THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

- This weekend marks the 28th and 29th meetings alltime between Penn State and Minnesota with the Golden Gophers holding the slim 15-12-0 series advantage.
- The Nittany Lions have won nine of the last 11 meetings between the two teams dating back to the 2017 B1G
 Tournament semifinals, but are only 3-9-0 at Mariucci with two of those victories coming in the last 11 meetings.
- Senior Denis Smirnov leads all active Nittany Lions with 15 career points in 15 career games against Minnesota scoring seven goals while adding eight assists. Junior Alex Limoges has also scored seven times against the Gophers while adding five assists for 12 points in 12 games. Both Brandon Biro and Nate Sucese have added 10 points in 15 games against Minnesota on five goals and five assists each.

NEW PLACE, SAME FACE

• Junior Clayton Phillips has played 26 career games at Mariucci, but this weekend will be his first time on the visiting bench after transferring to Penn State earlier this summer. The Edina, Minnesota native has seven career points at Mariucci with one goal and six assists.

START FAST, FINISH STRONG

• Penn State has jumped out to early leads in six of its first nine games while outscoring opponents 12-3 over the opening 20 minutes of play so far this season. The Nittany Lions have also closed strong offensively with 15 third period goals, the most in a single period so far this season. PSU is 6-0-0 when scoring first and 5-0-0 when leading after two periods so far this season. Last season the second period was the strongest for the Nittany Lions with 71 goals and a +16 goal differential.

HOCKEY VALLEY SPECIAL

- Penn State has dominated the special teams battle so far this season as the Nittany Lions rank second in the Big Ten and sixth nationally converting 29.3 percent (12for-41) of their power-play chances including a 40 percent clip (6-for-15) in Big Ten play.
- The PK has also held its own allowing just five opponent power-play goals in 37 chances (86.5 percent) to rank fourth in the Big Ten and 21st in the nation.

MR. JONES

- Senior goaltender Peyton Jones continued his hot start last weekend allowing just one 5-on-5 goal. His .937 save percentage leads the Big Ten and ranks ninth in the nation while his 1.89 goals against average is good for second and 13th, respectively.
- In eight starts this season, Jones has allowed just eight 5-on-5 goals including just three so far in four Big Ten games.

STRONG ISLAND'S FINEST IMPORT

• Junior Sam Sternschein collected his second game-winning goal in as many weeks last Saturday night and is currently tied for the Big Ten lead with his two game-winning tallies this season. The junior is one of 21 players with multiple game-winning goals this season ranking tied for fifth nationally. His four goals rank tied for seventh in the Big Ten.

CHASING HISTORY

• Senior Nate Sucese is tied with Andrew Sturtz for first on the Penn State all-time goals list with 54 for his career. His 54 goals are also the second most in the nation among active players only trailing the 56 of Minnesota State's Marc Michaelis.

- Sucese's 14 points this season lead the Big Ten and rank tied for seventh nationally while his 116 career points are third among active players and just two behind Chase Berger '19 (118) for second all-time at Penn State and 12 shy of David Goodwin's '17 (128) program record.
- Sucese's 10 assists are also tied for first in the Big Ten and sixth in the nation while he has moved into fourth on the Penn State all-time assists list with 62.

BLUE-LINE BEAUTY

- Junior Cole Hults is also chasing history of his own as he is currently tied for third all-time in Penn State history for points by a defenseman with 57 just three shy of Luke Juha's '16 program record.
- Hults' 13 goals rank fourth all-time by defenseman as current teammate Kris Myllari holds the record which stands at 17. The junior's 44 career assists also rank fourth among Nittany Lion blue-liners and are just one shy of the top-10 all-time at Penn State.

FINNISH PHENOM

- In 25 career games, sophomore Aarne Talvitie is averaging just under a point per game with 25 points on eight goals and 17 assists including nine points in nine games this season with three goals and six assists.
- Talvitie also ranks fourth in the Big Ten and 21st nationally winning 62 percent (57-for-93) of his face-offs this season.
- With a plus-8 rating Talvitie is second on the team and tied for 14th in the Big Ten, however, he has only been on the ice for one even-strength goal against in nine games this season. Only OSU's Tate Singleton and Austin Pooley have been on the ice for less even strength goals this season with zero apiece.



NEXT UP



 Penn State returns home for the final time this semester with a weekend series against the Ohio State Buckeyes next Friday and Saturday.

HIGH ABOVE

• At 6'8" senior Nikita Pavlychev is one of three players in the NCAA that share the distinction of tallest player joining Stephen Mundinger of Maine and Keenan Suthers of St. Lawrence. There are then six players at 6'7".

