### OPENING TIPS

- Penn State looks to snap a three-game skid Thursday night when the #17/24 Indiana Hoosiers come to town for a 6 p.m. nationally-televised battle at the BJC.
- Penn State is 7-11 overall and earned its first Big Ten victory of the season against Michigan State on Jan. 9. Four of Penn State's wins this season have come over 2019 NCAA Tournament teams.
- Junior Kamaria McDaniel is the Big Ten's second-leading scorer with 19.1 points per game. Senior Siyeh Frazier (12.9 ppg) is also averaging double-digit points.

### IF PENN STATE BEATS INDIANA

- Penn State would earn its second win of Big Ten play and snap a three-game losing streak.
- The Lady Lions would hand Indiana its fourth-straight loss.
- Penn State would improve to 6-5 at the Bryce Jordan Center this season.

**Prowling At Night**

- Penn State is 4-1 in night games (after 5 p.m. local) this season and the Lady Lions are 3-1 in games played on Thursdays.
- PSU earned wins over Fordham (Nov. 13), Clemson (Nov. 21), Pittsburgh (Dec. 5) and Michigan State (Jan. 9) in 7 p.m. contests. Three of those teams were 2019 NCAA Tournament competitors.
- Penn State's only loss in a night game came on Jan. 16 in a close 57-62 defeat to Rutgers.

**Dangerous Duo**

- The duo of senior Siyeh Frazier and junior Kamaria McDaniel became the first pair of Penn State players to both score 20-plus points in back-to-back games since the 2011-12 season.
- Frazier and McDaniel both scored 24 points against Michigan State on Jan. 9 and followed that with 22-point performances at Ohio State on Jan. 12.
- The last time the same two players scored 20-plus points in back-to-back games was Nov. 26 and Nov. 30, 2011 when Zhaque Gray and Maggie Lucas did so. Gray scored 21 against Nevada on Nov. 26, 2011 and 25 against North Carolina on Nov. 30, 2011, while Lucas dropped 26 against Nevada and 21 against UNC.
- Frazier and McDaniel have been off to a torrid start in conference play. McDaniel is averaging 20.7 points per conference game, while Frazier owns a mark of 14.7 points per Big Ten contest.

**20-20 Vision**

- Junior Kamaria McDaniel scored 20 or more points in four of Penn State's first five Big Ten games. She was the first Lady Lion to score 20-plus in four of the first five conference games since Tyra Grant did so during the 2009-10 season.
- The Inkster, Mich. native has tallied seven 20-plus point efforts this season and has scored in double figures in 17 of Penn State's 18 games.

**Kamaria McBuckets**

- Kamaria McDaniel is the Big Ten's second-leading scorer and averaging 19.1 points per game. That mark ranks 30th in all of Division I as of Jan. 22. Her 20.7 points per Big Ten game ranks second in the conference.
- She dropped the third 40-point game in program history against Pittsburgh on Dec. 5 and put up a 31-point performance against Minnesota in the Big Ten opener on Dec. 28. McDaniel was just one assist away from recording Penn State's first triple-double of the Big Ten era on Jan. 9 against Michigan State as she tallied team-best marks of 24 points, 11 rebounds and nine assists. It marked her first career double-double.

**Finding the Free Throw Line**

- Penn State leads the Big Ten and ranks seventh nationally in free throws made (281) and 21st in free throws attempted (382) as of Jan. 22.
- Kamaria McDaniel has found her way to the free throw line the most, attempting a team-best 121 freebies. Her 121 free throw attempts lead the Big Ten and rank 11th in the nation. Freshman Makenna Marisa is shooting a team-best 84.8 percent (39-for-46) from the charity stripe.

**Four Wins Over 2019 NCAA Tournament Teams**

- Four of Penn State's seven wins this season have come against 2019 NCAA Tournament teams.
- The Lady Lions kicked off the season with a 73-67 victory at defending CAA Tournament champ Towson. It marked the first win in the Carolyn Kieger era.
- Penn State then picked up a 72-59 win against defending Atlantic 10 champion Fordham on Nov. 13. It marked the 950th win in program history.
- Penn State fought for a gritty 68-55 win over Clemson on Nov. 21. Penn State out-scored the Tigers 28-16 in the final 15 minutes to secure the win.
- Penn State earned its first Big Ten win of the season against Michigan State on Jan. 9. The Spartans advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament a season ago. Penn State out-scored the Spartans 25-16 in the final quarter to pull away for the 86-73 win and collect head coach Carolyn Kieger's first-career Big Ten victory.

**BIG Win**

- A full-team offensive onslaught led Penn State to its first Big Ten victory of the season on Jan. 9 as the Lady Lions took down visiting Michigan State 86-73 in Happy Valley.
- Penn State tallied a season-best 22 assists on 31 made field goals in its efficient offensive night, while shooting 49.2 percent (31-for-63) from the field, 46.7 percent (7-for-15) from three-point range, and 94.4 percent (17-for-18) from the free throw line.
- Senior Siyeh Frazier and junior Kamaria McDaniel both registered 24 points. McDaniel also led Penn State with career-best marks of 11 rebounds and nine assists, finishing just one assist shy of a triple-double.

