#### OPENING TIPS

- Penn State, winners of three of its last four games, hits the road for a big test Sunday at noon when the Nittany Lions take on #16 Ohio State in Columbus.
- PSU has won three of its last four games - a 61-58 home victory over Indiana, a 74-70 win at Northwestern, and a dominant 66-49 home victory against Rutgers.
- Four Nittany Lions are averaging double-digit points, led by junior Seth Lundy's 14.1 ppg. Seniors Jalen Pickett (13.4 ppg) and Sam Sessoms (11.9 ppg) follow, while grad student John Harrar is averaging a double-double with 11.1 ppg and 10.0 rpg.

#### IF PENN STATE BEATS OHIO STATE

- Penn State would beat a top-20 Big Ten team on the road for the first time since Feb. 4, 2020 (75-70 at #16 Michigan State).
- The Nittany Lions would earn their fourth win in the last five games.

**THREE OF FOUR**

Penn State returned from a 22-day layoff from game action to play four games in nine days and go 3-1 during that stretch since the turn of the calendar year.

The Nittany Lions earned a home win over Indiana (61-68) on Jan. 2, a road win at Northwestern (74-70) on Jan. 5, and a home victory against Rutgers (66-49) on Jan. 11. The only loss of the last four games was a tough 67-74 defeat to #3 Purdue on Jan. 8 in which the Nittany Lions wiped out a 13-point second-half deficit to come back and take a one-point lead before the Boilermakers closed the game on a 10-2 streak to escape Happy Valley with the 74-67 victory.

The Penn State defense has been the catalyst over the last four games as the Nittany Lions are holding their opponents to 62.8 ppg since the turn of the calendar year. Jalen Pickett has led Penn State offensively, averaging 17.3 points, 4.25 assists, and 3.3 rebounds per game over the last four games.

**3-3 ISN'T A BAD PLACE TO BE**

First-year head coach Micah Shrewsberry has the Nittany Lions at 3-3 in Big Ten play through the first six conference games of the season.

The 2021-22 season is Penn State's 30th year in the Big Ten, and this is just the ninth time the Nittany Lions have started .500 or better through the first six league games.

The Nittany Lions have gone on to make the national postseason in six of the previous eight times that Penn State has started .500 or better through the first six games of conference play (2 NCAA, 4 NIT including two NIT Championships).

**EXTINGUISHED**

Rutgers road a four-game win streak into Tuesday's game, in which the Scarlet Knights were averaging 81.8 points per game. But it was the Penn State defense that dominated the day to hand red-hot Rutgers a 66-49 loss in the Nittany Lions' most recent game.

Penn State's defense held a Big Ten opponent under 50 points in regulation for the first time since limiting Indiana to 49 during the 2019-20 season (1/29/20). Rutgers' 49 points was 21 points below its season average of 70.4 per game.

The Nittany Lions led wire-to-wire, marking the first time Penn State never trailed in a game since Feb. 11, 2020 in an 88-76 win at Purdue.

**FINALLY FULLY AVAILABLE (KNOCK ON WOOD)**

Tuesday's game against Rutgers was Penn State's 14th game of the season and the first time head coach Micah Shrewsberry had his entire roster available.

Starter Greg Lee missed the first nine games of the season with an injury and has since returned to make a large impact, averaging 6.8 points and 6.0 rebounds per game. His six rebounds per game ranks second on the team.

Junior college transfer Jevonnie Scott saw his first action of the season Tuesday against Rutgers after working his way back into form after clearing NCAA transfer red tape. Scott provides key big-man depth.

**PICKETT'S CHARGE**

Senior transfer Jalen Pickett is the only Big Ten player averaging at least 17.5 points and 4.2 assists per conference game thus far this season. Pickett owns the only points-assists double-double in a Big Ten game this season after registering 21 points and 10 assists against #3 Purdue Saturday.

The guard is averaging 17.5 points, 4.2 assists and 3.5 rebounds per Big Ten contest while shooting 45.7 percent from the field.