VETERAN PRESENCE

• With 10 seniors, the Nittany Lions have the second largest senior class in the nation behind only Boston College's 11, but factor in the nine juniors and Penn State has the most upper classmen in the nation with 19 of its 29 players as either a junior or senior.

SCOUTING MINNESOTA

- The Gophers started the season winning three of their first four games, but have just one regulation win over their last six contests, however, with seven points and a 1-1-2-2 record in the Big Ten Minnesota currently sits in third place just two points behind Penn State for second. The Gophers have a pair of 3-on-3 overtime victories to secure the extra point in back-to-back weekends against Notre Dame and last week at Michigan where Minnesota took five of a possible six points on the road against the Wolverines.
- The Gophers entered the season without the services of five of their top-10 scorers from last season including each of its top three as leading scorer Rem Pitlick (21-24-45) left early to sign an NHL contract while Tyler Sheehy (12-29-41) and Brent Gates Jr. (13-18-31) each graduated.
- Minnesota is led by 2018-19 Big Ten Freshman of the Year Sammy Walker who has five goals and eight points through ten games this season ranking tied for third in the Big Ten with his five goals. Brannon McManus is second on the team with four goals and seven points while Scott Reedy has chipped in three goals of his own for the Gophers.
- Between the pipes, Minnesota has a trio of newcomers that have each seen time led by freshman Jared Moe with six starts and a 3-2-1 record with a .929 save percentage and a 2.15 goals against average to rank fifth in the Big Ten for each. Moe ranks third nationally among first-year goalies in both save percentage and goals against average. Michigan transfer Jack LaFontaine has four starts with a 1-2-1 record, .905 save percentage and a 2.75 goals against average.
- Minnesota ranks just sixth in the Big Ten and 41st nationally scoring 2.40 goals per game while allowing 2.60 to rank fifth and tied 29th, respectively. The Gopher power-play is also middle of the pack converting just 16.1 percent of its man-up chances (5-for-31) but is 0-for-16 over the last six-plus games. The PK has been better ranking 17th allowing just four opponent scores in 35 chances (88.6 percent) including killing off 18 of their last 19 penalties.

· Senior Brandon Biro was selected by his peers as the seventh captain in program history for the 2019-20 season after serving as an alternate last season. Fellow senior Liam Folkes and Kris Myllari with serve as alternates.

FOUR LAND ON PRESEASON ALL-B1G TEAMS

- Junior classmates Evan Barratt and Alex Limoges were named First-Team All-Big Ten by the league's coaches as part of the preseason awards while junior Cole Hults landed on the second-team and Kris Myllari was an honorable mention.
- Barratt became just the fourth Nittany Lion to earn firstteam All-Big Ten accolades following the 2018-19 season scoring 16 goals while adding 27 assists for 43 points, the third highest single-season total in program history. Barratt's 1.34 points per game led the Big Ten and ranked fourth in the nation setting a new single-season program record while his 43 points were good for fourth in the Big Ten and 13th nationally.
- Hults' 28 points last season were the third-most by a Penn State defenseman in a single-season and ranked third in the conference for blueliners. His plus-19 rating was the second-best mark for defensemen in the Big Ten while his 68 blocked shots were good for ninth in the league. Hults enters his junior season seventh on the Penn State all-time points list for defensemen with 48. just 12 shy of Luke Juha's program record of 60.
- · Myllari ranked second in the Big Ten and fifth in the nation last season with 90 blocked shots while his 21 points were the ninth most in the conference for defensemen. The senior alternate captain set the Penn State career record for goals by a defenseman last season when he notched the 17th of his career at Michigan State.

NITTANY LIONS TABBED B1G FAVORITE

- · For the first time in program history Penn State was picked to win the Big Ten by the league coaches in the Preseason Poll.
- After finishing in the cellar during the inaugural B1G season in 2013-14, Penn State has finished fourth in threestraight seasons and four of the last five mixing in a thirdplace finish in 2015-16.
- The regular season champion receives home-ice advantage and a first-round bye in the Big Ten playoffs while the next three seeds earn home ice in the best-of-three quarterfinal round.
- The semifinal and final are then single game contests at the higher-seeded school.

RECAPPING 2018-19

 Penn State narrowly missing its third-consecutive NCAA Tournament last season after posting a 22-15-2 record and advancing to its second Big Ten Championship game in the past three seasons. The 22 wins are the second most in a single-season in program history.

