

OPENING TIPS

- Penn State closes out its 2019-20 home slate Thursday night when the Lady Lions face Michigan at the Bryce Jordan Center in the penultimate game of the regular season.
- Four of Penn State's wins this season have come over 2019 NCAA Tournament teams.
- Junior Kamaria McDaniel is the Big Ten's second-leading scorer with 19.6 points per game. Senior Siyeh Frazier (12.4 ppg) is also averaging double-digit points.
- McDaniel enters the game 21 points away from her 1,000th career point.

IF PENN STATE BEATS MICHIGAN

- Penn State would beat Michigan for the first time since Feb. 26, 2017.
- The Lady Lions would snap their 12-game losing streak.
- Penn State would pick up its second conference win of the season.

Nearing 1,000

- Kamaria McDaniel enters Thursday’s game against Michigan with 979 career points, putting her just 21 points away from the 1,000-point mark.
- With at least three games remaining on the schedule (two regular-season and one guaranteed Big Ten Tournament game), McDaniel will need to average seven points per game to reach the 1,000-point mark. She currently averages 19.6 ppg.
- McDaniel has scored 529 points thus far this year, 79 more than her first two seasons combined (450).
- McDaniel would become the 39th member of the Lady Lion 1,000-Point Club and first to join since Teniya Page (Class of 2019 - 2,108 career points).

Kamaria McBuckets

- Kamaria McDaniel is the Big Ten’s second-leading scorer and averaging 19.6 points per game. That mark ranks 16th in all of Division I as of Feb. 26. Her 20.7 points per Big Ten game ranks first in the conference.
- She dropped the third 40-point game in program history against Pittsburgh on Dec. 5 and put up a 31-point performance against Minnesota in the Big Ten opener on Dec. 28. McDaniel was just one assist away from recording Penn State’s first triple-double of the Big Ten era on Jan. 9 against Michigan State as she tallied team-best marks of 24 points, 11 rebounds and nine assists. It marked her first career double-double. She then put together a 35-point effort at Purdue on Jan. 26. It was her third 30-plus point performance of the season.

20-20 Vision

- Kamaria McDaniel has tallied twelve 20-plus point efforts, nine of which have come in conference play, and has scored in double figures in 25 of Penn State’s 27 games.
- McDaniel’s scoring jump comes after she finished her sophomore campaign averaging 9.7 ppg in 2018-19.

Siyeh Stepping Up Her Game

- Siyeh Frazier has taken her game to a new level in her senior season. She currently ranks second on the team with 12.4 points per game.
- The Detroit native entered this season having made only 12 three-pointers in her career, and has already drained 20 this season.
- She leads the team with 62 steals and ranks third in the conference with 2.3 steals per game. She has already surpassed her mark of 48 steals from a season ago.

Finding the Free Throw Line

- Penn State ranks 35th nationally in free throws made (373) as of Feb. 26.
- Kamaria McDaniel has found her way to the free throw line the most, attempting a team-best 180 freebies. Her 180 free throw attempts lead the Big Ten and rank 10th in the nation. Freshman Makenna Marisa is shooting a team-best 84.2 percent (48-for-57) from the charity stripe.

Four Wins Over 2019 NCAA Tournament Teams

- Four of Penn State’s seven wins this season have come against 2019 NCAA Tournament teams.
- The Lady Lions kicked off the season with a 73-67 victory at defending CAA Tournament champ Towson. It marked the first win in the Carolyn Kieger era.
- Penn State then picked up a 72-59 win against defending Atlantic 10 champion Fordham on Nov. 13. It marked the 950th win in program history.
- Penn State fought for a gritty 68-55 win over Clemson on Nov. 21. Penn State out-scored the Tigers 28-16 in the final 15 minutes to secure the win.
- Penn State earned its first Big Ten win of the season against Michigan State on Jan. 9. The Spartans advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament a season ago. Penn State out-scored the Spartans 25-16 in the final quarter to pull away for the 86-73 win and collect head coach Carolyn Kieger’s first-career Big Ten victory.

B1G Win

- A full-team offensive onslaught led Penn State to its first Big Ten victory of the season on Jan. 9 as the Lady Lions took down visiting Michigan State 86-73 in Happy Valley.
- Penn State tallied a season-best 22 assists on 31 made field goals in its efficient offensive night, while shooting 49.2 percent (31-for-63) from the field, 46.7 percent (7-for-15) from three-point range, and 94.4 percent (17-for-18) from the free throw line.
- Senior Siyeh Frazier and junior Kamaria McDaniel both registered 24 points. McDaniel also led Penn State with career-best marks of 11 rebounds and nine assists, finishing just one assist shy of a triple-double.

