#### Eagles Show Balanced Scoring in Win Over Albany ...

- The Eagles showcased a balanced scoring effort with three players in double figures in the win over Albany.
- Makayla Dickens came off the bench to score a season-high 21 points on 8-of-13 shooting from the field. The senior added five rebounds and four assists in the victory.
- Ally VanTimmeren also provided a lift off the bench, as she scored a season-high 15 points on 7-of-8 shooting. VanTimmeren scored 13 of her points in the first half.
- The Eagles scored 26 points off 25 turnovers, while Dickens and VanTimmeren scored 36 of the reserves' season-high 39 points.

### About the Eagles ...

- Boston College enters year four of the Joanna Bernabei-McNamee era as the Eagles are coming off an unconventional 2020-21 campaign due to COVID-19.
- The Eagles bring back all five starters and 100 percent of their numbers across the board, including the trio of Taylor Soule (15.7 ppg), Cameron Swartz (13.4 ppg), and Makayla Dickens (12.6 ppg). The seniors combined to score 41.7 points per game.
- BC also returns the likes of All-ACC Defensive performer Marnelle Garraud, and Clara Ford.

#### Inside the Penn State series ...

• The Eagles and Nittany Lions face each other for the first time since 2016, where PSU captured a narrow 60-56 win in Conte Forum. Penn State is 2-1 all-time in the series. The lone win for BC came in a 113-104 overtime victory in 2010.

#### What's Next

• BC will hit the road to face a tough VCU squad on Sunday, Dec. 5 at 1 p.m.

During the 2020-21 campaign, Taylor Soule was named to the All-ACC first-team while Marnelle Garraud collected All-ACC Defensive team honors.

Joanna Bernabei-McNamee became the eighth women's basketball coach in Boston College program history on April 11, 2018.

In 2019-20, her second season at BC, Bernabei-McNamee was named the Coach of the Year in the Atlantic Coast Conference. She led BC to an impressive 20-12 overall record and a fourth place finish in the conference with an 11-7 record.

The 20 victories were the most in program history since the 2010-11 season. The team also set a new program record for the most ACC victories with 11.

With Bernabei-McNamee at the helm, senior forward Emma Guy flourished as she led the ACC in field goal percentage throughout the season and finished 10th in

- Penn State is off to a 4-3 start after dropping its last two matchups to then-No.
   13 Iowa State and Kent State, respectively.
- Makenna Marisa led four players in double figures with 23 points and tied a team-high with five assists.
- Marisa leads the team and is fifth in the nation averaging 22.4 points per game.
- Ali Brigham is second on the team in scoring (12.3 ppg) while leading the team in rebounds per game (5.4).
- Marisa also leads the team in assists per game at just over three per game.
- The Nittany Lions' 80.7 points per game is 18th in the country.
- PSU is also 32nd in the country in pace, averaging 77.1 possessions per 40 min.
- Penn State is 30th in total steals with 75 and in the top 55 in steals per game (10.7).
- The Nittany Lions are 5-9 in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge.

#### THINGS TO WATCH

- Watch if the Eagles can win the battle on the glass as Penn State's average rebounding margin is minus-14.7 in three losses and plus-6 in its four wins.
- Boston College is 4-0 this season when at least three players score in double figures, highlighted by five players against Providence. See if the Eagles can showcase a balanced-scoring attack on Thursday.
- The Eagles' defense is allowing 58.8 points per game in their five victories this season. See if the defense can contain a Penn State offense that is 18th in the country in scoring.
- See if Boston College can protect the rock on Thursday, as Penn State is forcing 22.5 turnovers in its three wins compared to 12.3 in losses.
- Makayla Dickens is turning in 15 points over the last three games, shooting 48.4 percent from the floor, 42 percent from beyond the arc, 3.6 rebounds, and three assists. See if the senior can continue her solid play.

#### **Depth Across the Board**

- The Eagles bring back 100 percent of their numbers across the board.
- BC is one of five teams in the ACC to return at least three players who averaged double figures in scoring.
- Of those returning, all five starters are back, including the trio of Taylor Soule, Cameron Swartz and Makayla Dickens.
- The trio averaged a combined 41.7 points and 15.7 rebounds per game.
- All-ACC defensive performer, Marnelle Garraud and starter Clara Ford are also back.
- Garraud led the team and finished first in the ACC in steals (2.1), while leading the team in assists and blocked shots.
- The Eagles also have some youth with nine freshmen and sophomores.
- Dontavia Waggoner is in her first year with BC after transferring from NC State.
- Allie VanTimmeren both enrolled in school early last season and were able to get some playing experience.

