### THE MATCHUP - CORNELL

- Penn State is 22-21 in the all-time series with Cornell. The series began in 1923 with a 3-1 win by the Big Red.
- Sunday marks the fifth-consecutive year Penn State and Cornell play each other. The Lions won three of the past four meetings, including a 19-13 win in last year's Crown Lacrosse Classic.
- **Mac O'Keefe** scored six goals and added one assist in last year's victory. **Grant Ament** tied a program record with nine assists. **Dylan Foulds** added four goals.

### THE MATCHUP - FURMAN

- Penn State is 2-0 in the all-time series with Furman. The Lions won 16-7 on the road in 2016 and 12-10 at home in 2017.
- **Kevin Hill** scored two goals in Penn State's win in 2017.

### WEEK 5 RECAP

- **Mac O'Keefe** scored four goals, including the game-winner 1:12 in to overtime in an 18-17 win at then-No. 6 Penn.
- **Jack Kelly** picked up a ground ball while being pulled to the ground from behind and went on to make a pass to O'Keefe to set up the game-winning shot.
- With his third goal of the game, **O'Keefe** broke the Big Ten record of 184 career goals held by Johns Hopkins' Terry Riordan (1992-95).
- **Nick Cardile** was named the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week for his play against the Quakers. He scored his second goal of the season, picked up one ground ball and caused one turnover. His ground ball tied the game at 11-all early in the fourth quarter.
- **Colby Kneese** recorded the win in goal, making 18 saves on 35 shots on goal. He has stopped 59.7 percent of the shots he has faced over the past three games.

### NCAA LEADERS

- **Grant Ament** ranks second in the nation in assists/game (4.60), third in assists (23), third in points (34) and third in points/game (6.80).
- **Mac O'Keefe** ranks third in the nation in goals (22), third in goals/game (4.4), ninth in points/game (5.60) and points (28).
- **Gerard Arceri** ranks fourth in the nation in ground balls (54) and sixth in ground balls/game (10.80).
- **Jack Traynor** ranks fourth in the nation in shot percentage (.600).
- As a team, Penn State ranks fourth in the nation in man-up offense (.700), fifth in assists (40), sixth in assists/game (10.0), sixth in shot percentage (.364), seventh in points (104), eighth in goals (64), ninth in points/game (26.0), ninth in scoring margin (+7.25) and ninth in goals/game (16.0).

### SCOUTING CORNELL

- Cornell is unbeaten at 4-0 and ranked seventh in the USILA Coaches Poll.
- The Big Red are winning by an average of 6.8 goals, beating Albany (19-10), Towson (17-10), High Point (21-11) and Ohio State (17-16).
- Jeff Teat ranks third in Cornell history in career points with 262.
- Cornell ranks first in the nation in shot percentage (.394) and second in scoring offense (18.5).

### SCOUTING FURMAN

- Furman is 1-5 following an 18-11 loss to No. 3 North Carolina on Friday.
- The Paladins trailed by just one, 4-3, at halftime in the loss to North Carolina and by three, 9-6, after three quarters.
- Furman's win this season came by a 19-4 score over Hampton.
- Alec Van De Bovenkamp ranks ninth in the nation in saves per game, averaging 13.6.

# 2020 PENN STATE MEN'S LACROSSE

## HISTORIC 2019 SEASON

- Penn State is coming off the best season in program history, finishing with a program record for wins (16-2) while advancing to the NCAA Semifinal for the first time.
- The Lions won their first Big Ten regular season and Tournament titles. The regular season title was won outright with a perfect 5-0 record.
- Penn State had a program record nine USILA All-Americans.
- Head coach **Jeff Tambroni** was voted the Big Ten Coach of the Year, while **Grant Ament** was named the NCAA's Most Outstanding Attackman and the Big Ten Offensive Player of the Year.
- The Lions led the nation in scoring offense (17.94), assists (10.83), man-up offense (.613), points per game (28.78), scoring margin (+6.89) and shot percentage (.434).
- In addition to wins, Penn State broke program records for winning streak (13) and goals (323).

## UP NEXT

Penn State returns to Panzer Stadium to host No. 19 Lehigh on Saturday, March 21. The teams will meet for the first time since 2013. The Mountain Hawks are 4-1 after posting three-straight wins over VMI, NJIT and Navy.

## AMENT POINT STREAK

- **Grant Ament** is fourth among active players with a 53-game point streak.
- Ament has totaled 274 points on 91 goals and 183 assists during that stretch.
- Ament has registered a point in all 53 games of his career.

## O'KEEFE GOAL STREAK

- **Mac O'Keefe** is third among active players with a 30-game goal-scoring streak.
- O'Keefe has 119 goals during that stretch, which is 28 more than any other player on the list.
- The last game O'Keefe didn't score a goal was in a 9-7 loss to Cornell on March 10, 2018.

