OPENING TIPS

- Penn State continues its three-game homestand to open the 2022-23 season Thursday evening when the Nittany Lions host Loyola University Maryland.
- The Nittany Lions began the season in record-setting fashion Monday night as Penn State drilled a program-record 18 3-pointers to take down Winthrop, 93-68.
- Preseason All-Big Ten pick Jalen Pickett led Penn State against the Eagles with 23 points, five rebounds and five assists, while graduate transfer Andrew Funk added six 3-pointers and 22 points.

IF PENN STATE BEATS LOYOLA MARYLAND

- Penn State would improve to 2-0 on the season for the fifth time in the last six years.
- The Nittany Lions would improve to 6-1 all-time against the Greyhounds and earn their fifth-straight win over Loyola Maryland.

RECORD-SETTING OPENING NIGHT

The Nittany Lions wasted no time taking down a program record that stood for 126 years.

Penn State drilled a program-record 18 3-points in Monday night’s season opener against Winthrop, besting the previous school mark of 15 that was reached on three occasions, most recently on Nov. 21, 2021 against Cornell.

Penn State shot the long ball at a 47.4 percent clip (18-38) Monday night, with seven different Nittany Lions contributing a trey. Graduate transfer Andrew Funk led the way with six 3-pointers behind a 6-for-10 showing from deep, while Myles Dread chipped in four and Jalen Pickett added three.

FIRE POWER

Penn State’s offense was clicking on all cylinders in Monday night’s season-opening win.

Penn State’s 93 points was its most since putting up 95 against Nebraska on Feb. 19, 2019.

The Nittany Lions shot 55.5 percent (33-for-60) from the field, their best single-game field goal percentage since shooting 60.0 percent against Bucknell on Nov. 19, 2019.

SHARING THE ROCK

Penn State had 24 assists on 33 made field goals in Monday night’s season opener. The 24 assists were Penn State’s most since recording 24 against Central Connecticut State on Dec. 20, 2019.

Senior+ guards Jalen Pickett (23) and Andrew Funk (22) both went off for 20-plus points in Monday night’s season opener, marking the first pair of Nittany Lions to score 20 each since Nov. 21, 2021 when Seth Lundy (23) and Sam Sessoms (22) did so in a win over Cornell.

BEWARE OF THE BACKCOURT

Penn State boasts a strong and experienced backcourt for the 2022-23 season. The six upperclassmen of Jalen Pickett, Myles Dread, Andrew Funk, Dallion Johnson, Seth Lundy and Camren Wynter have combined for 6,291 career points, 2,053 career rebounds and 1,632 career assists throughout their collegiate careers.

Jalen Pickett (1,575 points, 511 rebounds, 603 assists) is one of just two active Division I players with career marks of 1,500+ points, 500+ rebounds and 500+ assists.

Wyoming’s Hunter Maldonado (1,720 points, 670 rebounds, 520 assists) is the only other active DI player to have reached the multi-faceted achievement.

Grad transfer Camren Wynter (1,666 points, 496 rebounds, 580 assists) is just four rebounds away from joining Pickett in the exclusive 1,500/500/500 club.

TWO OF THE TOP FIVE

Jalen Pickett and Camren Wynter rank No. 2 and No. 5 respectively in career assists amongst active Division I players.

Pickett owns 603 assists while Wynter has 580. Florida’s Kyle Lofton (606) is just three assists ahead of Pickett to hold down the top spot on the active career assists leaders list.

BACK-TO-BACK TOP 30 CLASSES

Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry has signed his second-straight top-30 recruiting class, as three highly-touted signees inked their National Letters of Intent on National Signing Day Wednesday.

Penn State’s three-member class currently ranks 24th in the nation according to 247 sports and 26th according to ESPN. It marks the first time in program history that the Nittany Lions have signed back-to-back top-30 recruiting classes, both of which have come under Shrewsberry.

The three-member class is comprised of Carey Booth (Englewood, Colo.), Logan Imes (Zionsville, Ind.) and Braeden Shrewsberry (State College, Pa.).

Booth is an ESPN Top 100 recruit (No. 75), and ranked as the No. 15 power forward in his class per 247 Sports. He is the second-highest ranked recruit in program history behind Tony Carr and the highest-ranked recruit of Shrewsberry’s tenure. Booth is Shrewsberry’s second ESPN Top 100 signee (also Kebba Njie).

Imes is an ESPN four-star prospect who ranks as the No. 24 combo guard in the 2023 class and No. 6 overall player in the state of Indiana per 247 Sports.

