#### THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

- This weekend marks the 28th and 29th meetings alltime between Penn State and Ohio State with the Buckeyes holding the 15-10-2 all-time advantage including winning the season series last year taking the final nine points after dropping the opening game. However, Penn State earned revenge by going into Columbus for the Big Ten semifinals and securing the 5-1 victory.
- Ohio State has had great success over the years at Pegula Ice Arena boasting a 7-4-1 record including a 4-1-1 record over the past three seasons in Hockey Valley. This weekend pits the top offense in the Big Ten vs. the top defense in the Big Ten as Penn State is averaging 4.73 goals per game and Ohio State is allowing just 1.80.
- Senior Brandon Biro leads all current Nittany Lions with 12 points in 11 career games against Ohio State scoring four goals while adding eight assists. Junior Evan Barratt also has four career goals against the Buckeyes and has added five assists for nine points in nine career games.

#### STERN'SHINING' IN CONFERENCE PLAY

- Junior Sam Sternschein has exploded since the start of Big Ten play three weeks ago with six goals and one assist for seven points. The junior has scored at least one goal in five of the six conference games so far as his six Big Ten goals lead the conference.
- Overall, Sternschein's seven goals this season rank second in the Big Ten and tied for 13th nationally. His current three-game goal-streak is also a career best.

#### **B1G LEADERS**

- Penn State is two points clear of Notre Dame leading the Big Ten with 15 points and a 5-1-0-0 record. The Nittany Lions also have 10 of the top-16 scorers in conference games this season including the top four as both Evan Barratt and Aarne Talvitie lead the conference with eight points in six games while Sternschein and Nate Sucese are right on their heels with seven conference points each.
- Penn State is averaging 5.00 goals per game over its six conference games this season to lead the Big Ten a full 1.75 goals clear of second place Michigan State. The Nittany Lions have also made a vast improvement this season and are allowing just 2.33 goals per game in conference action compared to 4.00 last season.
- Nationally, Penn State ranks third in the nation in scoring averaging 4.73 goals per game while allowing just 2.27, good for 18th in the nation.

#### **BFL BACK AT IT**

- After a slow start to the season, the BFL line has started clicking again in conference play having accounted for eight goals and 12 assists for 20 points over the last five Big Ten games with each member of the trio currently on a three-game point-streak.
- Barratt has multiple points in three-straight games and his eight Big Ten points leads the conference. The junior was recently named the Big Ten Third Star of the Week after leading the conference and ranking second in the nation with five points, all assists, over the weekend at Minnesota.

#### **MARATHON NOT A SPRINT**

 After starting the season getting out to early first period leads, Penn State has actually been held off the scoresheet over the opening twenty minutes during four of the last five contests, but have used strong showings over the final forty minutes to secure victories in three of those games.

- Last weekend at Minnesota, the Nittany Lions outscored the Gophers 14-3 over the final two periods of play and are now outscoring opponents 18-9 and 22-11 in the second and third periods, respectively.
- Overall, Penn State's plus-27 goal differential this season is tied for the national lead with North Dakota while its 52 goals scored are five more than Providence in second.

#### **PHILLI SPECIAL**

- Junior Clayton Phillips is coming off a sweet homecoming last weekend at Minnesota having scored the game-winning goal on Saturday night to lead Penn State to it's first-ever sweep over the Gophers at Mariucci Arena
- Phillips has settled in nicely to Hockey Valley and ranks second on the team in defensemen scoring with eight points on two goals and six assists. The junior is already approaching a career-high point total after registering just 10 points in 34 games with the Gophers last season. His current three-game point-streak is also a career-high.
- Phillips' eight points from the blue-line this season rank third in the Big Ten for defensemen scoring only behind teammate Cole Hults and Wisconsin's Wyatt Kalynuk who lead the league with ten points each.

#### **NEW TOP 'NATE' DOGG**

- Last Saturday night, senior Nate Sucese broke the tie with Andrew Sturtz to become the Penn State all-time goal scoring leader as he netted a pair of goals and he now has 56 for his career, a mark that is also tied for the most in the nation among active players.
- Sucese also passed Chase Berger '19 for second on the Penn State all-time points list with 120 for his career, just eight shy of David Goodwin's '17 program record of 128. His 120 career points are also the most in the Big Ten among active players and rank second nationally.
- Sucese's 18 points this season lead the Big Ten and rank third in the nation while his six goals are tied for third in the Big Ten and 22nd nationally. The senior was also named Big Ten Second Star of the Week for his accomplishments over the weekend at Minnesota.

