OPENING TIPS

- The final three-game stretch of the regular season gets underway Wednesday when Penn State opens a two-game homestand against #15 Ohio State at the Bryce Jordan Center.
- Penn State has drilled double-digit three-pointers in each of its last two games, marking the first time since 2010 the Lady Lions have recorded 10-plus treys in back-to-back games.
- Johnasia Cash has recorded a double-double in eight of Penn State's last 12 games and is averaging 15.3 ppg and 9.8 rpg in Big Ten play. Niya Beverley leads the Big Ten and ranks second in the nation with a 4.3 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- The Lady Lions are the youngest team in the Big Ten with an average age of 19.56 and eight true freshmen on the roster.

IF PENN STATE BEATS OHIO STATE

- Penn State would beat a team ranked in the top 15 of the AP poll for the first time since Nov. 20, 2016 when unranked PSU defeated #13 Tennessee 70-56 inside the Bryce Jordan Center.
- The Lady Lions would snap their 11-game losing streak to the Buckeyes and earn their first victory over Ohio State since Feb. 9, 2014 when Penn State beat OSU 74-54 in Columbus.

Deadly From Deep

- Penn State’s shooters have come alive as the Lady Lions are coming off back-to-back games with double-digit treys and have made an average of 9.6 three-pointers per game over the last seven games. The Lady Lions were averaging 6.8 threes per game in the first 12 games of the season.
- In its last two games, Penn State drilled 11 threes at Nebraska (Feb. 21) and a program record-tying 14 treys at Iowa (Feb. 18), marking the first time in over 10 years (Nov. 2010) that the Lady Lions have drained double-digit threes in back-to-back games.
- Burke has hit 26 three-pointers in the last seven games combined, shooting 44.8 percent (26-for-58) from deep in that stretch. Sophomore Shay Hagans is shooting 45.5 percent (5-for-11) from three-point range in the last seven games, while senior Niya Beverley is shooting 39.5 percent (15-for-38).

Freshman On Fire

- Freshman Maddie Burke ranks fourth amongst all Division I freshmen with 49 three-pointers this season.
- Burke has hit six three-pointers in each of Penn State’s last two games, making her the first Penn State player to record back-to-back games with six or more three-pointers since former All-American and Big Ten Player of the Year Maggie Lucas ‘14.
- Her 49 treys already put her in fourth place on Penn State’s freshman season three-point FGs made records list with at least four games remaining in the season (three regular season and one guaranteed Big Ten Tournament game), and an already shortened season due to the Covid-19 pandemic.
- Burke has drilled three or more treys in seven of Penn State’s last eight games.
- The Doylestown, Pa. native has nailed five or more triples four times this season, including a career-best seven against Maryland on Dec. 31.

Cash Is Money

- Senior transfer Johnasia Cash (previously SMU) has been on a tear as of late, recording double-doubles in eight of Penn State’s last 12 games.
- Cash is averaging 15.3 ppg and 9.8 rpg in Big Ten play. Her season-long averages are 14.7 ppg and 9.3 rpg with nine total double-doubles.
- She earned Big Ten Player of the Week honors on Feb. 8 after shooting 63.0 percent (17-for-27) from the field while averaging 22.5 points per game and 11.5 rebounds per contest to lead Penn State to wins over Nebraska and Wisconsin.
- The McKeesport, Pa. native became the first Penn State player to record double-doubles in four-consecutive games since 1997 when she notched her fourth-straight against Nebraska on Feb. 4. Angie Potthoff was the last PSU player to accomplish the feat 24 years ago.
- Cash’s efficiency has improved greatly in her first year under Head Coach Carolyn Kieger. She’s shooting 46.9 percent (113-for-241) from the field this season and was a 36.0 percent (266-for-738) shooter in her three seasons at SMU.

Beverley Blossoming

- Senior transfer Niya Beverley (previously Wisconsin) currently leads the Big Ten and ranks second nationally with a 4.3 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Over the last eight games, Beverley has dished 36 assists compared to just six turnovers in 323 minutes of action.
- She has also turned her scoring up a notch, averaging 13.5 ppg in the last four contests combined. Beverley is shooting 40.0 percent (20-for-50) from three-point range in Big Ten play.
- Beverley was granted immediate eligibility for the start of Big Ten play due to the NCAA’s blanket transfer waiver.

