**SHREWSBERRY ERA BEGINS 1-0**

With fans back in the Bryce Jordan Center for the first time in 617 days, Peter and Ann Tombros Endowed Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry earned his first-career Division I head coaching victory when Penn State defeated Youngstown State 75-59 in Wednesday's season opener.

**A NEW SHERIFF IN TOWN**

Shrewsberry was announced as the 14th men's basketball head coach in Penn State history on March 15, 2021. He came to Penn State after two years as the associate head coach at Purdue, his second stint with the Boilermakers, that followed a six-year run as assistant coach with the Boston Celtics under head coach Brad Stevens. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018.

Shrewsberry's first stint at Purdue came during the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons, in which he helped the Boilers reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Prior to that, he spent four seasons at Butler under Stevens, helping guide the Bulldogs to three NCAA Tournaments and two Final Four appearances.

**TRIO LEADS THE WAY AGAINST PENGUINS**

Penn State's returning veteran trio of Seth Lundy, Sam Sessoms and John Harrar led the way for the Nittany Lions in their 75-59 victory over Youngstown State.

The trio of returning Nittany Lions combined for 56 of Penn State's 75 points, 25 of Penn State's 43 rebounds and the three Nittany Lions collectively shot 63.2 percent (24-for-38) from the field.

Lundy tallied his fifth career 20-point game, rattling off a game-high 23 points to go along with six rebounds.

Sessoms stuffed the stat sheet with 17 points, eight assists and five rebounds. Fourteen of his 17 points came in the second half.

Harrar was a perfect 7-for-7 from the field en route to his seventh-career double-double with 16 points and a career high-tying 14 rebounds. His perfect shooting performance made him the first Nittany Lion to shoot 100% from the field with at least 7 FGA since Mike Watkins was a perfect 8-for-8 at Iowa on March 5, 2017.

**DEFENSE FINDS ITS FOOTING**

Youngstown State started Wednesday night's season opener 9-for-11 (81.8%) from the field through the game's opening 11 minutes, but the Penn State defense acclimated quickly.

The Nittany Lions held the Penguins to just a 28.9 percent (14-for-45) clip from the field for the final 29 minutes of Wednesday's contest as Penn State controlled the tempo to put the Penguins out of reach.

**CORE RETURNEES**

Penn State returns a number of familiar faces for the 2021-22 season. Graduate student John Harrar returns to utilize the extra year of eligibility granted by the NCAA due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Harrar earned honorable mention All-Big Ten honors last season after leading the Nittany Lions with 8.8 rebounds per game and a 54.9 field goal percentage.

Junior Seth Lundy is the team's returning leading scorer from a season ago. Lundy tallied 10.1 points per game, including two 30-plus point contests in his sophomore campaign.

Seniors Myles Dread and Sam Sessoms will play large roles in the backcourt once again. Dread ranked first or second on the team in three-pointers made in each of his three years as a Nittany Lion. Sessoms is set for his second season at Penn State after playing two years at Binghamton. The Philadelphia native ranked second on the team in steals a season ago and tallied nine double-digit scoring games.

Sophomores Caleb Dorsey, Dallion Johnson and Andy Christos also return looking to make a jump in their second year in Happy Valley.

**NEW FACES IN NEW PLACES**

Eight new faces pair with seven returners to comprise Penn State's 15-man roster.

Five new Nittany Lions joined the team via the transfer portal in Jaheam Cornwall (Gardner-Webb), Greg Lee (Western Michigan), Jalen Pickett (Siena), Jevonnie Scott (South Plains College), and Jalanni White (Canisius). Three others joined as walk-ons, two of whom have played college basketball in previous years, in Dan Conlan (Dickinson), Irekefe Oweh (St. Thomas Aquinas) and Ishaan Jagiasi.

**AGE & EXPERIENCE**

The average age of Penn State's 15-man roster on the official Nov. 9 start date of the 2021-22 college basketball season (Penn State opened on Nov. 10) was 21.61 years old. Penn State is believed to be the sixth-oldest Division I team in the country this season, oldest Power 5 team, and oldest team in the Big Ten.

The Nittany Lions have no freshmen on their roster and are bolstered by seven players who have played three or more years of college basketball.

**PALPABLE BUZZ**

With fans set to return to the Bryce Jordan Center for the first time since the 2019-20 season, and the excitement surrounding first-year head coach Micah Shrewsberry, the buzz in Happy Valley is palpable.

Penn State sold nearly 2,800 student season tickets, the most ever sold in the history of Penn State Basketball student season ticket sales.

**STAFF TIES**

Shrewsberry was tasked with assembling his first staff immediately upon arrival in Happy Valley. While this group has never all worked together, there are some key connections to both each other and the University.

Associate Head Coach and Penn State alumnus Adam Fisher '06 returns for his third stint in Happy Valley. He was the Nittany Lions' head student manager from 2003-06 during his undergraduate days. He later returned for the 2011-12 season as video coordinator and 2012-13 season as director of player development. Fisher spent the last eight years with the Miami Hurricanes.

