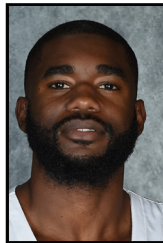

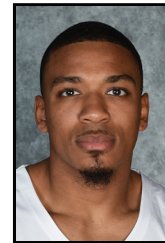

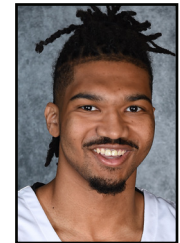

**NEW FACE ON THE SHORE:** Jason Crafton was named head coach on April 30, 2019, the 21th head coach in Maryland Eastern Shore men's basketball history. He spent last season with the Delaware Blue Coats, a G-League affiliate of the Philadelphia 76ers. He was the head coach at his alma mater, Nyack College, for six seasons from 2012-18 compiling a 47-108 record. Crafton has also served as an assistant at Navy under Billy Lange (2005-10) and Villanova under Jay Wright (2003-05).

**COMBINE THE OLD AND NEW:** The Hawks return seven players to the program from the 2018-19 season, two of which (Marlon Adams and Derrick Green) missed the season with injury. Seniors AJ Cheeseman and Bryan Urrutia are the top returners for Eastern Shore. Cheeseman was the team's leading scorer last season prior to an injury that cost him half of his junior campaign. Urrutia finished 2018-19 in the top 10 in the MEAC conference in assists, steals and minutes. Joining them are four JUCO transfers and four freshmen. Headlining the newcomers are guard Ty Gibson, who averaged 35.1 percent from three point range at Gulf Coast State College, and forward Bruce Guy, who is a 3-star recruit from Cordova, Tenn. that was an all-state selection each year of high school.

**SEEING IT THROUGH:** Redshirt senior Ahmad Frost is in his fifth year with the Hawks program. He is playing under his third head coach at Eastern Shore. Frost suffered an injury early in his career that cost him a season and a half from Jan. 2016-March 2017. He enters the 2019-20 season with 83 games played and could reach the top five in school history in games played.

**CONSISTENT:** Senior forward Gabriel Gyamfi played in all 32 games for the Hawks a season ago. He led the squad in total rebounds (163) and field goal percentage (.602). Named the team's most improved player last year, Gyamfi was in the top 15 in offensive rebounds per game in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC).

**ON THE ROAD:** Eastern Shore takes on an imposing nonconference slate leading into its MEAC opener on January 4. After opening the season at Penn State, the Hawks battle at Liberty and Longwood. Other marquee matchups include road bouts with Stanford, Oklahoma, Baylor and Virginia Tech. The Hawks have eight nonconference road games scheduled, including a Nov. 29 showdown against local rival Delaware. The Shore will play their first home game on Nov. 26 against Wofford.

**2018-19 Record:** 14-18 (7-13 Big Ten)  
**All-Time Series:** Penn State leads 2-0

LAST MEETING (Dec. 6, 1994): The Nittany Lions were led by future NBA player John Amaechi and defeated the Hawks 86-55.

CHASING THE TOURNEY: Penn State is looking to make it to the NCAA tournament for the first time since 2011. They finished last season winning seven of their last 10 games before falling to Minnesota in overtime in the Big Ten Tournament. The Nittany Lions come into the season predicted to finish tenth in the conference.

THE ONE TO WATCH: Senior forward Lamar Stevens returns after being named an All-Big Ten first-team honoree in 2018-19. The Philadelphia product averaged 19.9 points and 7.7 rebounds a season ago. Stevens currently sits in fifth on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,660 points.

KEEPING CONNECTIONS: Coach Pat Chambers is a graduate of Philadelphia University and he historically keeps the "City of Brotherly Love" represented on his squad. His 2010-11 team at Boston University featured six guys from Philadelphia. He has continued that trend as three players on Penn State this year are from Philly.

REUNITED: Head coach Pat Chambers and Hawks head coach Jason Crafton once shared the sidelines as assistants to Jay Wright at Villanova in the 2004-05 season.

Jason Crafton was announced as the head coach of the University of Maryland Eastern Shore men's basketball team on April 24, 2019. The 16-year-veteran of coaching spent this past season in the NBA ranks as an assistant coach with the Philadelphia 76ers' G-League affiliate Delaware Blue Coats. Prior to that, he was the head coach at his alma mater, Nyack College from 2012-18. He spent the beginning of his career as an assistant at the United States Naval Academy and Villanova University.