**This Is BIG**

- Penn State enters its 28th season as a member of the Big Ten Conference and has enjoyed immense success since becoming a member of the storied conference in 1992-93.
- The Lady Lions own a winning record against nine of the 13 other Big Ten programs. Penn State owns an all-time mark of 274-180 in Big Ten play, with marks of 164-64 at home and 110-116 on the road.
- Penn State's eight regular-season championships since joining the conference in 1992-93 are the second-most won by any Big Ten team during that span. The Lady Lions also own a pair of Big Ten Tournament titles, winning in 1995 and 1996.

**SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION**

**Scouting Indiana**

- #17/24 Indiana enters Thursday's contest with a 14-5 overall record and 4-3 mark in Big Ten play.
- The Hoosiers started conference play 4-0, but have since lost three-straight games. Indiana fell in double overtime at Iowa (85-91) on Jan. 12 before dropping a home overtime contest to Northwestern (69-71) on Jan. 16. The Hoosiers are coming off a 62-76 loss at Maryland in their most recent game Monday night.
- Indiana ranks in the top three of the Big Ten in scoring margin (+16.9 - second), field goal percentage (48.0 - second), field goal percentage defense (35.5 - second), three-point field goal percentage defense (24.8 - first) and defensive rebounds (28.6 - first).
- Six Hoosiers are averaging nine or more points per game, led by Grace Berger's 13.5 points per contest.

**Against The Hoosiers**

- Penn State leads the all-time series against Indiana 33-14, including a 19-3 edge when playing in Happy Valley. The Hoosiers have won five of the last six meetings, but Penn State emerged victorious in the last matchup in the BJC on Jan. 3, 2018.
- The two teams last met on New Year's Eve a season ago, with Indiana claiming an 83-75 victory.
- The Hoosiers held a one-point lead entering the fourth quarter before outscoring the Lady Lions 27-20 in the final term with the help of a 13-for-15 showing from the free throw line and 12 fourth-quarter points from Ali Patberg.
- Teniya Page led four Lady Lions in double figures with 24 points. Alisia Smith and Kamaria McDaniel followed with 15 and 14 points, respectively, while Siyeh Frazier added 11.
- Sophomores Alisia Smith and Kamaria McDaniel followed with 15 and 14 points, respectively, while junior Siyeh Frazier added 11.

### **950 And Counting**

- The Lady Lions earned the 950th victory in program history on Nov. 13 when Penn State beat Fordham 72-59 at the Bryce Jordan Center. The Lady Lions hold an all-time record of 955-493. This is the 56th season of Penn State Women's Basketball.
- Penn State became the 20th Division I women's basketball teams to have reached the 950-win mark. The Lady Lions joined Tennessee, UConn, Louisiana Tech, James Madison, Stanford, Texas, Stephen F. Austin, Old Dominion, Ohio State, Green Bay, Western Kentucky, Maryland, Notre Dame, South Dakota State, Georgia, North Carolina, Belmont, Baylor and Kansas State in the 950 win club.

### **Keep It 100**

- Head Coach Carolyn Kieger earned her 100th career head coaching victory with Penn State's season-opening 73-67 win at Towson on Nov. 5. She came to Penn State with a 99-64 record in five seasons as the head coach at Marquette.

### **Among The NCAA's Elite**

- Penn State is one of only 19 schools with at least 25 NCAA Tournament appearances, joining Tennessee, Georgia, Stanford, Texas, UConn, Louisiana Tech, Vanderbilt, North Carolina, Purdue, LSU, Maryland, Old Dominion, Iowa, Notre Dame, Ohio State, Rutgers, Virginia and NC State.
- Penn State has been to 25 NCAA Tournaments, 13 Sweet Sixteens, four Elite Eights and one Final Four.

### **A New Era Begins**

- Penn State enters its first season under head coach Carolyn Kieger in 2019-20. Kieger, a 2019 Naismith Women's Coach of the Year Award semifinalist, guided Marquette University to the top of the Big East Conference and three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances as the Golden Eagles' head coach.
- Kieger, a 2006 Marquette graduate, came to Happy Valley after five years at the helm of her alma mater, posting a 99-64 overall record. During the past three seasons, Kieger led the Golden Eagles to sparkling 76-26 mark (43-11 in Big East), which included a pair of Big East regular-season championships and a Big East Tournament Championship. Marquette made three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in 20 years, advancing to the round of 32 the past two seasons.

Players will generally be available on a weekly basis throughout the season, in conjunction with head coach Carolyn Kieger's weekly availability. Interviews will not be granted on game day prior to tip-off. Player phone numbers will not be released. Following games, requested Penn State student-athletes will be brought to the postgame media interview room. The Penn State locker room is closed.

### **CREDENTIALS**

Single game and season press credentials are issued to accredited members of the working media only. Requests for credentials should be directed to Chelsea Vielhauer at least one week in advance of each game. Press credentials can be picked up at Media Will Call, which is located at the Media/Team entrance, on the south side of the Bryce Jordan Center, across from the Penn State Lacrosse Complex.

