and was second in 3-point field goal percentage in 2017-18, behind the NBA champion Golden State Warriors.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of current NBA stars Jaylen Brown and Jayson Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors. Shrewsberry was also an assistant coach in the 2017 NBA All-Star Game.

Shrewsberry's first stint as an assistant coach at Purdue spanned the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons where he helped the Boilers reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament. He played an integral role in helping Purdue's offense lead the country in fewest turnovers per game with 8.74 in 2011-12. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the Big Ten in 2011-12, improving his field goal percentage by nearly 13 percent and upping his scoring average by more than five points per game from his freshman to sophomore year.

The Indianapolis native spent four seasons at Butler University under head coach Brad Stevens. He started his time with the Bulldogs as the coordinator of basketball operations before serving as an assistant coach for three seasons. With Shrewsberry on the bench, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles, and made three NCAA Tournament appearances.

During Shrewsberry's time at Butler, the Bulldogs reached the 2010 and 2011 National Championship games. He aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year in 2010 and on the Final Four All-Tournament Team in 2010. Hayward was selected as the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz.

Shrewsberry was the head coach at Indiana University-South Bend from 2005-07. He served as the Chicagoland Collegiate Athletic Conference (CCAC) Division I Men's Basketball Chair in 2006-07. In his second season at the helm, the Titans showed a nine-game improvement from his inaugural season.

He was also the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

As player, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain at Hanover College. He led the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference in free throw shooting (.833) and assists (4.4) in 1998-99.

Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree in sports management from Indiana State in 2003. He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.

PENN STATE DRILLS PROGRAM-RECORD 18 3-POINTERS IN OPENING NIGHT WIN

Penn State drained a program-record 18 3-pointers en route to a dominant 93-68 victory over Winthrop in the 2022-23 season opener at the Bryce Jordan Center.

Penn State put together a dominant offensive effort to the tune of 93 points, its most in a single game since putting up 95 against Nebraska on Feb. 19, 2019. The Nittany Lions' single-game record 18 3-pointers came on a blistering 47.4 percent (18-38) clip from beyond the arc.

Guard Jalen Pickett led Penn State with 23 points on 9-of-13 shooting, five rebounds and five assists. Guard Andrew Funk drilled six three points and shot 8-for-12 from the field to put up 22 points in his Penn State debut. Myles Dread (12) and Seth Lundy (10) also finished in double figures. A total of 10 Nittany Lions scored in the balanced team effort.

The Nittany Lions had 24 assists on 33 made field goals, their most since recording 24 against Central Connecticut State on Dec. 20, 2019.

The Nittany Lions shot 55.0 percent (33-for-60) from the field, their best single-game field goal percentage since shooting 60.0 percent against Bucknell on Nov. 19, 2019.

Penn State scored 28 points off 17 Winthrop turnovers. The Nittany Lion defense collected eight steals and five blocks.

WELL-BALANCED TEAM EFFORT LEADS NITTANY LIONS TO 90-65 WIN

Penn State got contributions from up and down the lineup in another highly-efficient offensive performance as the Nittany Lions took down Loyola University Maryland 90-65 inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

Eleven different Nittany Lions scored as Penn State shot a blistering 57.9 percent (33-57) from the field and 53.5 percent (16-30) from 3-point range. The Penn State bench contributed 46 points in the full-team effort.

Camren Wynter led the Nittany Lions with 18 points, while Myles Dread and Kebba Njie each had 12 and Seth Lundy chipped in 10. Jalen Pickett facilitated all night long, dishing 11 of Penn State's 21 assists.

Penn State raced out to an early lead before the Greyhounds pulled within two at 21-19 with 8:49 left in the first-half clock. A trio of Myles Dread 3-pointers helped the Nittany Lions answer with a 14-4 streak over the next 5:39 and Penn State never looked back as it cruised to the 25-point win.

Penn State's 90 points against Loyola Maryland and 93 points in the season opener marks the first time since December 2016 that Penn State has scored 90 points in back-to-back games (92 in win over St. John's on Dec. 18, 2016 and 96 in win over Morgan State on Dec. 21, 2016). Penn State shot 70.4 percent (19-27) from the field in the second half. It marks the first time that the Nittany Lions have shot over 70 percent in a half since Jan. 15, 2018 against Northwestern (70.8%).
