## UCF VS. PENN STATE - THE MATCHUP

### THE SERIES

• In the first meeting between UCF and Penn State in 2002, the No. 24 Nittany Lions scored 17 unanswered points after halftime en route to a 27-24 win. Matt Prater was 3-for-3 in field goals, Ryan Schneider went 32-for-46 with 345 yards and Doug Gabriel caught 11 passes for 153 yards.

• Two years later and with head coach George O'Leary in his first season at UCF, the visitors dropped a 37-13 decision.

• UCF has a 4-4 all-time record vs. teams from the Keystone State.

### SCOUTING THE PENN STATE NITTANY LIONS

• After Eastern Michigan returned a fumble 11 yards to lead Penn State, 7-0, the Nittany Lions scored 45 unanswered points for a 45-7 win Sept. 7. Combined with a 23-17 neutral-site victory over Syracuse Aug. 31, PSU currently stands 2-0 on the year.

• PSU posted 574 total yards compared to EMU's 183.

• For 2013, true freshman QB Christian Hackenberg is completing 70.3 percent of his passes with three TDs and three INTs.

• Three running backs have at least 100 yards this season: Bill Belton (127), Akeel Lynch (108) and Zach Zwinak (104).

• Penn State has five sacks, but given up seven.

• PSU has converted 2-of-26 third-down opportunities.

## TEAM NOTES

### THE START OF AN ENTERTAINING SERIES WITH PSU

- With a 2-0 record, UCF kicks off a two-game series with 2-0 Penn State Saturday at 6 p.m. on Big Ten Network. It will be the Knights' first trip to Beaver Stadium since 2004.
- Next season's contest will take place across the pond for the Croke Park Classic in Dublin, Ireland, Aug. 30, 2014.
- If the Knights can get a victory in Pennsylvania, they will move to 3-0 for the first time since 1988 and for the fourth time dating back to the first year of the program in 1979.
- Since joining its first conference in 2002 (MAC), UCF has never won two non-conference regular-season road games in the same year. It will be looking to do that Saturday at Penn State.

### FACING THE BIG TEN

- The 2013 schedule serves as the second-straight season UCF travels to a Big Ten opponent, as it visited Ohio State in 2012.
- This will be UCF's eighth contest against current Big Ten teams as it has faced Nebraska (0-1), Purdue (0-2) and Wisconsin (0-1) along with PSU (0-2) and OSU (0-1) since the Knights jumped to the FBS level in 1996. It also will be the first of two trips to Pennsylvania in 2013, as UCF is slated to visit Temple in Philadelphia as well.

### WHAT A DIFFERENCE

- UCF just visited FIU Stadium, which has an official capacity of 20,000, making it the second-smallest venue (Idaho) among full FBS programs this year.
- This week it travels to Beaver Stadium, the second-largest college stadium with a capacity of 106,572.

### THE TURNOVER BATTLE

- Through two games in 2013, UCF has yet to turn the ball over, and has not committed a turnover in three straight outings dating back to last year.
- The 2009 season (Rice, Marshall, Texas) was the last time the Knights went three consecutive games where they did not have a turnover.
- UCF's last time it started a season without a turnover in the first two contests was in 2006.
- The Knights are one of nine teams in the country without having a turnover this year.

### NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULE

- UCF is one of 19 schools which does not play an

FCS opponent or a school from another level.

- It has not played a FCS school since Sept. 3, 2011 (Charleston Southern). UCF is one of 11 teams in the nation without a FCS school on both its 2012 and 2013 schedules.

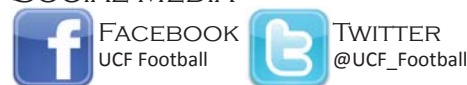

### UCF-PENN STATE CONNECTIONS

- It will be a reunion between UCF head coach George O'Leary and PSU head coach Bill O'Brien, as the Nittany Lions' leader worked under O'Leary at Georgia Tech from 1995-01, including serving as the offensive coordinator in 2001.
- This will be the first time the two veteran coaches will be on opposite sidelines.
- PSU assistant head coach and WR coach Stan Hixon was Georgia Tech's WR coach from 1995-99.
- PSU offensive line coach Mac McWhorter served in the same capacity at Georgia Tech from 2000-01 and was the assistant head coach in 2001.
- Current UCF offensive line and assistant head coach Brent Key played for both O'Leary and O'Brien with the Yellow Jackets from 1997-00.
- UCF's first head football coach, Don Jonas, was a running back at Penn State and was selected by Philadelphia in the 1961 NFL Draft. He coached the Knights from 1979-81.
- UCF does not have a player from Pennsylvania, and Penn State's lone student-athlete from Florida is redshirt freshman linebacker Gary Wooten (Miami).
- There are no high school connections between the two programs.

# OFFENSE NOTES

## A HALLMARK SHOWING

- Junior Rannell Hall recorded his first career 100-yard receiving game at FIU. He finished with four catches for 127 yards, marking the most receiving yards since A.J. Guyton had 163 at BYU Sept. 23, 2011.
- With Breshad Perriman having 113 vs. Akron, it was the first time UCF had 100-yard receivers in back-to-back games since 2010 when Jamar Newsome had 123 at Houston Nov. 5 and he then collected 100 vs. Southern Miss Nov. 13.

## EFFICIENT OFFENSE

- UCF has scored a touchdown on 48 percent (10-of-21) of its offensive possessions (not counting the two small drives at the end of each victory).
- The Knights are 4-for-4 when facing third-and-two or less.
- Blake Bortles is 7-for-12 on third-down passing, with all seven completions resulting in a first down.

