### OPENING TIPS

- Penn State heads to Michigan for its first Big Ten road battle of the season on New Year's Eve.
- Penn State is 6-6 overall and coming off a tough 81-74 loss to Minnesota on Saturday in the Big Ten opener. Three of Penn State's wins this season have come over 2019 NCAA Tournament teams.
- Junior Kamaria McDaniel is the Big Ten's second-leading scorer with 19.1 points per game. Senior Siyeh Frazier (12.5 ppg) and freshman Makenna Marisa (10.6 ppg) are also averaging double-digit points.

### IF PENN STATE BEATS MICHIGAN

- Penn State would snap its three-game skid against the Wolverines and beat Michigan for the first time since Feb. 26, 2017.
- The Lady Lions would pick up their first win in Ann Arbor since Jan. 21, 2013 when Penn State defeated Michigan 59-49.

**Last Time Out**

- It was a tale of two halves in the Bryce Jordan Center Saturday afternoon as Penn State found itself down by 35 points to red-hot Minnesota, but the Lady Lions put together a valiant comeback attempt that fell just short in an 81-74 conference-opening loss to the Gophers.
- Minnesota led by as much as 35 points at 49-14 in the second quarter. Penn State out-scored the Gophers 53-27 in the second half to pull all the way back within single digits.
- Junior Kamaria McDaniel led the way for Penn State with 31 points. Senior Siyeh Frazier chipped in a career-best 21 points to go along with nine rebounds and three assists. Freshman Makenna Marisa added 12 points, while sophomore Lauren Ebo hauled in a team-best 10 rebounds.

**Kamaria McBuckets**

- Junior Kamaria McDaniel is the Big Ten’s second-leading scorer and averaging 19.1 points per game. That marks ranks 29th in all of Division I as of Dec. 29.
- The Inkster, Mich. native has tallied four 20-plus point efforts this season and has scored in double figures in 11 of Penn State’s 12 games.
- She dropped the third 40-point game in program history against Pittsburgh on Dec. 5 and is coming off a 31-point performance against Minnesota in the Big Ten opener.
- McDaniel has transformed into the team’s go-to scorer after averaging 9.7 points per game a season ago as a sophomore.

**Siyeh Stuffing The Stat Sheet**

- Senior Siyeh Frazier has proven she can do it all this season, as the Detroit native is averaging 12.5 points per game in addition to a team-best 7.0 rebounds per contest.
- Frazier also leads the team with 30 steals and ranks second with 35 assists.
- The guard has notched eight double-digit scoring games while leading the team in scoring in six contests.
- She is coming off a career night against Minnesota in Saturday’s Big Ten opener as she tallied a career-best 21 points to go along with nine rebounds.

**Finding the Free Throw Line**

- Penn State leads the Big Ten and ranks sixth nationally in free throws made (202) and 11th in free throws attempted (281) as of Dec. 29.
- Kamaria McDaniel has found her way to the free throw line the most, attempting a team-best 78 freebies. Her 78 free throw attempts rank 15th in the nation. Freshman Makenna Marisa is shooting a team-best 82.5 percent (33-for-40) from the charity stripe.

**This Is BIG**

- Penn State enters its 28th season as a member of the Big Ten Conference and has enjoyed immense success since becoming a member of the storied conference in 1992-93.
- The Lady Lions own a winning record against nine of the 13 other Big Ten programs. Penn State owns an all-time mark of 273-176 in Big Ten play, with marks of 163-63 at home and 110-113 on the road.
- Penn State’s eight regular-season championships since joining the conference in 1992-93 are the second-most won by any Big Ten team during that span. The Lady Lions also own a pair of Big Ten Tournament titles, winning in 1995 and 1996.

**Three Wins Over 2019 NCAA Tournament Teams**

- Three of Penn State’s six wins this season have come against 2019 NCAA Tournament teams.
- The Lady Lions kicked off the season with a 73-67 victory at defending CAA Tournament champ Towson. It marked the first win in the Carolyn Kieger era.
- Penn State then picked up a 72-59 win against defending Atlantic 10 champion Fordham on Nov. 13. It marked the 950th win in program history.
- Penn State fought for a gritty 68-55 win over Clemson on Nov. 21. Penn State out-scored the Tigers 28-16 in the final 15 minutes to secure the win.

**Stepping Up Their Game**

- Penn State’s upperclassmen have stepped their game up in the first 12 games of the season as four key members have all recorded career highs in points.
- Kamaria McDaniel scored a career-best 40 points against Pittsburgh. Coming into this season, her career best was 24 points.
- Alisia Smith put up a career-high 22 points against N.C. Central, besting her previous high of 17 that was set last season.
- Siyeh Frazier scored a career-high 21 against Minnesota in the Dec. 28 Big Ten opener.
- Lauren Ebo tallied a career-high 16 against Clemson on Nov. 21.

