BIG TEN TOURNAMENT UPDATES NO. 1PENN STATE VS. NO. 4 PURDUE * MARCH 3, 2012

- The Lady Lions are 16-25 all-time against Purdue, including a 2-3 mark in Big Ten Tournament games. Penn State snapped an 11-game losing streak to the Boilers with a 73-61 win in the quarterfinals of the Big Ten Tournament last year.
- Penn State is 24-15 all-time in the Big Ten Tournament, including a 12-3 mark in quarterfinal contests.
- ✓ The Lady Lions are 7-4 in Big Ten Tournament semifinal games,
- → PSU extends its winning streak to eight games, the longest streak since the 2003-04 squad won 11 consecutive contests from Jan. 2 to Feb. 5.
- ✓ The Lady Lions advanced to the Big Ten semifinals with a 78-74 comeback win over No. 8 Minnesota.
- The top seed is now 16-2 all-time in quarterfinal games.
- Alex Bentley's seven steals in the Big Ten Quarterfinal win over Minnesota are tied for the fifth-most in a tourney game.
- Sophomore Maggie Lucas sprinted up Penn State's single-season scoring chart after a 24 point night against Minnesota in the Big Ten quarters. With 565 points this year, she jumped seven spots to 11th place on the scoring chart. She is also third on PSU's sophomore season scoring list.
- With 24 points against Minnesota, sophomore Maggie Lucas surpassed the 1,100-point plateau for her career. Additionally, Lucas moved into 29th place on Penn State's career scoring list, passing Missy Masley (1,106; 1992-95).
- Friday's win over Minnesota marked the 90th win of Coquese Washington's career.
- With 11 points and eight rebounds against the Golden Gophers, junior center Nikki Greene reached a pair of milestones. Greene surpassed the 800-point mark and 700-rebound plateau for her career.
- In two of the three games against Minnesota this season, the Lady Lions have had two rally from double figure deficits for the victory. At Minnesota, the Lady Lions erased a 15-point first half deficit to come back for a 68-65 win. In Friday's quarterfinal contest, Penn State was down 13 points in the opening half, but outscored the Gophers, 49-38, to come away with the 78-74 victory.
- Penn State has rallied for double-digit deficits three times this season.
- The Lady Lions clinched the Big Ten regular-season title outright for the first time since 2004 with a 74-51 win over Minnesota Feb. 26.
- ✓ It is the sixth overall regular-season crown for the Lady Lions and fourth outright (2000, 2003, 2004).
- Penn State is the top seed in the Big Ten Tournament for the first time since 2004 and the fifth time in program history (1995, 2000, 2003, 2004).
- ✓ The Pink Zone crowd of 13,849 is the fourth-largest in school history.
- ✓ The Lady Lions picked up with 13th Big Ten win of the season. The 13 victories are the most by a Penn State team since the 2004-05 squad went 13-3 in conference play.
- Coquese Washington was selected as the Big Ten Coach of the Year by both the coaches and the media. She joins four-time winner Rene Portland (1994, 2000, 2003, 2004) on the list of PSU mentors to win top coaching honors.
- Junior guard Alex Bentley and sophomore guard Maggie Lucas were both named to the All-Big Ten first team after stellar seasons.
- A first team choice last season, Bentley becomes the ninth different Lady Lion to earn first team accolades twice, while Lucas is the 12th different Penn State player to earn top all-conference honors.
- The Lady Lions have 26 All-Big Ten first team selections, the most of any team in the Big Ten since joining the conference in 1992-93.
- Nikki Greene earned third team All-Big ten honors from media and an honorable mention nod from coaches.
- Senior guard Zhaque Gray and junior forward Mia Nickson were named Honorable Mention All-Big Ten.
- The Purdue and Ohio State wins gave the Lady Lions back-to-back victories over Top 20 opponents for the first time since the 1999-00 season.
- Junior guard Alex Bentley paced Big Ten action with 49 steals in 16 games. She is the first Lady Lion to lead the league in steals since Jess Strom did it in back-to-back years in 2003-04 and 2004-05.
- The Lady Lions led all teams in scoring (74.8 ppg) for the first time since the 2002-03 squad averaged 74.6 points in 16 conference games.
- ✓ Penn State also won the Big Ten title for rebounding margin (+6.1) for the first time since 1998-99 (+5.1).
- The Lady Lions moved up two spots in this week's Associated Press Top 25 to ninth place, it's highest ranking of the year. It is the Lady Lions' highest ranking in the AP poll since they were fifth in the 2004 poll.
- PSU moved up to 12th in the Feb. 28 ESPN/USA Today coaches poll. It ranking equals Penn State's best of the year and is the highest ranking in the Coaches' Poll since they were seventh in the final 2004 poll.
