TWO EARLY-SEASON WINS

With fans back in the Bryce Jordan Center for the first time in 617 days, Peter and Ann Tombros Endowed Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry earned his first-career Division I head coaching victory when Penn State defeated Youngstown State 75-59 in the season opener on Nov. 10.

After a tough road loss at UMass on Nov. 15, Penn State bounced back with a 74-59 victory over St. Francis Brooklyn Thursday night in an Emerald Coast Classic campus site matchup.

The Nittany Lions have held their opponents to 59 points in both of the wins. It marks the first time since the 2017-18 season that Penn State has held its opponent under 60 points in two of the first three games of the season. The 2017-18 squad limited both Fairleigh Dickinson and Montana to 57 points in a pair of victories within the first three games of that campaign.

A NEW SHERIFF IN TOWN

Shrewsberry was announced as the 14th men's basketball head coach in Penn State history on March 15, 2021. He came to Penn State after two years as the associate head coach at Purdue, his second stint with the Boilermakers, that followed a six-year run as assistant coach with the Boston Celtics under head coach Brad Stevens. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018.

Shrewsberry's first stint at Purdue came during the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons, in which he helped the Boilers reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Prior to that, he spent four seasons at Butler under Stevens, helping guide the Bulldogs to three NCAA Tournaments and two Final Four appearances.

THE BIG THREE

Penn State's returning veteran trio of John Harrar, Seth Lundy and Sam Sessoms lead the way for the Nittany Lions through the first three games of the season.

The trio of returning Nittany Lions has combined for 68.8 percent of Penn State's scoring production (141 of 205 points) while shooting a combined 60.5 percent (52-of-86) from the field.

Harrar, Lundy and Sessoms are also contributing 48.2 percent (55 of 114) of Penn State's rebounding.

HOME SWEET HAPPY VALLEY

The home court advantage has been friendly to the Nittany Lions, as Penn State is 56-25 (.691) when playing inside the Bryce Jordan Center over the last six years. The Nittany Lions are 33-49 (.402) when playing away from the friendly confines of the Jordan Center over the last six seasons.

CORE RETURNEES

Penn State returns a number of familiar faces for the 2021-22 season. Graduate student John Harrar returns to utilize the extra year of eligibility granted by the NCAA due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Harrar earned honorable mention All-Big Ten honors last season after leading the Nittany Lions with 8.8 rebounds per game and a 54.9 field goal percentage.

Junior Seth Lundy is the team's returning leading scorer from a season ago. Lundy tallied 10.1 points per game, including two 30-plus point contests in his sophomore campaign.

Seniors Myles Dread and Sam Sessoms will play large roles in the backcourt once again. Dread ranked first or second on the team in three-pointers made in each of his three years as a Nittany Lion. Sessoms is set for his second season at Penn State after playing two years at Binghamton. The Philadelphia native ranked second on the team in steals a season ago and tallied nine double-digit scoring games.

Sophomores Caleb Dorsey, Dallion Johnson and Andy Christos also return looking to make a jump in their second year in Happy Valley.

NEW FACES IN NEW PLACES

Eight new faces pair with seven returners to comprise Penn State's 15-man roster.

Five new Nittany Lions joined the team via the transfer portal in Jaheam Cornwall (Gardner-Webb), Greg Lee (Western Michigan), Jalen Pickett (Siena), Jevonnie Scott (South Plains College), and Jalanni White (Canisius). Three others joined as walk-ons, two of whom have played college basketball in previous years, in Dan Conlan (Dickinson), Irekefe Oweh (St. Thomas Aquinas) and Ishaan Jagiasi.

AGE & EXPERIENCE

The average age of Penn State's 15-man roster on the official Nov. 9 start date of the 2021-22 college basketball season (Penn State opened on Nov. 10) was 21.61 years old. Penn State is believed to be the sixth-oldest Division I team in the country this season, oldest Power 5 team, and oldest team in the Big Ten.

The Nittany Lions have no freshmen on their roster and are bolstered by seven players who have played three or more years of college basketball.

BIG JOHN

Graduate student John Harrar currently leads the Big Ten and ranks sixth in Division I with 13.0 rebounds per game through the first three contests.

Harrar is averaging a double-double through the first three games of the season with 12.7 points and 13.0 boards per contest. He leads the team with a 71.4 (15-21) FG% that is tied for second-best in the Big Ten and 21st in the nation. The Wallingford, Pa. native has tallied two double-doubles thus far and has pulled down double-digit rebounds in all three contests.

Harrar is coming off a 2020-21 season that saw him earn All-Big Ten Honorable Mention laurels as he led the team with 8.8 rebounds per game and a 54.9 field goal percentage.

SESSOMS' STEP UP

Senior Sam Sessoms has stepped into a larger role this season, currently leading the team with 18.3 points per game in addition to 3.0 assists per game, which ranks second on the squad.