**950 And Counting**

- The Lady Lions earned the 950th victory in program history on Nov. 13 when Penn State beat Fordham 72-59 at the Bryce Jordan Center. The Lady Lions hold an all-time record of 954-488. This is the 56th season of Penn State Women’s Basketball.
- Penn State became the 20th Division I women’s basketball teams to have reached the 950-win mark. The Lady Lions joined Tennessee, UConn, Louisiana Tech, James Madison, Stanford, Texas, Stephen F. Austin, Old Dominion, Ohio State, Green Bay, Western Kentucky, Maryland, Notre Dame, South Dakota State, Georgia, North Carolina, Belmont, Baylor and Kansas State in the 950 win club.

**Keep It 100**

- Head Coach Carolyn Kieger earned her 100th career head coaching victory with Penn State’s season-opening 73-67 win at Towson on Nov. 5. She came to Penn State with a 99-64 record in five seasons as the head coach at Marquette.

**SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION**

**Scouting Michigan**

- Michigan enters Tuesday’s contest with a 9-3 overall record and 0-1 mark in conference play.
- The Wolverines dropped a 70-55 road battle to the Big Ten’s top-ranked team in #12/11 Maryland in Saturday’s conference opener.
- Michigan leads the Big Ten in both rebounding defense (33.3 rpg) and rebound margin (+7.2).
- The Wolverines own a balanced offensive attack, while Naz Hillmon leading the way with 14.9 points and 8.0 rebounds per game.
- Kayla Robbins (12.3 ppg), Amy Dilk (10.4 ppg) and Akienreh Johnson (9.8 ppg) are also key offensive contributors.
- Dilk leads the team with 50 assists, while Michelle Sidor has drained a team-best 13 three-pointers this season.

**Against The Wolverines**

- Penn State holds a 36-16 edge in the all-time series against Michigan, but the Wolverines have won the last three contests and six of the last seven matchups.
- Michigan pulled out a narrow 66-62 win in last season’s meeting on Feb. 10, 2019 in Penn State’s Play4Kay Game Benefiting Pink Zone at the Bryce Jordan Center. Penn State led 60-56 with 3:23 to play, but Michigan closed the game on a 10-2 run to earn the victory.
- Teniya Page tallied a team-best 17 points. Siyeh Frazier followed with 12 points, while Amari Carter chipped in 10.

**Kieger Inks Four Highly-Touted Signees**

- Four signees have inked their National Letters of Intent during the November signing period to join the Penn State Women’s Basketball program and head coach Carolyn Kieger in Happy Valley.
- The four-member class is comprised of Maddie Burke (Doylestown, Pa.), Kaci Donovan (Owego, N.Y.), Nan Garcia (Jeffersonville, Ind.) and Leilani Kapinus (Madison, Wis.).
- Kapinus is a five-star recruit that was rated as the No. 8 player at her position and the No. 30 player overall in the recruiting class by ESPN.
- Burke ranked in the top 50 of her class by Preferred Athlete (#27), Blue Star (#39) and Prospect Nation (#48). She has earned All-State honors and first team All-League accolades in all three of her high school seasons.
- Nan Garcia ranked as the No. 24 player at her position by College Girls Basketball Report. She has totaled career numbers of 1,081 points (14.8 ppg), 486 rebounds (6.7 rpg), 138 steals (1.9 spg) and 88 assists (1.2 apg) at Jeffersonville High School.
- Kaci Donovan is a two-time All-State and three-time All-Conference pick from Owego Free Academy. She has tallied 1,456 points (14.1 ppg), 504 rebounds (4.9 rpg), 236 assists (2.3 apg), 229 steals (2.2 spg) and 71 blocks (0.7 bpg) in 103 games played.

**Among The NCAA's Elite**

- Penn State is one of only 19 schools with at least 25 NCAA Tournament appearances, joining Tennessee, Georgia, Stanford, Texas, UConn, Louisiana Tech, Vanderbilt, North Carolina, Purdue, LSU, Maryland, Old Dominion, Iowa, Notre Dame, Ohio State, Rutgers, Virginia and NC State.
- Penn State has been to 25 NCAA Tournaments, 13 Sweet Sixteens, four Elite Eights and one Final Four.

**A New Era Begins**

- Penn State enters its first season under head coach Carolyn Kieger in 2019-20. Kieger, a 2019 Naismith Women’s Coach of the Year Award semifinalist, guided Marquette University to the top of the Big East Conference and three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances as the Golden Eagles’ head coach.
- Kieger, a 2006 Marquette graduate, came to Happy Valley after five years at the helm of her alma mater, posting a 99-64 overall record. During the past three seasons, Kieger led the Golden Eagles to sparkling 76-26 mark (43-11 in Big East), which included a pair of Big East regular-season championships and a Big East Tournament Championship. Marquette made three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in 20 years, advancing to the round of 32 the past two seasons.

Following games, requested Penn State student-athletes will be brought to the postgame media interview room. The Penn State locker room is closed.

Requests for credentials should be directed to Chelsea Vielhauer at least one week in advance of each game. Press credentials can be picked up at Media Will Call, which is located at the Media/Team entrance, on the south side of the Bryce Jordan Center, across from the Penn State Lacrosse Complex.

