OPENING TIPS

- Penn State faces a tough test Sunday when first-place #10 Maryland comes to Happy Valley. The Lady Lions will honor their three-member senior class (Siyeh Frazier, Kayleigh Semion and Jaida Travascio-Green) prior to tipoff on Senior Day.
- Four of Penn State's wins this season have come over 2019 NCAA Tournament teams.
- Junior Kamaria McDaniel is the Big Ten's leading scorer with 19.4 points per game. Senior Siyeh Frazier (12.2 ppg) is also averaging double-digit points.

IF PENN STATE BEATS MARYLAND

- Penn State would defeat an opponent ranked in the top ten of at least one of the national polls for the first time since Feb. 20, 2012 when the Lady Lions beat No. 8/11 Ohio State, 84-66.
- The Lady Lions would earn their first victory over the Terrapins since 2003 and first win in the series since Maryland joined the Big Ten.

Senior Day

- Penn State will honor its three-member senior class prior to tipoff Sunday on Senior Day.
- Siyeh Frazier has been a go-to leader both on and off the court throughout her time at Penn State. A key player in all four years of her career, Siyeh has tallied marks of nearly 900 points and 400 rebounds. She’s revered as one of the best defensive players in the Big Ten, earning team defensive MVP honors in previous seasons and currently ranking third in the Big Ten in steals per game. Siyeh was named Penn State’s recipient of the Big Ten Sportsmanship award at the conclusion of the 2018-19 season.
- Jaida Travascio-Green has exemplified what it means to excel in all areas of the student-athlete experience. She is a biochemistry and molecular biology major that is a two-time Academic All-Big Ten honoree. She holds the number eight spot on Penn State’s three-pointers in a single season chart and sits top 30 in three-pointers made in a career. Despite being injured for her senior season, Jaida took on a student coaching role this season and has continued to make an impact on her teammates.
- Kayleigh Semion has proven the value of hard work and dedication throughout her time at Penn State. She began her career as a club basketball player and team manager before earning a roster spot during the 2017-18 season. A consummate teammate, Kayleigh has made an impact both on and off the court for the Lady Lions. She has provided a crucial spark off the bench and always given her all. A true student-athlete, Kayleigh is a two-time Academic All-Big Ten selection and pursuing her master’s degree in Management and Organizational Leadership.

Kamaria McBuckets

- Kamaria McDaniel is the Big Ten’s leading scorer and averaging 19.4 points per game. That mark ranks 20th in all of Division I as of Feb. 15. Her 20.5 points per Big Ten game is tied for fifth place in the conference.
- She dropped the third 40-point game in program history against Pittsburgh on Dec. 5 and put up a 31-point performance against Minnesota on Dec. 28. McDaniel was just one assist away from recording Penn State’s first triple-double of the Big Ten era on Jan. 9 against Michigan State as she tallied team-best marks of 24 points, 11 rebounds and nine assists. It marked her first career double-double. She then put together a 35-point effort at Purdue on Jan. 26. It marked her third 30-plus point performance of the season.

Nearing 1,000

- Kamaria McDaniel enters Sunday’s game against Maryland with 935 career points, putting her just 65 points away from the 1,000-point mark.
- With at least five games remaining on the schedule (four regular-season and one guaranteed Big Ten Tournament game), McDaniel will need to average 13 points per game to reach the 1,000-point mark. She currently averages a Big Ten-leading 19.4 ppg.
- McDaniel has scored 485 points thus far this year, 35 more than her first two seasons combined (450).
- McDaniel would become the 39th member of the Lady Lion 1,000-Point Club and first to join since Teniya Page (Class of 2019 - 2,108 career points).

20-20 Vision

- Kamaria McDaniel has tallied ten 20-plus point efforts, seven of which have come in conference play, and has scored in double figures in 23 of Penn State’s 25 games.
- McDaniel’s scoring jump comes after she finished her sophomore campaign averaging 9.7 ppg in 2018-19.

Finding the Free Throw Line

- Penn State ranks 22nd nationally in free throws made (349) and 37th in free throws attempted (477) as of Feb. 15.
- Kamaria McDaniel has found her way to the free throw line the most, attempting a team-best 164 freebies. Her 164 free throw attempts lead the Big Ten and rank 10th in the nation. Freshman Makenna Marisa is shooting a team-best 83.6 percent (46-for-55) from the charity stripe.