Sessoms is coming off his best game in a Penn State uniform Thursday as the senior went off for a game-high 26 points on 10-of-13 shooting and a 6-for-7 clip from the charity stripe. It was his 29th-career 20-point game, but first in a Penn State uniform.

Sessoms played in a key sixth-man role for the Nittany Lions last year after transferring in from an exceptional two-year career at Binghamton.

LUNDY'S LEAP

Junior Seth Lundy ranks second on the team in scoring with 16.0 ppg in addition to his 5.3 rpg. Lundy notched his fifth-career 20-point game in the season opener against Youngstown State with a team-best 23 points on 9-of-15 (60%) shooting.

Lundy is shooting 53.6 percent (15-28) from the field, 53.8 percent (7-13) from deep, and 91.7 percent (11-12) from the charity stripe through the first three games.

He went off for 30-plus points on two occasions during his sophomore season - 32 vs. VCU on Dec. 2, 2020 and 31 at Maryland on March 7, 2021.

4,332 TRANSFER POINTS

Penn State's eight newcomers, seven of whom have played college basketball at their previous schools, combine to bring 4,332 career points to Happy Valley, which is believed to rank fourth in the nation in 2021-22 incoming transfer class scoring.

THE OPPOSITION

SCOUTING CORNELL

- The Big Red comes to town at a perfect 4-0 after earning wins over Binghamton (76-69), Lafayette (90-85), Colgate (78-68) and Division III Wells College (107-48).
- Cornell's 4-0 start is its first since 1961.
- Cornell is averaging 87.8 points per game through its first four games and owns a balanced offensive attack as seven Big Red players average seven or more points per game.
- Jordan Jones leads the team with 16.0 points per game, while Chris Manon follows with 13.0 per contest.
- Kobe Dickson contributes a team-best 7.0 rebounds per contest and also leads the squad with 12 assists.

AGAINST THE BIG RED

- Penn State is 7-5 all time against Cornell, including a perfect 6-0 record when playing the Big Red in Happy Valley.
- The Nittany Lions have won the last four meetings, and haven't lost to Cornell since 1972.
- Penn State won the most recent meeting, 90-59, when Cornell made the trip to the Bryce Jordan Center on Dec. 29, 2019. Lamar Stevens and Mike Watkins both tallied a game-high 19 points to lead Penn State to victory.

DREAD FROM DEEP

Senior Myles Dread returns for his senior season after ranking first or second on the Nittany Lion squad in 3-pointers made in each of his first three seasons.

His 180 career 3-pointers currently ranks ninth in the Penn State career record books. Dread needs 14 treys to match Dan Earl's eighth-best mark of 194 career 3-pointers.

SPEAKING OF SHOOTERS...

Graduate transfer Jaheam Cornwall (Gardner-Webb) owns a 42.1 (232-550) career 3-point shooting percentage, which ranks 23rd amongst all active Division I players. Cornwall was a two-time All-Big South honoree at Gardner-Webb.

BIG PICKETT-UP

Jalen Pickett was one of the most highly-touted transfers in the portal, coming in at No. 21 on ESPN's transfer rankings this spring. Shrewsberry secured the big pick up who announced his commitment to Penn State on April 25.

Pickett owned career averages of 15.0 points, 6.1 assists and 4.9 rebounds per game through three seasons at Siena, where he earned MAAC Player of the Year honors as a sophomore in 2019-20 and MAAC Rookie of the Year honors as a freshman in 2018-19. The Rochester, N.Y. native was a three-time first-team All-MAAC selection with the Saints.

PALPABLE BUZZ

With fans set to return to the Bryce Jordan Center for the first time since the 2019-20 season, and the excitement surrounding first-year head coach Micah Shrewsberry, the buzz in Happy Valley is palpable.

Penn State sold nearly 2,800 student season tickets, the most ever sold in the history of Penn State Basketball student season ticket sales.

STAFF TIES

Shrewsberry was tasked with assembling his first staff immediately upon arrival in Happy Valley. While this group has never all worked together, there are some key connections to both each other and the University.

Associate Head Coach and Penn State alumnus Adam Fisher '06 returns for his third stint in Happy Valley. He was the Nittany Lions' head student manager from 2003-06 during his undergraduate days. He later returned for the 2011-12 season as video coordinator and 2012-13 season as director of player development. Fisher spent the last eight years with the Miami Hurricanes.

Assistant Coach Aki Collins and Shrewsberry were on the same staff at Marshall from 2003-05, where the two coached current Assistant to the Head Coach Tre Whitted. Shrewsberry also coached current Director of Player Development Mike Green at Butler as Green earned All-America honors under Shrewsberry's tutelage. Shrewsberry worked on the same staff as current Video Coordinator Grady Eifert for each of the last two seasons, as the former Boilermaker standout was serving as a graduate assistant at Purdue.

