OPENING TIPS

- Penn State returns to the Bryce Jordan Center to begin a four-game homestand Sunday when the Nittany Lions welcome Canisius for a noon non-conference tilt.
- Penn State is 7-3 on the season and coming off its largest road win against a ranked Big Ten team in program history last Saturday, a 74-59 win at #17 Illinois.
- Jalen Pickett leads Penn State in scoring (16.2 ppg), rebounds (7.7 rpg) and assists (7.5 apg) and is the only player in the country averaging 16/7/7. Seth Lundy (14.1 ppg), Andrew Funk (11.0 ppg) & Camren Wynter (10.3 ppg) also average double-digit points.

IF PENN STATE BEATS CANISIUS

- Penn State would move to 4-0 all-time against the Golden Griffins.
- The Nittany Lions would improve to 5-1 at home this season.
- Penn State would improve to 17-6 all-time against current members of the MAAC.

BIG RANKED ROAD WIN

Penn State returns to action Sunday against Canisius for the first time since the Nittany Lions picked up their largest road win against a ranked Big Ten team in program history last Saturday when Penn State defeated #17 Illinois 74-59 in Champaign.

The Nittany Lions handed #17 Illinois its first home loss of the season and its largest loss of the season. The Illini, who were coming off a win over then-No. 2 Texas, had not lost a game by double-digits this season. Penn State controlled a nine-point halftime lead and held off several Illinois runs in the second half while shooting 50.0 percent (12-24) from 3-point range to earn the dominant road win.

Andrew Funk and Jalen Pickett scored 20 points apiece to lead four Nittany Lions in double figures. Funk was 6-for-9 from deep while Pickett added seven rebounds and six assists to round out his strong overall performance. Seth Lundy finished with 16 points and seven rebounds while Myles Dread nailed five triples for 15 points.

Penn State is off to a 7-3 start to the 2022-23 season. Four of the Nittany Lions' seven wins have come over teams currently ranked in the top 100 of the KenPom rankings, and Penn State's three losses were a two-point neutral-site defeat to Virginia Tech, a double-overtime road loss at Clemson, and a loss to Michigan State in a game that was a one-possession contest until the final two minutes.

The Nittany Lions opened the season with a pair of 25-point wins over Winthrop (93-68) and Loyola Maryland (90-65). Penn State earned a pair of closer victories over Butler (68-62) and Furman (73-68) before falling to the Hokies (59-61) in the Nittany Lions' first loss of the season. Penn State bounced back with wins over Colorado State (68-56) and Lafayette (70-57) before falling in double-overtime at Clemson (94-101) in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge and dropping the Big Ten opener to Michigan State (58-67). The Nittany Lions bounced back in a big way on Dec. 10, taking down #17 Illinois on the road (74-59) in dominant fashion.

THE THREE IS KEY

Penn State ranks third in the nation with 11.7 3-pointers made per game. The Nittany Lions are shooting the long ball at a 40.2 percent (117-291) clip, a mark that ranks 13th in the country.

The 3-point line has existed in the college game for 36 years. Heading into this season, Penn State had never made more than 15 3-pointers in a single game, but the Nittany Lions did so twice in the first two games of the season. Penn State drilled a program-record 18 3-pointers in the Nov. 7 season opener against Winthrop, besting the previous school mark of 15 that was reached on three occasions. The Nittany Lions followed that up with 16 treys on Nov. 10 against Loyola Maryland.

Penn State has made double-digit 3-pointers in eight of its 10 games this season.

THE MAESTRO

Preseason All-Big Ten selection Jalen Pickett is the only player in the country currently averaging at least 16 points per game, 7 rebounds per game and 7 assists per game. The point guard is averaging 16.2 points, 7.7 rebounds and 7.5 assists per game while shooting 47.8 percent (66-138) from the field through the first 10 games of the season.

Pickett ranks fourth in the country with a conference-best 7.5 assists per game and his 3.95 assist-to-turnover ratio is the sixth-best in the nation.

