PENN STATE HOCKEY

THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

- The Nittany Lions enter the weekend on a five-game winless streak after going unbeaten in their previous 11 games.
- The Irish are also reeling in a sense of having been shut-out in two of their last three games after a 16-game winning-streak, but remain 11 points clear of second place Ohio State in the Big Ten standings.
- This weekend marks just the seventh and eighth matchup between the two schools as Notre Dame joined the Big Ten at the beginning of the season coming over from Hockey East.
- After sweeping Penn State, Notre Dame now leads the all-time series 3-2-1.

RUSSIAN ROCKET

- Sophomore Denis Smirnov contributed 50 percent of the Penn State offense last weekend against Wisconsin as he scored three goals to grab the team lead with 13 on the season, which is tied for third in the Big Ten.
- Smirnov also registered his 20th career multi-point effort and the 6th multi-goal game of his career during the 4-4 tie on Saturday evening.
- On Friday, Smirnov scored a power-play goal giving him six on the season to tie a Penn State single-season record for power-play tallies and tie for third in the Big Ten this season.
- With 69 career points Smirnov also moved into a tie with David Glen '16 for seventh on Penn State's all-time points list while his 32 career goals now rank sixth all-time.

FROM START TO FINNISH

- Senior Erik Autio has been a mainstay on the blue-line during his time in Happy Valley and currently ranks fourth all-time in games played with 129 and has a chance to climb as high as second by the end of the season.
- Last weekend the Finnish born player snapped a personal six-game (13 total games, missed seven with injury) pointless streak with an assist on a Denis Smirnov goal on Friday.
- With the assist Autio tied Luke Juha '16 for fourth on the Penn State all-time assists list and first among Nittany Lion defensemen with 45.
- Autio's 52 points also tie longtime defensive partner Vince Pedrie for second on the all-time points list for defensemen.

TARGET PRACTICE

- Since the calendar turned to 2018, Penn State leads the nation with 157 blocked shots in eight games averaging 19.62 blocks per game, which also leads the nation.
- A big part of that has been the play of Trevor Hamilton and Cole Hulst who rank first and second in the nation during that span with 27 and 24 blocks, respectively.
- In fact Hamilton leads the entire country in blocked shots on the season with 72 while Kris Myllari ranks 5th in the Big Ten and tied for 13th nationally with 55 blocked shots.

CLOSE BUT NO CIGAR

- Penn State entered last weekend unbeaten when holding a lead entering the third period as they were 12-0-2 in such games on the year and had been unbeaten in 17 straight games dating back to last season when taking a lead into the second intermission. Penn State went 20-3-2 overall in games when leading after two periods in 2016-17
- However, Wisconsin outscored Penn State by a combined 6-1 score over the final 20 minutes last weekend as they lit the lamp three times during each third period.
- On the season Penn State is now being outscored in the third period 39-34 while Notre Dame is outscoring its opponents 30-18 in the third period this season.

HOTTEST TICKET IN TOWN

- Penn State has sold out 70 consecutive games at Pegula Ice Arena and 85 of 87 total contests since the building opened its doors for the start of the 2013-14 season.
- With tickets being exhausted again this weekend the Nittany Lions look to run their sellout streak to 72 games come Saturday night.

BETTER AT THE DOT

- Since the last time these two teams faced each other Penn State has improved its play at the faceoff circle winning 51.7 percent of draws since November 17 to rank 15th in the nation over that stretch and second in the Big Ten.
- The Irish have won 51.3 percent of faceoffs ranking fifth in the Big Ten and 22nd nationally since November 17.

CLANK

- During this five-game winless streak the Nittany Lions haven't had many bounces go in their favor including ringing a total of five shots off the posts during the last three games alone.

BAD BOYS BAD BOYS WHAT'CHA GONNA DO?

- Last Saturday both Penn State and Wisconsin were whistled for 12 penalties and 24 minutes each. This marked the fifth time this season Penn State has had at least 20 penalty minutes in a game and the second against the Badgers.
- The Nittany Lions have have been handed 20-plus penalty minutes 30 times in program history, but the 12 penalties are the second most all-time and the most in a single-game since Penn State's inaugural season in 2012-13 when they received 15 penalties against Buffalo State and 12 against Holy Cross.

PERFECT ATTENDANCE AWARD

- Junior forward Chase Berger hasn't missed a single game in his entire Penn State career and three weeks ago played in his 100th consecutive game becoming the first Nittany Lion in program history to reach 100 games without missing a single one.

