

FIRST SERVE

» Penn State will travel to Cambridge, MA to take on Harvard Friday, Feb. 12 at 7 p.m. ET, followed by a roadtrip to Fairfield, CT to take on the Pioneers of Sacred Heart Saturday February, 13 at 7 p.m.

» Penn State went 1-0 last week, winning in straight sets, against Mount Olive in Rec Hall pushing the all-time series record to 9-0 - Penn State pushed its series set record to 27-0 against the Trojans of Mount Olive dating back to 2005.

» Penn State jumped one spot to No. 7 in the latest AVCA Top 15 Coaches Poll. PSU has been in the top 15 the last five consecutive weeks since debuting at No. 10 in the AVCA DI-II pre-season poll. The Nittany Lions have now seen or will see a total of nine teams from the top 15 at some point during the regular season.

» Penn State is currently second in the EIVA with a 1-0 record in conference play. Princeton is first in the EIVA with a record of 2-4 overall and 2-0 in conference play following a straight set win over Charleston (W.V.) on February 6th.

» The Nittany Lions head to Cambridge, MA with a 9-1 all-time series lead over the Crimson. Penn State's lone loss in the series came on February 15, 2013 on the road. Harvard swept the Nittany Lions 3-0 to upset the then No. 9 team in the country.

» Penn State will look to continue its success against Sacred Heart Saturday February 13th as they'll enter the match holding an 8-0 series lead over the Pioneers. The Nittany Lions defeated Sacred Heart 3-1 during their last matchup in Rec Hall back on April 11, 2015.

» This is the third straight week that Penn State will face a team they've never lost to following matchups against Saint Francis, as Penn State extended the all-time series to 37-0 against the Red Flash, and Mount Olive who Penn State sent home in straight sets to bring the all time series record to 9-0 since the series began in 2005.

» Following a 2015 season that featured Penn State men's volleyball's 17th consecutive trip the NCAA national semifinals, the Nittany Lions return a core group of nine letterwinners and three starters this year, while welcoming four freshmen to the roster

» Penn State is ranked in the top-25 in five different team categories including top-10 rankings in Assists Per Set - 12.79 (3rd), and and Kills Per Set - 13.46 (3rd). Individually, Chris Nugent is ranked eighth in the nation in Points Per Set (4.87) and 10th in the nation in Kills Per Set (4.15), while Taylor Hammond is ranked second in Assists Per Set currently averaging 11.27.

The 27-time defending EIVA champion Penn State men's volleyball team was selected as this year's EIVA preseason favorite. The Nittany Lions were voted to capture this year's championship crown by the league's seven head coaches, receiving six of a possible eight first-place votes in the preseason poll.

» The Nittany Lions will square off a total of nine teams featured in the this season's AVCA preseason poll including eight teams ranked within the top 15 and two receiving votes.

» University Park will be the site of the 2016 National Collegiate Men's Volleyball Championship, marking the sixth time in school history that Rec Hall has hosted the event. Penn State will serve as the host of the vaunted event on May 5-7, 2016. Penn State men's volleyball was selected as one of two Nittany Lion programs to host an NCAA national championship.

FRESH FACES ON THE COURT IN 2016