He has proven to be one of the best all-around guards in the Big Ten and currently ranks in the top 10 of the conference in scoring (6th), rebounding (8th) and assists (1st). He's recorded a triple-double and three double-doubles through 10 games this season.

He put together the second triple-double and first points-rebounds-assists triple-double in Penn State history Nov. 14 against Butler with his 15 points, 10 rebounds and 11 assists. Penn State's only other triple-double came in 1998 when all-time great Calvin Booth tallied 19 points, 10 rebounds and 10 blocks against Dayton in an NIT game. Pickett's triple-double was just the eighth turnover-free triple-double by a collegiate player in the last four seasons. 2021.

ELITE EFFICIENCY FOR LUNDY

Senior Seth Lundy is producing at an elite level on both ends of the floor through the first 10 games of the season. The Paulsboro, N.J. native is the only player in the Big Ten that is averaging more 10 points and 6 rebounds per game while shooting at least 60% from 2-point range, 40% from 3-point range and 75% from the charity stripe.

Lundy is averaging 14.1 points and 6.8 rebounds per game while shooting 67.6% from two, 43.8% from three and 78.0% from the free throw line.

Lundy has scored in double figures in nine of 10 games this season. In addition to his offensive consistency, Lundy serves as one of the team's top defenders and is consistently tasked with guarding the opposing team's best players.

1-2 PUNCH

Penn State's duo of Myles Dread and Andrew Funk have provided a lethal 1-2 punch on the perimeter as they both rank in the top three in the Big Ten in both 3-point field goal percentage and 3-pointers made per game.

Myles Dread (2.7 3-pointers/game) leads the Big Ten in 3-point field goal percentage, converting his looks from deep at a 47.4 percent clip that is 21st in the nation. Andrew Funk has made a Big Ten-best 2.8 3-pointers per contest at a 40.6 percent clip. The two combined for 11 3-pointers in Penn State recent road win at #17 Illinois.

1,500/500/500

Jalen Pickett (1,714 points, 583 rebounds, 673 assists) and Camren Wynter (1,760 points, 518 rebounds, 596 assists) are two of just three active Division I players with career marks of 1,500+ points, 500+ rebounds and 500+ assists.

Wyoming's Hunter Maldonado (1,829 points, 705 rebounds, 547 assists) is the only other active DI player to have reached the multi-faceted achievement.

TWO OF THE TOP SEVEN

Jalen Pickett and Camren Wynter rank No. 2 and No. 7 respectively in career assists amongst active Division I players. Pickett owns 673 assists while Wynter has 596.

90+

Penn State's 90 points against Loyola Maryland and 93 points against Winthrop marked the first time since December 2016 that Penn State scored 90 points in back-to-back games (92 in win over St. John's on Dec. 18, 2016 and 96 in win over Morgan State on Dec. 21, 2016).

SHARING THE ROCK

The Nittany Lions have tallied 15 or more assists in six of their 10 games this season after reaching the 15-assist mark just six times all of last season.

Penn State dished 21 assists on Nov. 10 against Loyola Maryland after tallying 24 in the Nov. 7 season opener against Winthrop. It marked the first time Penn State has recorded 20-plus assists in back-to-back games since Jan. 2, 2018 (20 at Maryland) and Dec. 30, 2017 (22 vs. Coppin State).

BEWARE OF THE BACKCOURT

Penn State boasts a strong and experienced backcourt for the 2022-23 season. The six upperclassmen of Jalen Pickett, Myles Dread, Andrew Funk, Dallion Johnson, Seth Lundy and Camren Wynter have combined for 6,843 career points, 2,266 career rebounds and 1,751 career assists throughout their collegiate careers.