## LOTS OF OPTIONS

- At FIU, UCF traveled six running backs, including four true freshmen.
- Three of those freshmen have at least two rushing attempts, led by William Stanback who is averaging a team-best 5.8 yards per carry on 93 yards and 16 rushes.
- Storm Johnson paces all running backs with 188 yards on 38 carries.

- UCF has a pair of true freshmen vying for the backup quarterback spot, and both enrolled with the Knights in the spring.
- Justin Holman has already appeared in his first collegiate game, coming on at FIU and going 2-for-2 with 11 yards.
- Pete DiNovo hails from Tarpon Springs north of St. Petersburg, and was the 2012 *Tampa Bay Times* Suncoast Player of the Year after setting the Pinellas County career record with 6,733 passing yards.

## PRODUCTION FROM EVERYONE

- J.J. Worton has posted a touchdown reception in each of the first two games, while Rannell Hall leads the team with seven catches and 181 yards.
- Hall has recorded a catch in 17 straight games, and Jeff Godfrey is right behind him with a reception in 16 consecutive outings.
- UCF's starting quarterback from 2010-11, Godfrey received his first career start as a wide receiver at FIU.

## WHAT A START

- On just the second offensive play of 2013, UCF made some history in the win against Akron, as Blake Bortles found Breshad Perriman for a 91-yard touchdown pass, marking the longest play from scrimmage in school history.

## BRESHAD MAKES A STATEMENT

- Backed by his 91-yard touchdown reception, sophomore wide receiver Breshad Perriman opened 2013 with three receptions for 113 yards vs. Akron.
- Perriman did not have more than 113 yards last season until his seventh game.
- He already has 32.2% of his total yards he put up a year ago (125 in 2013 compared to 388 in 2012).

#### Interview Policy

All interviews must be coordinated through the UCF Athletics Communications Office. Please do not attempt to contact players, coaches or other team personnel directly by any means of communication, including personal phone numbers, email and social networking accounts.

Student-athlete interviews are permitted on Tuesday and Wednesday as arranged through the athletics communications office unless practice has been closed by the head coach. Interview requests with assistant coaches must be submitted to UCF Athletics Communications for approval from head coach George O'Leary.

#### Head Coach George O'Leary

Head coach George O'Leary will be available for interviews during Monday's press conference at Bright House Networks Stadium, and following practice Thursday. The press conference begins at approximately 1 p.m. and also includes a pair of players each week.

#### Filming at Practice

On Tuesday and Wednesday only, TV station video and photo access is available during individual drills at the beginning of practice up to period five (approximately 20-25 minutes). No filming is permitted during team work. Tripods are not permitted on the practice field at all times and media must stand at least five yards off the sideline. Media members must stay on the perimeter of the practice fields. At all times, videography at practice is at the discretion of the coaching staff and the UCF Office of Athletics Communications.

#### Postgame Interviews

Coach O'Leary and selected student-athletes will meet the media approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game. UCF's locker room is closed to the media.

#### Credential Requests

All requests, home and away, for media credentials and scouting passes should be directed to the UCF Athletics Communications Office at least one week in advance. The media will call entrance at UCF is at Gate 18. Parking passes for media will be distributed based on availability and priority.

- As a member of the FCS, UCF blanked Valdosta State, 12-0, in front of 6,379 fans at Martin Stadium in Valdosta, Ga.
- Willie English put the Knights on the board with an 8-yard run in the second quarter before Ron Thow posted a 1-yard run in the third quarter. The first extra-point had a high snap, while the 2-point conversion on the second TD failed.

### BREAKING THEM IN

- UCF has used 12 true or redshirt freshmen on the defensive side of the ball, including starting defensive end Luke Adams and starting cornerback Jacoby Glenn.
- In all, the Knights have had 17 defensive players make their debuts in a Black and Gold uniform in 2013.

### SACK METER

- 2012 Conference USA All-Freshman Team member Deion Green has just two tackles this year. But the defensive end has made them count as he posted a sack against Akron and then at FIU.
- The Knights have another sack on the board, and it came from true freshman defensive end Blake Keller when he earned his first collegiate sack at FIU.
- The last true freshman to record a sack for UCF was linebacker Troy Gray when he accomplished the feat against Memphis Oct. 29, 2011.
- The last true freshman defensive lineman with a sack was E.J. Dunston vs. East Carolina Oct. 30, 2010.

### EARLY RANKINGS

- It may be early, but through the first two contests, UCF ranks in the top two in the American in rushing, passing, total and scoring defense, including placing first in the latter three categories.

### NOT ALLOWING BIG PLAYS

- Akron's longest play from scrimmage was a 23-yard rush, while FIU's biggest play came on a 20-yard pass.
- Overall, those were the only two plays the UCF defense has given up of at least 20 yards.
- Also, opponents have had just 10 passes and five rushes that went for 10 yards or more.

### NOTHING THROUGH THE AIR

- Akron mustered just 116 passing yards against the UCF defense in the season opener.
- Since the Knights joined their first conference in 2002, it was the 10th fewest passing yards given up to a non-conference opponent:

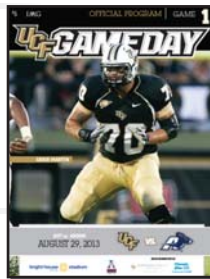