#### **BLUE-LINE BEAUTY**

- Junior Cole Hults is chasing history of his own as he is currently tied for second all-time in Penn State history for points by a defenseman with 58 just two shy of Luke Juha's '16 program record.
- Hults' 13 goals rank fourth all-time by defenseman as current teammate Kris Myllari holds the record which stands at 17. The junior's 45 career assists also rank tied for third among Nittany Lion blue-liners and are just one shy of the top-10 all-time at Penn State.

#### **SCOUTING OHIO STATE**

- The Buckeyes enter the weekend coming off a bye and stand fifth in the Big Ten standings with six points. Overall, OSU is 6-3-1 on the season and rank 11th in both national polls.
- Ohio State remains one of the toughest defensive teams in the country after finishing second in the Big Ten and 14th nationally last year allowing just 2.31 goals per game, the Buckeyes currently lead the Big Ten and rank fifth in the nation allowing just 1.80 goals per game.
- A big reason for the defensive success is junior goaltender Tommy Nappier who has played every minute between the pipes this season for OSU posting a 1.79 goals against average and a .935 save percentage to rank first and second in the Big Ten and seventh and 10th in the nation, respectively, for each category. Nappier's career winning percentage of .727 is the best mark among current NCAA goaltender who have played multiple seasons.
- The Buckeye offense has sputtered at times this season scoring over three goals in a game just once and averaging just 2.70 goals per game to rank fifth in the Big Ten and middle of the pack nationally. OSU did lose four of its top-10 scorers from last season's roster including Big Ten all-time leading scorer Mason Jobst who had 164 career points including team-high's of 17 goals and 36 points last season. Penn State kryptonite Dakota Joshua also graduated after finishing second on the team with 22 points on nine goals and 13 assists a year ago.
- The Buckeyes do return Philadelphia Flyers draft-pick Tanner Laczynski who ranks just behind Nate Sucese among active Big Ten scorers with 119 career points, good for third nationally. He leads the team so far this season with 10 points, but only has a pair of goals in the early going. Sophomore Gustaf Westlund leads the Buckeyes with five goals.
- Ohio State has produced well on special teams this season ranking third in the Big Ten and ninth in the nation with the man-advantage scoring 13 goals in 50 chances (26 percent) while the PK has only allowed four goals on 39 chances (89.7 percent) to lead the Big Ten and rank ninth nationally.



THE FINNISHER

- Sophomore Aarne Talvitie is currently tied for the Big Ten lead with eight points in six conference games while his 12 total points are good for tied seventh in the con-
- Overall, through his first 28 career games, Talvitie is averaging a point-per-game with 28 points on nine goals
- Talvitie has also been strong at the dot this season winning 63.7 percent (79-for-124) of his draws ranking first in the Big Ten and tied for ninth in the nation while Penn State as a team ranks fourth in the Big Ten and 19th in the nation at the face-off circle winning 51.5 percent of draws so far this season.

#### **GOALIE OFFENSE**

- · Senior Peyton Jones tallied his second assist of the season last weekend in Minnesota, both goals have been scored by Sam Sternschein. For his career, Jones now has eight assists to lead all active goaltenders nationwide.
- Offensive numbers aside, Jones is also stifling opposing offenses ranking third in the Big Ten and 12th in the nation with a .934 save percentage while his 2.01 goals against average is good for second and 17th, respectively.
- . Jones' 67 career wins are also the most among active goaltenders in the NCAA.

# **BLUE-LINE BEAUTY**

- Junior Cole Hults is chasing history of his own as he is currently tied for second all-time in Penn State history for points by a defenseman with 58 just two shy of Luke Juha's '16 program record.
- . Hults' 13 goals rank fourth all-time by defenseman as current teammate Kris Myllari holds the record which stands at 17. The junior's 45 career assists also rank tied for third among Nittany Lion blue-liners and are just one shy of the top-10 all-time at Penn State.

#### **HOCKEY VALLEY SPECIAL**

- Penn State is coming off another very successful weekend on the power-play going 3-for-5 against Minnesota. Penn State is now 15-for-46 (32.6 percent) this season to rank first in the Big Ten and third in the nation, PSU's 15 PPG's this season are good for second in the nation just one shy of the 16 scored by Northern Michigan.
- In conference only action, the Nittany Lions are converting at an even higher clip going 9-for-21 (42.9 percent) having scored at least one power-play goal in five of the last six games.
- Penn State's PK has also been consistent this season allowing just six goals in 44 chances to the opposition ranking second in the Big Ten and 13th in the nation killing off 86.4 percent of opposing power-plays.

#### **HIGH ABOVE**

• At 6'8" senior Nikita Pavlychev is one of three players in the NCAA that share the distinction of tallest player joining Stephen Mundinger of Maine and Keenan Suthers of St. Lawrence. There are then six players at 6'7".