THE OPPOSITION

SCOUTING CANISIUS

- The Golden Griffins are 2-7 on the season and 0-2 in MAAC conference action.
- Canisius' two wins this season have come against St. Bonaventure (84-80 OT) on Nov. 12 and Fredonia (98-52) on Nov. 20.
- The Golden Griffins will be playing their sixth-straight road game when they travel to Happy Valley Sunday. Canisius is 0-5 in road games thus far this season.
- Tahj Staveskie leads Canisius with 13.7 points per game and 3.2 assists per contest.
- Jordan Henderson (12.9 ppg) and Jamir Moultrie (12.1 ppg) are also averaging double-digit points for Canisius.

AGAINST THE GOLDEN GRIFFINS

- The Nittany Lions own a 3-0 all-time record against Canisius and the two programs are set to meet for the first time since 2015.
- Penn State earned an 81-67 win over the Golden Griffins in the most recent meeting on Dec. 10, 2015 inside the Bryce Jordan Center.
- The teams first met in the 1995 NIT consolation game, a 66-62 Penn State win Madison Square Garden on March 29, 1995.

THE CAPTAINS

Four Nittany Lions were elected as captains for the 2022-23 season. Jalen Pickett, Seth Lundy, Myles Dread and Andrew Funk will each hold the captain title this season.

Coach Shrewsberry had this to say about his four captains: "Jalen, Seth, Andrew and Myles have each been great leaders for our program throughout the summer and fall. Not only have they served as on-court leaders for their teammates, but each of them has also helped drive and enforce the culture of our program. All four of them play an important role for our team this year and are very deserving of the captain title."

BACK-TO-BACK TOP 30 CLASSES

Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry has signed his second-straight top-30 recruiting class, as three highly-touted signees inked their National Letters of Intent on National Signing Day Nov. 9.

Penn State's three-member class currently ranks 24th in the nation according to 247 sports and 27th according to ESPN. It marks the first time in program history that the Nittany Lions have signed back-to-back top-30 recruiting classes, both of which have come under Shrewsberry.

The three-member class is comprised of Carey Booth (Englewood, Colo.), Logan Imes (Zionsville, Ind.) and Braeden Shrewsberry (State College, Pa.).

Booth is an ESPN Top 100 recruit (No. 75), and ranked as the No. 15 power forward in his class per 247 Sports. He is the second-highest ranked recruit in program history behind Tony Carr and the highest-ranked recruit of Shrewsberry's tenure. Booth is Shrewsberry's second ESPN Top 100 signee (also Kebba Njie).

Imes is an ESPN four-star prospect who ranks as the No. 24 combo guard in the 2023 class and No. 6 overall player in the state of Indiana per 247 Sports.

Braeden Shrewsberry, Micah's oldest son, is an ESPN four-star prospect and ranked as the No. 33 shooting guard in the 2023 class and No. 4 player in the state of Pennsylvania per 247 Sports.

YEAR TWO

Penn State enters its second season under head coach Micah Shrewsberry in 2022-23. Shrewsberry came to Penn State with a wealth of experience and success at both the collegiate and NBA levels, having coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs and two NBA Conference Finals.

Shrewsberry immediately put his stamp on the Nittany Lion program during his first season at the helm. He engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense in 2021-22 and guided the Nittany Lions to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in 11 years. The Nittany Lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games. The regular season saw Penn State earn a number of statement wins, including victories over 19th-ranked Michigan State, Big Ten Tournament champion Iowa, and NCAA Tournament participants Indiana and Rutgers.

CORE RETURNEES

An experienced group of returnees headline the 2022-23 roster as Penn State returns four starters and eight letterwinners from the 2021-22 campaign.

The Nittany Lions' 2021-22 leading scorer returns in Jalen Pickett. The guard led Penn State in scoring (13.3 ppg), assists (135), steals (35) and minutes played (37.2 mpg) a season ago. Senior Seth Lundy is coming off a 2021-22 season in which he finished as the team's second-leading scorer (11.9 ppg) and third-leading rebounder (4.9 ppg) while emerging as the team's top defender.