- The Nittany Lions led the nation in several offensive categories during the 2018-19 campaign including goals (177), assists (301), points (478) and goals per game (4.54) each total set a new program record.
- · Penn State is returning 20 letter-winners from that 2018-19 roster including 82 percent of total offense. Nine newcomers will round out the 2019-20 roster.
- Junior Alex Limoges became the first Nittany Lion ever to pace the country in scoring as his program record 50 points tied for the national lead. Limoges also set a program record with 23 goals, a total that led the Big Ten and tied for the second most nationally.
- Junior Evan Barratt became the fourth Nittany Lion to secure Big Ten first-team All-Conference recognition after leading the league and ranking fourth in the nation averaging 1.34 points per game. He potted 16 goals while adding 27 assists for 43 points, the third highest single-season total in program history.
- Along with Limoges and Barratt, Penn State had seven total players with double-digit goals and 11 players register 20 or more points including four with 40-plus points. Senior classmates Liam Folkes and Brandon Biro also had career years with 42 and 40 points, respectively.
- Freshman Paul DeNaples led the Big Ten in plus/minus and ranked third in the nation at +31, the second-best single-season rating in program history.

EUROPEAN CONNECTION

- Penn State has four players on its 2019-20 roster from european countries with two each from Russia and Finland.
- A pair of Nittany Lion seniors hail from Russia by the way of Pennsylvania as both Nikita Pavlychev (Yaroslavl) and Denis Smirnov (Moscow) become the first Lions to wear the Blue and White from the Motherland.
- Both forwards migrated to the U.S. and to Pennsylvania in their early teen years, playing youth hockey in the Keystone State.
- The Nittany Lions also have a pair of sophomores from Finland as goaltender **Oskar Autio** is following in his brothers footsteps joined by longtime friend and New Jersey Devils draft pick **Aarne Talvitie**. Both players are from Espoo and grew up playing for the Esspoo Blues.

PACKING THE PEG

- Penn State has played to a sellout crowd in 109-of-116 home games, 94-straight regular season, including all 20 regular season contests last season.
- More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on 76 occasions including 17 games last season.
- · Last season, Penn State ranked seventh

in average attendance (5,801) and first in the nation in building capacity percentage (101.7 percent).

 Penn State saw a single-season record 133,422 fans come through the gates last season.

WELCOME HOME

- Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.
- The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.
- The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

- The Big Ten is in its seventh season entering 2019-20. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.
- The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member at the start of the 2017-18 season.
- Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation or overtime victory, two points for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout win and one point for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout loss.
- The 2018-19 season was the first season the Big Ten instituted a 3-on-3 overtime period joining the NCHC and WCHA.
- Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.
- The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockey.
- The Big Ten tournament will take place at campus sites once again during the 2019-20 season.

MEET COACH GADOWSKY

Guy Gadowsky will guide the Nittany Lions in his 20th collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program during the 2019-20 campaign and his eighth at Penn State.

AT PENN STATE

In 2018-19, Gadowsky led Penn State to its second-highest win total in program history with 22, along with becoming the winningiest coach in Big Ten Tournament history, compiling a 10-6 record over six seasons. The Nittany Lions returned to the Big Ten Championship game for the second time in the past three seasons, but dropped a tough 3-2 decision at Notre Dame.

Penn State secured its most Big Ten



wins in program history with 11 while its 35 points were also the most in a single season. The Nittany Lions once again led the nation in goals per game with a new single-season record of 4.54 while also setting single-season records for goals (177), assists (301) and points (478), each of which were also tops in the nation.

Gadowsky saw sophomore Alex Limoges become the first Nittany Lion ever to lead the nation in points as he set a single-season program record with 50 while his 23 goals were also a new program standard and ranked tied for second in the nation.

Sophomore Evan Barratt became just the fourth player in program history and third in the last three seasons to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Barratt, along with teammate Aarne Talvitie, also became the first Niittany Lions ever to represent their countries at the IIHF World Junior Championship. Talvitie captained Finland to the gold medal while Barratt helped Team USA take home the silver.

Despite the win total and records the Nittany Lions fell one spot short of the NCAA Tournament, finishing the season at No. 16 in the PairWise rankings.

In 2017-18, Gadowsky led his Nittany Lions to their second-straight NCAA Tournament. Penn State was able to take the short drive down to Allentown, Pennsylvania, as it served as host for the Midwest Regional. The Nittany Lions' season was cut short at the hands of the Denver Pioneers, 5-1, in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal.

Earlier in the 2017-18 season, Gadowsky secured his 100th career victory at Penn State, which in turn, was the 100th victory for the program, a 5-1 victory over Min-

nesota on February 23, 2018. That victory was the start of the first-ever sweep of the Golden Gophers by the Nittany Lions, which secured home-ice for Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament Quarterfinals. Penn State went on to sweep Minnesota in two games, clinching the series and its fourth B1G Semifinal appearance in five years.