Pickett came to PSU after three seasons at Siena, where he earned MAAC Player of the Year honors as a sophomore in 2019-20 and MAAC Rookie of the Year honors as a freshman in 2018-19. The Rochester, N.Y. native was a three-time first-team All-MAAC selection with the Saints.

### THREE CAN BE A KEY

Penn State's performance from three-point range has proven to be a major key to success. The Nittany Lions are shooting 38.1 percent (74-194) from deep with an average of 9.3 made threes per game in Penn State's eight wins.

Penn State is shooting 29.4 percent (40-136) from downtown with an average of 6.7 treys per game in the Nittany Lions' six losses.

The Nittany Lions shot a season-best 50 percent (11-22) from deep in Penn State's win over Indiana on Jan. 2. Penn State made a program-record tying 15 3-pointers in its win over Cornell on Nov. 22.

### NON-CON AT A GLANCE

Penn State wrapped up non-conference play with a 5-3 record.

All five of Penn State's non-conference victories came by double digits - Youngstown St. (75-59), St. Francis Brooklyn (74-59), Cornell (85-74), Oregon State (60-45) and Wagner (74-54).

Penn State fell on the road to UMass (56-81) in the second game of the season, but the Nittany Lions' other two non-conference losses were close five-point games. Penn State took LSU, a team currently ranked #12 in the AP Poll, to overtime before falling 63-68. The Nittany Lions fell to Miami in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge 58-63.

Seth Lundy and Sam Sessoms both contributed a team-best 14.5 points per game through Penn State's eight non-conference contests.

### AGE & EXPERIENCE

The average age of Penn State's 15-man roster on the official Nov. 9 start date of the 2021-22 college basketball season (Penn State opened on Nov. 10) was 21.61 years old. Penn State is believed to be the sixth-oldest Division I team in the country this season, oldest Power 5 team, and oldest team in the Big Ten.

## THE OPPOSITION

### SCOUTING OHIO STATE

- The #16/15 Buckeyes own a 10-4 overall record and 4-2 mark in Big Ten play. Ohio State is a perfect 7-0 in home games this season.
- Ohio State's two conference losses have come in their last three games. The Buckeyes dropped a 78-68 decision at #13 Wisconsin Thursday night. OSU also fell on the road at Indiana (51-67) on Jan. 6.
- The Buckeyes are led by E.J. Liddell who averages team-best marks of 19.9 points and 7.1 rebounds per game. Malaki Branham is the only other Buckeye averaging double-digit points with 10.4 ppg, but six other OSU players chip in six or more points per game in a balanced attack.

### AGAINST THE BUCKEYES

- Ohio State owns a 42-19 edge in the all-time series and a 22-6 advantage in home games against the Nittany Lions.
- The Nittany Lions will be looking for their road win in Columbus since Jan. 25, 2018 (82-79).
- The two teams met in this season's conference opener on Dec. 5, with the Buckeyes earning a 76-64 win inside the Bryce Jordan Center. The Nittany Lions trimmed an 18-point second-half deficit down to six, but weren't able to complete the comeback. Pickett led PSU with 23 points, Lundy had 13, and Harrar added 12 points and 12 rebounds.

**LOCKDOWN LUNDY**

Junior Seth Lundy is the team's leading scorer through the first 14 games of the season, averaging 14.1 points per game. But it's his defense that has stolen the show as he proves himself as a legitimate two-way player in the Big Ten.

**BIG JOHN**

Penn State graduate student John Harrar and Illinois All-American Kofi Cockburn are the only two Big Ten men's basketball players averaging a double-double thus far into the season. Harrar owns season-long marks of 11.1 points and 10.0 rebounds per game. His 10.0 rebounds per game ranks 14th nationally, as of Thursday, Jan. 13.