Myles Dread sits in the top five in program history in career 3-pointers made and returns to utilize the extra year of eligibility granted by the NCAA due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Penn State also returns junior Dallion Johnson who broke into the starting lineup for the final 14 games of the 2021-22 season, in addition to classmate Caleb Dorsey.

TRANSFER HAUL

The Nittany Lions added three highly-accomplished graduate transfers this spring who brought 3,666 career points, 1,236 career rebounds and 901 career assists to Happy Valley.

Guards Andrew Funk (Bucknell) and Camren Wynter (Drexel) each averaged double-digit points in their final three seasons at their respective previous institutions and are primed to bolster an already strong backcourt. Forward Mikey Henn (Denver) will add experience to an otherwise young frontcourt.

HIGHEST-RANKED CLASS IN PROGRAM HISTORY

Penn State's five-man freshman class, Shrewsberry's first recruiting class, is the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history and ranks as a consensus top-30 class in the nation by all major recruiting services.

The five-man class is comprised of guards Jameel Brown (Philadelphia, Pa.), Kanye Clary (Virginia Beach, Va.), wing Evan Mahaffey (Cincinnati, Ohio), and forwards Demetrius Lilley (Philadelphia, Pa.) and Kebba Njie (Centerville, Ohio).

DE-FENSE!

The Nittany Lions led the Big Ten in scoring defense a season ago, allowing just 65.0 points per game. Penn State's mark of 66.2 points allowed per conference game also led the Big Ten.

Penn State's 65.0 points per game allowed was its best defensive mark since the 2010-11 team surrendered just 62.5 points per contest.

THE 2022-23 SLATE

Penn State hosts 16 home games inside the Bryce Jordan Center to highlight the 2022-23 schedule.

The Nittany Lions played their first three games of the season at home before heading to the Charleston Classic for three tournament contests. Penn State's only true road game of non-conference play comes on Nov. 29 in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge at Clemson.

The Nittany Lions open conference play at home on Dec. 7 when Penn State hosts Michigan State. Five weekend games inside the Bryce Jordan Center highlight the Nittany Lions' home conference slate, while Penn State will also host Purdue in the historic Palestra on Sunday, Jan. 8.

BACK TO PHILLY

Penn State makes its return to the historic Palestra on Sunday, Jan. 8, when the Nittany Lions host Purdue in the City of Brotherly Love. General public tickets for the contest are already sold out.

The Nittany Lions have won both Big Ten games they've previously hosted in the "Cathedral of College Basketball", defeating Michigan State in 2017 and Iowa in 2020. Penn State has played 60 total games in The Palestra dating back to 1927.

The 2022-23 Nittany Lion roster includes several student-athletes with Philadelphia-area ties including Seth Lundy (Paulsboro, N.J.; Roman Catholic), Jameel Brown (Philadelphia, Pa.; Westtown School), Andrew Funk (Warrington, Pa.; Archbishop Wood), Demetrius Lilley (Philadelphia, Pa.; Lower Merion) and Camren Wynter (transfer from Drexel.)

PETER AND ANN TOMBROS ENDOWED HEAD COACH

MICAH SHREWSBERRY

Micah Shrewsberry was announced as the 14th men's basketball head coach in Penn State history on March 15, 2021, and enters his second season on Happy Valley in 2022-23. Shrewsberry came to Penn State with a wealth of experience and success at both the collegiate and NBA levels, having coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs, and two NBA Conference Finals.

Shrewsberry immediately put his stamp on the Nittany Lion program during his first season at the helm. He engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense in 2021-22 and guided the Nittany Lions to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in 11 years. The Nittany Lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games. The regular season saw Penn State earn a number of statement wins, including victories over 19th-ranked Michigan State, Big Ten Tournament champion Iowa, and NCAA Tournament participants Indiana and Rutgers.

Shrewsberry's efforts on the recruiting trail were felt immediately as he and the Penn State staff signed the highest ranked recruiting class in Penn State men's basketball history in November 2021, less than eight months into his tenure in Happy Valley. The 2022 signing class ranks as a consensus top-30 class in the nation by all major recruiting services.