In the Spring of 2012, Crafton inherited a major rebuilding project, taking over a Warrior program which produced a 1-26 record the year prior to his arrival and was ranked 276 out of 277 NCAA Division II programs. In his second season, he propelled the Warriors one of the best turnarounds in the Central Atlantic Collegiate Conference (CACC).

By the 2015-16 season the Warriors 11-15 record marked as the programs best since 2009. The Warriors also achieved 22 conference wins between 2013-2016, it's best 3-year span in several years.

Throughout his tenure, the Warriors made a name for themselves on defense. In 2016, Nyack ranked 11th in the nation in turnovers forced per game. The 2015 squad led the league in steals per game while the 2018 team finished with a zone defense that was rated in the top 10 percent nationally by Synergy.

Prior to Nyack, Crafton was Associate head coach at the U.S. Naval Academy for two seasons under then head coach Billy Lange. Before that, he was an assistant coach for the Midshipmen from 2005 to 2010 also under Lange who is now the St. Joseph's University head coach.

He began his college coaching career as video coordinator for two seasons at Villanova under head coach Jay Wright (2003-05). While working at Villanova, he helped mentor two future NBA guards: All-Star Kyle Lowry and Randy Foye.

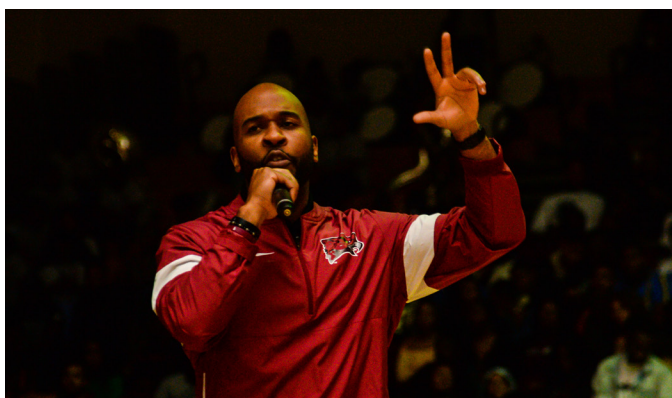
While at Navy, Crafton was instrumental in developing Greg Sprink (2008 Patriot League Player of the Year) and J.J. Avila (2011 Patriot League Rookie of the Year). At Nyack, he spearheaded the development of Nick Moore and Chris Hampton, who both earned CACC All-Conference accolades.

This past season Crafton worked with the Blue Coats to help instill similar philosophies as the parent club, the 76ers, while also maintaining a developmental mindset. The energetic coach played an integral role and took every opportunity to contribute in all phases of the program as well as use the experience to broaden his coaching knowledge, at different times throughout the season serving as Offensive and Defensive Coordinator as well as Director of Player Development. He assisted with the on-court development of multiple players who became contributors to the 76ers including 2018 first-round pick Zhaire Smith.

The former Warrior was a member of the Nyack College basketball team from 1999-2003 and served as team captain during his junior and senior seasons. He graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Communications in 2003.

**Assistant Coach**

Larry Stewart enters his 1st season as an Assistant Coach at Eastern Shore.



Stewart came to Eastern Shore after spending the last four seasons at Morgan State. Prior to MSU, he spent six seasons at Bowie State University from 2019-15. During his tenure at BSU, the team went 91-50 and captured the 2013 CIAA Tournament title.

As a player, Stewart was a star at Coppin State University from 1987-91. He tallied 1,824 points and 1,052 rebounds at CSU and the team would advance to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. After college, he played 17 years of professional basketball with the first six of those years in the NBA with the Washington Bullets, Vancouver Grizzlies and Seattle Supersonics.

**Assistant Coach**

Dominic Parker is in his first season as an assistant coach at Eastern Shore.



Parker joined Eastern Shore after having spent the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at Christopher Newport. The team went 51-11 during his tenure and advanced to the Final Four in March 2019.

Parker has also made stops Richard Bland College (2013-15) and Shenandoah College(2015-17). He was named to the 2017-18 Under Armour 30 under 30 team.

The Raleigh, N.C. native is a 2012 graduate of Virginia State.

**Assistant Coach**

Calvin Baker is in his 1st season as an assistant coach at Eastern Shore.



Baker was an assistant at Paul IV Catholic High School in Fairfax, Va. for three seasons before coming to the Hawks.

In 2018, he became an assistant coach with DC based Nike Team Takeover. He also served as the director for recruiting for Virginia's Under Armour Association grassroots program.

Baker played college basketball at William & Mary in 2005-06 before transferring to Virginia to complete his final years of eligibility. He was a team captain for the Cavaliers during his junior and senior seasons.