This Is B1G

- Penn State is in its 28th season as a member of the Big Ten Conference and has enjoyed immense success since becoming a member of the storied conference in 1992-93.
- The Lady Lions own a winning record against nine of the 13 other Big Ten programs. Penn State owns an all-time mark of 274-190 in Big Ten play, with marks of 164-69 at home and 110-120 on the road.
- Penn State's eight regular-season championships since joining the conference in 1992-93 are the second-most won by any Big Ten team during that span. The Lady Lions also own a pair of Big Ten Tournament titles, winning in 1995 and 1996.

SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION

Scouting Michigan

- Michigan owns an 18-9 overall record and 9-7 mark in conference play.
- The Wolverines have won their last two games and five of their last seven.
- Michigan is coming off a 65-57 victory at Michigan State in their most recent game Sunday.
- Michigan owns a balanced offensive attack, with four Wolverines averaging double-digit points.
- Naz Hillmon leads the way with 16.9 points per game in addition to a team-best 8.7 rebounds per contest.
- Kayla Robbins and Amy Dilk follow with 11.6 points per game, while Akienreh Johnson has chipped in 10.5 ppg.
- Dilk leads the team with 120 assists.

Against The Wolverines

- Penn State holds a 36-17 edge in the all-time series against Michigan, but the Wolverines have won the last four contests and seven of the last eight matchups.
- The Lady Lions hold a 17-4 advantage when playing Michigan in Happy Valley.
- The Wolverines earned an 82-48 win in the season's first meeting on Dec. 31 in Ann Arbor, Mich.
- Senior Siyeh Frazier and junior Kamaria McDaniel led Penn State with a game-high 16 points apiece.

950 And Counting

- The Lady Lions earned the 950th victory in program history on Nov. 13 when Penn State beat Fordham 72-59 at the Bryce Jordan Center. The Lady Lions hold an all-time record of 955-502. This is the 56th season of Penn State Women’s Basketball.
- Penn State became the 20th Division I women’s basketball teams to have reached the 950-win mark. The Lady Lions joined Tennessee, UConn, Louisiana Tech, James Madison, Stanford, Texas, Stephen F. Austin, Old Dominion, Ohio State, Green Bay, Western Kentucky, Maryland, Notre Dame, South Dakota State, Georgia, North Carolina, Belmont, Baylor and Kansas State in the 950 win club.

Keep It 100

- Head Coach Carolyn Kieger earned her 100th career head coaching victory with Penn State’s season-opening 73-67 win at Towson on Nov. 5. She came to Penn State with a 99-64 record in five seasons as the head coach at Marquette.

Among The NCAA’s Elite

- Penn State is one of only 19 schools with at least 25 NCAA Tournament appearances, joining Tennessee, Georgia, Stanford, Texas, UConn, Louisiana Tech, Vanderbilt, North Carolina, Purdue, LSU, Maryland, Old Dominion, Iowa, Notre Dame, Ohio State, Rutgers, Virginia and NC State.
- Penn State has been to 25 NCAA Tournaments, 13 Sweet Sixteens, four Elite Eights and one Final Four.

A New Era Begins

- Penn State enters its first season under head coach Carolyn Kieger in 2019-20. Kieger, a 2019 Naismith Women’s Coach of the Year Award semifinalist, guided Marquette University to the top of the Big East Conference and three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances as the Golden Eagles’ head coach.
- Kieger, a 2006 Marquette graduate, came to Happy Valley after five years at the helm of her alma mater, posting a 99-64 overall record. During the past three seasons, Kieger led the Golden Eagles to sparkling 76-26 mark (43-11 in Big East), which included a pair of Big East regular-season championships and a Big East Tournament Championship. Marquette made three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in 20 years, advancing to the round of 32 the past two seasons.

Following games, requested Penn State student-athletes will be brought to the postgame media interview room. The Penn State locker room is closed.

CREDENTIALS

Single game and season press credentials are issued to accredited members of the working media only. Requests for credentials should be directed to Chelsea Vielhauer at least one week in advance of each game. Press credentials can be picked up at Media Will Call, which is located at the Media/Team entrance, on the south side of the Bryce Jordan Center, across from the Penn State Lacrosse Complex.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

A photo pass must be issued to gain access courtside in the Bryce Jordan Center. Please contact Chelsea Vielhauer one week in advance for photo passes. Courtside photographers must follow NCAA guidelines, which prohibit entry to the bench areas and the stands, and must remain seated at all times.