#### **VETERAN PRESENCE**

 With 10 seniors, the Nittany Lions have the second largest senior class in the nation behind only Boston College's 11, but factor in the nine juniors and Penn State has the most upper classmen in the nation with 19 of its 29 players as either a junior or senior.

 Senior Brandon Biro was selected by his peers as the seventh captain in program history for the 2019-20 season after serving as an alternate last season. Fellow senior Liam Folkes and Kris Myllari with serve as alternates.

#### **FOUR LAND ON PRESEASON ALL-B1G TEAMS**

- Junior classmates Evan Barratt and Alex Limoges were named First-Team All-Big Ten by the league's coaches as part of the preseason awards while junior Cole Hults landed on the second-team and Kris Myllari was an hon-
- · Barratt became just the fourth Nittany Lion to earn firstteam All-Big Ten accolades following the 2018-19 season scoring 16 goals while adding 27 assists for 43 points, the third highest single-season total in program history. Barratt's 1.34 points per game led the Big Ten and ranked fourth in the nation setting a new single-season program record while his 43 points were good for fourth in the Big Ten and 13th nationally.
- · Hults' 28 points last season were the third-most by a Penn State defenseman in a single-season and ranked third in the conference for blueliners. His plus-19 rating was the second-best mark for defensemen in the Big Ten while his 68 blocked shots were good for ninth in the league. Hults enters his junior season seventh on the Penn State all-time points list for defensemen with 48, just 12 shy of Luke Juha's program record of 60.
- Myllari ranked second in the Big Ten and fifth in the nation last season with 90 blocked shots while his 21 points were the ninth most in the conference for defensemen. The senior alternate captain set the Penn State career record for goals by a defenseman last season when he notched the 17th of his career at Michigan State.

#### PACKING THE PEG

- Penn State has played to a sellout crowd in 109-of-116 home games, 94-straight regular season, including all 20 regular season contests last season.
- More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on 76 occasions including 17 games last season.
- · Last season, Penn State ranked seventh

in average attendance (5,801) and first in the nation in building capacity percentage (101.7 percent).

 Penn State saw a single-season record 133,422 fans come through the gates last season.

## **WELCOME HOME**

- Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.
- The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.
- The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

#### THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

- The Big Ten is in its seventh season entering 2019-20. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.
- The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member at the start of the 2017-18 season.
- Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation or overtime victory, two points for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout win and one point for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout loss.
- The 2018-19 season was the first season the Big Ten instituted a 3-on-3 overtime period joining the NCHC and WCHA.
- Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.
- The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockey.
- The Big Ten tournament will take place at campus sites once again during the 2019-20 season.

## **MEET COACH GADOWSKY**

**Guy Gadowsky** will guide the Nittany Lions in his 20th collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program during the 2019-20 campaign and his eighth at Penn State.

# **AT PENN STATE**

In 2018-19, Gadowsky led Penn State to its second-highest win total in program history with 22, along with becoming the winningiest coach in Big Ten Tournament history, compiling a 10-6 record over six seasons. The Nittany Lions returned to the Big Ten Championship game for the second time in the past three seasons, but dropped a tough 3-2 decision at Notre Dame.

Penn State secured its most Big Ten



wins in program history with 11 while its 35 points were also the most in a single season. The Nittany Lions once again led the nation in goals per game with a new single-season record of 4.54 while also setting single-season records for goals (177), assists (301) and points (478), each of which were also tops in the nation.

Gadowsky saw sophomore Alex Limoges become the first Nittany Lion ever to lead the nation in points as he set a single-season program record with 50 while his 23 goals were also a new program standard and ranked tied for second in the nation.

Sophomore Evan Barratt became just the fourth player in program history and third in the last three seasons to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Barratt, along with teammate Aarne Talvitie, also became the first Niittany Lions ever to represent their countries at the IIHF World Junior Championship. Talvitie captained Finland to the gold medal while Barratt helped Team USA take home the silver.

Despite the win total and records the Nittany Lions fell one spot short of the NCAA Tournament, finishing the season at No. 16 in the PairWise rankings.

In 2017-18, Gadowsky led his Nittany Lions to their second-straight NCAA Tournament. Penn State was able to take the short drive down to Allentown, Pennsylvania, as it served as host for the Midwest Regional. The Nittany Lions' season was cut short at the hands of the Denver Pioneers, 5-1, in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal.

Earlier in the 2017-18 season, Gadowsky secured his 100th career victory at Penn State, which in turn, was the 100th victory for the program, a 5-1 victory over Min-

nesota on February 23, 2018. That victory was the start of the first-ever sweep of the Golden Gophers by the Nittany Lions, which secured home-ice for Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament Quarterfinals. Penn State went on to sweep Minnesota in two games, clinching the series and its fourth B1G Semifinal appearance in five years.

