• The Nittany Lions will open ALC play against Vanderbilt for the 13th straight season Saturday afternoon. The teams will meet for the final time in the regular season as ALC members as the Big Ten will begin its first season in 2015.

NITTANY LIONS IN ALC OPENERS

• Penn State improved to 6-6 all-time in ALC openers with a 20-14 victory against the Commodores in Happy Valley March 17, 2013.

LAST YEAR VS. THE COMMODORES

- The Nittany Lions won both their contests against Vanderbilt during the 2013 season, defeating the Commodores by a 20-14 score March 17 before securing a 16-14 victory in the ALC quarterfinals in Baltimore, Md., May 2.
- Among returning players, attacker **Maggie McCormick** secured a team-high eight points (7g, 1a), while junior **Kelly Lechner** (6g, 1a) and senior **Mackenzie Cyr** (4g, 3a) notched seven points each. Sophomore **Jenna Mosketti** grabbed a team-best seven draw controls, while classmate **Madison Cyr** collected a team-high seven caused turnovers.