## CAPTAINS

Penn State head coach Jeff Tambroni named **Grant Ament, Nick Cardile, Mac O'Keefe** and **Tommy Wright** as captains for the 2020 season.

## PANZER STADIUM

- Penn State opened Panzer Stadium with a 15-14 win over Penn on March 2, 2019. **Grant Ament** assisted on Nick Spillane's game-winning goal with 2:39 left in the game.
- The Lions are 7-1 at Panzer Stadium, with the first loss coming to No. 3 Yale last week.

## TAMBRONI RANKS SIXTH IN WINNING %

- **Jeff Tambroni**, who is in his 20th season as a head coach, is 197-93.
- His .679 winning percentage ranks sixth among all active NCAA Division I coaches.
- Tambroni's 88 wins at Penn State are the second-most in program history.
- Tambroni's .625 winning percentage at Penn State is easily the best in program history. Glenn Thiel is second at .559.

## SEVEN RETURNING ALL-AMERICANS

The Lions have seven players that have combined to earn 11 USILA All-America honors, including honorable mentions. **Mac O'Keefe** is a three-time All-American, **Grant Ament** and **Gerard Arceri** have each won two All-America awards, and **Jack Kelly, Tommy Wright, Nick Cardile** and **Colby Kneese** all received their first honor last season when the team had a program record nine.

## AMENT, O'KEEFE NAMED TO TEWAARATON WATCH LIST

- Seniors **Grant Ament** and **Mac O'Keefe** were named to the 2020 Tewaaraton Watch List by the Tewaaraton Foundation committee.
- Ament was a finalist for the award last season, while O'Keefe made the Watch List.

## TWO LIONS ARE SENIOR CLASS AWARD CANDIDATES

- Seniors **Grant Ament** and **Colby Kneese** were named candidates for the Senior CLASS Award.
- **Ament** and **Kneese** were one of 20 Division I players in the nation selected as candidates.
- The list will be narrowed to 10 finalists sometime this month.
- An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School®, the Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities.

Jeff Tambroni is in his 10th year as Penn State's head coach in 2020, looking to build off the most successful season in

program history. One of the sport's most decorated coaches, he ranks sixth among all active Division I coaches in career win percentage (197-93, .679).

The 2019 Nittany Lions racked up program firsts on their way to a 16-2 record, winning their first-ever Big Ten regular season and tournament titles and advancing to their first-ever NCAA Semifinal. They went a perfect 5-0 against league opponents during the regular season, including the team's first-ever varsity win over Maryland, which led to Tambroni being named the Big Ten Coach of the Year. A program-record nine players were recognized on the USILA All-America list, including Grant Ament and Chris Sabia on the first team. Nick Spillane and Mac O'Keefe earned spots on the second team, Gerard Arceri and Jack Kelly made the third team, and Colby Kneese, Tommy Wright, and Nick Cardile were selected as honorable mentions. Ament was selected as the Big Ten Offensive Player of the Year, while Sabia was the Defensive Player of the Year.

The 2019 team was easily the top offensive team in the nation, finishing first in the NCAA in assists per game (10.83), man-up offense (.613), points per game (28.78), scoring margin (+6.89), scoring offense (17.94), and shot percentage (.434). The Lions broke single-season school records in wins (16), goals (323), and winning streak (13), and a single-game record for goals with 27 in a win over Robert Morris.

Grant Ament and Mac O'Keefe led the charge for the nation's top offense. Ament was a finalist for the prestigious Tewaaraton Award while setting NCAA records for assists (96) and assists per game (5.65), and a Big Ten and program record for points (129). O'Keefe tied a Big Ten and program record for goals in a season (78).

In 2018, the Nittany Lions went 8-6, 2-3 in Big Ten play. During the season, Penn State grabbed ranked wins over No. 13 Penn, 10-7, and the program's first win over No. 5 Johns Hopkins, 14-12. Arceri made a name for himself on a national level with a 68.1-winning percentage at the 'x,' earning 216 wins on the season. He scooped up an impressive 145 ground balls, for 10.36 per game, adding a career-best six goals while dishing out one assist. His percentage on faceoffs and his ground balls per game were both good for fourth in the NCAA and led the Big Ten. He was named the Big Ten Specialist of the Year, first team All-Big Ten, and a USILA third team All-American. Mac O'Keefe was also named first team All-Big Ten and was a USILA honorable mention All-American along with Sabia. Ryan Keenan was selected to play in the USILA North-South All-Star Game and was drafted 54th in the MLL Draft to the Ohio Machine.

In 2017, Tambroni led the Nittany Lions to a 12-4 record, just the seventh season with double-digit wins and just the second in 20 seasons (2013, 2017). Penn State set a program record after opening the season with a 10-0 record, the best start in school history. The 10th win highlighted the streak as Penn State took down No. 5 Ohio State 9-4 to earn just the eighth win in program history over a top-five team. Penn State also earned its first winning record in Big Ten play, going 3-2. Tambroni saw three earn USILA All-America honorable mention honors, while Nick Aponte added a USILA Scholar All-America honor.