First Season • Marquette '06
Overall Career Record: 106-84
Penn State Record: 7-20

Penn State and Vice President of Athletics Sandy Barbour announced the selection of Carolyn Kieger as the sixth head coach of the women's basketball program on April 3, 2019. Kieger (pronounced KEY-grr), a 2019 Naismith Women's Coach of the Year Award semifinalist, guided Marquette University to the top of the Big East Conference and three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances as the Golden Eagles' head coach.

Kieger, a 2006 Marquette graduate, comes to Happy Valley after five years at the helm of her alma mater, posting a 99-64 overall record. During the past three seasons, Kieger led the Golden Eagles to sparkling 76-26 mark (43-11 in Big East), which included a pair of Big East regular-season championships and a Big East Tournament Championship. Marquette made three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in 20 years, advancing to the round of 32 the past two seasons.

Widely regarded as one of the nation's brightest and rising coaching stars, Kieger's first Marquette team in 2014-15 won nine games. She proceeded to lead the Golden Eagles to 14, 25, 24 and a program-record 27 victories over the next four seasons.

Kieger was named a semifinalist for the 2019 Naismith Women's Coach of the Year Award after leading the Golden Eagles to one of the best seasons in program history this past season. Marquette captured its second consecutive, but first-ever outright Big East regular-season title and a posted a school-best 27-8 record. The Golden Eagles were ranked in every Associated Press poll of the season for the first time in school history.

Marquette earned its third-straight NCAA Tournament berth in 2018-19, advancing to the second round for the second consecutive year. The Golden Eagles garnered a No. 5 seed and defeated Rice before dropping a two-point decision at No. 4 seed Texas A&M in the second round. The three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances were Marquette's first since a three-year run from 1997-99.

Kieger mentored Allazia Blockton and Natisha Hiedeman to become Marquette's first Big East Players of the Year in 2017-18 and 2018-19, respectively. Kieger coached nine All-Big East selections in the last three seasons.



The 2017-18 campaign was another banner year as Kieger was named Big East Co-Coach of the Year after guiding the Golden Eagles to a program-record 15-3 conference mark and their first Big East regular season title. Kieger earned her first NCAA Tournament coaching victory with a first-round win over Dayton before falling at No. 1 seed Louisville.

Kieger coached Marquette to new heights in 2016-17 as the Golden Eagles won the Big East Tournament title for the first time in program history, while also earning a program-best No. 5 seed in the NCAA Tournament. She directed MU to the Big Dance for the first time since 2011. Kieger led Marquette to a 25-8 record in 2016-17, finishing with a 6-0 mark against teams ranked in the Top 25.

In her second year at the helm of the Golden Eagles, Kieger had the youngest program in NCAA Division I with eight freshmen on the roster in 2015-16, as MU improved its win total by five games. She made her collegiate head coaching debut on Nov. 15, 2014 against Green Bay and earned her first career victory on Nov. 17, 2014 when Marquette defeated Loyola-Chicago.

Prior to being named head coach at her alma mater, Kieger spent six seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Miami from 2008-14. Following graduation, she was at Miami as the coordinator of basketball operations (2006-07) and then served as director of operations at Marquette in 2007-08.

Kieger returned to Miami as an assistant coach in 2008-09 and was primarily responsible for guard development with the Hurricanes. She helped advance the skills of Miami guard Shenise Johnson, who earned All-America and ACC Player of the Year honors in 2010-11, while the squad was crowned ACC regular-season champions. She also helped guard Riquna Williams earn All-ACC first team accolades and finish as the ACC scoring leader with 21.7 points per game. Miami made three NCAA Tournament appearances and two in the WNIT during Kieger's last five seasons with the Hurricanes.

Kieger was a four-year starter at Marquette, a three-year captain and is MU's all-time assists leader. She is the only player in program history with at least 1,200 career points, 400 career rebounds and 600 assists. Kieger averaged 10.3 points per game during her career and was a second-team All-Big East selection in 2005-06, as well as, a second-team All-Conference USA selection for the 2003-04 and 2004-05 seasons.

During her senior campaign, Kieger was a finalist for the Nancy Lieberman Award, presented to the nation's top point guard. In addition to her athletic accomplishments, Kieger received the Big East Conference's Sportsmanship award as a senior.

A native of Roseville, Minnesota, Kieger graduated Cum Laude from Marquette with a bachelor's degree in broadcasting and electronic communications in 2006. She received the McCahill Award in 2007, presented to a graduated MU senior student-athlete who demonstrated the highest performance in scholarship, leadership and athletics.
