Last season, the Nittany Lions took a 2-0 setback in game one as Tori Dubois tallied the only hit of the game. In game two, the Blue and White were again kept to one hit. Madison Shaffer pitched a gem, going all eight innings in the 1-0 loss with four strikeouts.

### **SCOUTING SAINT FRANCIS**

The Red Flash, under seventh year head coach Jennifer Patrick-Swift, hold a 24-17 overall record and are 6-0 to open conference play. Saint Francis is hitting .251 as a team and keeping opponents at a .227 batting average. Madison Cabell and Sierra McKee are the two Red Flash hitters with batting averages over .300, hitting .325 and .314, respectively. Cabell has a team-best 41 hits, which includes eight doubles, one triple, and 12 home runs, while she has driven in 40 RBI in 41 appearances. McKee has driven in 20 runs on the year on 38 hits with eight doubles and five home runs. The Red Flash also have speed on the base path, having stolen 40 bases on 49 attempts. Jordan Seneca, who bats in the six hole for Saint Francis, has stolen 15 bases on 16 attempts this season as she carries a .403 on-base percentage with 31 walks on the season. The Red Flash have two different looks in the circle with Abby Trahan and Adrian Smith. Trahan has taken on the majority of the work load in the circle, throwing 182.1 innings in 33 appearances and 26 starts, while Smith has only thrown 86.2 innings in the season.

### **DUBOIS PROVIDING POWER IN THE LINEUP**

Junior **Tori Dubois** has been one of the top hitters for the Nittany Lion offense the past two seasons and her recent move to the leadoff position has proved to be no different. The Mt. Vernon, New Hampshire native blasted home runs in back-to-back games for the Nittany Lions against Michigan State. Dubois also is hitting .370 when she is the first batter of the inning and .500 when bases are loaded. Furthermore, Dubois is 12-for-35 with runners in scoring position to hold a .343 batting average. Finally, the starting left fielder is on a team-best six-game hitting streak and nine-game reached base streak heading into the doubleheader.

### **GRIECO STEPS UP**

Sophomore walk-on **Amanda Grieco** was given the opportunity to pinch hit with runners in scoring position against Michigan Friday, April 6. The Basking Ridge, New Jersey native dug in and roped a double into the left center field gap, bringing in both of Penn State runs against the Wolverines. The extra-base hit marked the first of her career donning the Blue and White. Grieco has since earned the start at second base and is on a five-game reached base streak for the Nittany Lions. The starting second baseman had two hits and brought in two runs for the Blue and White in game one of the three-game series against the Spartans.

### **ELLING WORKS THE PLATE AT No. 22 OHIO STATE**

Sophomore **Delaney Elling** went a perfect 4-for-4 from the batter's box against No. 22 Ohio State and drove in three of Penn State's four runs in game two. Elling ripped a double off the left center field wall in her first at-bat before following it up with a single to bring in her third run of the day in her second time at the plate. This season, Elling has driven in 12 runs on 20 hits and ranks third on the team with a .238.

### Amanda Lehotak at a Glance

In her fourth season at the helm, Lenotak led the Nittany Lions to 23 wins, including to the quarterfinals of the Big Ten Tournament after an upset victory over Nebraska. The Blue and White picked up two wins over ranked opponents in the 2017 campaign, including beating then-No. 4 LSU and then-No. 25 Ohio State. Lehotak guided First

Team All-Big Ten selection Tori Dubois to a .457 batting average in Big Ten play to rank third in the conference, while Rebecca Ziegler notched Big Ten All-Tournament honors in 2017. Senior Shelby Miller closed out her career under Lehotak ranking second in Penn State career laurels with 118 RBIs and went out as the career sacrifice hit leader with nine, while senior Kristina Brackpool ranks No. 7 all-time with 106 RBIs and No. 9 all-time with 19 home runs. In the circle, the Nittany Lions saw an increase in complete games going from 16 in 2016 to 25 in 2016, while strikeouts jumped from 180 to 194 in the 2017 campaign. Senior Marlaina Laubach started a team-best 25 games and threw 14 complete games en route to 12 wins. The right-handed hurler closed out her career as the all-time leader with 139 appearances in the circle and ranks third with 97 starts and fourth with four career saves Laubach tallied 46 career victories to rank sixth all-time and tossed 611.1 innings to rank fifth all-time in Nittany Lion laurels, while her 49 complete games and 323 strikeouts rank seventh all-time for the Blue and White.