During the 2016 season, Tambroni guided Penn State to its fifth season going .500 or above under his guidance. Most notable during the 2016 campaign, he led Penn State to a win over a top-ranked opponent for the first time in program history on March 26, when the Nittany Lions earned a 15-10 victory over defending national champion and No. 1 ranked Denver, snapping the opponent's 20-game win streak. Penn State notched two other

wins over ranked opponents during the 2016 campaign, as well, knocking off No. 18 Cornell and No. 8 Harvard in the process.

Tambroni led Penn State to be one of the most efficient teams in the country in 2016, with the team finishing second in Division I in turnovers per game while finishing sixth in the country in shooting percentage. Penn State earned its first unanimous All-Big Ten selection in Aponte, while Ament and Mike Aronow earned All-Big Ten honorable mention recognition. Tambroni also led TJ Sanders to be named Penn State's ninth USILA Scholar All-America selection.

Tambroni guided the Nittany Lions through a historic season in 2015 that brought Penn State's first appearance in the Big Ten Tournament following the first ever season of Big Ten lacrosse. The Nittany Lions opened the season ranked No. 14 in the USILA DI Preseason Coaches' Poll and knocked off No. 16/11 Penn during the 2015 season. Tambroni also led Penn State to its first two Big Ten conference victories as well as a berth to the conference tournament. He also mentored Sanders to USILA All-America honorable mention honors.

In 2014, Tambroni led Penn State to its fourth consecutive above-.500 season. His student-athletes earned the eighth USILA All-America and third Scholar All-America honors of Tambroni's Penn State career. He also coached goalkeeper Austin Kaut to his school record third All-America honor and an All-CAA first team award.

Penn State's 2013 campaign saw Tambroni lead Penn State to one of the greatest seasons in program history while celebrating its 100th season. The Nittany Lions set records for wins (12) and earned the program's first outright regular season conference title by sweeping the CAA with a 6-0 record. PSU rattled off 10 straight wins from March through May to earn the school's third NCAA bid and first chance to host an NCAA game.

Tambroni was named CAA Coach of the Year for the second time in his career (2011), while Kaut (under Tambroni's tutelage) was named Ensign C. Markland Kelly, Jr. Award for the nation's best goalie. Also, Kaut was CAA Player and Defensive Player of the Year. Sanders was named Rookie of the Year and the Nittany Lions placed six on the All-CAA first team.

During the 2012 campaign, Tambroni led the Nittany Lions to a second-place CAA finish with two USILA All-Americans and six All-CAA honorees. Penn State finished with a 9-6 overall record and a 5-1 mark in conference action.

The 2011 CAA Co-Coach of the Year, Tambroni led the Nittany Lions to a 7-7 record and their first-ever CAA tournament berth during his first year at the program's helm.

In 2011, eight Nittany Lions garnered All-CAA recognition and Kaut earned Rookie of the Year honors while being named a USILA honorable mention All-American.

Prior to Penn State, Tambroni spent 10 seasons as head coach at Cornell (2001-10). He guided the Big Red to a 109-40 record and three NCAA Semifinal appearances (2007, 2009-10), including the 2009 National Championship game.

Tambroni was named USILA Division I Coach of the Year following the 2009 season and was tabbed the 2007 and 2009 Field Turf/NCAA Division I Coach of the Year. Tambroni was also the 2004 and 2009 Ithaca Journal Male Coach of the Year and a three-time National Coach of the Week.

While at Cornell, Tambroni became the 10th-fastest coach to reach the 100-win mark when he accomplished the feat in his 134th career game in March 2010.

During his tenure, his players earned 37 first team All-Ivy honors, including five Ivy League awards, and three conference Rookie of the Year selections.

In addition, 39 players garnered All-America recognition.

Prior to serving as Cornell's head coach, he spent four seasons as a Big Red assistant coach (1997-2000). Tambroni also served as assistant coach at Loyola College in 1997 and at his alma mater, Hobart College, for three seasons. With the Statesmen, he helped the program reach the 1994 NCAA Division III National Championship game.

A 1992 graduate, Tambroni earned his bachelor's degree in American studies. He earned first-team All-America honors as a senior and was twice named a second-team All-American (1990-91). The MVP of the 1990 NCAA title game, Tambroni helped lead the team to back-to-back NCAA titles (1990-91) and left Hobart tied for seventh on the school's all-time scoring

list with 202 points.

Before embarking upon his collegiate coaching career, Tambroni coached the Heaton Mersey Lacrosse Club of the English Lacrosse Union for one year and served as a visiting coach for the Czech-American Lacrosse Foundation in Prague in the summer of 1996.

Tambroni and his wife, Michelle, have three daughters, Carissa, Madison, and Ella. Michelle played field hockey at Penn State from 1988-90 and earned All-America honors as a senior.