SCOUTING NOTRE DAME



- Notre Dame enters the weekend No. 1 in the Pairwise and No. 2 in the nation at 20-5-1 overall.
- The Irish lead the Big Ten 11 points clear of second place Ohio State with 42 points and a 14-2-0 record winning their first 13 conference games to start the season.
- Notre Dame boasts the third best defense in the nation behind only Cornell and Clarkson allowing just 1.96 goals per game. The Irish offense sputters at times, but ranks 23rd in the nation scoring 3.04 goals per game, fifth in the Big Ten.
- Jake Evans leads the team with 31 points on nine goals and 22 assists to rank tied for 2nd in the Big Ten and 13th in the nation. Evans is also a plus-14 this season ranking second in the Big Ten and tied for 12th in the nation.
- Cal Burke leads Notre Dame with 12 goals while Andrew Oglevie is second with 10 as the only two double-digit goal scorers so far this season for the Irish.
- Cale Morris leads the entire nation in save percentage at .952 and is third in goals against average allowing 1.61 goals per contest. Morris has started all but four games for the Irish this season posting a 19-3-0 record with two of those losses coming in the last two weekends.
- Notre Dame has been successful on the power-play this season ranking first in the Big Ten and 17th in the nation converting 19-of-88 (21.6 percent) opportunities. The Irish PK has also been impressive leading the Big Ten and ranking fifth in the entire nation at 87.5 percent (77-for-88). The 11 power-play goals allowed is the third fewest in all of Division I.





HOT & COLD

• During its 11-game unbeaten streak Penn State led the nation scoring 54 goals for an average of 4.91 per game while averaging 40.18 shots per game. The Nittany Lions were a plus-23 during this stretch.

• The defense was also solid allowing just 2.09 goals per game to rank eighth in the nation during that span.

• However, during their latest winless streak of five games Penn State has averaged just 1.80 goals per game to rank 56th in the nation. Penn State is also second to last in the nation in plus/minus at minus-10.

• Penn State has also been outshot in two of those games firing almost four shots less per game (36.60) and is allowing 4.00 goals per game ranking tied for 55th in the nation.

HOBEY HOPEFULS

• For the second consecutive season junior Andrew Sturtz and sophomore Denis Smirnov have been nominated for the Hobey Baker Memorial Award, presented to the top player in NCAA Division I men's hockey.

• Sturtz currently leads the team with 31 points. The junior has scored 11 goals and already has a career-high 20 assists on the season in 27 games played.

• Sturtz recently had a career-long nine-game point streak snapped. Sturtz currently leads the team with 10 multi-point efforts this season.

• Sturtz's 95 career points rank second all-time at Penn State and are tied for 20th in the nation among active players and fifth among the junior class.

• Smirnov missed eight games earlier this season due to an illness, but is still one of the top scorers in the conference with 13 goals and nine assists for 22 points.

• The sophomore's 69 career points are the second most nationally among sophomore's, only trailing Henrik Borgstrom from Denver.

RECAPING 2016-17

• Penn State finished the 2016-17 season with an overall record of 25-12-2. The Lions finished fourth in the Big Ten during the regular season with a record of 10-9-1 for the second straight season.

• The Nittany Lions became the first conference team to capture the Big Ten Tournament Championship by winning three games in three consecutive nights. PSU defeated Michigan, Minnesota and Wisconsin to secure its first ever title with the semifinal and final being decided in double-overtime.

• Penn State advanced to its first-ever NCAA Tournament where it defeated Union (N.Y.) 10-3 before falling 6-3 to eventual National Champion, Denver. The ten goals scored against Union tied an NCAA Tournament record for most goals scored by a team in its debut game and where also the most any team has scored since 1990.

• Penn State broke or tied 65 program/individual records last season including the program marks for most wins (25), points (425), goals (160), assists (265), shots (1,719) and shots per game (44.1).

• Andrew Sturtz became just the second 20-goal scorer in program history as he tied Casey Bailey's single-season record of 22 set during the 2014-15 season.

• The Nittany Lions led the entire nation averaging 4.10 goals per contest.

• The Nittany Lions led the nation in freshman scoring with 157 points on 64 goals and 93 assists.

SMIRNOV, JONES NAMED BIG PLAYERS TO WATCH

• Sophomore classmates Denis Smirnov and Peyton Jones were part of a 17 player watch list as voted on by the seven head coaches in the Big Ten.

• Both players were named an All-Big Ten honorable mention as well as a member of the All-Freshman team following the conclusion of the 2016-17 season.

• Smirnov led the entire nation last season in freshman scoring with 47 points. The Russian winger secured 19 goals and 28 assists for those 47 points all numbers, which are now single-season Penn State records for a freshman. His 47 points and 28 assists are also single-season Penn State records for any player.

• Jones also had a record setting season for Penn State as his 23 wins and 884 saves are both single-season program records.

• Both players were Hobey Baker Award nominees in 2016-17.

• Last season, Penn State had a season-total of 120,513 fans that have been to Pegula Ice Arena, which is the most in the facilities short four-year history.

WELCOME HOME

• Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.

• The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.