Lehotak led Penn State to its most successful season since the 2011 campaign with a 30-24 overall record and a fourth-place 14-9 record in the Big Ten Conference, breaking three offensive records in the process. The 2016 Nittany Lions posted a record-breaking .314 batting average with 468 hits that included 75 doubles. The Blue and White got off to its best start in conference action in the history of the program with an 11-3 record before winning a program-best five conference series and sweeping three B1G series in 2016. Penn State carried an 11-game win streak at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field, sweeping two conference series at home. The Blue and White secured 14 wins in 2016, which ranks second in program history and earned 10 wins for just the eighth time in program history. Furthermore, the Nittany Lions reached their 10 conference victories in fewer games than any other team as it took just 13 conference contests. The Nittany Lion offense had 23 games with 10-or-more hits and scored 10-or-more runs on nine occasions. After the conclusion of conference play, the Blue and White paced the conference with 457 hits, while ranking third with a .317 batting average and a .969 fielding

In 2016, senior Macy Jones broke the Penn State career RBI record and walk record with 137 career RBI and 100 career walks donning the Blue and White. Furthermore, under Lehotak's tutelage, Jones ranks in the top-10 in six single season batting categories and nine career batting categories at Penn of seven career batting categories for the Nittany Lions.

Defensively, Penn State finished the season ranked third in the Big Ten with a .969 fielding percentage, while senior Reina Furuya tied for third all-time in single game assists with eight against Saint Francis. In the circle, Marlaina Laubach established herself as the ace for Lehotak, tying for third in Penn State season history with 41 appearances and ranking fourth with 29 starts. Laubach also ranks 15th in innings pitched, tossing 165.2 for the Nittany Lions in the 2016 campaign.

# **2018** NOTES AND HEADLINES

### **COMFORTABLE AT HOME**

The Nittany Lions have seen five of their seven wins come inside the friendly confines of Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field. Penn State picked up the series victory against Kent State before earning one win against Maryland and one win against Robert Morris.

### MAKING PROGRESS AGAINST THE WOLVERINES

Despite dropping all the three games to Michigan, head coach Amanda Lehotak has seen progress in her team against the No. 17 Wolverines. The Nittany Lions played six innings in game one with sophomore Amanda Grieco stepping in as a pinch hitter and ripping her first career extra-base hit to drive in two runs. In Saturday's contest, junior hurler **Madison Shaffer** went all seven innings, giving up just three runs on five hits. In the series finale, junior Tori **Dubois** launched her team-best fifth home run of the season.

### SHAFFER THROWS GEM AGAINST No. 17 MICHIGAN

Junior pitcher Madison Shaffer had the Wolverine hitters on their toes throughout all seven innings in game two of the series. Shaffer threw a complete game, having given up just two hits threw six innings of work before Michigan scored three runs on three hits in the top of the seventh inning to earn the win. The New Castle, Pennsylvania native struck out four Wolverine hitters in her seven innings of work.

### FEY POISED FOR BREAKOUT FRESHMAN SEASON

Freshman **Dani Fey** has been standout at the plate for the Nittany Lions since moving into the leadoff spot in the batting order in the third week of the season. Fey hit .385 in Jacksonville, Florida and carried a .556 on-base percentage, drawing four walks, while also holding a .385 slugging percentage. The freshman outfielder tallied five hits while scoring a team-high five times for the Blue and White in its five games at the JU Tournament. Since then, Fey has maintained the leadoff spot for the Nittany Lions, hitting .341 when she is State. Senior Lexi Knief also closed out her career in the top-10 the first batter of the inning. The Bangor, Pennsylvania native ranks fourth in the Big Ten Conference in walks with 26 base on balls.

### **POLK PERFECTION**

Junior Toni Polk put together a perfect plate performance in game three of the Big Ten Conference series against Rutgers, going 4-for-4. The junior outfielder notched two singles and two doubles and drove in one run in the final game against the Scarlet Knights. Polk's performance allowed her to take a team-high .305 batting average and a team-best 29 hits.