Marisa Coming Into Her Own

- Makenna Marisa has turned her game up a notch in her sophomore season.
- Marisa is currently averaging 14.2 ppg, 4.9 rpg and 4.9 apg compared to her freshman year numbers of 9.2 ppg, 4.5 rpg and 2.7 apg.
- Marisa has gone for 20-plus points on six occasions this season and has tallied 12 double-digit games.
- Marisa is coming off a 21-point, 7-rebounds, 6-assist effort at Nebraska Sunday.

Not Just A TikTok Star

- Sophomore Anna Camden, who has more than 162,000 followers on the popular social media app TikTok, has scored in double figures in six of the last eight games.
- She had just five double-digit games in the first 41 games of her career before her six double-figure efforts in the last three weeks.
- Camden set a new career high for the second straight game with 18 points in Penn State’s game at Iowa last Thursday. She added a Big Ten career-best seven rebounds against the Hawkeyes.

Senior Night Presented By The Penn State Alumni Association

- Nia Staples will be celebrated on Senior Night prior to tipoff of Wednesday’s game against Ohio State.
- Staples will graduate this year with her master’s degree in Counselor Education. Staples transferred to Penn State ahead of the 2019-20 season after graduating from West Virginia in three years with a bachelor’s degree in sport and exercise psychology.
- Staples’ story is one of resilience as the guard has suffered two ACL tears in the same knee during her collegiate career.
- The Cincinnati, Ohio native wrote a heartfelt and moving letter to the sport of basketball titled “Dear Basketball” ahead of Wednesday’s Senior Night. The letter can be found on GoPSUSports.com.

Youngest Team In The Big Ten

- Penn State’s 2020-21 roster features eight freshmen and four transfers who are seeing their first court time in in the Blue and White this season. The eight freshmen, all true freshmen, are tied for the national lead in number of freshmen on Division I rosters. Oral Roberts and Incarnate Word also have eight freshmen on their rosters.
- Penn State is ranked as the ninth-youngest team in Division I, and the youngest in the Big Ten, with an average age of 19.56.
- Penn State has 11 players that have two or less years of Division I playing experience, which equates to 73.3 percent of its roster.

THE OPPOSITION

Scouting Ohio State

- The 15th-ranked Buckeyes carry a 13-4 overall record and 9-4 mark in Big Ten play into Wednesday’s matchup.
- Ohio State currently sits fourth in the tightly-packed Big Ten standings.
- The Buckeyes have lost two of their last three games, dropping a Feb. 10 contest at Wisconsin (70-75) and Feb. 21 game at #11 Michigan (66-75) in their most recent action Sunday.
- All five Buckeyes starters are averaging double-digit points, led by Jacy Sheldon’s 16.9 points per game. Dorca Juhasz follows with 14.9 points and a team-best 11.2 rebounds per game.

Against The Buckeyes

- Penn State leads the all-time series 36-32, but the Buckeyes have won the last 11 matchups.
- Penn State will be looking for its first win over Ohio State since 2014.
- The two teams met last on Jan. 4 when Ohio State claimed an 82-69 victory in Columbus, Ohio.
- Penn State trimmed a 21-point deficit down to single digits with a 20-9 third-quarter run, but Ohio State held on to pull out the 82-69 win in the season’s first meeting.
- Makenna Marisa led Penn State with 21 points and nine rebounds. Kelly Jekot followed with 19 points and six rebounds, while Niya Beverley added 14 points and five boards.

- Penn State has seen significant improvement in a number of statistical categories from the 2019-20 season to thus far this season, despite having one of the youngest teams in the country this year:

Super Sophomores

- Penn State’s three-member sophomore class of Anna Camden, Shay Hagans and Makenna Marisa are the only three players on the PSU roster who had seen court time under Kieger prior to this season, and are being relied upon as key on-court and culture leaders in 2020-21.

Adjusting Without Jekot

- Graduate transfer Kelly Jekot suffered a season-ending injury in practice prior to the Lady Lions’ Jan. 17 game against Northwestern. Jekot was the team’s leader in scoring (15.9 ppg) and minutes played (34.6 mpg), and the team’s second-leading rebounder (6.8 rpg).
- Jekot was relied upon as a key veteran leader for a young Penn State squad.

#IgniteTheCHANGE

- The Penn State women’s basketball team has been highly active in the fight against social injustice.
- The team is wearing Penn State United warm-up shirts this season, as well as holding a moment of silence prior to every home game in remembrance of those who have lost their lives to COVID-19 and racial injustice.
- During quarantine, the initiative of #IgniteTheCHANGE developed as a way for the team to commit to taking purposeful steps every month to ignite change, with the intention of educating themselves and others as well as continuing to spread awareness of social injustice.
- Action items that were spearheaded by the Lady Lions over the offseason included a candle lighting, registering the entire team to vote in the 2020 general election, watching the Netflix documentary “13th” and holding a powerful discussion about the documentary with the women’s soccer team, and participating in a peaceful protest in honor of Breonna Taylor. The team plans to participate in this initiative every month in order to continue the important conversations surrounding social injustice.