Prior to Penn State, Shrewsberry spent the previous two seasons with Big Ten foe Purdue as the associate head coach. As the offensive coordinator, Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a fourth-place finish with a 13-6 Big Ten record in 2020-21. Purdue finished with an 18-9 overall mark and earned an NCAA Tournament berth in 2021. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections.

Before his time at Purdue, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018. Under Shrewsberry, Boston ranked sixth in the NBA in 3-pointers made and seventh in 3-point field goal percentage in the 2018-19 season and was second in 3-point field goal percentage in 2017-18, behind the NBA champion Golden State Warriors.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of current NBA stars Jaylen Brown and Jayson Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors. Shrewsberry was also an assistant coach in the 2017 NBA All-Star Game.

Shrewsberry's first stint as an assistant coach at Purdue spanned the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons where he helped the Boilers reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament. He played an integral role in helping Purdue's offense lead the country in fewest turnovers per game with 8.74 in 2011-12. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the Big Ten in 2011-12, improving his field goal percentage by nearly 13 percent and upping his scoring average by more than five points per game from his freshman to sophomore year.

The Indianapolis native spent four seasons at Butler University under head coach Brad Stevens. He started his time with the Bulldogs as the coordinator of basketball operations before serving as an assistant coach for three seasons. With Shrewsberry on the bench, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles, and made three NCAA Tournament appearances.

During Shrewsberry's time at Butler, the Bulldogs reached the 2010 and 2011 National Championship games. He aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year in 2010 and on the Final Four All-Tournament Team in 2010. Hayward was selected as the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz.

Shrewsberry was the head coach at Indiana University-South Bend from 2005-07. He served as the Chicagoland Collegiate Athletic Conference (CCAC) Division I Men's Basketball Chair in 2006-07. In his second season at the helm, the Titans showed a nine-game improvement from his inaugural season.

He was also the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

As player, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain at Hanover College. He led the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference in free throw shooting (.833) and assists (4.4) in 1998-99.

Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree in sports management from Indiana State in 2003. He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.

PENN STATE DRILLS PROGRAM-RECORD 18 3-POINTERS IN OPENING NIGHT WIN

Penn State drained a program-record 18 3-pointers en route to a dominant 93-68 victory over Winthrop in the 2022-23 season opener at the Bryce Jordan Center.

Penn State put together a dominant offensive effort to the tune of 93 points, its most in a single game since putting up 95 against Nebraska on Feb. 19, 2019. The Nittany Lions' single-game record 18 3-pointers came on a blistering 47.4 percent (18-38) clip from beyond the arc.

Guard Jalen Pickett led Penn State with 23 points on 9-of-13 shooting, five rebounds and five assists. Guard Andrew Funk drilled six three points and shot 8-for-12 from the field to put up 22 points in his Penn State debut. Myles Dread (12) and Seth Lundy (10) also finished in double figures. A total of 10 Nittany Lions scored in the balanced team effort.

The Nittany Lions had 24 assists on 33 made field goals, their most since recording 24 against Central Connecticut State on Dec. 20, 2019.

The Nittany Lions shot 55.0 percent (33-for-60) from the field, their best single-game field goal percentage since shooting 60.0 percent against Bucknell on Nov. 19, 2019.

Penn State scored 28 points off 17 Winthrop turnovers. The Nittany Lion defense collected eight steals and five blocks.

WELL-BALANCED TEAM EFFORT LEADS NITTANY LIONS TO 90-65 WIN

Penn State got contributions from up and down the lineup in another highly-efficient offensive performance as the Nittany Lions took down Loyola University Maryland 90-65 inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

Eleven different Nittany Lions scored as Penn State shot a blistering 57.9 percent (33-57) from the field and 53.5 percent (16-30) from 3-point range. The Penn State bench contributed 46 points in the full-team effort.