#### **Closer Look: Backcourt**

- •The Eagles boast a sharpshooting roster that averaged 7 3-pointers per game and drained at least 10 trifectas in four contests.
- Dickens (54 3's), Swartz (30's) and Garraud (28 3's) led the attack outside the arc, while Swartz finished second on the team in scoring and Dickens, third.
- Garraud stuffed the stat sheet, averaging 7.3 points, 3.1 assists, 2.1 steals and fnished third on the team in trevs made.
- Swartz ended the season on a high note, averaging 15.8 points over the last four games, highlighte by a career-high 33 points in the ACC Tournament against Pitt

- Dickens' scoring came on strong in the last half of the season, hitting double figures in 10 of the final 11 games of the season.
- Waggoner saw limited action at NC State, averaging 7.4 minutes in 16 games, but brings defensive versatility to the table.
- Kaylah Ivey is back for her sophomore season after playing in 18 of 19 contests and chipping in 3.6 points per game. Ivey's best performance came in a 23-point outing against UMass Lowell last season.

#### **Closer Look: Frontcourt**

- Leading the frontcourt is one of the 20 members that made the Cheryl Miller Award Watch List in Taylor Soule.
- Soule led the team in points, averaging a careerhigh 15.7 points per game and 7.0 rebounds.
- The senior was one of two players in the ACC and one of 35 players in the country to average at least 15.5 points, 7.0 rebounds, 1.5 assists, and 1.0 steals per game, according to Her Hoop Stats.
- Clara Ford has been the staple down low for the Eagles. Ford started a career-high 17 games last season, while she also averaged 17.6 minutes. Ford tallied personal highs in scoring (5.0 ppg) and rebounding (5.6 rpg).
- Allie VanTimmeren also enrolled early, playing in 10 games with one start. The freshman scored in double figures in two of her first four appearances, including a personal-high 17 points at Louisville.
- Jaelyn Batts and Jojo Lacey bring added depth as well. Lacey played in seven games last season, while Batts put forth two games in double figures.

#### Newcomers

- · Amaria Fields, Maria Gakdeng, Andrea Daley and Waggoner make up the group of newcomers.
- •The trio of freshmen in Fields, Gakdeng and Daley were nationally ranked on numerous recruiting sites
- Fields is a 5'11 freshman from Texas that was rated the No. 44 prospect at her position according to the Dan Olson Collegiate Report.
- From Maryland, Gadkeng was rated 76th nationally over and 18th at her position according to Blue Star Basketball



#### **Three's Company**

- The trio of Soule, Swartz, and Dickens are back as one of the most dangerous scoring trios in the league.
- Soule (15.7 ppg), Swartz (13.4 ppg), and Dickens (12.6 ppg) combined to score 41.7 points per game, which was 61 percent of the team's scoring output.
- Of the top trios in the ACC, the Boston College trio is tied with NC State for second in highest returning trio in scoring.
- The scoring trio of Elizabeth Kitley, Aisha Sheppard, and Georgia Aramore of Virginia Tech averaged 47.7 ppg.

### **Spreading the Wealth**

- The Eagles assisted on 72.6 of their field goals (45/62) through the first two games while assisting on 95 of 142 field goals in their four wins.
- BC assisted on 75.9 percent of its field goals against Holy Cross, which was the third-highest assisted shot rate in the Bernabei-McNamee era.
- Since the 2018-19 season, the Eagles are 8-3 when assisting on at least 70 percent of their field goals and 22-10 when assisting at least on 60 percent of made baskets.
- Four players are averaging at least two assists per game, while Marnelle Garraud (5.0 apg) and Kaylah Ivey (3.2 apg) are dishing out a combined 8.2 assists per game.
- In the Eagles' lone loss against Boston University, they only had 12 helpers on 28 baskets.

- The Eagles are averaging 40.6 points in the third and fourth periods, while 54.6 percent of its scoring has come in the second half.
- · BC is shooting 56.0 percent in the second half compared to 39.7 percent in the first half.