Braeden Shrewsberry, Micah’s oldest son, is an ESPN four-star prospect and ranked as the No. 33 shooting guard in the 2023 class and No. 4 player in the state of Pennsylvania per 247 Sports.

THE CAPTAINS

Four Nittany Lions were elected as captains for the 2022-23 season. Jalen Pickett, Seth Lundy, Myles Dread and Andrew Funk will each hold the captain title this season.

Coach Shrewsberry had this to say about his four captains: “Jalen, Seth, Andrew and Myles have each been great leaders for our program throughout the summer and fall. Not only have they served as on-court leaders for their teammates, but each of them has also helped drive and enforce the culture of our program. All four of them play an important role for our team this year and are very deserving of the captain title.”

PRESEASON NODS FOR PICKETT

Guard Jalen Pickett was named to the 2022-23 Preseason All-Big Ten Team heading into the 2022-23 season.

Pickett is coming off a 2021-22 season in which he led the Nittany Lions in scoring (13.3 ppg), assists (135) and steals (35). The guard ranked second on the team in blocks (19), third in rebounds (133) and served as one of the Nittany Lions’ toughest defenders. He led the Big Ten and ranked 11th in all of Division I with 37.2 minutes per game and ranked second in the conference and 27th in the country with a 2.45 assist-to-turnover ratio.

The Rochester, N.Y. native scored in double figures in 25 games a season ago with four 20-point efforts. Pickett led Penn State at the Big Ten Tournament, averaging 18.0 points, 6.3 rebounds and 5.0 assists per tournament game.

LOCKED IN ON LUNDY

Senior Seth Lundy emerged as one of the Big Ten’s best defenders during the 2021-22 season and was consistently tasked with guarding the opposing team’s top scoring threat. He finished his junior campaign as the team’s second-leading scorer (11.9 ppg) and third-leading rebounder (4.9 ppg), while leading the team in blocks (20) and finishing third in steals (30). Lundy shot a team-best (min. 10 att.) 86.7 percent (52-60) from the free-throw line and drained a team-leading 64 3-pointers.

Lundy is now in his fourth year with the Nittany Lion program, but it’s the first time in his collegiate career that he’s playing for the same head coach in back-to-back years. Both Lundy and Shrewsberry have noted that Lundy looks and feels much more comfortable this year than he has in the past thanks to the continuity in systems between year one and year two under Shrewsberry.

DREAD FROM DEEP

Myles Dread returns to utilize his extra year of eligibility and already has his name etched in the Penn State record books. Dread has drained 236 career 3-pointers, the fifth-most in Penn State history.

The Detroit, Mich. native has proven to have a knack for clutch shots throughout his Nittany Lion career. He hit game-winning 3-pointers in the final minute vs. Yale (11/23/19), Rutgers (2/26/20) and VCU (12/2/20), and the game-tying 3-pointer to send game to double-overtime vs. Iowa (1/31/22).

Dread shot a career-best 40.7 percent (55-135) from 3-point range during the 2021-22 season and ranked second on the team with 55 made 3-pointers despite battling a season-long injury.

THE OPPOSITION

SCOUTING LOYOLA MARYLAND

- The Greyhounds come to Happy Valley seeking their first win of the season after dropping a 72-66 decision at DePaul in their season opener Monday night.
- Loyola Maryland was within four points of the Blue Demons in the final 10 seconds, but DePaul held on for the six-point win.
- Kenneth Jones led the Greyhounds with 20 points with the help of a 4-for-7 showing from beyond the arc. Deon Perry made his collegiate debut with 13 points, and Jaylin Andrews had 12. Golden Dike posted nine points and grabbed 11 rebounds to lead all players.
- Loyola Maryland is coming off a 2021-22 season that saw the Greyhounds go 14-16 overall and 8-10 in the Patriot League.

AGAINST THE GREYHOUNDS

- Penn State and Loyola Maryland meet for the seventh time in program history and first time since 2000 Thursday night.
- The Nittany Lions are 5-1 all-time against the Greyhounds.
- Penn State defeated Loyola Maryland 87-58 in the last meeting between the two programs in 2000.

YEAR TWO

Penn State enters its second season under head coach Micah Shrewsberry in 2022-23. Shrewsberry came to Penn State with a wealth of experience and success at both the collegiate and NBA levels, having coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs and two NBA Conference Finals.

Shrewsberry immediately put his stamp on the Nittany Lion program during his first season at the helm. He engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense in 2021-22 and guided the Nittany Lions to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in 11 years. The Nittany Lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games. The regular season saw Penn State earn a number of statement wins, including victories over 19th-ranked Michigan State, Big Ten Tournament champion Iowa, and NCAA Tournament participants Indiana and Rutgers.

