OPENING TIPS

- Penn State returns from a nine-day layoff when the Lady Lions travel to Princeton Saturday afternoon.
- Penn State is 5-4 on the young season and has won its last two games, including a 78-73 win over Pittsburgh in its most recent contest on Dec. 5. Three of Penn State's wins this season have come over 2019 NCAA Tournament teams.
- Junior Kamaria McDaniel is the Big Ten's leading scorer and ranks 17th nationally with 19.9 points per game. Senior Siyeh Frazier (11.1 ppg) and freshman Makenna Marisa (10.0 ppg) are also averaging double-digit points.

IF PENN STATE BEATS PRINCETON

- Penn State would earn its fourth win this season over 2019 NCAA Tournament teams.
- Penn State would win its third-straight game and improve to 6-4 overall.
- The Lady Lions would snap Princeton's 10-game home winning streak and hand the Tigers just their second loss of the season.

Last Time Out

- Junior Kamaria McDaniel recorded the third 40-point game in school history to lead the Lady Lions to a 78-73 win over Pittsburgh in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge on Dec. 5 at the Bryce Jordan Center.
- A strong second quarter proved to be the separation that Penn State would need as the Lady Lions outscored the Panthers 23-11 in the second frame before holding on in the final minutes for the 78-73 win.
- It marked Penn State's second-straight victory and helped the Big Ten win the Big Ten/ACC Challenge for the first time in the history of the challenge.

Kamaria McBuckets

- Junior Kamaria McDaniel currently leads the Big Ten and ranks 17th nationally with 19.9 points per game.
- The Inkster, Mich. native earned Big Ten Co-Player of the Week honors and a spot on the NCAA Starting Five of the Week after dropping 40 points on Pittsburgh in Penn State's most recent game on Dec. 5.
- McDaniel's 40 points marked a Penn State record in the Bryce Jordan Center and she became the first Lady Lion to put up 40-plus points in a game since former All-American Kelly Mazzante scored a school-record 49 points at Minnesota on Dec. 28, 2001. The only other Penn State player to top 40 points was Jen Bednarek, when she posted 42 points vs. Syracuse in 1979.
- McDaniel has scored in double figures in every game this season and 15-straight games dating back to last year.

Three Wins Over 2019 NCAA Tournament Teams

- Three of Penn State's five wins this season have come against 2019 NCAA Tournament teams.
- The Lady Lions kicked off the season with a 73-67 victory at defending CAA Tournament champ Towson. A tough offensive first half had the Lady Lions trailing by eight early in the second half, but Penn State rallied to outscore the Tigers 25-13 in the third quarter to gain the separation it would need for the 73-67 win. It marked the first win in the Carolyn Kieger era.
- Penn State then picked up a 72-59 win against defending Atlantic 10 champion Fordham on Nov. 13. Penn State shot a then season-best 53.2 percent (25-for-47) from the field against the Rams, highlighted by a blistering 65.2 percent (15-for-23) clip in the second half. It marked the 950th win in program history.
- Penn State fought for a gritty 68-55 win over Clemson on Nov. 21. The Lady Lions held a 14-point halftime lead that was trimmed down to one midway through the third quarter thanks to a 13-0 Clemson run. The Lady Lions responded with a 10-0 streak that would help Penn State out-score the Tigers 28-16 in the final 15 minutes to secure the 68-55 victory.

Finding the Free Throw Line

- Penn State leads the Big Ten and ranks seventh nationally in free throws made (157) and 10th in free throws attempted (221) as of Dec. 12.
- Kamaria McDaniel has found her way to the free throw line the most, attempting a team-best 61 freebies. Her 61 free throw attempts rank 20th in the nation. Freshman Makenna Marisa is shooting a team-best 82.4 percent (28-for-34) from the charity stripe.

Stepping Up Their Game

- Penn State's upperclassmen have stepped their game up in non-conference play as four key members have all recorded career highs in points this season.
- Kamaria McDaniel is coming off back-to-back games of tallying new career highs after she scored 27 against N.C. Central and 40 against Pittsburgh. Coming into this season, her career best was 24 points.
- Alisia Smith put up a career-high 22 points against N.C. Central, besting her previous high of 17 that was set last season.
- Siyeh Frazier scored a career-high 19 in Nov. 13's win over Fordham, while Lauren Ebo tallied a career-high 16 against Clemson on Nov. 21.

950 And Counting

- The Lady Lions earned the 950th victory in program history on Nov. 13 when Penn State beat Fordham 72-59 at the Bryce Jordan Center. The Lady Lions hold an all-time record of 953-486. This is the 56th season of Penn State Women’s Basketball.
- Penn State became the 20th Division I women’s basketball teams to have reached the 950-win mark. The Lady Lions joined Tennessee, UConn, Louisiana Tech, James Madison, Stanford, Texas, Stephen F. Austin, Old Dominion, Ohio State, Green Bay, Western Kentucky, Maryland, Notre Dame, South Dakota State, Georgia, North Carolina, Belmont, Baylor and Kansas State in the 950 win club.