• The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

• The Big Ten is in its fifth season entering 2017-18. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.

• The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member for the start of the 2017-18 season.

• Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation or overtime victory, two points for a shootout win and one point for a shootout loss.

• Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.

• The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockey.

• The Big Ten tournament will take place at on campus sites for the first time in league history beginning during the 2017-18 season.

MEET COACH GADOWSKY

Guy Gadowsky, the 2017 Big Ten Tournament Champion coach, will guide the Nittany Lions in his 18th collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program in 2017-18. Gadowsky is currently coaching his sixth Penn State varsity team.

AT PENN STATE

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Along the way Penn State opened the season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com



No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest scoring team in the country averaging 4.10 goals per game.

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with the program-best 25 victories.

In 2015-16 Gadowsky led Penn State to its first 20-win season, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose to as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll during the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6th the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before bowing out to eventual champion Michigan 7-2 in the semifinals.

Of his 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, garnering a winning season in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title up until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a two-year contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs, eventually scoring his first NHL goal in the season finale. Bailey was an All-Big Ten First Team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable mention by the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions

knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play. Additionally, his Lions earned wins over every Big Ten team during the season including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions during the Big Ten Conference's first season. Penn State, which faced seven NCAA tournament teams and three Frozen Four participants, capped its season with a 2-1 double-overtime victory against Michigan in the Big Ten quarterfinals.

In 2012-13, Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to a 13-14-0 record during their inaugural NCAA Division I season. He guided the squad to several marquee victories, including wins against three future Big Ten opponents (Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin). Penn State also topped Vermont at Wells Fargo Arena in front of the largest crowd to watch a college hockey game in an NHL barn (19,529).

In 2011-12, Gadowsky steered Penn State's final season in the ACHA, while recruiting for the future. That team went 29-5-0.

AT PRINCETON

Before coming to Happy Valley, Gadowsky served as Princeton's bench boss for seven seasons. In his first five years as head coach, the Tigers improved their win total in each season. In 2008-09, Princeton captured a program-record 22 victories and earned its second-straight NCAA tournament appearance.

During the 2007-08 campaign, Gadowsky, who inherited a program that had won a combined eight games in the two seasons prior to his arrival, guided Princeton to both the ECAC Hockey tournament and Ivy League crowns. The team earned its first





NCAA tournament berth since 1998, Gadowsky garnered ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year honors and was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, presented to Division I hockey's top coach. He was also named Inside College Hockey National Coach of the Year.

Gadowsky had more than 20 Tiger players go on to sign professional contracts, with Kevin Westgarth playing for the Stanley Cup champion Los Angeles Kings in 2011-12. Gadowsky also coached two ECAC and Ivy League Players of the Year as Lee Jubinville (2008) and Zane Kalemba (2009) each won the award in their junior seasons.

AT ALASKA

Prior to Princeton, Gadowsky spent five seasons as head coach of Alaska (1999-2004), where he inherited a team that had not won more than 14 games in the previous five seasons since joining the then-Central Collegiate Hockey Association. After two rebuilding seasons, the 2002 CCHA Coach of the Year led the Nanooks, ranked 11th nationally at the end of the season, to their only 20-win campaign since joining the conference. He followed that up with 15 wins in 2002-03 and 16 victories his last season.

Alaska twice hosted the first round of the CCHA playoffs in a three-year span, a feat never accomplished prior to Gadowsky's arrival. During his tenure with the Nanooks, his teams set school records for team grade point average, wins and game attendance.

BEFORE COLLEGE COACHING

Before joining the collegiate ranks, Gadowsky spent three seasons (1996-99) as head coach and director of hockey operations for the Fresno Falcons of the West Coast Hockey League. He led the squad to the playoffs in each season and left the team as the winningest coach in franchise history. In his first season, Gadowsky posted a 38-win campaign as he garnered WCHL Coach of the Year accolades.

PLAYING CAREER

The Edmonton, Alberta, native played collegiately at Colorado College from 1985-89, serving as team captain as a senior, while also earning the team's Rodman Award, given for outstanding leadership and sportsmanship. The three-time WCHA All-Academic Team member collected 46 points in 134 career games.

Upon graduation, Gadowsky embarked on a seven-year professional career that included stops with the ECHL's Richmond Renegades, the IHL's San Diego Gulls and the AHL's St. John's Maple Leafs and Prince Edward Island Senators. Gadowsky saved his best season for last as he totaled 52 goals and 29 assists for the Fresno Falcons in 1995-96. He earned league MVP and first-team all-star recognition.

Gadowsky also competed with the Canadian National Team and played professionally in Austria, The Netherlands and Sweden during the 1993-94 season.

PERSONAL LIFE

Gadowsky and his wife, Melissa, have two sons, Mac and Magnus, and a daughter, Mia.