BIG Win

- A full-team offensive onslaught led Penn State to its first Big Ten victory of the season on Jan. 9 as the Lady Lions took down visiting Michigan State 86-73 in Happy Valley.
- Penn State tallied a season-best 22 assists on 31 made field goals in its efficient offensive night, while shooting 49.2 percent (31-for-63) from the field, 46.7 percent (7-for-15) from three-point range, and 94.4 percent (17-for-18) from the free throw line.
- Senior Siyeh Frazier and junior Kamaria McDaniel both registered 24 points. McDaniel also led Penn State with career-best marks of 11 rebounds and nine assists, finishing just one assist shy of a triple-double.

This Is BIG

- Penn State is in its 28th season as a member of the Big Ten Conference and has enjoyed immense success since becoming a member of the storied conference in 1992-93.
- The Lady Lions own a winning record against nine of the 13 other Big Ten programs. Penn State owns an all-time mark of 274-188 in Big Ten play, with marks of 164-68 at home and 110-119 on the road.
- Penn State's eight regular-season championships since joining the conference in 1992-93 are the second-most won by any Big Ten team during that span. The Lady Lions also own a pair of Big Ten Tournament titles, winning in 1995 and 1996.

SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION

Scouting Maryland

- Maryland is the Big Ten's highest-ranked team, coming in at No. 10 in both the AP and Coaches Polls.
- The Terrapins are 21-4 overall and 12-2 in conference play. Maryland owns sole possession of first place in the Big Ten standings.
- Maryland leads the Big Ten with 81.9 points per game as well as a +24.7 scoring margin.
- The Terrapins have won their last 10 games, including a dominant 93-59 victory over #17/20 Iowa in their most recent game Thursday night.
- Only nine Terrapins have seen the court this season, but Maryland owns a balanced offensive attack that gets contributions from top to bottom.
- Kaila Charles leads five Terrapins in double figures with 15.2 points per game. She also leads the team with 7.9 rebounds per contest.

Against The Terrapins

- Penn State will be looking for its first win over the Terrapins since Maryland joined the Big Ten.
- Maryland holds a slim 15-14 lead in the all-time series and the Terrapins have won the last seven matchups.
- Maryland swept last season's regular-season series. The Terrapins were ranked in the top 10 during both of those meetings.
- Penn State hung right with No. 9/9 Maryland for three quarters before the Terrapins spent the final 12:06 of the game on a 30-16 run en route to a 79-67 win in the most recent meeting on Jan. 20, 2019 in College Park, Md.
- Teniya Page led the Lady Lions with 20 points. Siyeh Frazier followed with 13 points to go along with eight rebounds.

950 And Counting

- The Lady Lions earned the 950th victory in program history on Nov. 13 when Penn State beat Fordham 72-59 at the Bryce Jordan Center. The Lady Lions hold an all-time record of 955-500. This is the 56th season of Penn State Women’s Basketball.
- Penn State became the 20th Division I women’s basketball teams to have reached the 950-win mark. The Lady Lions joined Tennessee, UConn, Louisiana Tech, James Madison, Stanford, Texas, Stephen F. Austin, Old Dominion, Ohio State, Green Bay, Western Kentucky, Maryland, Notre Dame, South Dakota State, Georgia, North Carolina, Belmont, Baylor and Kansas State in the 950 win club.

Keep It 100

- Head Coach Carolyn Kieger earned her 100th career head coaching victory with Penn State’s season-opening 73-67 win at Towson on Nov. 5. She came to Penn State with a 99-64 record in five seasons as the head coach at Marquette.

Among The NCAA’s Elite

- Penn State is one of only 19 schools with at least 25 NCAA Tournament appearances, joining Tennessee, Georgia, Stanford, Texas, UConn, Louisiana Tech, Vanderbilt, North Carolina, Purdue, LSU, Maryland, Old Dominion, Iowa, Notre Dame, Ohio State, Rutgers, Virginia and NC State.
- Penn State has been to 25 NCAA Tournaments, 13 Sweet Sixteens, four Elite Eights and one Final Four.

A New Era Begins

- Penn State enters its first season under head coach Carolyn Kieger in 2019-20. Kieger, a 2019 Naismith Women’s Coach of the Year Award semifinalist, guided Marquette University to the top of the Big East Conference and three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances as the Golden Eagles’ head coach.
- Kieger, a 2006 Marquette graduate, came to Happy Valley after five years at the helm of her alma mater, posting a 99-64 overall record. During the past three seasons, Kieger led the Golden Eagles to sparkling 76-26 mark (43-11 in Big East), which included a pair of Big East regular-season championships and a Big East Tournament Championship. Marquette made three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in 20 years, advancing to the round of 32 the past two seasons.