Keep It 100

- Head Coach Carolyn Kieger earned her 100th career head coaching victory with Penn State’s season-opening 73-67 win at Towson on Nov. 5. She came to Penn State with a 99-64 record in five seasons as the head coach at Marquette.

Non-Conference Schedule At A Glance

- Penn State’s non-conference slate features seven home games and seven games against teams that made national postseason tournament appearances a season ago.
- Penn State opened the season against defending CAA champion and NCAA Tournament competitor Towson. The Lady Lions’ next opponent, Rider, made an appearance in the WNIT a season ago. Fordham and Princeton both won their respective conferences and earned berths to the NCAA Tournament. Penn State also faced 2019 NCAA Tournament competitor Clemson, and will take on a Sacred Heart team that reached the WNIT.

SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION

Scouting Princeton

- Princeton, who is receiving votes in the USA Today Coaches Poll, carries a strong 8-1 record into Saturday afternoon’s matchup.
- The Tigers are out-scoring their opponents by an average of 17.7 points per game, and their only loss this season came at the hands of fellow Big Ten member Iowa. The Tigers fell 77-75 in overtime on the road against the Hawkeyes on Nov. 20.
- Bella Alarie is leading the Tigers with 15.2 points and 7.6 rebounds per game, but has missed the last three contests. Carlie Littlefield has chipped in 13.9 points per game, while four other Tigers are averaging seven or more points per contest.
- Princeton won the Ivy League Championship a season ago to earn an NCAA Tournament bid. The Tigers finished 2018-19 22-10 overall and 12-2 in the Ivy League.

Against The Tigers

- Penn State and Princeton will be meeting for the second-straight year. The Lady Lions pulled out a 79-71 overtime victory on Nov. 18, 2018 at the Bryce Jordan Center in the only other meeting between the two teams.
- The Lady Lions rallied from a nine-point fourth-quarter deficit to force overtime against Princeton before outscoring the Tigers 16-8 in the extra frame to earn a gritty 79-71 win.
- Alisia Smith recorded a double-double with 16 points and 11 rebounds, while Siyeh Frazier chipped in 11 points.

Kieger Inks Four Highly-Touted Signees

- Four signees have inked their National Letters of Intent during the November signing period to join the Penn State Women’s Basketball program and head coach Carolyn Kieger in Happy Valley.
- The four-member class is comprised of Maddie Burke (Doylestown, Pa.), Kaci Donovan (Owego, N.Y.), Nan Garcia (Jeffersonville, Ind.) and Leilani Kapinus (Madison, Wis.).
- Kapinus is a five-star recruit that was rated as the No. 8 player at her position and the No. 30 player overall in the recruiting class by ESPN.
- Burke ranked in the top 50 of her class by Preferred Athlete (#27), Blue Star (#39) and Prospect Nation (#48). She has earned All-State honors and first team All-League accolades in all three of her high school seasons.
- Nan Garcia ranked as the No. 24 player at her position by College Girls Basketball Report. She has totaled career numbers of 1,081 points (14.8 ppg), 486 rebounds (6.7 rpg), 138 steals (1.9 spg) and 88 assists (1.2 apg) at Jeffersonville High School.
- Kaci Donovan is a two-time All-State and three-time All-Conference pick from Owego Free Academy. She has tallied 1,456 points (14.1 ppg), 504 rebounds (4.9 rpg), 236 assists (2.3 apg), 229 steals (2.2 spg) and 71 blocks (0.7 bpg) in 103 games played.

Among The NCAA’s Elite

- Penn State is one of only 19 schools with at least 25 NCAA Tournament appearances, joining Tennessee, Georgia, Stanford, Texas, UConn, Louisiana Tech, Vanderbilt, North Carolina, Purdue, LSU, Maryland, Old Dominion, Iowa, Notre Dame, Ohio State, Rutgers, Virginia and NC State.
- Penn State has been to 25 NCAA Tournaments, 13 Sweet Sixteens, four Elite Eights and one Final Four.

A New Era Begins

- Penn State enters its first season under head coach Carolyn Kieger in 2019-20. Kieger, a 2019 Naismith Women’s Coach of the Year Award semifinalist, guided Marquette University to the top of the Big East Conference and three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances as the Golden Eagles’ head coach.
- Kieger, a 2006 Marquette graduate, came to Happy Valley after five years at the helm of her alma mater, posting a 99-64 overall record. During the past three seasons, Kieger led the Golden Eagles to sparkling 76-26 mark (43-11 in Big East), which included a pair of Big East regular-season championships and a Big East Tournament Championship. Marquette made three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in 20 years, advancing to the round of 32 the past two seasons.

Interviews will not be granted on game day prior to tip-off. Player phone numbers will not be released. Following games, requested Penn State student-athletes will be brought to the postgame media interview room. The Penn State locker room is closed.