The Wallingford, Pa. native has tallied five double-doubles thus far, pulled down double-digit rebounds in eight contests, and is shooting a blistering 70.1 percent (61-87) from the field. Harrar owns 11 career double-doubles, making him one of just 17 Penn State players all-time to register double-digit double-doubles in their Penn State career.

**SESSOMS' STEP UP**

Senior Sam Sessoms has stepped into a larger role this season and currently ranks third on the team with 11.9 points per game and second with 3.3 assists per contest.

Sessoms led Penn State offensively in the Nittany Lions' win over Rutgers on Jan. 11 with a game-high 17 points and six assists. The senior shot 7-for-10 from the field and a percent 3-for-3 from downtown.

He scored his 1,500th career point during the victory over Rutgers.

**DREAD FROM DEEP**

Senior Myles Dread drilled his 200th career 3-pointer in Penn State's Jan. 5 win at Northwestern, making him the seventh Nittany Lion to ever reach 200 career triples. He currently has 201 career treys and needs five treys to match Titus Ivory's sixth-best mark of 206 career 3-pointers.

**HIGHEST-RANKED RECRUITING CLASS IN PROGRAM HISTORY**

It took head coach Micah Shrewsberry and his staff less than eight months to make history in Happy Valley, as the staff recently signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history on Signing Day 2021.

Penn State's five-member class currently ranks 24th in the nation according to 247Sports, 25th according to ESPN, and 29th according to Rivals.

The five-member class is comprised of Jameel Brown (Philadelphia, Pa.), Kanye Clary (Virginia Beach, Va.), Demetrius Lilley (Philadelphia, Pa.), Evan Mahaffey (Cincinnati, Ohio) and Kebba Njite (Centerville, Ohio). The five new Nittany Lions, who will join the program as the Class of 2026, will bring accomplished athletic and academic pedigrees to Penn State.

**CORE RETURNEES**

Penn State returns a number of familiar faces for the 2021-22 season. Graduate student John Harrar returns to utilize the extra year of eligibility granted by the NCAA due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Harrar earned honorable mention All-Big Ten honors last season after leading the Nittany Lions with 8.8 rebounds per game and a 54.9 field goal percentage.

Junior Seth Lundy is the team's returning leading scorer from a season ago. Lundy tallied 10.1 points per game, including two 30-plus point contests in his sophomore campaign.

Seniors Myles Dread and Sam Sessoms will play large roles in the backcourt once again. Dread ranked first or second on the team in three-pointers made in each of his three years as a Nittany Lion. Sessoms is set for his second season at Penn State after playing two years at Binghamton. The Philadelphia native ranked second on the team in steals a season ago and tallied nine double-digit scoring games.

Sophomores Caleb Dorsey, Dallion Johnson and Andy Christos also return looking to make a jump in their second year in Happy Valley.

**NEW FACES IN NEW PLACES**

Eight new faces pair with seven returners to comprise Penn State's 15-man roster.

Five new Nittany Lions joined the team via the transfer portal in Jaheam Cornwall (Gardner-Webb), Greg Lee (Western Michigan), Jalen Pickett (Siena), Jevonnie Scott (South Plains College), and Jalanni White (Canisius). Three others joined as walk-ons, two of whom have played college basketball in previous years, in Dan Conlan (Dickinson), Irekefe Oweh (St. Thomas Aquinas) and Ishaan Jagiasi.

**A NEW SHERIFF IN TOWN**

Peter and Ann Tombros Endowed Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry was announced as the 14th men's basketball head coach in Penn State history on March 15, 2021. He came to Penn State after two years as the associate head coach at Purdue, his second stint with the Boilermakers, that followed a six-year run as assistant coach with the Boston Celtics under head coach Brad Stevens. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018.

Shrewsberry's first stint at Purdue came during the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons, in which he helped the Boilers reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Prior to that, he spent four seasons at Butler under Stevens, helping guide the Bulldogs to three NCAA Tournaments and two Final Four appearances.