CORE RETURNEES

An experienced group of returnees headline the 2022-23 roster as Penn State returns four starters and eight letterwinners from the 2021-22 campaign.

The Nittany Lions' 2021-22 leading scorer returns in Jalen Pickett. The guard led Penn State in scoring (13.3 ppg), assists (135), steals (35) and minutes played (37.2 mpg) a season ago. Senior Seth Lundy is coming off a 2021-22 season in which he finished as the team's second-leading scorer (11.9 ppg) and third-leading rebounder (4.9 ppg) while emerging as the team's top defender.

Myles Dread sits in the top five in program history in career 3-pointers made and returns to utilize the extra year of eligibility granted by the NCAA due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Penn State also returns junior Dallion Johnson who broke into the starting lineup for the final 14 games of the 2021-22 season, in addition to classmate Caleb Dorsey.

TRANSFER HAUL

The Nittany Lions added three highly-accomplished graduate transfers this spring who have combined for 3,666 career points, 1,236 career rebounds and 901 career assists in 341 Division I games.

Guards Andrew Funk (Bucknell) and Camren Wynter (Drexel) each averaged double-digit points in their final three seasons at their respective previous institutions and are primed to bolster an already strong backcourt. Forward Mikey Henn (Denver) will add experience to an otherwise young frontcourt.

HIGHEST-RANKED CLASS IN PROGRAM HISTORY

Penn State's five-man freshman class, Shrewsbury's first recruiting class, is the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history and ranks as a consensus top-30 class in the nation by all major recruiting services.

The five-man class is comprised of guards Jameel Brown (Philadelphia, Pa.), Kanye Clary (Virginia Beach, Va.), wing Evan Mahaffey (Cincinnati, Ohio), and forwards Demetrius Lilley (Philadelphia, Pa.) and Kebba Njie (Centerville, Ohio).

DE-FENSE!

The Nittany Lions led the Big Ten in scoring defense a season ago, allowing just 65.0 points per game. Penn State's mark of 66.2 points allowed per conference game also led the Big Ten.

Penn State's 65.0 points per game allowed was its best defensive mark since the 2010-11 team surrendered just 62.5 points per contest.

CLOSE GAMES

The Nittany Lions consistently found themselves in close games last season, with 16 contests decided by seven points or less.

Fourteen of Penn State's 23 contests against Big Ten foes (including Big Ten Tournament) were decided by seven points or less.

Eight of Penn State's 13 Big Ten losses came by seven points or less: #3 Purdue (67-74), at #16 Ohio State (56-61), at #11 Wisconsin (49-51), Michigan (57-58), at Minnesota (70-76), at Maryland (61-67), at #20 Illinois (55-60), and at Rutgers (58-59). Including non-conference play, 10 of Penn State's 17 losses in 2021-22 came by seven points or less.

THE 2022-23 SLATE

Penn State hosts 16 home games inside the Bryce Jordan Center to highlight the 2022-23 schedule.

The Nittany Lions play their first three games of the season at home before heading to the Charleston Classic for three tournament contests. Penn State's only true road game of non-conference play comes on Nov. 29 in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge at Clemson.

The Nittany Lions open conference play at home on Dec. 7 when Penn State hosts Michigan State. Five weekend games inside the Bryce Jordan Center highlight the Nittany Lions' home conference slate, while Penn State will also host Purdue in the historic Palestra on Sunday, Jan. 8.

BACK TO PHILLY

Penn State makes its return to the historic Palestra on Sunday, Jan. 8, when the Nittany Lions host Purdue in the City of Brotherly Love.

The Nittany Lions have won both Big Ten games they've previously hosted in the "Cathedral of College Basketball", defeating Michigan State in 2017 and Iowa in 2020. Penn State has played 60 total games in The Palestra dating back to 1927.

The 2022-23 Nittany Lion roster includes several student-athletes with Philadelphia-area ties including Seth Lundy (Paulsboro, N.J.; Roman Catholic), Jameel Brown (Philadelphia, Pa.; Westtown School), Andrew Funk (Warrington, Pa.; Archbishop Wood), Demetrius Lilley (Philadelphia, Pa.; Lower Merion) and Camren Wynter (transfer from Drexel.)

HOME SWEET HAPPY VALLEY

The home court advantage has been friendly to the Nittany Lions, as Penn State is 65-30 (.684) when playing inside the Bryce Jordan Center over the last six-plus years.