CREDENTIALS

Single game and season press credentials are issued to accredited members of the working media only. Requests for credentials should be directed to Chelsea Vielhauer at least one week in advance of each game. Press credentials can be picked up at Media Will Call, which is located at the Media/Team entrance, on the south side of the Bryce Jordan Center, across from the Penn State Lacrosse Complex.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

A photo pass must be issued to gain access courtside in the Bryce Jordan Center. Please contact Chelsea Vielhauer one week in advance for photo passes. Courtside photographers must follow NCAA guidelines, which prohibit entry to the bench areas and the stands, and must remain seated at all times.

HEAD COACH CAROLYN KIEGER

First Season • Marquette '06
Overall Career Record: 104-68

Penn State and Vice President of Athletics Sandy Barbour announced the selection of Carolyn Kieger as the sixth head coach of the women's basketball program on April 3, 2019. Kieger (pronounced KEY-grr), a 2019 Naismith Women's Coach of the Year Award semifinalist, guided Marquette University to the top of the Big East Conference and three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances as the Golden Eagles' head coach.

Kieger, a 2006 Marquette graduate, comes to Happy Valley after five years at the helm of her alma mater, posting a 99-64 overall record. During the past three seasons, Kieger led the Golden Eagles to sparkling 76-26 mark (43-11 in Big East), which included a pair of Big East regular-season championships and a Big East Tournament Championship. Marquette made three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in 20 years, advancing to the round of 32 the past two seasons.

Widely regarded as one of the nation's brightest and rising coaching stars, Kieger's first Marquette team in 2014-15 won nine games. She proceeded to lead the Golden Eagles to 14, 25, 24 and a program-record 27 victories over the next four seasons.

Kieger was named a semifinalist for the 2019 Naismith Women's Coach of the Year Award after leading the Golden Eagles to one of the best seasons in program history this past season. Marquette captured its second consecutive, but first-ever outright Big East regular-season title and a posted a school-best 27-8 record. The Golden Eagles were ranked in every Associated Press poll of the season for the first time in school history.

Marquette earned its third-straight NCAA Tournament berth in 2018-19, advancing to the second round for the second consecutive year. The Golden Eagles garnered a No. 5 seed and defeated Rice before dropping a two-point decision at No. 4 seed Texas A&M in the second round. The three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances were Marquette's first since a three-year run from 1997-99.

Kieger mentored Allazia Blockton and Natisha Hiedeman to become Marquette's first Big East Players of the Year in 2017-18 and 2018-19, respectively. Kieger coached nine All-Big East selections in the last three seasons.



The 2017-18 campaign was another banner year as Kieger was named Big East Co-Coach of the Year after guiding the Golden Eagles to a program-record 15-3 conference mark and their first Big East regular season title. Kieger earned her first NCAA Tournament coaching victory with a first-round win over Dayton before falling at No. 1 seed Louisville.

Kieger coached Marquette to new heights in 2016-17 as the Golden Eagles won the Big East Tournament title for the first time in program history, while also earning a program-best No. 5 seed in the NCAA Tournament. She directed MU to the Big Dance for the first time since 2011. Kieger led Marquette to a 25-8 record in 2016-17, finishing with a 6-0 mark against teams ranked in the Top 25.

In her second year at the helm of the Golden Eagles, Kieger had the youngest program in NCAA Division I with eight freshmen on the roster in 2015-16, as MU improved its win total by five games. She made her collegiate head coaching debut on Nov. 15, 2014 against Green Bay and earned her first career victory on Nov. 17, 2014 when Marquette defeated Loyola-Chicago.

Prior to being named head coach at her alma mater, Kieger spent six seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Miami from 2008-14. Following graduation, she was at Miami as the coordinator of basketball operations (2006-07) and then served as director of operations at Marquette in 2007-08.

Kieger returned to Miami as an assistant coach in 2008-09 and was primarily responsible for guard development with the Hurricanes. She helped advance the skills of Miami guard Shenise Johnson, who earned All-America and ACC Player of the Year honors in 2010-11, while the squad was crowned ACC regular-season champions. She also helped guard Riquna Williams earn All-ACC first team accolades and finish as the ACC scoring leader with 21.7 points per game. Miami made three NCAA Tournament appearances and two in the WNIT during Kieger's last five seasons with the Hurricanes.

Kieger was a four-year starter at Marquette, a three-year captain and is MU's all-time assists leader. She is the only player in program history with at least 1,200 career points, 400 career rebounds and 600 assists. Kieger averaged 10.3 points per game during her career and was a second-team All-Big East selection in 2005-06, as well as, a second-team All-Conference USA selection for the 2003-04 and 2004-05 seasons.

During her senior campaign, Kieger was a finalist for the Nancy Lieberman Award, presented to the nation's top point guard. In addition to her athletic accomplishments, Kieger received the Big East Conference's Sportsmanship award as a senior.

A native of Roseville, Minnesota, Kieger graduated Cum Laude from Marquette with a bachelor's degree in broadcasting and electronic communications in 2006. She received the McCahill Award in 2007, presented to a graduated MU senior student-athlete who demonstrated the highest performance in scholarship, leadership and athletics.