A photo pass must be issued to gain access courtside in the Bryce Jordan Center. Please contact Chelsea Vielhauer one week in advance for photo passes. Courtside photographers must follow NCAA guidelines, which prohibit entry to the bench areas and the stands, and must remain seated at all times.

# HEAD COACH CAROLYN KIEGER

First Season • Marquette '06  
Overall Career Record: 105-70  
Penn State Record: 6-6

Penn State and Vice President of Athletics Sandy Barbour announced the selection of Carolyn Kieger as the sixth head coach of the women's basketball program on April 3, 2019. Kieger (pronounced KEY-grr), a 2019 Naismith Women's Coach of the Year Award semifinalist, guided Marquette University to the top of the Big East Conference and three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances as the Golden Eagles' head coach.

Kieger, a 2006 Marquette graduate, comes to Happy Valley after five years at the helm of her alma mater, posting a 99-64 overall record. During the past three seasons, Kieger led the Golden Eagles to sparkling 76-26 mark (43-11 in Big East), which included a pair of Big East regular-season championships and a Big East Tournament Championship. Marquette made three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in 20 years, advancing to the round of 32 the past two seasons.

Widely regarded as one of the nation's brightest and rising coaching stars, Kieger's first Marquette team in 2014-15 won nine games. She proceeded to lead the Golden Eagles to 14, 25, 24 and a program-record 27 victories over the next four seasons.

Kieger was named a semifinalist for the 2019 Naismith Women's Coach of the Year Award after leading the Golden Eagles to one of the best seasons in program history this past season. Marquette captured its second consecutive, but first-ever outright Big East regular-season title and a posted a school-best 27-8 record. The Golden Eagles were ranked in every Associated Press poll of the season for the first time in school history.

Marquette earned its third-straight NCAA Tournament berth in 2018-19, advancing to the second round for the second consecutive year. The Golden Eagles garnered a No. 5 seed and defeated Rice before dropping a two-point decision at No. 4 seed Texas A&M in the second round. The three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances were Marquette's first since a three-year run from 1997-99.

Kieger mentored Allazia Blockton and Natisha Hiedeman to become Marquette's first Big East Players of the Year in 2017-18 and 2018-19, respectively. Kieger coached nine All-Big East selections in the last three seasons.



The 2017-18 campaign was another banner year as Kieger was named Big East Co-Coach of the Year after guiding the Golden Eagles to a program-record 15-3 conference mark and their first Big East regular season title. Kieger earned her first NCAA Tournament coaching victory with a first-round win over Dayton before falling at No. 1 seed Louisville.

Kieger coached Marquette to new heights in 2016-17 as the Golden Eagles won the Big East Tournament title for the first time in program history, while also earning a program-best No. 5 seed in the NCAA Tournament. She directed MU to the Big Dance for the first time since 2011. Kieger led Marquette to a 25-8 record in 2016-17, finishing with a 6-0 mark against teams ranked in the Top 25.

In her second year at the helm of the Golden Eagles, Kieger had the youngest program in NCAA Division I with eight freshmen on the roster in 2015-16, as MU improved its win total by five games. She made her collegiate head coaching debut on Nov. 15, 2014 against Green Bay and earned her first career victory on Nov. 17, 2014 when Marquette defeated Loyola-Chicago.

Prior to being named head coach at her alma mater, Kieger spent six seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Miami from 2008-14. Following graduation, she was at Miami as the coordinator of basketball operations (2006-07) and then served as director of operations at Marquette in 2007-08.

Kieger returned to Miami as an assistant coach in 2008-09 and was primarily responsible for guard development with the Hurricanes. She helped advance the skills of Miami guard Shenise Johnson, who earned All-America and ACC Player of the Year honors in 2010-11, while the squad was crowned ACC regular-season champions. She also helped guard Riquna Williams earn All-ACC first team accolades and finish as the ACC scoring leader with 21.7 points per game. Miami made three NCAA Tournament appearances and two in the WNIT during Kieger's last five seasons with the Hurricanes.

Kieger was a four-year starter at Marquette, a three-year captain and is MU's all-time assists leader. She is the only player in program history with at least 1,200 career points, 400 career rebounds and 600 assists. Kieger averaged 10.3 points per game during her career and was a second-team All-Big East selection in 2005-06, as well as, a second-team All-Conference USA selection for the 2003-04 and 2004-05 seasons.

During her senior campaign, Kieger was a finalist for the Nancy Lieberman Award, presented to the nation's top point guard. In addition to her athletic accomplishments, Kieger received the Big East Conference's Sportsmanship award as a senior.

A native of Roseville, Minnesota, Kieger graduated Cum Laude from Marquette with a bachelor's degree in broadcasting and electronic communications in 2006. She received the McCahill Award in 2007, presented to a graduated MU senior student-athlete who demonstrated the highest performance in scholarship, leadership and athletics.