Prominent players coached by Shrewsberry include Jaylen Brown (Celtics), Jayson Tatum (Celtics), Isaiah Thomas (Celtics), Al Horford (Celtics), Kyrie Irving (Celtics), Marcus Smart (Celtics), Rajon Rondo (Celtics), Gordon Hayward (Butler), Shelvin Mack (Butler), and Robbie Hummel (Purdue).

**PALPABLE BUZZ**

With fans set to return to the Bryce Jordan Center for the first time since the 2019-20 season, and the excitement surrounding first-year head coach Micah Shrewsberry, the buzz in Happy Valley is palpable.

Penn State sold nearly 2,800 student season tickets, the most ever sold in the history of Penn State Basketball student season ticket sales.

**STAFF TIES**

Shrewsberry was tasked with assembling his first staff immediately upon arrival in Happy Valley. While this group has never all worked together, there are some key connections to both each other and the University.

Associate Head Coach and Penn State alumnus Adam Fisher '06 returns for his third stint in Happy Valley. He was the Nittany Lions' head student manager from 2003-06 during his undergraduate days. He later returned for the 2011-12 season as video coordinator and 2012-13 season as director of player development. Fisher spent the last eight years with the Miami Hurricanes.

Assistant Coach Aki Collins and Shrewsberry were on the same staff at Marshall from 2003-05, where the two coached current Assistant to the Head Coach Tre Whitted. Shrewsberry also coached current Director of Player Development Mike Green at Butler as Green earned All-America honors under Shrewsberry's tutelage. Shrewsberry worked on the same staff as current Video Coordinator Grady Eifert for each of the last two seasons, as the former Boilermaker standout was serving as a graduate assistant at Purdue.

# MICAH SHREWSBERRY

Penn State Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics Sandy Barbour announced the hiring of Purdue Associate Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry as the 14th men's basketball head coach in Penn State history. Shrewsberry comes to Penn State with a wealth of experience as an assistant coach for a pair of nationally ranked programs and in the NBA. He also has two years of head coaching experience.

Shrewsberry spent the last two seasons with Big Ten foe Purdue University as the associate head coach. As the offensive coordinator, Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a fourth-place finish with a 13-6 Big Ten record in 2020-21. Purdue finished with an 18-9 overall mark and earned an NCAA Tournament berth. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections.

Prior to his time at Purdue, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018. Under Shrewsberry, Boston ranked sixth in the NBA in 3-pointers made and seventh in 3-point field goal percentage in the 2018-19 season and was second in 3-point field goal percentage in 2017-18, behind the NBA champion Golden State Warriors.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of Jaylen Brown and Jayson Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors. Shrewsberry was also an assistant coach in the 2017 NBA All-Star Game.

Shrewsberry's first stint as an assistant coach at Purdue spanned the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons where he helped the Boilers reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament. He played an integral role in helping Purdue's offense lead the country in fewest turnovers per game with 8.74 in 2011-12. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the Big Ten in 2011-12, improving his field goal percentage by nearly 13 percent and upping his scoring average by more than five points per game from his freshman to sophomore year.

The Indianapolis native spent four seasons at Butler University under head coach Brad Stevens. He started his time with the Bulldogs as the coordinator of basketball operations before serving as an assistant coach for three seasons. With Shrewsberry on the bench, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles, and made three NCAA Tournament appearances.

During Shrewsberry's time at Butler, the Bulldogs reached the 2010 and 2011 National Championship games. He aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year in 2010 and on the Final Four All-Tournament Team in 2010. Hayward was selected as the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz. Shrewsberry was the head coach at Indiana University-South Bend from 2005-07. He served as the Chicagoland Collegiate Athletic Conference (CCAC) Division I Men's Basketball Chair in 2006-07. In his second season at the helm, the Titans showed a nine-game improvement from his inaugural season.

He was also the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

As player, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain at Hanover College. He led the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference in free throw shooting (.833) and assists (4.4) in 1998-99.

Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree in sports management from Indiana State in 2003. He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.