Assistant Coach Aki Collins and Shrewsberry were on the same staff at Marshall from 2003-05, where the two coached current Assistant to the Head Coach Tre Whitted. Shrewsberry also coached current Director of Player Development Mike Green at Butler as Green earned All-America honors under Shrewsberry's tutelage. Shrewsberry worked on the same staff as current Video Coordinator Grady Eifert for each of the last two seasons, as the former Boilermaker standout was serving as a graduate assistant at Purdue.

**4,332 TRANSFER POINTS**

Penn State's eight newcomers, seven of whom have played college basketball at their previous schools, combine to bring 4,332 career points to Happy Valley, which is believed to rank fourth in the nation in 2021-22 incoming transfer class scoring.

**PETER AND ANN TOMBROS ENDOWMENT**

Peter and Ann Tombros have endowed the Penn State men's basketball head coaching position as part of their new \$26 million commitment to the University, as announced on Oct. 20, 2021. The Tombroses' gift will establish a fund to enhance opportunities for student-athletes through scholarships, travel, equipment and other needs.

This gift to endow the men's basketball head coach position is part of a new \$26 million commitment from the Tombroses that supports Intercollegiate Athletics, the College of Agricultural Sciences, Penn State Health and the College of Arts and Architecture. The commitment places the Tombroses among the top five donors in the University's history.

**THE OPPOSITION**

**SCOUTING MASSACHUSETTS**

- UMass is 1-1 on the young season after defeating UMBC (77-60) in its season opener Tuesday and falling to Ivy League preseason favorite Yale (71-91) on Friday.
- Former Nittany Lion Trent Buttrick is the Minutemen's leading scorer though two games with 13.5 ppg. He is also tied for the team lead with 5.5 rebounds per contest.
- Noah Fernandes is also averaging double-digit points with 12.5 per contest. Four other UMass players have contributed eight or more points per game.
- The Minutemen finished the 2020-21 season with an 8-7 overall record with a 7-4 mark in Atlantic 10 play on their way to a fourth-place finish in the conference.

**AGAINST THE MINUTEMEN**

- Old Atlantic 10 foes meet again for the first time since 1991 when Penn State travels to UMass Monday evening.
- The Nittany Lions hold a 13-10 all-time advantage in the series that dates back to 1976.
- Penn State is 4-7 all-time when playing at UMass, but 9-2 when playing the Minutemen in Happy Valley.

**HARRAR'S RETURN**

Team leader John Harrar announced his committment to return to the Nittany Lions for a fifth and final season in the spring, giving Penn State its heart and soul back for one more year.

Harrar is coming off a 2020-21 season that saw him earn All-Big Ten Honorable Mention laurels as he led the team with 8.8 rebounds per game and a 54.9 field goal percentage.

Harrar was also among 28 conference honorees for the Big Ten Outstanding Sportsmanship Award. He is known for consistently bringing a strong leadership presence and outstanding work ethic that has been praised by opposing coaches and national media alike.

**LUNDY LOOKING TO LEAP**

Junior Seth Lundy will be a key player to watch heading into his junior season. The Paulsboro, N.J. native is Penn State's returning leading scorer from last year's squad, chipping in 10.1 points per game.

He went off for 30-plus points on two occasions during his sophomore season - 32 vs. VCU on Dec. 2, 2020 and 31 at Maryland on March 7, 2021. He is one of just 16 Nittany Lions in program history to have two 30-plus point games, and has at least two more seasons of eligibility remaining.

**DREAD FROM DEEP**

Senior Myles Dread returns for his senior season after ranking first or second on the Nittany Lion squad in 3-pointers made in each of his first three seasons.

His 177 career 3-pointers currently ranks ninth in the Penn State career record books. Dread needs 17 treys to match Dan Earl's eighth-best mark of 194 career 3-pointers.

**SPEAKING OF SHOOTERS...**

The addition of graduate transfer Jaheam Cornwall (Gardner-Webb) should provide a key outside threat for the Nittany Lions.

Cornwall owns a 42.3 (231-546) career 3-point shooting percentage, which ranks 21st amongst all active Division I players.

Cornwall was a two-time All-Big South honoree at Gardner-Webb.

**BIG PICKETT-UP**

Jalen Pickett was one of the most highly-touted transfers in the portal, coming in at No. 21 on ESPN's transfer rankings this spring. Shrewsberry secured the big pick up who announced his commitment to Penn State on April 25.

Pickett owned career averages of 15.0 points, 6.1 assists and 4.9 rebounds per game through three seasons at Siena, where he earned MAAC Player of the Year honors as a sophomore in 2019-20 and MAAC Rookie of the Year honors as a freshman in 2018-19. The Rochester, N.Y. native was a three-time first-team All-MAAC selection with the Saints.

**SESSOMS READY FOR STEP UP**

Senior Sam Sessoms is another key player to keep an eye on as he looks to take a step up after acclimating to the Big Ten in 2020-21.