Junior Andrew Sturtz become just the second member of the 100-point club at Penn State in 2017-18 and became the all-time leading goal scorer in program history. Sturtz graduated early and signed an NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators.

Gadowsky also coached Trevor Hamilton to a Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year award, the first major conference honor awarded to a Nittany Lion. Hamilton joined Casey Bailey and Vince Pedrie as the only first-team All-Conference members in program history.

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Penn State opened the 2016-17 season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest-scoring team in the country, averaging 4.10 goals per game.



AT PRINCETON

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with the program-best 25 victories.

Penn State had its first 20-win season under Gadowsky in 2015-16, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose to as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll during the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6, the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before bowing out to eventual champion Michigan 7-2 in the semifinals.

Of Gadowsky's 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, garnering a winning season in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a two-year contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs, eventually scoring his first NHL goal in the season finale. Bailey was an All-Big Ten first-team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable mention recognition from the league coaches.

At Alaska

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play.

Penn State earned wins over every Big Ten team during the 2014-15 season including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions during the Big Ten Conference's first season of play. Penn State, which faced seven NCAA tournament teams and three Frozen Four participants, capped its season with a 2-1 double-overtime victory against Michigan in the Big Ten guarterfinals.

Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to a 13-14-0 record during their inaugural NCAA Division I season in 2012-13. He guided the squad to several marquee victories, including wins against three future Big Ten opponents (Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin). Penn State also topped Vermont at Wells Fargo Arena in front of the largest crowd to watch a college hockey game in an NHL barn (19,529).

In 2011-12, Gadowsky steered Penn State's final season in the ACHA, while recruiting for the future. That team went 29-5-0.

Before coming to Happy Valley, Gadowsky served as Princeton's bench boss for seven seasons. In his first five years as head coach, the Tigers improved their win total in each season. In 2008-09, Princeton captured a program-record 22 victories and earned its second-straight NCAA tournament appearance.

Gadowsky, inherited a program that had a won a combined eight games in the two seasons prior to his arrival and in 2007-08 he guided Princeton to both the ECAC Hockey tournament and Ivy League crowns. The team earned its first NCAA tournament berth since 1998 and Gadowsky garnered ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year honors and was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, presented to Division I hockey's top coach. He was also named Inside College Hockey National Coach of the Year.

More than 20 Tiger players went on to sign professional contracts, with Kevin Westgarth playing for the Stanley Cup champion Los Angeles Kings in 2011-12. Gadowsky also coached two ECAC and Ivy League Players of the Year as Lee Jubinville (2008) and Zane Kalemba (2009) each won the award in their junior seasons.

AT ALASKA

Gadowsky spent five seasons as head coach of Alaska (1999-2004), where he inherited a team that had not won more than 14 games in any of the previous five seasons since joining the then-Central Collegiate Hockey Association. After two rebuilding seasons, the 2002 CCHA Coach of the Year led the Nanooks, ranked 11th nationally at the end of the season, to their only 20-win campaign since joining the conference. He followed that up with 15 wins in 2002-03 and 16 victories his last season.

Alaska twice hosted the first round of the CCHA playoffs in a three-year span, a feat never accomplished prior to Gadowsky's arrival. During his tenure with the Nanooks, his teams set school records for team grade-point average, wins and game attendance.



BEFORE COLLEGE COACHING

Before joining the collegiate ranks, Gadowsky spent three seasons (1996-99) as head coach and director of hockey operations for the Fresno Falcons of the West Coast Hockey League. He led the squad to the playoffs in each season and left the team as the winningest coach in franchise history. In his first season, Gadowsky posted a 38-win campaign and garnered WCHL Coach of the Year accolades.

PLAYING CAREER

The Edmonton, Alberta, native played collegiately at Colorado College from 1985-89, serving as team captain as a senior, while also earning the team's Rodman Award, given for outstanding leadership and sportsmanship. The three-time WCHA All-Academic team member collected 46 points in 134 career games.

Upon graduation, Gadowsky embarked on a seven-year professional career that included stops with the ECHL's Richmond Renegades, the IHL's San Diego Gulls and the AHL's St. John's Maple Leafs and Prince Edward Island Senators. Gadowsky saved his best season for last as he totaled 52 goals and 29 assists for the Fresno Falcons in 1995-96. He earned league MVP and first-team all-star recognition.

Gadowsky also competed with the Canadian National Team and played professionally in Austria, the Netherlands and Sweden during the 1993-94 season.

PERSONAL LIFE

Gadowsky and his wife, Melissa, have two sons, Mac and Magnus, and a daughter, Mia.