Penn State announced in June 2022 that the Legion of Blue, the official student section for Penn State Men's Basketball, will be relocated to behind the home and visiting team benches, with additional student seating continuing to be behind the baskets.

PETER AND ANN TOMBROS ENDOWED HEAD COACH

MICAH SHREWSBERRY

Micah Shrewsberry was announced as the 14th men's basketball head coach in Penn State history on March 15, 2021, and enters his second season on Happy Valley in 2022-23. Shrewsberry came to Penn State with a wealth of experience and success at both the collegiate and NBA levels, having coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs, and two NBA Conference Finals.

Shrewsberry immediately put his stamp on the Nittany Lion program during his first season at the helm. He engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense in 2021-22 and guided the Nittany Lions to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in 11 years. The Nittany Lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games. The regular season saw Penn State earn a number of statement wins, including victories over 19th-ranked Michigan State, Big Ten Tournament champion Iowa, and NCAA Tournament participants Indiana and Rutgers.

Shrewsberry's efforts on the recruiting trail were felt immediately as he and the Penn State staff signed the highest ranked recruiting class in Penn State men's basketball history in November 2021, less than eight months into his tenure in Happy Valley. The 2022 signing class ranks as a consensus top-30 class in the nation by all major recruiting services.

Prior to Penn State, Shrewsberry spent the previous two seasons with Big Ten foe Purdue as the associate head coach. As the offensive coordinator, Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a fourth-place finish with a 13-6 Big Ten record in 2020-21. Purdue finished with an 18-9 overall mark and earned an NCAA Tournament berth in 2021. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections.

Before his time at Purdue, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018. Under Shrewsberry, Boston ranked sixth in the NBA in 3-pointers made and seventh in 3-point field goal percentage in the 2018-19 season and was second in 3-point field goal percentage in 2017-18, behind the NBA champion Golden State Warriors.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of current NBA stars Jaylen Brown and Jayson Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors. Shrewsberry was also an assistant coach in the 2017 NBA All-Star Game.

Shrewsberry's first stint as an assistant coach at Purdue spanned the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons where he helped the Boilers reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament. He played an integral role in helping Purdue's offense lead the country in fewest turnovers per game with 8.74 in 2011-12. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the Big Ten in 2011-12, improving his field goal percentage by nearly 13 percent and upping his scoring average by more than five points per game from his freshman to sophomore year.

The Indianapolis native spent four seasons at Butler University under head coach Brad Stevens. He started his time with the Bulldogs as the coordinator of basketball operations before serving as an assistant coach for three seasons. With Shrewsberry on the bench, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles, and made three NCAA Tournament appearances.

During Shrewsberry's time at Butler, the Bulldogs reached the 2010 and 2011 National Championship games. He aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year in 2010 and on the Final Four All-Tournament Team in 2010. Hayward was selected as the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz.

Shrewsberry was the head coach at Indiana University-South Bend from 2005-07. He served as the Chicagoland Collegiate Athletic Conference (CCAC) Division I Men's Basketball Chair in 2006-07. In his second season at the helm, the Titans showed a nine-game improvement from his inaugural season.

He was also the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

As player, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain at Hanover College. He led the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference in free throw shooting (.833) and assists (4.4) in 1998-99.

Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree in sports management from Indiana State in 2003. He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.

PENN STATE DRILLS PROGRAM-RECORD 18 3-POINTERS IN OPENING NIGHT WIN

Penn State drained a program-record 18 3-pointers en route to a dominant 93-68 victory over Winthrop in the 2022-23 season opener at the Bryce Jordan Center.

Penn State put together a dominant offensive effort to the tune of 93 points, its most in a single game since putting up 95 against Nebraska on Feb. 19, 2019. The Nittany Lions' single-game record 18 3-pointers came on a blistering 47.4 percent (18-38) clip from beyond the arc.

Guard Jalen Pickett led Penn State with 23 points on 9-of-13 shooting, five rebounds and five assists. Guard Andrew Funk drilled six three points and shot 8-for-12 from the field to put up 22 points in his Penn State debut. Myles Dread (12) and Seth Lundy (10) also finished in double figures. A total of 10 Nittany Lions scored in the balanced team effort.

The Nittany Lions had 24 assists on 33 made field goals, their most since recording 24 against Central Connecticut State on Dec. 20, 2019.

The Nittany Lions shot 55.0 percent (33-for-60) from the field, their best single-game field goal percentage since shooting 60.0 percent against Bucknell on Nov. 19, 2019.

Penn State scored 28 points off 17 Winthrop turnovers. The Nittany Lion defense collected eight steals and five blocks.