Sessoms transferred to Penn State ahead of the 2020-21 season from Binghamton, where he put together an exceptional two-year career with the Bearcats. Sessoms finished his tenure at Binghamton No. 2 on the Bearcats' Division-I era career scoring list with 1,151 points.

Sessoms played in a key sixth-man role for the Nittany Lions last year, seeing action in 24 games and tallying nine double-digit scoring efforts. He saved his best for last, scoring a season-high 18 points in Penn State's final game of the season against Wisconsin in the Big Ten Tournament.

# MICAH SHREWSBERRY



Penn State Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics Sandy Barbour announced the hiring of Purdue Associate Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry as the 14th men's basketball head coach in Penn State history. Shrewsberry comes to Penn State with a wealth of experience as an assistant coach for a pair of nationally ranked programs and in the NBA. He also has two years of head coaching experience.

Shrewsberry spent the last two seasons with Big Ten foe Purdue University as the associate head coach. As the offensive coordinator, Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a fourth-place finish with a 13-6 Big Ten record in 2020-21. Purdue finished with an 18-9 overall mark and earned an NCAA Tournament berth. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections.

Prior to his time at Purdue, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018. Under Shrewsberry, Boston ranked sixth in the NBA in 3-pointers made and seventh in 3-point field goal percentage in the 2018-19 season and was second in 3-point field goal percentage in 2017-18, behind the NBA champion Golden State Warriors.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of Jaylen Brown and Jayson Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors. Shrewsberry was also an assistant coach in the 2017 NBA All-Star Game.

Shrewsberry's first stint as an assistant coach at Purdue spanned the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons where he helped the Boilers reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament. He played an integral role in helping Purdue's offense lead the country in fewest turnovers per game with 8.74 in 2011-12. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the Big Ten in 2011-12, improving his field goal percentage by nearly 13 percent and upping his scoring average by more than five points per game from his freshman to sophomore year.

The Indianapolis native spent four seasons at Butler University under head coach Brad Stevens. He started his time with the Bulldogs as the coordinator of basketball operations before serving as an assistant coach for three seasons. With Shrewsberry on the bench, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles, and made three NCAA Tournament appearances.

During Shrewsberry's time at Butler, the Bulldogs reached the 2010 and 2011 National Championship games. He aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year in 2010 and on the Final Four All-Tournament Team in 2010. Hayward was selected as the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz. Shrewsberry was the head coach at Indiana University-South Bend from 2005-07. He served as the Chicagoland Collegiate Athletic Conference (CCAC) Division I Men's Basketball Chair in 2006-07. In his second season at the helm, the Titans showed a nine-game improvement from his inaugural season.

He was also the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

As player, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain at Hanover College. He led the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference in free throw shooting (.833) and assists (4.4) in 1998-99.

Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree in sports management from Indiana State in 2003. He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.

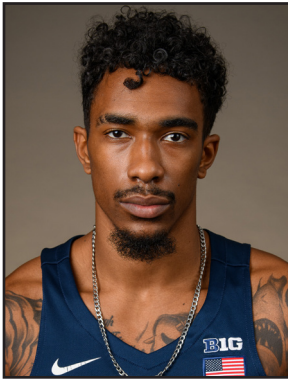

**SHREWSBERRY ERA BEGINS WITH 75-59 WIN OVER YOUNGSTOWN STATE**

The Penn State men's basketball team opened its highly-anticipated 2021-22 campaign presented by Highmark Health with a 75-59 win over Youngstown State on Wednesday evening inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

The win marked the first under the leadership of Peter and Ann Tombrson Endowed Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry.

Junior Seth Lundy led all players with a game-high 23 points on 9-of-15 shooting and 3-of-5 from beyond the arc. Senior Sam Sessoms added 17 points, with 14 coming in the second half, to go along with five rebounds and a game- and team-best eight assists.

Graduate student John Harrar registered his seventh career double-double with 16 points and a tied career-best 14 rebounds. Harrar was a perfect 7-for-7 from the field, making him the first Nittany Lion to shoot 100% from the field with at least 7 FGA since Mike Watkins was a perfect 8-for-8 at Iowa on March 5, 2017.

After an initial five-point advantage for the Nittany Lions less than two minutes in, the next 10 or so minutes would see a back-and-forth contest with seven lead changes. The Nittany Lions broke the trend by going on an 18-5 run in the final 10:57 of the stanza, holding the Penguins to shoot 2-of-14 from the field, to take a 35-26 lead at the break.

Penn State started the second half the way it ended the first, going on a 10-4 run with five points by Jalen Pickett in the first four minutes.

Youngstown State was able to cut the deficit back down to single digits and get within six points with 7:12 remaining before the Nittany Lions went on a 10-0 run in a three-minute span to go back up by 16 and force the Penguins to call a timeout. Down the stretch, the Penn State defense held the visitors to 2-of-12 from the field for an 16-point victory.