Camren Wynter led the Nittany Lions with 18 points, while Myles Dread and Kebba Njie each had 12 and Seth Lundy chipped in 10. Jalen Pickett facilitated all night long, dishing 11 of Penn State's 21 assists.

Penn State raced out to an early lead before the Greyhounds pulled within two at 21-19 with 8:49 left in the first-half clock. A trio of Myles Dread 3-pointers helped the Nittany Lions answer with a 14-4 streak over the next 5:39 and Penn State never looked back as it cruised to the 25-point win.

Penn State's 90 points against Loyola Maryland and 93 points in the season opener marks the first time since December 2016 that Penn State has scored 90 points in back-to-back games (92 in win over St. John's on Dec. 18, 2016 and 96 in win over Morgan State on Dec. 21, 2016). Penn State shot 70.4 percent (19-27) from the field in the second half. It marks the first time that the Nittany Lions have shot over 70 percent in a half since Jan. 15, 2018 against Northwestern (70.8%).

PENN STATE TAKES DOWN BUTLER 68-62 IN GAVITT TIPOFF GAMES

Penn State earned a hard-fought 68-62 win over Butler in the Gavitt Tipoff Games to move to 3-0 on the season inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

Senior+ guard Jalen Pickett recorded just the second triple-double in Penn State history, finishing with 15 points, 10 rebounds and 11 assists. It marks the first triple-double for a Nittany Lion since all-time great Calvin Booth had 19 points, 10 rebounds and 10 blocks in the NIT at Dayton on March 16, 1998.

Penn State's defense set the tone for the victory as the Nittany Lions held Butler to a 34.3 percent (23-for-67) mark from the field and 21.7 percent (5-for-23) clip from 3-point range. The Nittany Lions out-rebounded the Bulldogs 40-36 and held a 30-24 edge in points in the paint.

Pickett led the Nittany Lions offensively, while senior guards Andrew Funk and Camren Wynter added 11 points apiece and Seth Lundy chipped in 10.

The Nittany Lions have now shot 44-for-92 (47.8%) from 3-point range through the first three games.

Penn State moves to 3-0 for the first time since the 2019-20 season. The Nittany Lions are now 3-1 all-time in Gavitt Tipoff Games matchups. The Nittany Lions evened the all-time series with Butler at 2-2.

PENN STATE HOLDS OFF FURMAN FOR 73-68 WIN IN CHARLESTON CLASSIC OPENER

Penn State men's fended off a furious Furman comeback attempt as the Nittany Lions earned a 73-68 win over the Paladins in the opening game of the Charleston Classic at TD Arena.

The Nittany Lions got off to a hot start and led by as much as 21 in the first half. Furman heated up in the second half, slowly chipping away at the Penn State lead until it was a one-point game in the final two minutes. The Penn State defense held on, however, and added four clutch points from Seth Lundy in the final 1:22 to close out the 73-68 victory.

Lundy finished with 20 points and a team-best seven rebounds, while senior+ guard Jalen Pickett finished with 20 points and team-best seven assists. Myles Dread knocked down three triples for nine points.

Penn State moved to 4-0 to start the season 4-0 for the first time since the 2019-20 season.

The Penn State defense held Furman to a 42.2 percent mark from the field and 32.4 percent clip from downtown. The Paladins came into the game averaging 90.0 points per game with a 55.9 FG%.

Jalen Pickett notched his second 20-point game of the season. He started the game 7-for-7 from the floor, not missing a shot until the 17:18 mark of the second half.

Seth Lundy tallied his first 20-point game of the season.

NITTANY LIONS COME UP JUST SHORT IN 61-59 LOSS TO VIRGINIA TECH

Penn State trimmed a 16-point deficit down to two and had a chance to win the game at the end, but RV/RV Virginia Tech held on in the final seconds to hand the Nittany Lions their first loss of the season, 61-59, in the Charleston Classic semifinal round at TD Arena.

The Hokies got out to a 16-point lead just 10 minutes into the game, but Penn State chipped away and made it one-possession game in the final four minutes.