HEAD COACH CAROLYN KIEGER

Second Season • Marquette '06

Overall Career Record: 114-98

Penn State Record: 15-34

Penn State and Vice President of Athletics Sandy Barbour announced the selection of Carolyn Kieger as the sixth head coach of the women's basketball program on April 3, 2019. Kieger (pronounced KEY-grr), a 2019 Naismith Women's Coach of the Year Award semifinalist, enters her second season at the helm for the 2020-21 season.

In her first season leading the Lady Lions, Kieger coached Kamaria McDaniel to a First Team All-Big Ten selection as the conference's second-leading scorer with an average of 19.8 points per game, also a top-15 mark in the nation (13). She developed an aggressive up-tempo offense whose speed got the Lady Lions to the charity stripe 555 times during the 2019-20 season.

Kieger, a 2006 Marquette graduate, came to Happy Valley after five years at the helm of her alma mater, posting a 99-64 overall record. During the past three seasons, Kieger led the Golden Eagles to sparkling 76-26 mark (43-11 in Big East), which included a pair of Big East regular-season championships and a Big East Tournament Championship. Marquette made three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in 20 years, advancing to the round of 32 the past two seasons.

Widely regarded as one of the nation's brightest and rising coaching stars, Kieger's first Marquette team in 2014-15 won nine games. She proceeded to lead the Golden Eagles to 14, 25, 24 and a program-record 27 victories over the next four seasons.

Kieger was named a semifinalist for the 2019 Naismith Women's Coach of the Year Award after leading the Golden Eagles to one of the best seasons in program history in 2018-19. Marquette captured its second consecutive, but first-ever outright Big East regular-season title and a posted a school-best 27-8 record. The Golden Eagles were ranked in every Associated Press poll of the season for the first time in school history.

Marquette earned its third-straight NCAA Tournament berth in 2018-19, advancing to the second round for the second consecutive year. The Golden Eagles garnered a No. 5 seed and defeated Rice before dropping a two-point decision at No. 4 seed Texas A&M in the second round. The three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances were Marquette's first since a three-year run from 1997-99.



Kieger mentored Allazia Blockton and Natisha Hiedeman to become Marquette's first Big East Players of the Year in 2017-18 and 2018-19, respectively. Kieger coached nine All-Big East selections in the last three seasons.

The 2017-18 campaign was another banner year as Kieger was named Big East Co-Coach of the Year after guiding the Golden Eagles to a program-record 15-3 conference mark and their first Big East regular season title. Kieger earned her first NCAA Tournament coaching victory with a first-round win over Dayton before falling at No. 1 seed Louisville.

Kieger coached Marquette to new heights in 2016-17 as the Golden Eagles won the Big East Tournament title for the first time in program history, while also earning a program-best No. 5 seed in the NCAA Tournament. She directed MU to the Big Dance for the first time since 2011. Kieger led Marquette to a 25-8 record in 2016-17, finishing with a 6-0 mark against teams ranked in the Top 25.

In her second year at the helm of the Golden Eagles, Kieger had the youngest program in NCAA Division I with eight freshmen on the roster in 2015-16, as MU improved its win total by five games. She made her collegiate head coaching debut on Nov. 15, 2014 against Green Bay and earned her first career victory on Nov. 17, 2014 when Marquette defeated Loyola-Chicago.

Prior to being named head coach at her alma mater, Kieger spent six seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Miami from 2008-14. Following graduation, she was at Miami as the coordinator of basketball operations (2006-07) and then served as director of operations at Marquette in 2007-08.

Kieger returned to Miami as an assistant coach in 2008-09 and was primarily responsible for guard development with the Hurricanes. She helped advance the skills of Miami guard Shenise Johnson, who earned All-America and ACC Player of the Year honors in 2010-11, while the squad was crowned ACC regular-season champions. She also helped guard Riquna Williams earn All-ACC first team accolades and finish as the ACC scoring leader with 21.7 points per game. Miami made three NCAA Tournament appearances and two in the WNIT during Kieger's last five seasons with the Hurricanes.

Kieger was a four-year starter at Marquette, a three-year captain and is MU's all-time assists leader. She is the only player in program history with at least 1,200 career points, 400 career rebounds and 600 assists.