Junior Andrew Sturtz become just the second member of the 100-point club at Penn State in 2017-18 and became the all-time leading goal scorer in program history. Sturtz graduated early and signed an NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators.

Gadowsky also coached Trevor Hamilton to a Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year award, the first major conference honor awarded to a Nittany Lion. Hamilton joined Casey Bailey and Vince Pedrie as the only first-team All-Conference members in program history.

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Penn State opened the 2016-17 season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest-scoring team in the country, averaging 4.10 goals per game.



# **HEAD COACH GUY GADOWSKY**

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with the program-best 25 victories.

Penn State had its first 20-win season under Gadowsky in 2015-16, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose to as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll during the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6, the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before bowing out to eventual champion Michigan 7-2 in the semifinals.

Of Gadowsky's 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, garnering a winning season in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a twoyear contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs, eventually scoring his first NHL goal in the season finale. Bailey was an All-Big Ten first-team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable mention recognition from the league coaches.

At Alaska

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play.

Penn State earned wins over every Big Ten team during the 2014-15 season including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions during the Big Ten Conference's first season of play. Penn State, which faced seven NCAA tournament teams and three Frozen Four participants, capped its season with a 2-1 double-overtime victory against Michigan in the Big Ten quarterfinals.

Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to a 13-14-0 record during their inaugural NCAA Division I season in 2012-13. He guided the squad to several marquee victories, including wins against three future Big Ten opponents (Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin). Penn State also topped Vermont at Wells Fargo Arena in front of the largest crowd to watch a college hockey game in an NHL barn (19,529).

In 2011-12, Gadowsky steered Penn State's final season in the ACHA, while recruiting for the future. That team went 29-5-0.

## AT PRINCETON

Before coming to Happy Valley, Gadowsky served as Princeton's bench boss for seven seasons. In his first five years as head coach, the Tigers improved their win total in each season. In 2008-09, Princeton captured a program-record 22 victories and earned its second-straight NCAA tournament appearance.

Gadowsky, inherited a program that had a won a combined eight games in the two seasons prior to his arrival and in 2007-08 he guided Princeton to both the ECAC Hockey tournament and Ivy League crowns. The team earned its first NCAA tournament berth since 1998 and Gadowsky garnered ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year honors and was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, presented to Division I hockey's top coach. He was also named Inside College Hockey National Coach of the Year.

More than 20 Tiger players went on to sign professional contracts, with Kevin Westgarth playing for the Stanley Cup champion Los Angeles Kings in 2011-12. Gadowsky also coached two ECAC and Ivy League Players of the Year as Lee Jubinville (2008) and Zane Kalemba (2009) each won the award in their junior seasons.

## **AT ALASKA**

Gadowsky spent five seasons as head coach of Alaska (1999-2004), where he inherited a team that had not won more than 14 games in any of the previous five seasons since joining the then-Central Collegiate Hockey Association. After two rebuilding seasons, the 2002 CCHA Coach of the Year led the Nanooks, ranked 11th nationally at the end of the season, to their only 20-win campaign since joining the conference. He followed that up with 15 wins in 2002-03 and 16 victories his last season.

Alaska twice hosted the first round of the CCHA playoffs in a three-year span, a feat never accomplished prior to Gadowsky's arrival. During his tenure with the Nanooks, his teams set school records for team grade-point average, wins and game attendance.



# **BEFORE COLLEGE COACHING**

Before joining the collegiate ranks, Gadowsky spent three seasons (1996-99) as head coach and director of hockey operations for the Fresno Falcons of the West Coast Hockey League. He led the squad to the playoffs in each season and left the team as the winningest coach in franchise history. In his first season, Gadowsky posted a 38-win campaign and garnered WCHL Coach of the Year accolades.

## **PLAYING CAREER**

The Edmonton, Alberta, native played collegiately at Colorado College from 1985-89, serving as team captain as a senior, while also earning the team's Rodman Award, given for outstanding leadership and sportsmanship. The three-time WCHA All-Academic team member collected 46 points in 134 career games.

Upon graduation, Gadowsky embarked on a seven-year professional career that included stops with the ECHL's Richmond Renegades, the IHL's San Diego Gulls and the AHL's St. John's Maple Leafs and Prince Edward Island Senators. Gadowsky saved his best season for last as he totaled 52 goals and 29 assists for the Fresno Falcons in 1995-96. He earned league MVP and first-team all-star recognition.

Gadowsky also competed with the Canadian National Team and played professionally in Austria, the Netherlands and Sweden during the 1993-94 season.

## **PERSONAL LIFE**

Gadowsky and his wife, Melissa, have two sons, Mac and Magnus, and a daughter, Mia.