### **BIG HITS AGAINST SCARLET KNIGHTS**

The Penn State softball team capped off the weekend With Penn State's series opening win over Maryland, series with a 7-3 victory over Rutgers. The Nittany Lions head coach **Amanda Lehotak** picked up her 100th tallied a season-high 16 hits, scoring seven runs and win at Penn State. Furthermore, the win marked the committing just one error in the field. Junior **Toni Polk** 289th career win for the Lehotak. Lehotak is in her fifth had a perfect day at the plate going 4-for-4 with one season with the Nittany Lions, leading Penn State to RBI. Junior **Meghan Williams** also had a big day at the a Big Ten Tournament quarterfinal appearance in 2017 dish for the Blue and White, going 3-for-4. Juniors **Tori** and a semifinal appearance in 2016. Under Lehotak's **Dubois** and **Paige Johnson** had two hits and two RBI on the day and sophomore **Destiny Weber** had two hits and one RBI. Dubois and Weber both had home runs for the Nittany Lions with Dubois hitting her third in four games and Weber ripping her first of the season.

### FLASHING THE LEATHER

The Nittany Lion defense came up with some B1G defensive plays at Rutgers, despite falling in two games. Sophomore **Destiny Weber** made two stellar plays on the hot corner with a diving play and a line drive catch. Also making a huge catch with runners on base was the plate for a .375 batting average in the past three sophomore Delaney Elling, who dove for a ball in noman's land to prevent a run from scoring.

### **DUBOIS ROPES GRAND SLAM AGAINST ROBERT MORRIS**

In total, the Nittany Lions tallied a season-high 11 runs on 14 hits and did not make an error in the field.

### **DUBOIS BIG AGAINST KENT STATE**

Junior **Tori Dubois** opened the 2018 home campaign for the Nittany Lions with a .455 batting average, lacing five hits, driving in three RBI and scoring four times. Dubois's most important RBI of the weekend came in the bottom of the ninth inning against Kent State when she roped a single over the second baseman's head to score the runner on second and secure the 11-10 walk-off series victory for Penn State. The junior outfielder also had three putouts in left field, while carrying a .538 on-base percentage and a .636 slugging percentage through the three-game series with the Golden Flashes.

### FEY POWERFUL LEADING OFF THE LINEUP

Freshman **Dani Fey** continued to be a clutch lead off batter for Penn State as she notched a .462 on-base percentage and a .500 slugging percentage in the three-game series with Kent State. Fey hit .300 on the weekend with three hits, one RBI and scoring twice for the Blue and White, while drawing three walks at the plate. Fey ended the weekend with a double into left field in the bottom of the ninth and scored the winning run on a **Tori Dubois** single into right field.

### SHAFFER FINDS CONFIDENCE IN THE CIRCLE

Junior hurler **Madison Shaffer** found her stride at the Jacksonville Tournament for the Nittany Lions. Shaffer made a statement in the circle in week three of the season, pitching in all five games and making two starts for a total of 16.1 innings. The junior hurler came in against Western Carolina in relief and tossed 4.0 innings, striking out four and surrendering just one run. In her second appearance of the day, Shaffer earned the start and struck out a career-high eight batters at Jacksonville, while giving up just five hits in the loss.

### PENN STATE SECURES WIN NUMBER ONE

After searching for its groove with a young team, the Nittany Lions put it all together when they played their second game at Jacksonville Friday, Feb. 23. Penn State used a string of hits to bring in its runs, while getting the leadoff batter on four times in the contest. After the Dolphins tied the game, Penn State would answer to go up by one, 3-2, before Fey scored one final security run to help the Blue and White to a 4-2 victory.

### THREE HITTERS EMERGE IN WEEK ONE

Despite playing only 12 innings opening weekend and only one hitter seeing over five at-bats outside, three hitters have emerged to lead Penn State this season. Junior **Tori Dubois** is poised to surpass her 2017 season, securing hits in back-to-back games over the weekend and tallying the lone hit against No. 11 Alabama, while sophomore **Destiny Weber** also notched two hits for the Blue and White. Weber placed a ball to the middle infield against Virginia Tech that would cause a throwing error, scoring Penn State's lone run of the weekend. # BLUE AND WHITE TO PLAY 24 HOME GAMES IN 2018

Penn State will play 24 of its 56 scheduled games insides the friendly confines of Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field. The home-heavy schedule will be a nice change for the Blue and White as it played only 15 of its 56 games at home in the 2017 campaign. Penn State will kick off its season with 20 away contests before opening its 2018 home campaign with a weekend series against non-conference opponent Kent State, March 16-18. The Nittany Lions hold a 61-59-1 overall record at Beard Field in its seven year existence which is good for a .504 winning percentage. Penn State will play 10 home contests in the month of March before taking on six opponents in 14 games in the month of April.

Penn State softball fans will see a new look on the field as it returns just four starters to its 2018 lineup.