Following games, requested Penn State student-athletes will be brought to the postgame media interview room. The Penn State locker room is closed.

Requests for credentials should be directed to Chelsea Vielhauer at least one week in advance of each game. Press credentials can be picked up at Media Will Call, which is located at the Media/Team entrance, on the south side of the Bryce Jordan Center, across from the Penn State Lacrosse Complex.

A photo pass must be issued to gain access courtside in the Bryce Jordan Center. Please contact Chelsea Vielhauer one week in advance for photo passes. Courtside photographers must follow NCAA guidelines, which prohibit entry to the bench areas and the stands, and must remain seated at all times.

HEAD COACH CAROLYN KIEGER

First Season • Marquette '06
Overall Career Record: 106-82
Penn State Record: 7-18

Penn State and Vice President of Athletics Sandy Barbour announced the selection of Carolyn Kieger as the sixth head coach of the women's basketball program on April 3, 2019. Kieger (pronounced KEY-grr), a 2019 Naismith Women's Coach of the Year Award semifinalist, guided Marquette University to the top of the Big East Conference and three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances as the Golden Eagles' head coach.

Kieger, a 2006 Marquette graduate, comes to Happy Valley after five years at the helm of her alma mater, posting a 99-64 overall record. During the past three seasons, Kieger led the Golden Eagles to sparkling 76-26 mark (43-11 in Big East), which included a pair of Big East regular-season championships and a Big East Tournament Championship. Marquette made three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in 20 years, advancing to the round of 32 the past two seasons.

Widely regarded as one of the nation's brightest and rising coaching stars, Kieger's first Marquette team in 2014-15 won nine games. She proceeded to lead the Golden Eagles to 14, 25, 24 and a program-record 27 victories over the next four seasons.

Kieger was named a semifinalist for the 2019 Naismith Women's Coach of the Year Award after leading the Golden Eagles to one of the best seasons in program history this past season. Marquette captured its second consecutive, but first-ever outright Big East regular-season title and a posted a school-best 27-8 record. The Golden Eagles were ranked in every Associated Press poll of the season for the first time in school history.

Marquette earned its third-straight NCAA Tournament berth in 2018-19, advancing to the second round for the second consecutive year. The Golden Eagles garnered a No. 5 seed and defeated Rice before dropping a two-point decision at No. 4 seed Texas A&M in the second round. The three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances were Marquette's first since a three-year run from 1997-99.

Kieger mentored Allazia Blockton and Natisha Hiedeman to become Marquette's first Big East Players of the Year in 2017-18 and 2018-19, respectively. Kieger coached nine All-Big East selections in the last three seasons.



The 2017-18 campaign was another banner year as Kieger was named Big East Co-Coach of the Year after guiding the Golden Eagles to a program-record 15-3 conference mark and their first Big East regular season title. Kieger earned her first NCAA Tournament coaching victory with a first-round win over Dayton before falling at No. 1 seed Louisville.

Kieger coached Marquette to new heights in 2016-17 as the Golden Eagles won the Big East Tournament title for the first time in program history, while also earning a program-best No. 5 seed in the NCAA Tournament. She directed MU to the Big Dance for the first time since 2011. Kieger led Marquette to a 25-8 record in 2016-17, finishing with a 6-0 mark against teams ranked in the Top 25.

In her second year at the helm of the Golden Eagles, Kieger had the youngest program in NCAA Division I with eight freshmen on the roster in 2015-16, as MU improved its win total by five games. She made her collegiate head coaching debut on Nov. 15, 2014 against Green Bay and earned her first career victory on Nov. 17, 2014 when Marquette defeated Loyola-Chicago.

Prior to being named head coach at her alma mater, Kieger spent six seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Miami from 2008-14. Following graduation, she was at Miami as the coordinator of basketball operations (2006-07) and then served as director of operations at Marquette in 2007-08.

Kieger returned to Miami as an assistant coach in 2008-09 and was primarily responsible for guard development with the Hurricanes. She helped advance the skills of Miami guard Shenise Johnson, who earned All-America and ACC Player of the Year honors in 2010-11, while the squad was crowned ACC regular-season champions. She also helped guard Riquna Williams earn All-ACC first team accolades and finish as the ACC scoring leader with 21.7 points per game. Miami made three NCAA Tournament appearances and two in the WNIT during Kieger's last five seasons with the Hurricanes.

Kieger was a four-year starter at Marquette, a three-year captain and is MU's all-time assists leader. She is the only player in program history with at least 1,200 career points, 400 career rebounds and 600 assists.