NITTANY LIONS CRUISE TO 68-56 WIN OVER COLORADO STATE

Penn State used a dominating defensive effort to take down Colorado State 68-56 in the third-place game of the Charleston Classic at TD Arena.

The Nittany Lions set the tone from the start, jumping out to a 13-0 lead and never letting the Rams closer than six in the wire-to-wire victory. The Penn State defense held Colorado State to a season-low 56 points, 18.2 points below the 74.2 ppg average the Rams entered the game with.

Senior Seth Lundy led the Nittany Lions with 17 points and added eight rebounds. Senior+ Jalen Pickett recorded a double-double with 16 points and 11 rebounds. Senior+ Camren Wynter added nine points, while senior+ Andrew Funk and freshman Kebba Njie each tallied eight.

Pickett earned a spot on the Charleston Classic All-Tournament team after averaging 15.0 ppg, 7.3 rpg and 6.0 apg through the three tournament contests.

The Nittany Lion defense limited the Rams to a 32.8% (21-64) mark from the field and 20.0% clip (6-30) from downtown.

Seth Lundy finished with a game-high 17 points on 6-of-10 shooting. He added eight rebounds and a steal. Jalen Pickett notched his second double-double in the last four games with 16 points and 11 rebounds.

Penn State held a 12-2 edge in fast-break points.

PENN STATE TAKES DOWN LAFAYETTE, 70-57

Penn State improved to 6-1 on the season with a 70-57 win over Lafayette on Black Friday inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

The Nittany Lions used a 38-12 run from the 5:18 mark of the first half to the 7:34 mark of the second half to find the separation they would need to pull away from the Leopards. Penn State was stellar defensively after finding its footing in the early going as Lafayette shot just 22.2 percent (8-36) from the field in the game's final 26 minutes.

Jalen Pickett led Penn State with 18 points to go along with eight assists and six rebounds. Seth Lundy tallied 15 points and seven rebounds. Camren Wynter chipped in 11 points to round out the double-digit scorers.

Penn State got off to a slow start, finding itself down 19-12 just under eight minutes into the game before a Dallion Johnson 3-pointer at the 12:35 mark sparked a 33-16 Nittany Lion run to close the first half. The Nittany Lions shot 61.9 percent (13-21) from the field and 50 percent (5-10) from downtown in the final 12:35 of the half, while the Penn State defense thwarted Lafayette's hot start to limit the Leopards to just 16 points in the final 12-plus minutes as Penn State controlled a 42-32 lead heading into the locker room.

Penn State was red hot to open the second half as the Nittany Lions spent the first 5:16 of the term on a 15-2 run to stretch their lead to 57-34. The PSU defense kept the Leopards scoreless for a 6-minute stretch during the streak, while five different Nittany Lions scored to put the game out of reach for Lafayette. The Leopards wouldn't get closer than 17 until there were less than four minutes to play and Lafayette scored the game's final 10 points, but Penn State walked away with the 70-57 win.

PENN STATE FALLS IN DOUBLE-OVERTIME HEARTBREAKER AT CLEMSON

Penn State rallied from a seven-point deficit in the final 51 seconds of regulation and graduate student Andrew Funk banked in a game-tying 3-pointer to force overtime, but the Nittany Lions eventually fell 101-94 in double-overtime at Clemson in the ACC/Big Ten Men's Basketball Challenge presented by Continental Tire.

Graduate student Camren Wynter led Penn State with 26 points with the help of an 11-for-12 effort from the free throw line. Jalen Pickett finished with 23 points, eight assists and seven rebounds, while Seth Lundy tallied a double-double with 23 points and 12 rebounds.

Penn State had three players (Wynter 26, Lundy 23, Pickett 23) finish with 20-plus points for the first time since Dec. 20, 2006 against VMI (Claxton, Cornley, Hassell).