### **PHOTOGRAPHERS**

A photo pass must be issued to gain access courtside in the Bryce Jordan Center. Please contact Chelsea Vielhauer one week in advance for photo passes. Courtside photographers must follow NCAA guidelines, which prohibit entry to the bench areas and the stands, and must remain seated at all times.

# HEAD COACH CAROLYN KIEGER

First Season • Marquette '06  
Overall Career Record: 106-75  
Penn State Record: 7-11

Penn State and Vice President of Athletics Sandy Barbour announced the selection of Carolyn Kieger as the sixth head coach of the women's basketball program on April 3, 2019. Kieger (pronounced KEY-grr), a 2019 Naismith Women's Coach of the Year Award semifinalist, guided Marquette University to the top of the Big East Conference and three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances as the Golden Eagles' head coach.

Kieger, a 2006 Marquette graduate, comes to Happy Valley after five years at the helm of her alma mater, posting a 99-64 overall record. During the past three seasons, Kieger led the Golden Eagles to sparkling 76-26 mark (43-11 in Big East), which included a pair of Big East regular-season championships and a Big East Tournament Championship. Marquette made three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in 20 years, advancing to the round of 32 the past two seasons.

Widely regarded as one of the nation's brightest and rising coaching stars, Kieger's first Marquette team in 2014-15 won nine games. She proceeded to lead the Golden Eagles to 14, 25, 24 and a program-record 27 victories over the next four seasons.

Kieger was named a semifinalist for the 2019 Naismith Women's Coach of the Year Award after leading the Golden Eagles to one of the best seasons in program history this past season. Marquette captured its second consecutive, but first-ever outright Big East regular-season title and a posted a school-best 27-8 record. The Golden Eagles were ranked in every Associated Press poll of the season for the first time in school history.

Marquette earned its third-straight NCAA Tournament berth in 2018-19, advancing to the second round for the second consecutive year. The Golden Eagles garnered a No. 5 seed and defeated Rice before dropping a two-point decision at No. 4 seed Texas A&M in the second round. The three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances were Marquette's first since a three-year run from 1997-99.

Kieger mentored Allazia Blockton and Natisha Hiedeman to become Marquette's first Big East Players of the Year in 2017-18 and 2018-19, respectively. Kieger coached nine All-Big East selections in the last three seasons.



The 2017-18 campaign was another banner year as Kieger was named Big East Co-Coach of the Year after guiding the Golden Eagles to a program-record 15-3 conference mark and their first Big East regular season title. Kieger earned her first NCAA Tournament coaching victory with a first-round win over Dayton before falling at No. 1 seed Louisville.

Kieger coached Marquette to new heights in 2016-17 as the Golden Eagles won the Big East Tournament title for the first time in program history, while also earning a program-best No. 5 seed in the NCAA Tournament. She directed MU to the Big Dance for the first time since 2011. Kieger led Marquette to a 25-8 record in 2016-17, finishing with a 6-0 mark against teams ranked in the Top 25.

In her second year at the helm of the Golden Eagles, Kieger had the youngest program in NCAA Division I with eight freshmen on the roster in 2015-16, as MU improved its win total by five games. She made her collegiate head coaching debut on Nov. 15, 2014 against Green Bay and earned her first career victory on Nov. 17, 2014 when Marquette defeated Loyola-Chicago.

Prior to being named head coach at her alma mater, Kieger spent six seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Miami from 2008-14. Following graduation, she was at Miami as the coordinator of basketball operations (2006-07) and then served as director of operations at Marquette in 2007-08.

Kieger returned to Miami as an assistant coach in 2008-09 and was primarily responsible for guard development with the Hurricanes. She helped advance the skills of Miami guard Shenise Johnson, who earned All-America and ACC Player of the Year honors in 2010-11, while the squad was crowned ACC regular-season champions. She also helped guard Riquna Williams earn All-ACC first team accolades and finish as the ACC scoring leader with 21.7 points per game. Miami made three NCAA Tournament appearances and two in the WNIT during Kieger's last five seasons with the Hurricanes.

Kieger was a four-year starter at Marquette, a three-year captain and is MU's all-time assists leader. She is the only player in program history with at least 1,200 career points, 400 career rebounds and 600 assists. Kieger averaged 10.3 points per game during her career and was a second-team All-Big East selection in 2005-06, as well as, a second-team All-Conference USA selection for the 2003-04 and 2004-05 seasons.

During her senior campaign, Kieger was a finalist for the Nancy Lieberman Award, presented to the nation's top point guard. In addition to her athletic accomplishments, Kieger received the Big East Conference's Sportsmanship award as a senior.

A native of Roseville, Minnesota, Kieger graduated Cum Laude from Marquette with a bachelor's degree in broadcasting and electronic communications in 2006. She received the McCahill Award in 2007, presented to a graduated MU senior student-athlete who demonstrated the highest performance in scholarship, leadership and athletics.
