### PENN STATE HOSTS # 13 OHIO STATE ON FRIDAY

The Penn State men's soccer team, under fifth-year head coach Jeff Cook, return to Jeffrey Field to host #13 Ohio State on Friday, Oct. 21 at 7:00 p.m.

### LAST TIME OUT

- » Penn State lost its most recent game to Indiana 4-2 on the road.
- » Butts scored his sixth goal of the season and 21st of his career in the first half off a massive assist from Seth Kuhn.
- » Peter Mangione scored his seventh goal of the season and 21st of his career after being awarded a penalty kick in the second half.
- » Kris Shakes came up with five crucial saves in goal.

### PENN STATE-OHIO STATE MOST RECENT

- » The Nittany Lions lost to the Buckeyes on the road in Columbus last season, 2-1.
- » Prior to last year, Penn State won the previous four consecutive games dating back to 2018.
- » Penn State is 13-3-2 against Ohio State at Jeffrey Field.

### 2022 ACCOLADES

- » Penn State is ranked 25th in the Top Drawer Soccer Weekly Poll.
- » Liam Butts was named Big Ten Offensive Player of the Week and was selected to College Soccer New National Team of the Week (Oct. 11).
- » United Soccer Coaches ranked the Nittany Lions 21st in the country in their Preseason Poll.
- » Mangione was selected as a United Soccer Coaches Forward to Watch.
- » Mangione, Kuhn and Femi Awodesu were named Big Ten Players to Watch.
- » Mangione was named to the Hermann Award Trophy List.

### 2021 IN REVIEW

- » The Nittany Lions finished the 2021 season 13-7-1 overall, 6-2 conference.
- » They were Big Ten regular season and tournament Champions for the first time in program history.
- » Penn State made its 35th NCAA Tournament appearance when they hosted Hofstra in the second round of the tournament after earning the automatic bid from the conference championship.
- » Andrew Privett led the Nittany Lion offense last season scoring nine goals with four assists and 22 points.
- » Junior Peter Mangione was not far behind Privett with seven goals on the season, with four eventual game-winners.
- » Mangione was named the 2021 Big Ten Offensive Player of the Year, the second Big Ten Player of the Year award under head coach Jeff Cook.
- » Cook was named 2021 Big Ten Coach of the Year in a unanimous vote.
- » Cook and his coaching staff were selected as the North Region Staff of the Year
- » Six Nittany Lions were honored in Big Ten season awards along with Cook and Mangione. Brandon Hackenberg and

Mangione were named to All-Big Ten First Team. Andrew Privett, Seth Kuhn and Pierre Reedy were selected to All-Big Ten Second Team and Alex Stevenson was awarded Penn State's Sportsmanship Award.

- » Four Nittany Lions landed on the 2021 All-North Region Teams. Pete Mangione made first team, Hackenberg and Kuhn made second and Andrew Privett was selected to third-team.

### 2022 NEWCOMERS

- » Penn State welcomed nine new players to the team this year. The freshmen include goalkeeper Ryan Aiken, defenders Sam Ovesen and Ben Ofori and Kaleb Alva, and midfielders Cohen Weaver, and Sebastian Vainstein. The Nittany Lions secured two transfers; sophomore forward from Portland Atem Kato and fifth year defender from Michigan State Olu Ogunwale.