The double-overtime game was Penn State's first since Jan. 31, 2022 when the Nittany Lions defeated Iowa 90-86 in double-overtime at the Bryce Jordan Center.

The Nittany Lions shot 86.2 percent (25-29) from the free throw line. Clemson shot 50.8 percent (32-63) from the field and 52.4 percent (11-21) from 3-point range compared to Penn State's 40.8 FG% (29-71) and 30.6 3FG% (11-36).

The Nittany Lions are now 11-11 all-time in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge.

NITTANY LIONS EARN GUTSY 74-59 ROAD WIN AT NO. 17 ILLINOIS

A gutsy team effort and strong three-point shooting performance led the Penn State men's basketball team to a 74-59 road win at No. 17 Illinois. Penn State controlled a nine-point halftime lead and held off several Illinois runs in the second half while shooting 50.0 percent (12-24) from 3-point range to earn the dominant road win.

Andrew Funk and Jalen Pickett scored 20 points apiece to lead four Nittany Lions in double figures. Funk was 6-for-9 from deep while Pickett added seven rebounds and six assists to round out his strong overall performance. Seth Lundy finished with 16 points and seven rebounds while Myles Dread nailed five triples for 15 points.

Penn State's 15-point win at #17 Illinois marked its largest margin of victory in a true road win against a ranked Big Ten team in program history. Penn State's previous largest margin of victory in a true road win at a ranked Big Ten team came in 1999, a 78-70 victory at #17/18 Purdue.

Penn State defeated a top-20 Big Ten team on the road for the first time since Feb. 4, 2020 (75-70 at #16 Michigan State). Penn State earned its first true road win since Jan. 5, 2022 (74-70 at Northwestern).

The Nittany Lions handed #17 Illinois its first home loss of the season and its largest loss of the season. The Illini, who just beat #2 Texas Tuesday, have not lost a game by double-digits this season.

The Penn State defense held Illinois (59) 22.3 points below its season scoring average of 81.3 ppg. The Nittany Lions limited the high-flying Illini to a 44.2 percent (23-52) mark from the field and 30.4 percent (7-23) clip from deep.

After shooting an uncharacteristically low 30.2 percent (19-63) from 3-point range in the last two games combined against Clemson and Michigan State, Penn State shot 50.0 percent (12-24) from downtown in the win over Illinois. It marked the second time this season the Nittany Lions have finished the game 50 percent or better from deep.

NITTANY LIONS DROP BIG TEN OPENER TO MICHIGAN STATE

A cold-shooting second half doomed the Penn State men's basketball team as the Nittany Lions fell 67-58 to RV/RV Michigan State in the Big Ten opener at the Bryce Jordan Center.

The back-and-forth battle saw 12 lead changes and four tie scores and was a one-possession contest until the final two minutes. Penn State entered the game leading the nation in 3-pointers made per game, but went cold in the second half, shooting just 1-for-9 from deep in the final 20 minutes.

Seth Lundy finished with a team-best 16 points. Jalen Pickett recorded 13 points, a career-best 17 rebounds and eight assists. Camryn Wynter also finished in double figures with 10 points, away with the 70-57 win.

Penn State broke open an early 4-4 tie with a 14-2 run to surge out to an early 16-6 lead less than eight minutes into the game. The Spartans slowly clawed back over the remainder of the opening half as Penn State was just 6-for-15 from the field in the final 12:19. MSU momentarily took the lead in the final minute before a Pickett layup knotted the score at 35 heading into halftime.

The teams traded leads and neither team led by more than three in the first 13 minutes of the second half until a Tyson Walker 3-point capped a 7-2 Spartan stretch that put MSU ahead 56-52 with 6:51 to play. Penn State was back within two at 56-54 and 58-56, but a Joey Hauser layup sparked a 9-2 Spartan run in the game's final 2:22. Penn State went 0-for-4 in the final two minutes and the Spartans sealed the contest with a 7-for-9 showing at the charity stripe to leave Happy Valley with the 67-58 victory.