PETER AND ANN TOMBROS ENDOWMENT

Peter and Ann Tombros have endowed the Penn State men's basketball head coaching position as part of their new \$26 million commitment to the University, as announced on Oct. 20, 2021. The Tombroses' gift will establish a fund to enhance opportunities for student-athletes through scholarships, travel, equipment and other needs.

This gift to endow the men's basketball head coach position is part of a new \$26 million commitment from the Tombroses that supports Intercollegiate Athletics, the College of Agricultural Sciences, Penn State Health and the College of Arts and Architecture. The commitment places the Tombroses among the top five donors in the University's history.

PETER AND ANN TOMBROS ENDOWED HEAD COACH

MICAH SHREWSBERRY



Penn State Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics Sandy Barbour announced the hiring of Purdue Associate Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry as the 14th men's basketball head coach in Penn State history. Shrewsberry comes to Penn State with a wealth of experience as an assistant coach for a pair of nationally ranked programs and in the NBA. He also has two years of head coaching experience.

Shrewsberry spent the last two seasons with Big Ten foe Purdue University as the associate head coach. As the offensive coordinator, Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a fourth-place finish with a 13-6 Big Ten record in 2020-21. Purdue finished with an 18-9 overall mark and earned an NCAA Tournament berth. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections.

Prior to his time at Purdue, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018. Under Shrewsberry, Boston ranked sixth in the NBA in 3-pointers made and seventh in 3-point field goal percentage in the 2018-19 season and was second in 3-point field goal percentage in 2017-18, behind the NBA champion Golden State Warriors.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of Jaylen Brown and Jayson Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors. Shrewsberry was also an assistant coach in the 2017 NBA All-Star Game.

Shrewsberry's first stint as an assistant coach at Purdue spanned the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons where he helped the Boilers reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament. He played an integral role in helping Purdue's offense lead the country in fewest turnovers per game with 8.74 in 2011-12. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the Big Ten in 2011-12, improving his field goal percentage by nearly 13 percent and upping his scoring average by more than five points per game from his freshman to sophomore year.

The Indianapolis native spent four seasons at Butler University under head coach Brad Stevens. He started his time with the Bulldogs as the coordinator of basketball operations before serving as an assistant coach for three seasons. With Shrewsberry on the bench, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles, and made three NCAA Tournament appearances.

During Shrewsberry's time at Butler, the Bulldogs reached the 2010 and 2011 National Championship games. He aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year in 2010 and on the Final Four All-Tournament Team in 2010. Hayward was selected as the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz. Shrewsberry was the head coach at Indiana University-South Bend from 2005-07. He served as the Chicagoland Collegiate Athletic Conference (CCAC) Division I Men's Basketball Chair in 2006-07. In his second season at the helm, the Titans showed a nine-game improvement from his inaugural season.

He was also the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

As player, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain at Hanover College. He led the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference in free throw shooting (.833) and assists (4.4) in 1998-99.

Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree in sports management from Indiana State in 2003. He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.

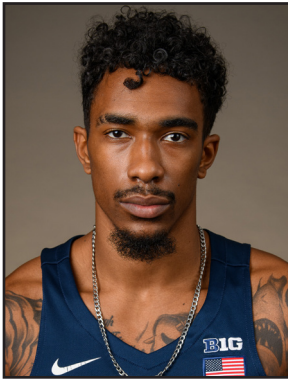

PENN STATE BOUNCES BACK WITH 74-59 WIN OVER ST. FRANCIS BROOKLYN

Twenty-six points from senior Sam Sessoms and the second double-double of the season from graduate student John Harrar helped lead the Penn State men's basketball team to a 74-59 victory over St. Francis Brooklyn Thursday evening inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

Sessoms led all players with 26 points, a personal best as a Nittany Lion for the second-year transfer. Harrar posted his second double-double of the season and eighth of his career with 14 points on 5-of-6 from the field and a game-high 13 rebounds.

Junior Seth Lundy added 11 points while senior Jalanni White made his first start as a Nittany Lion and recorded eight points off a 4-of-5 from the field with seven rebounds.

After initially trailing 6-2 to start the contest, Penn State went on a 12-5 run through the under-12 media timeout to take a 14-11 lead and never looked back.

The Nittany Lions led by nine, 24-15, midway through the first half thanks to two quick 3-pointers by Lundy prior to the under-8 media timeout.

Sam Sessoms would then score Penn State's final six points of the half, and totaled 14 in the final six minutes, to put the home team ahead by 13 at the break, 40-27.

The second half started with back-and-forth scoring as the Nittany Lions would lead by as much as 16.

Both teams would see periods of scoring droughts through the second half as Penn State outscored Saint Francis Brooklyn, 34-32, in the second stanza to maintain a double-digit lead into victory.

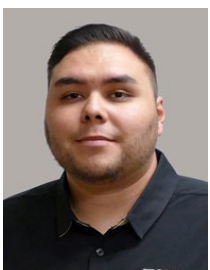
